FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of an airplane depicting our new design;

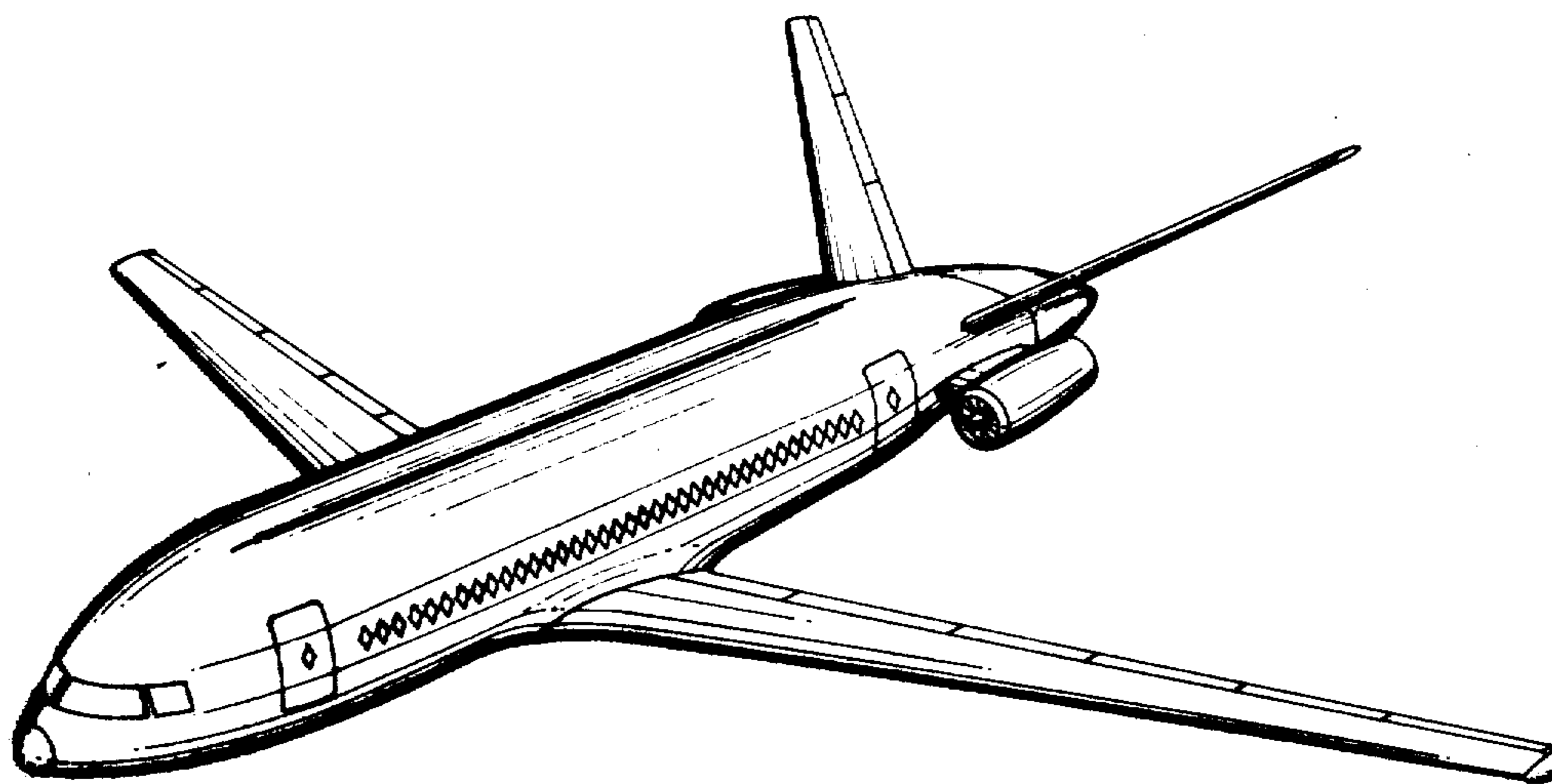
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view;

FIG. 6 is an upper rear side perspective view.



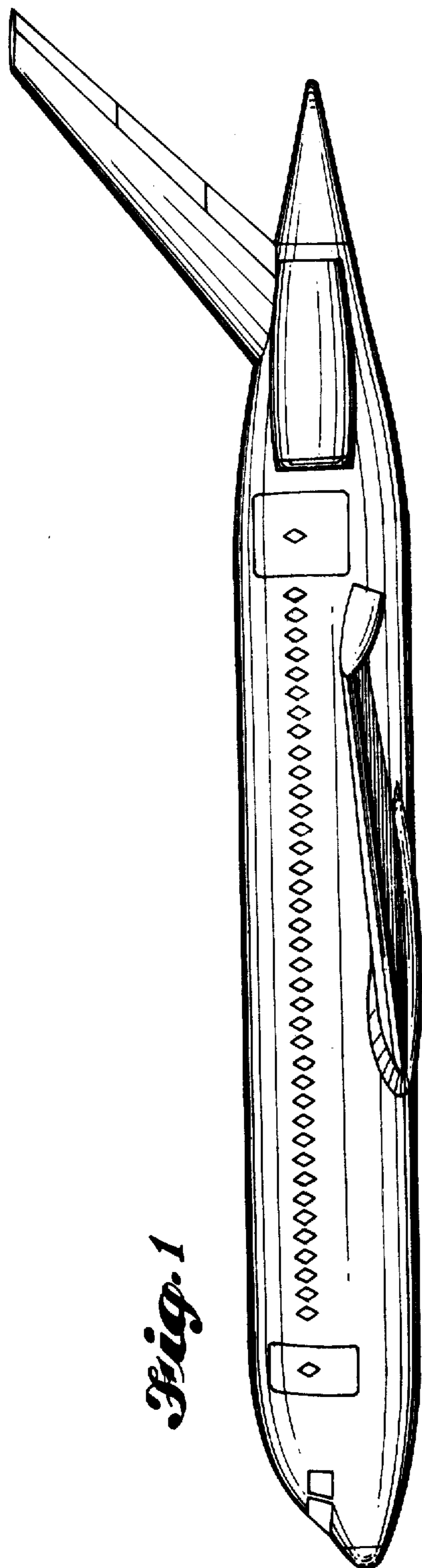

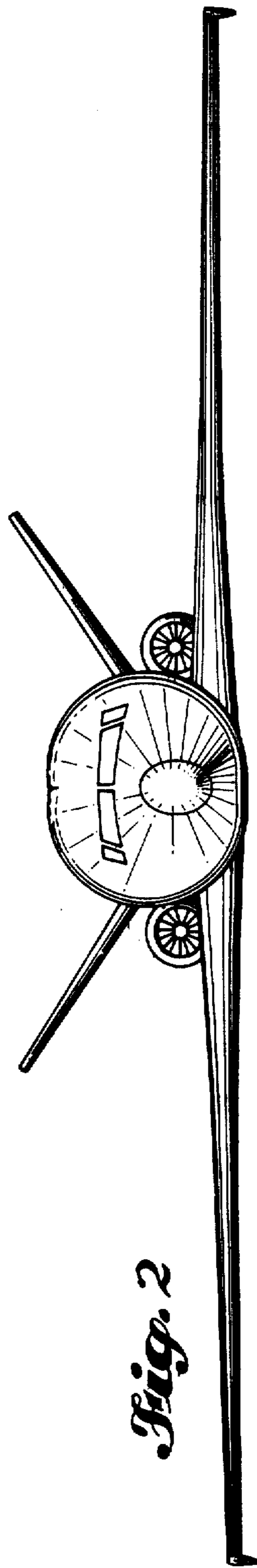
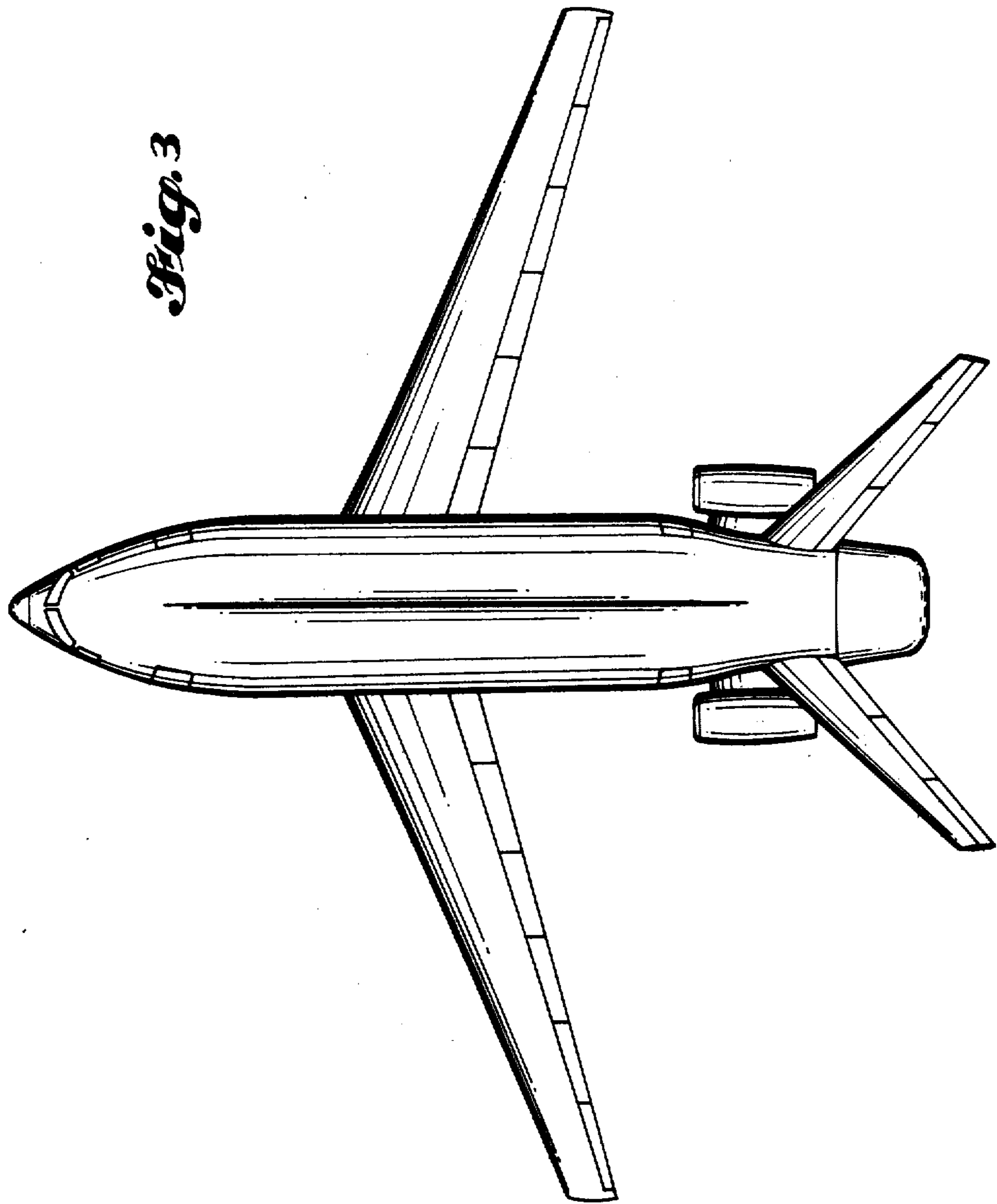

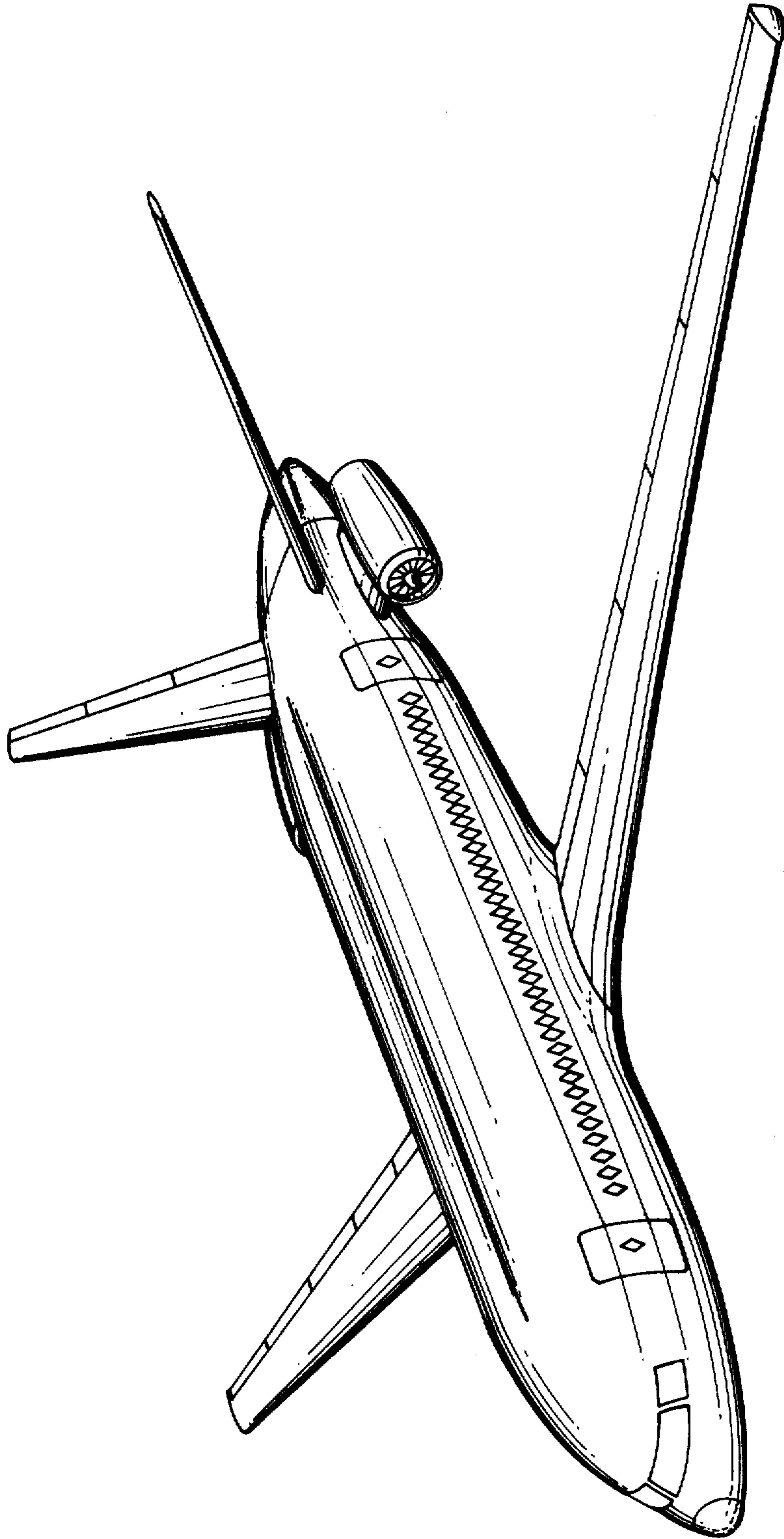

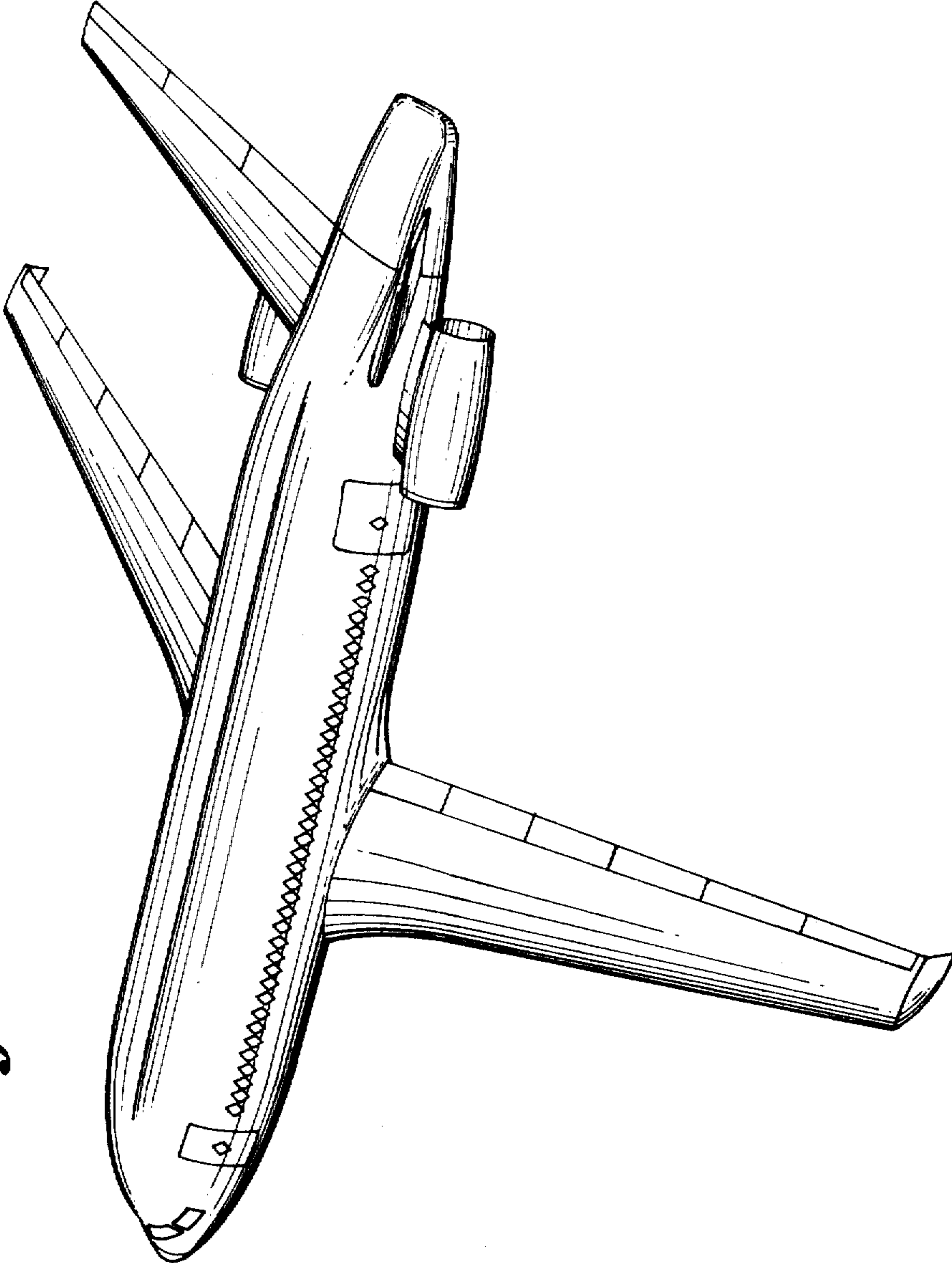

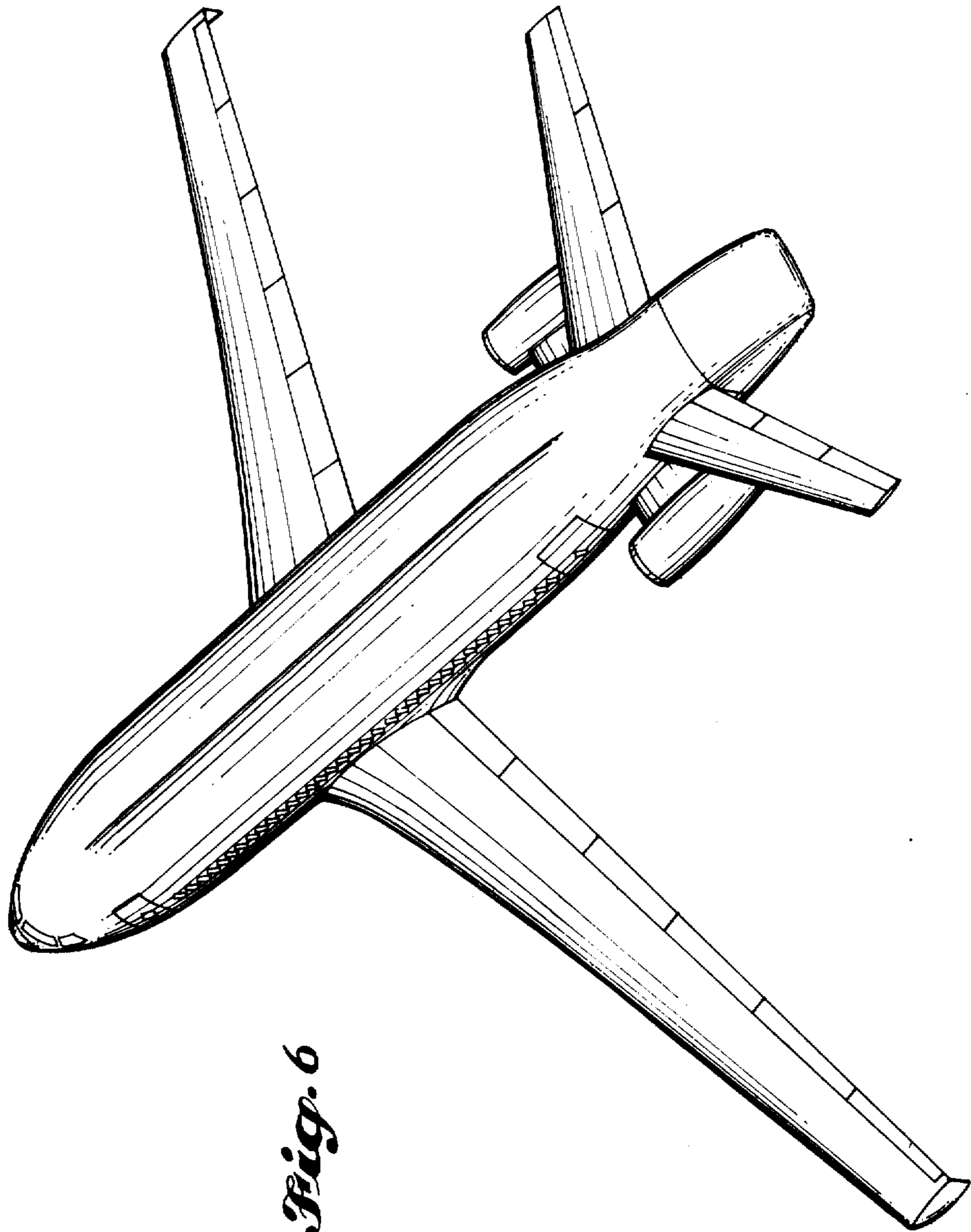
