[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a bathtub for invalids or the like, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bathtub for invalids or the like showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a perspective view taken from the rear and left side thereof; and
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof showing the access door in a open position.

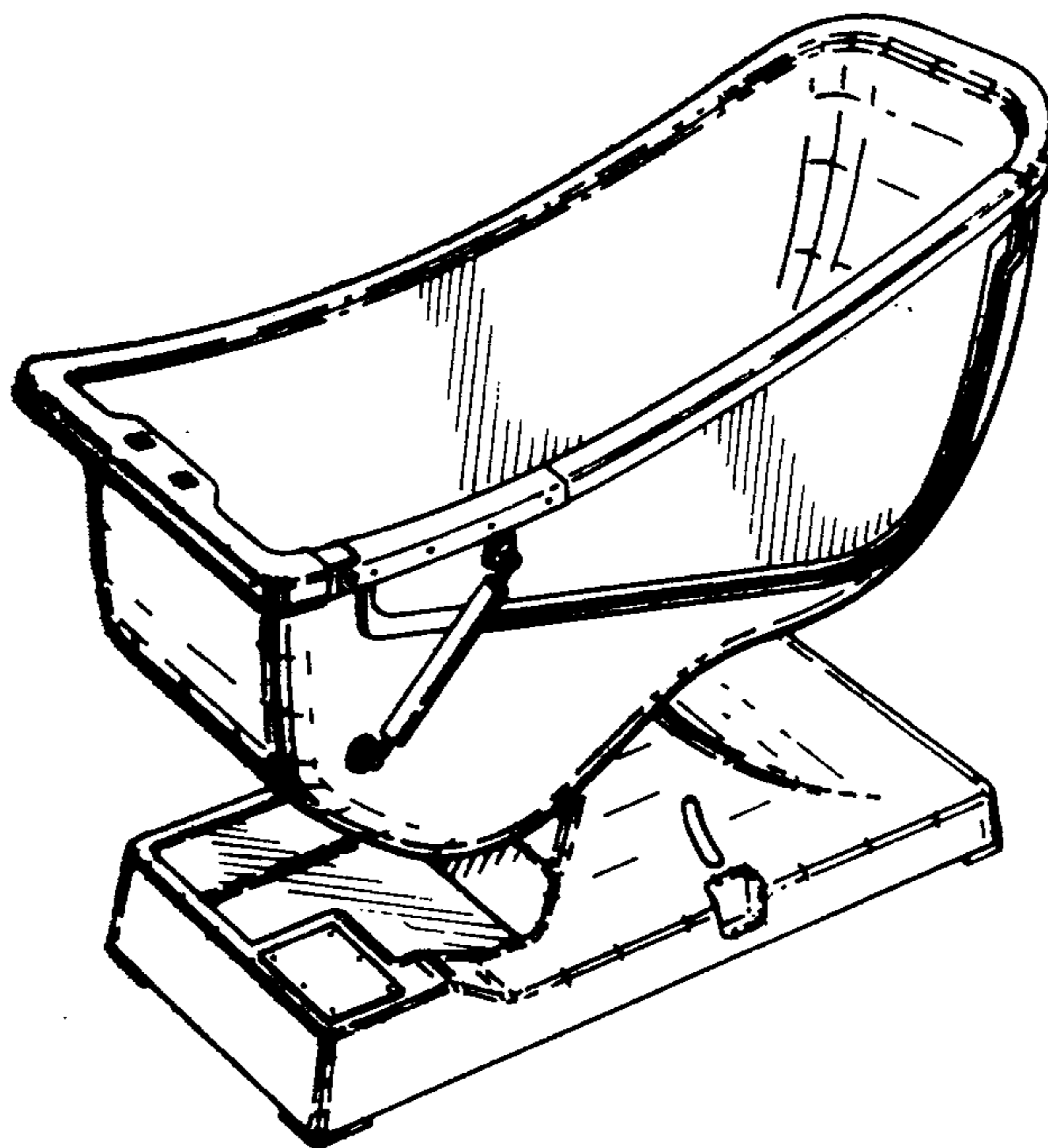

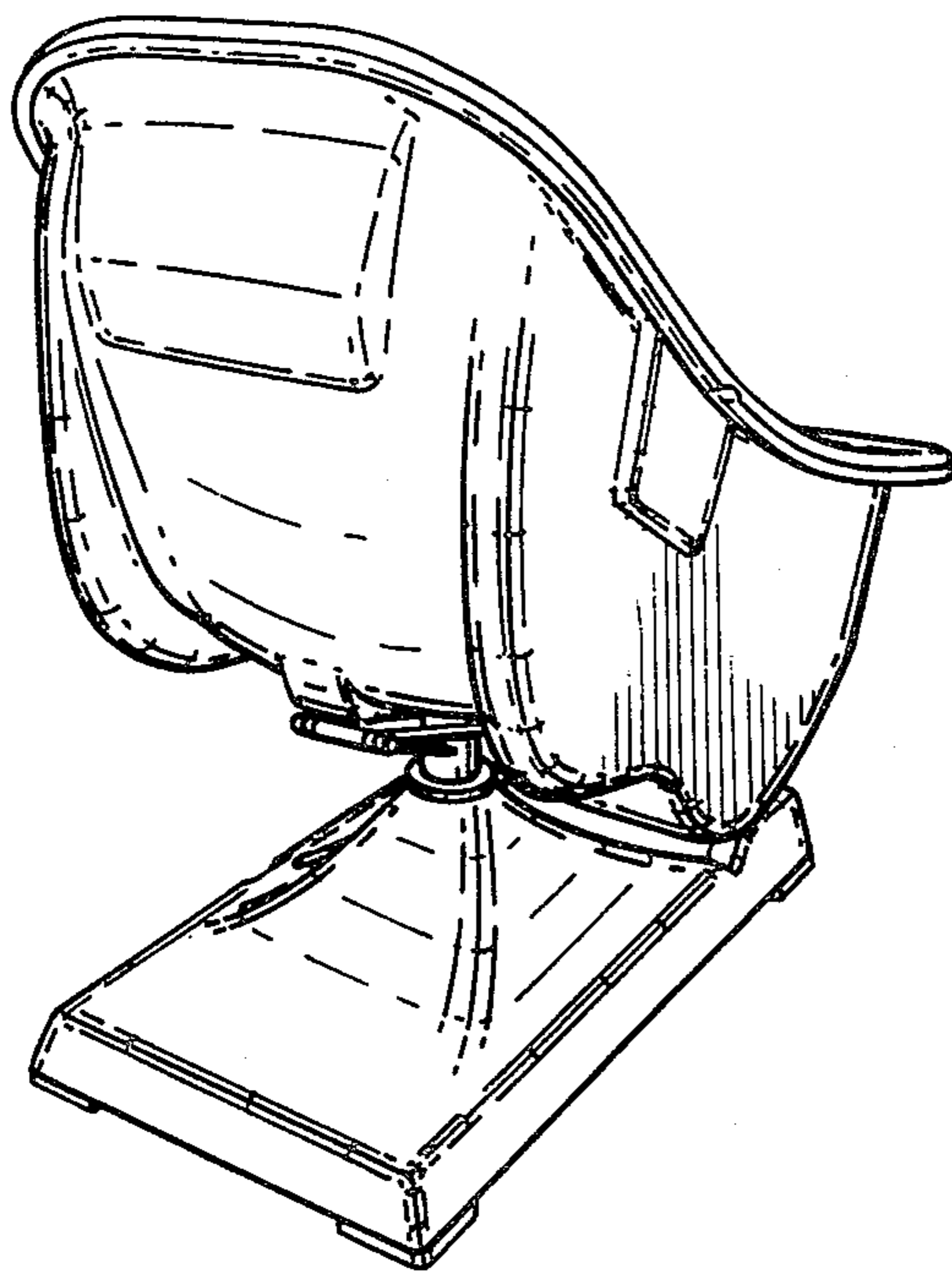
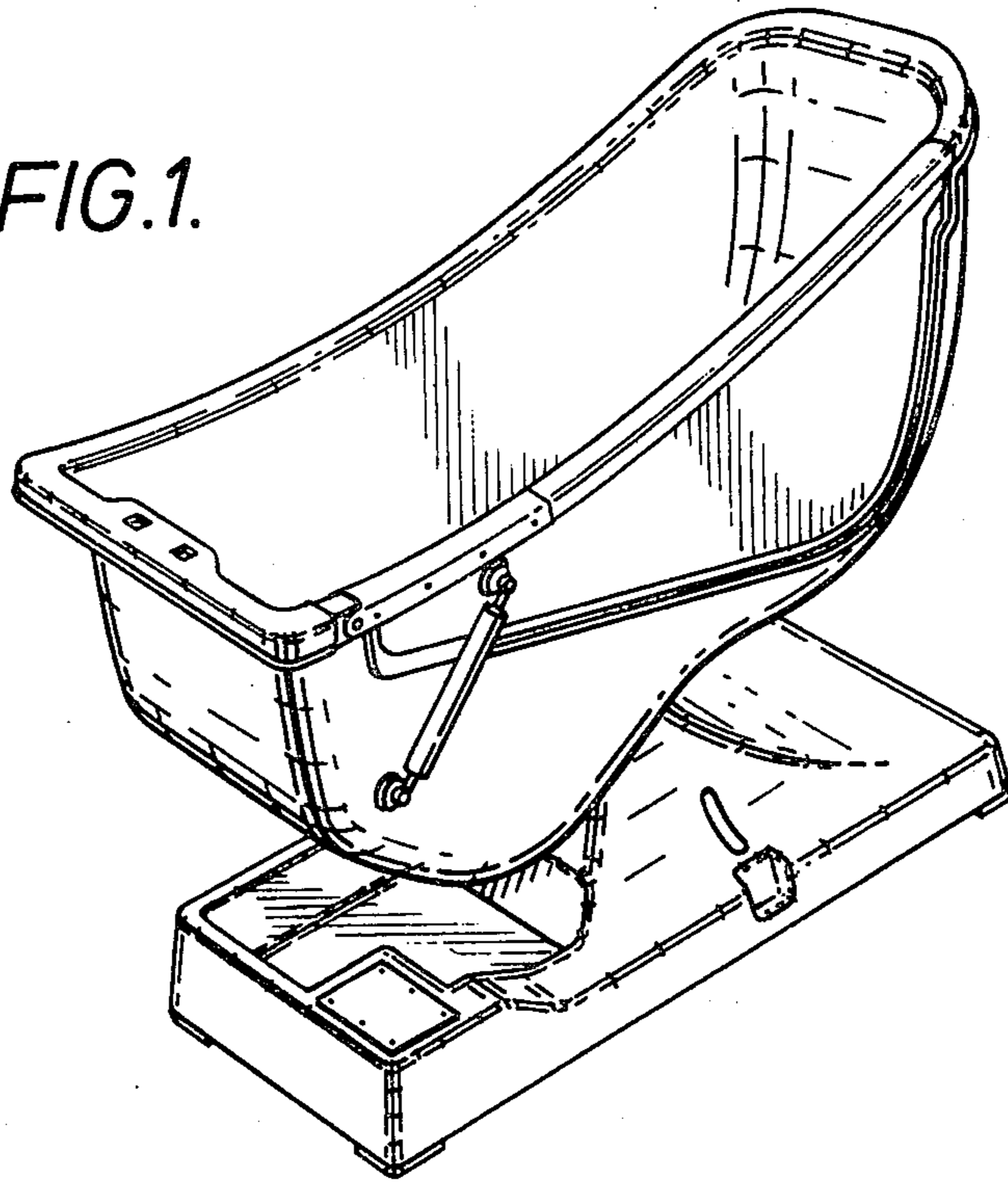
