
The ornamental design for a spoiler for a vehicle and the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION


FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a spoiler for a vehicle and the like showing my new design, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof.


FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, and
