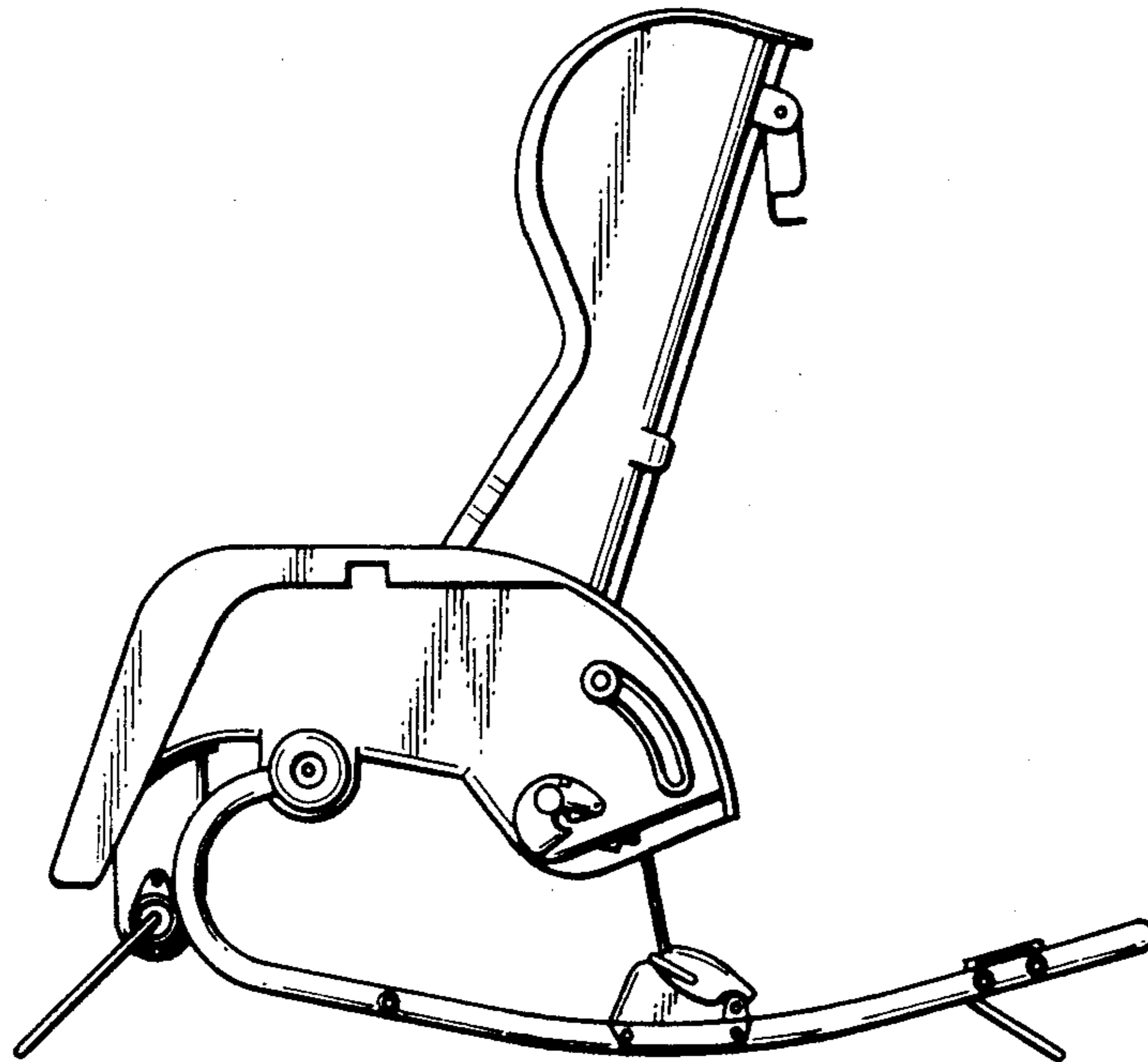

The ornamental design for a baby seat, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side elevational view of a baby seat showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a front and right side perspective view thereof; and
 FIG. 8 is a similar perspective view to that of FIG. 7 with the legs in folded up position for vehicle use.



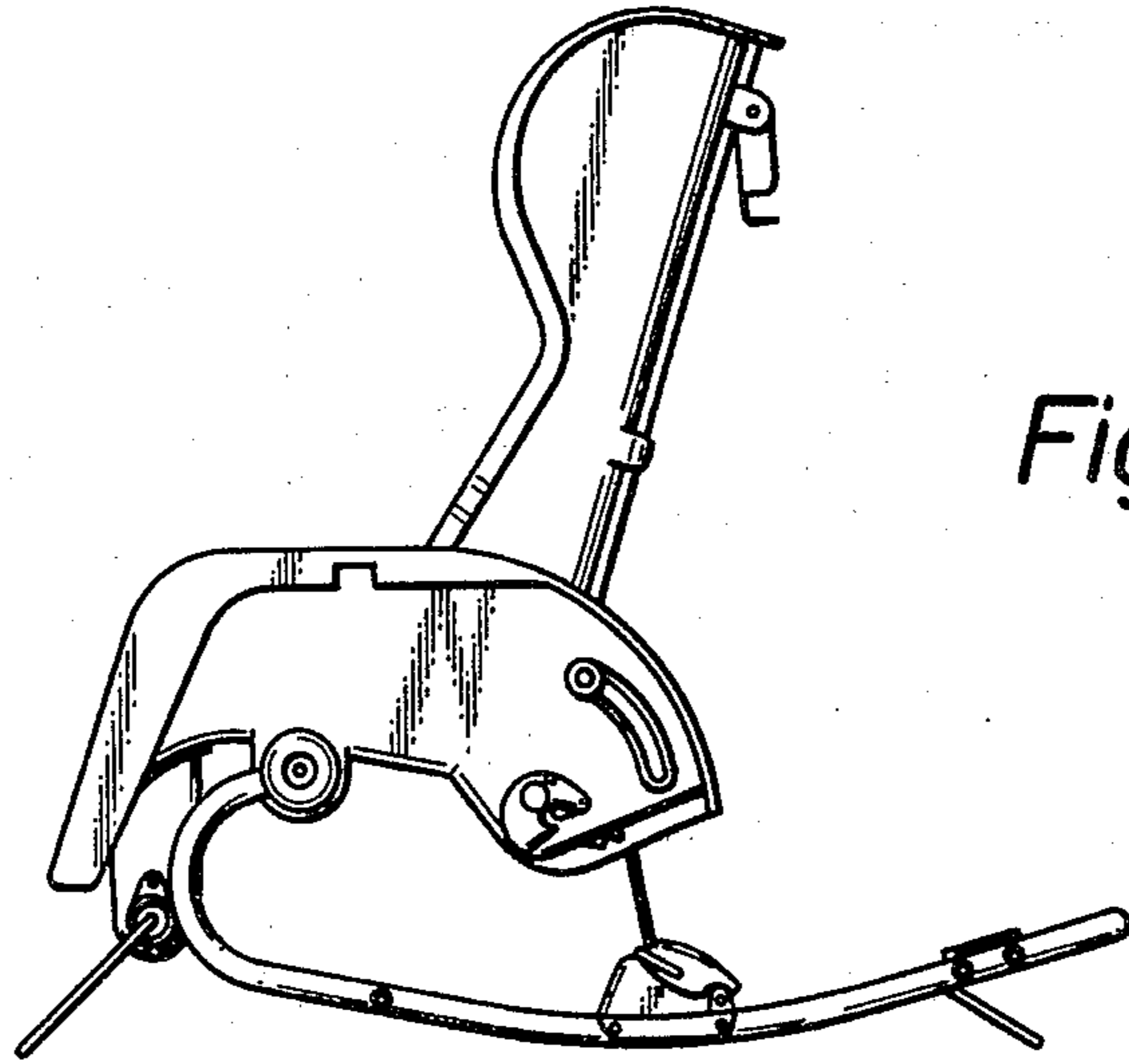

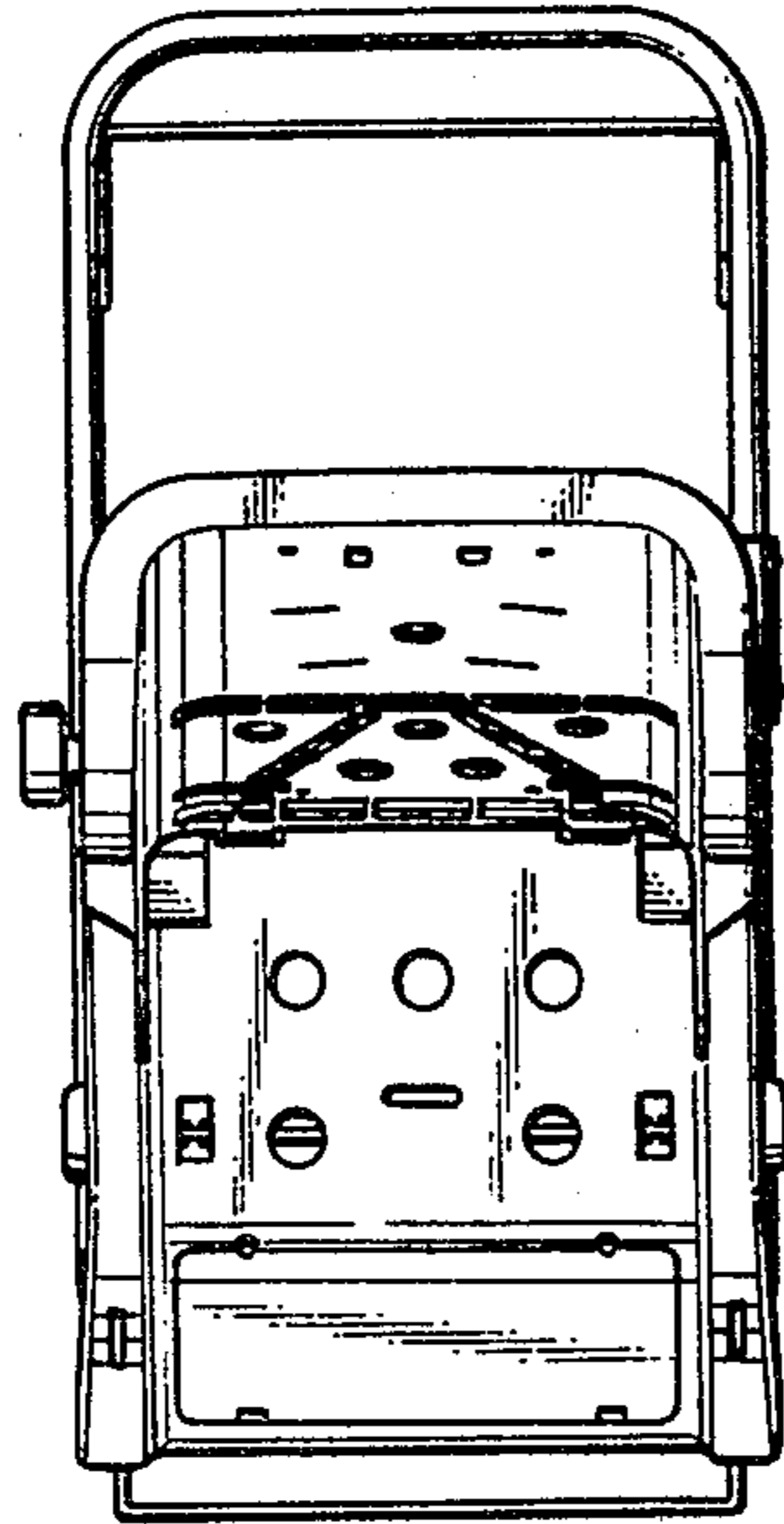

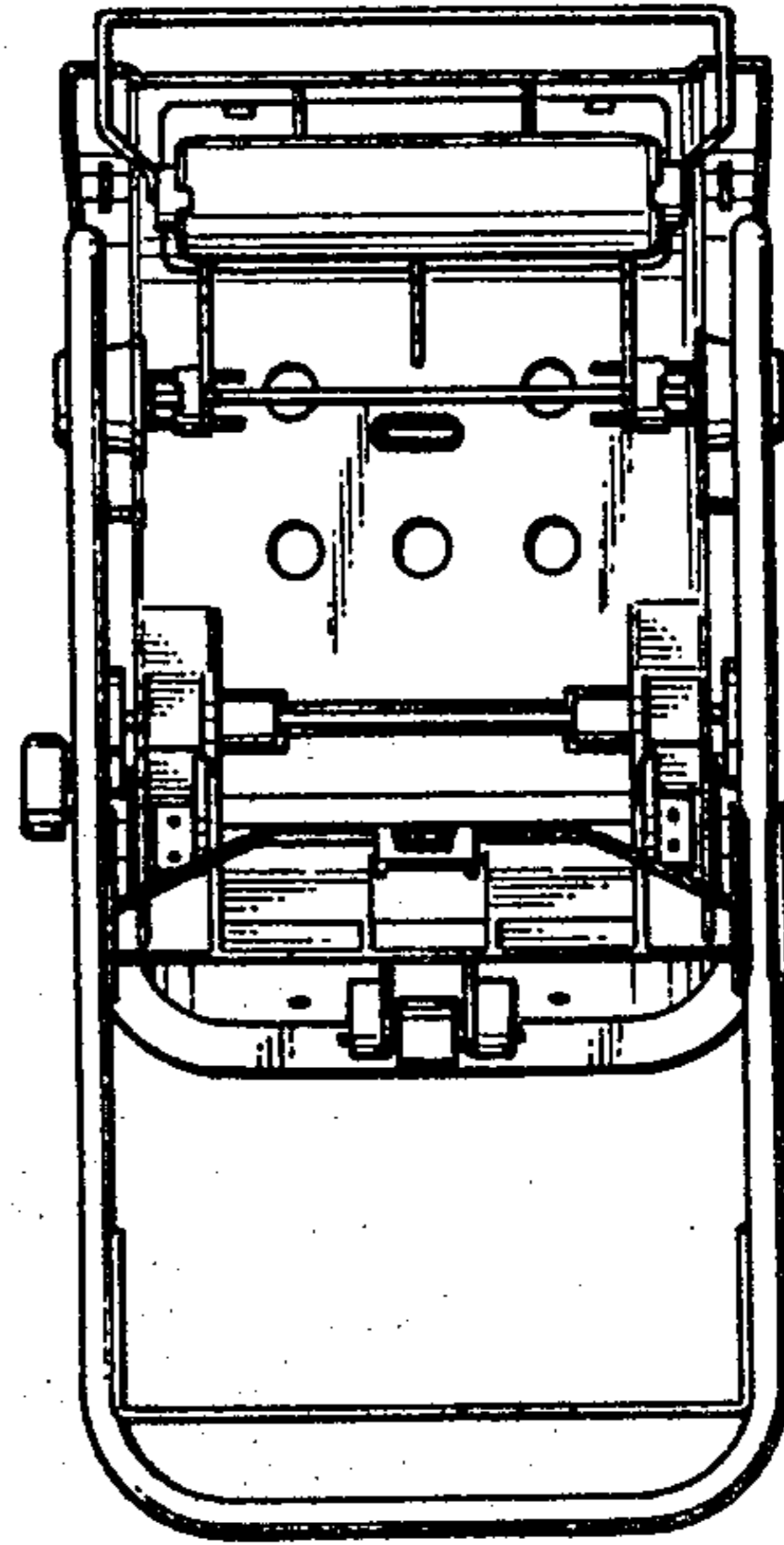

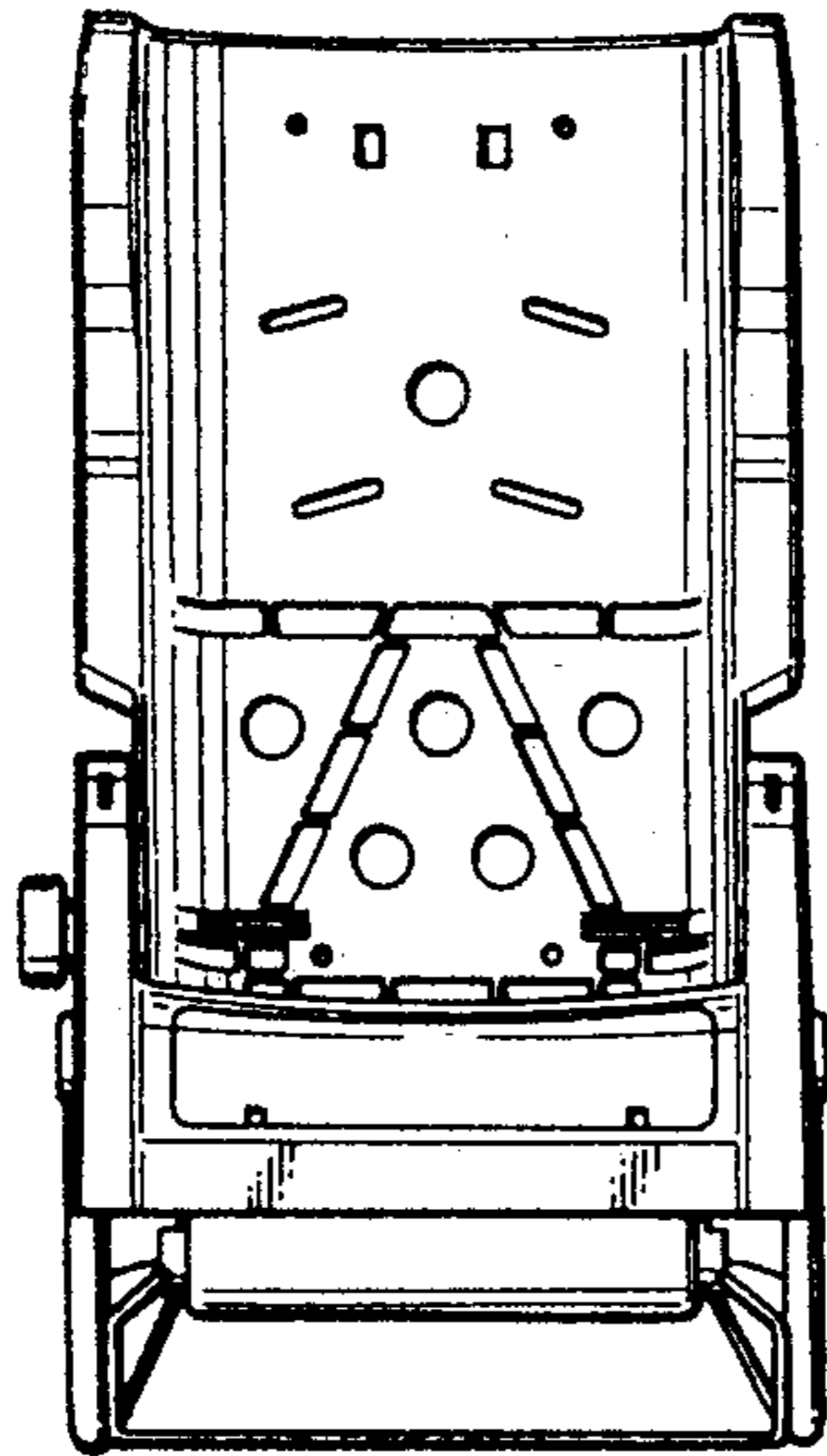

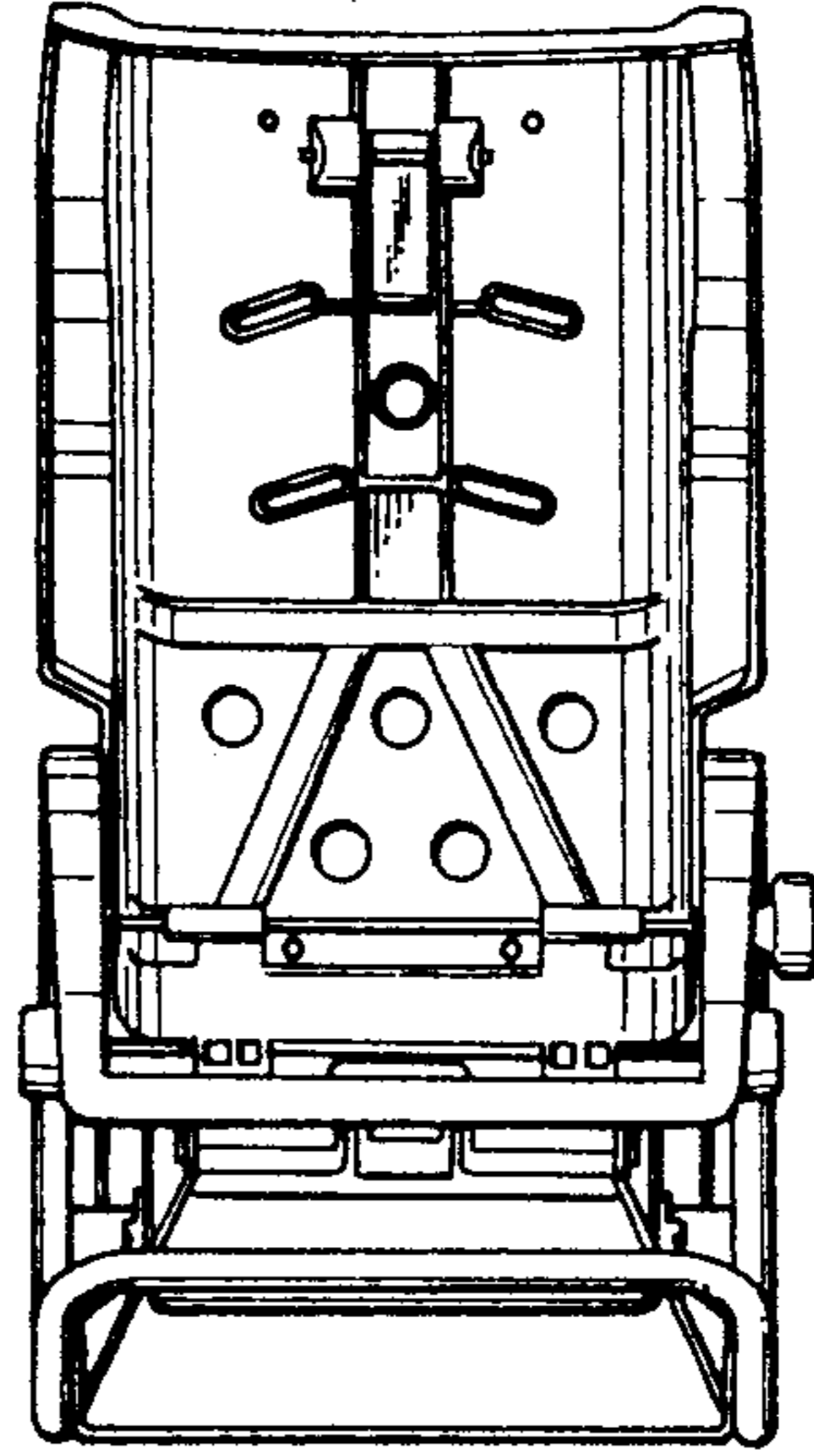

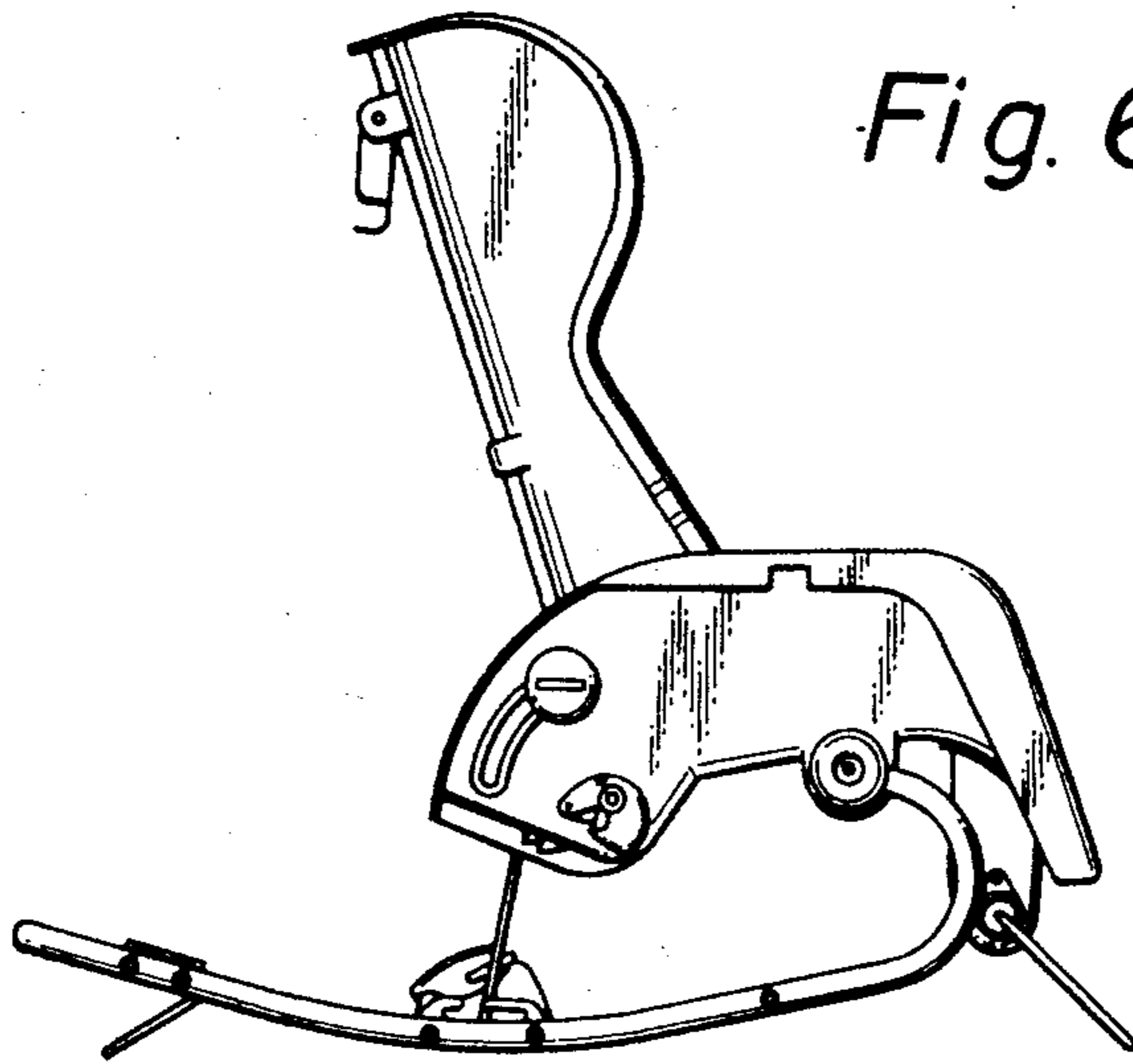

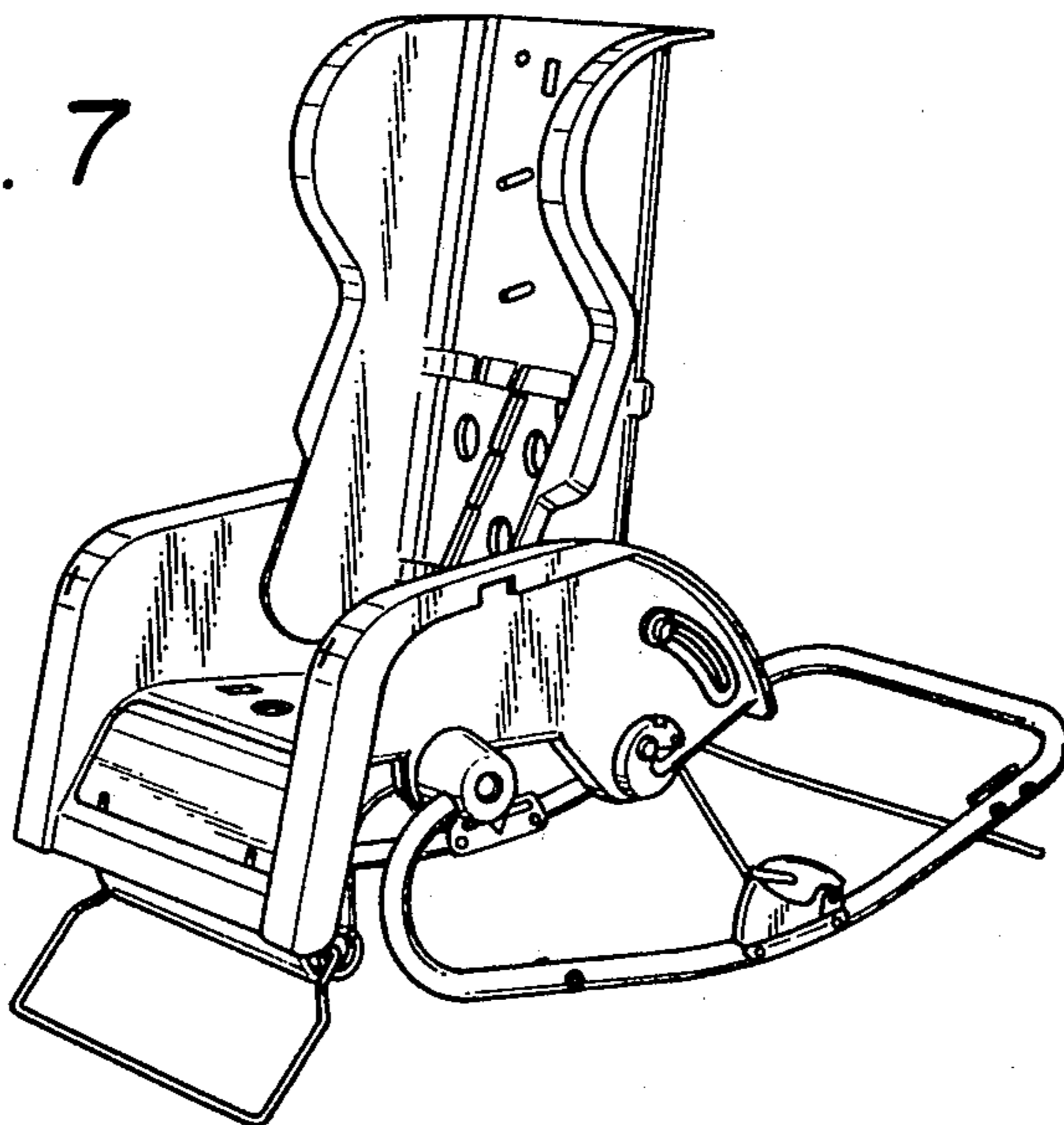
