The ornamental design for sport glasses, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

- FIG. 1 is a perspective view of sport glasses embodying my new design;
- FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale, the temples being omitted for convenience of illustration;
- FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale, the temples being omitted for convenience of illustration;
- FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof on an enlarged scale, the temples being omitted for convenience of illustration;
- FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof on an enlarged scale, the temples being omitted for convenience of illustration.

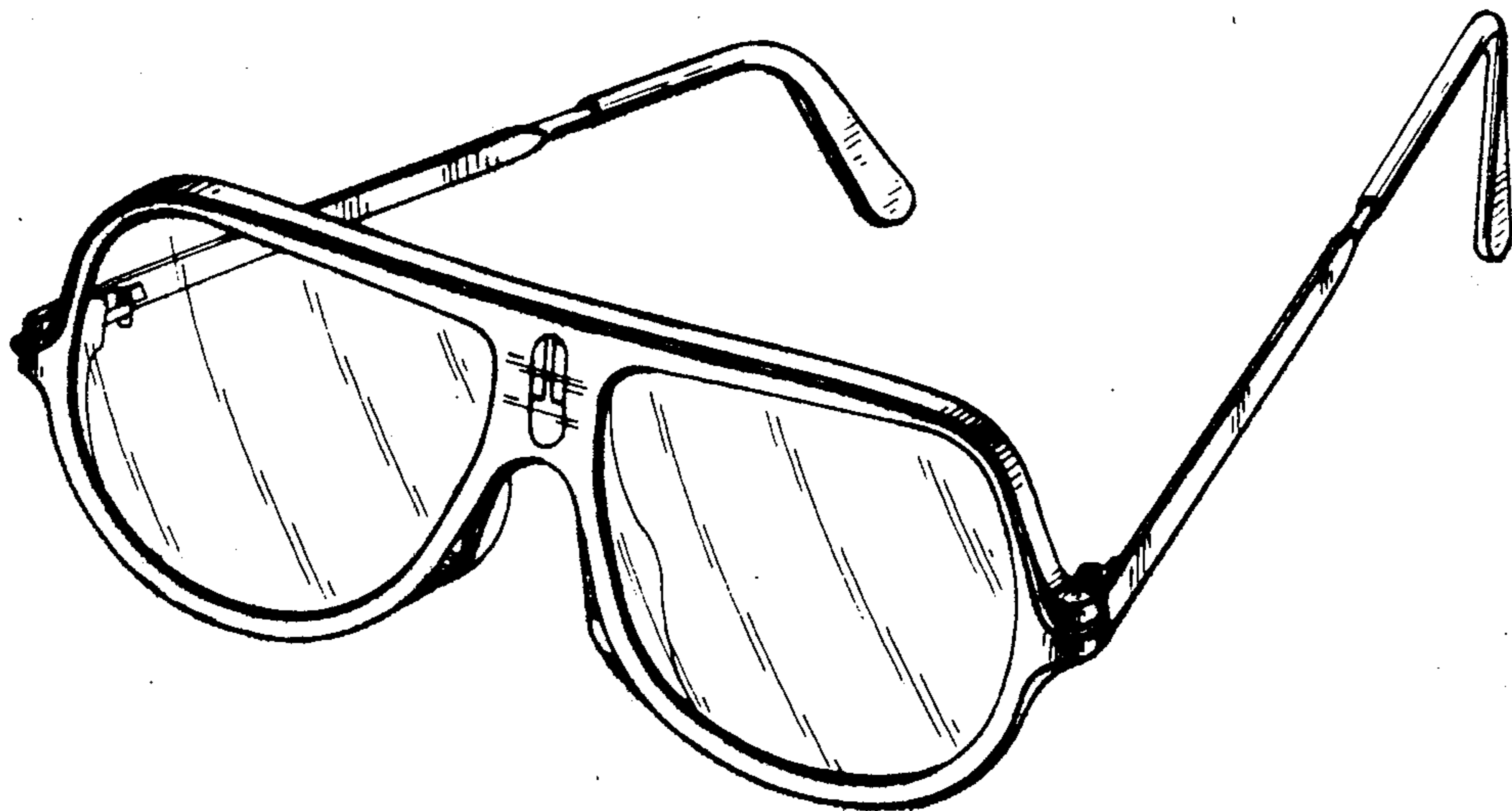

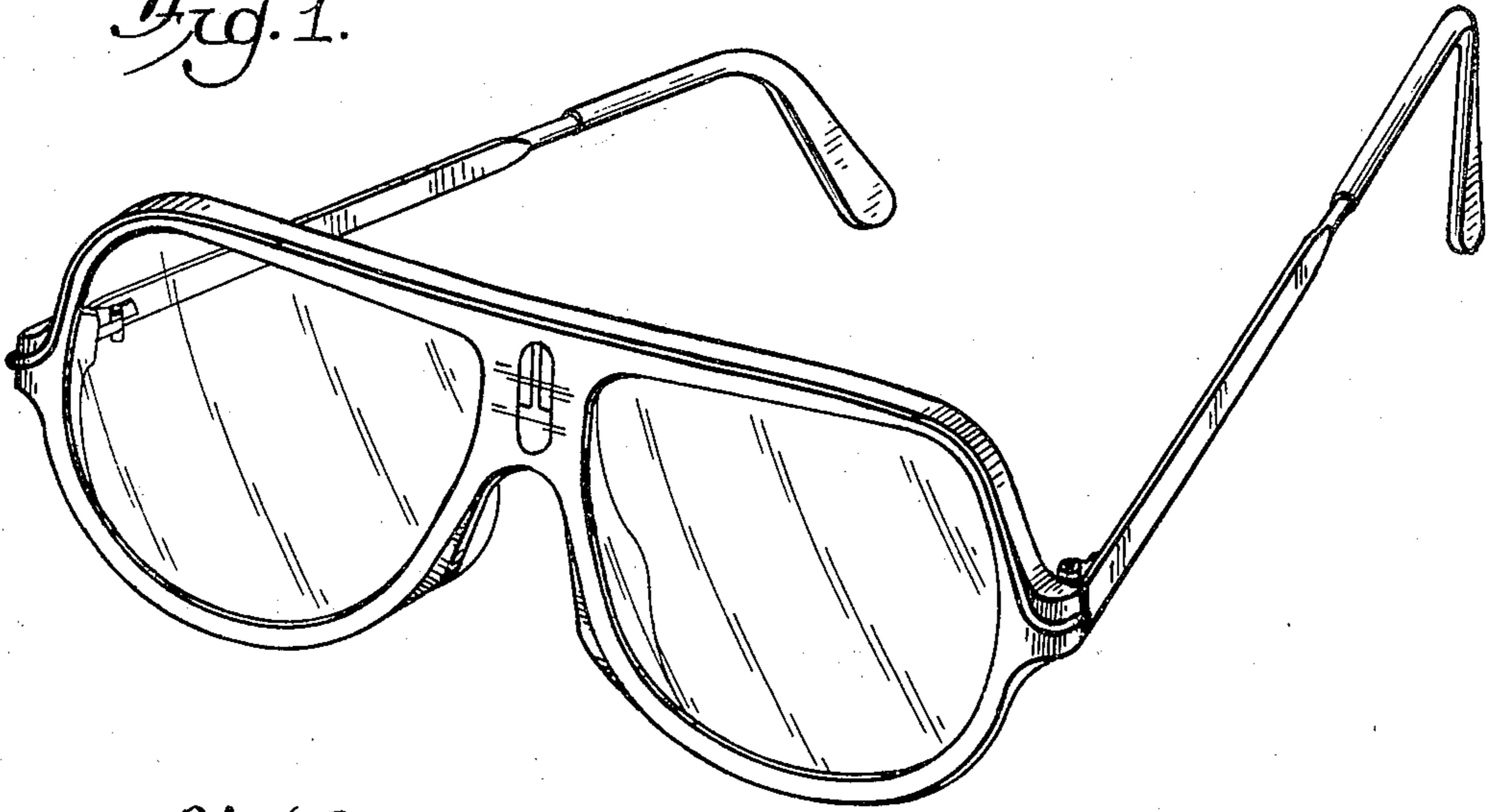

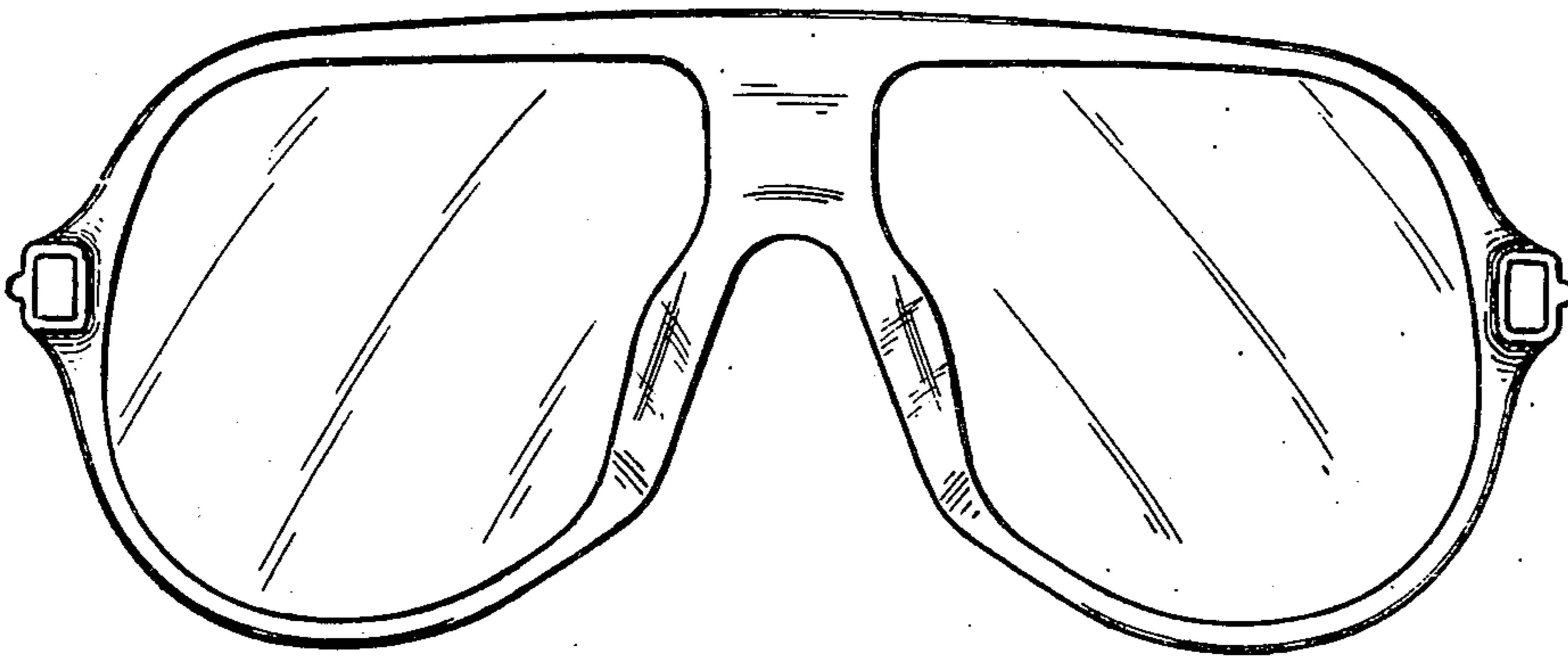

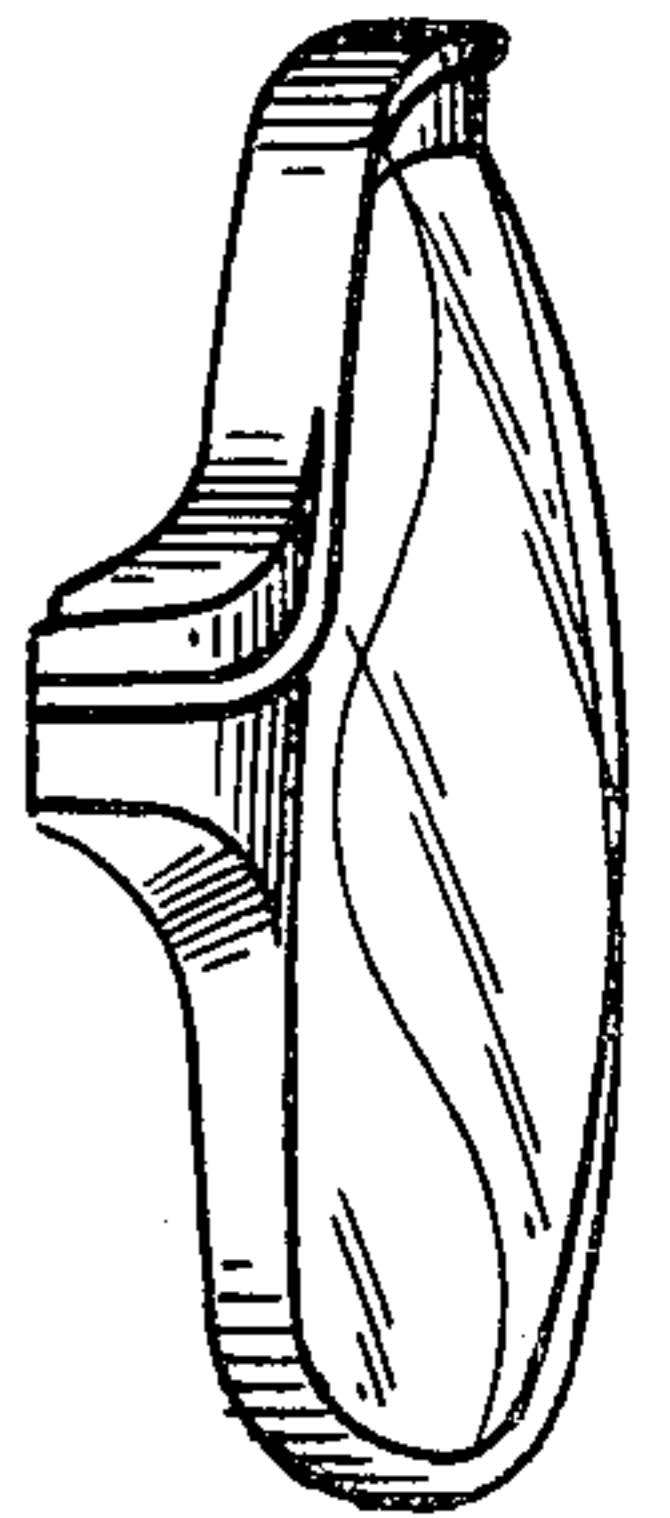
