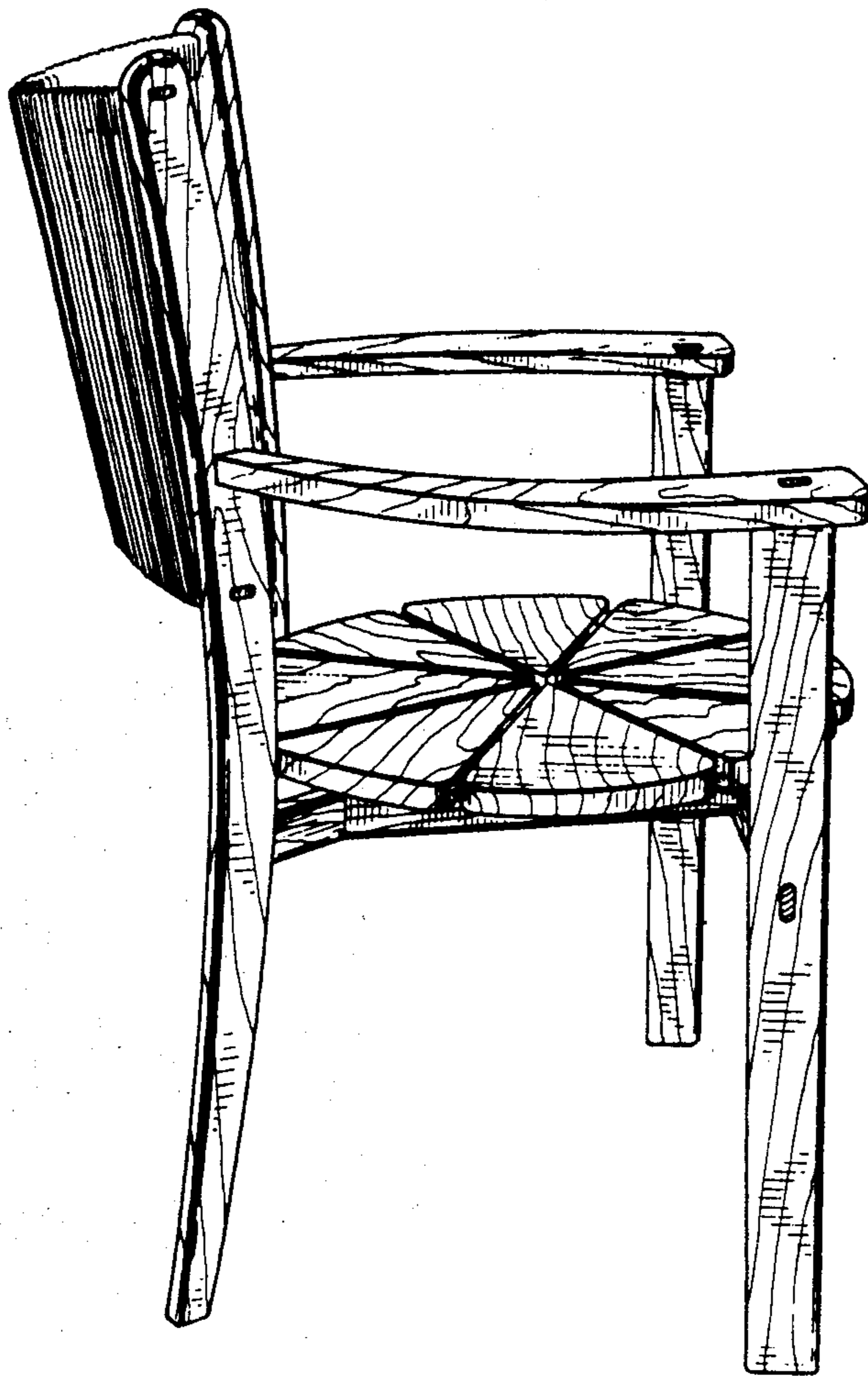

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a chair, or similar article as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side perspective view of the new chair design;
 FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; and,
 FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof.
 The back of the chair is characterized in part by runs of rope woven in a straight pattern and transversely spaced at the bottom end by one wrap of rope around a support and at the top end by two wraps of rope around a support.



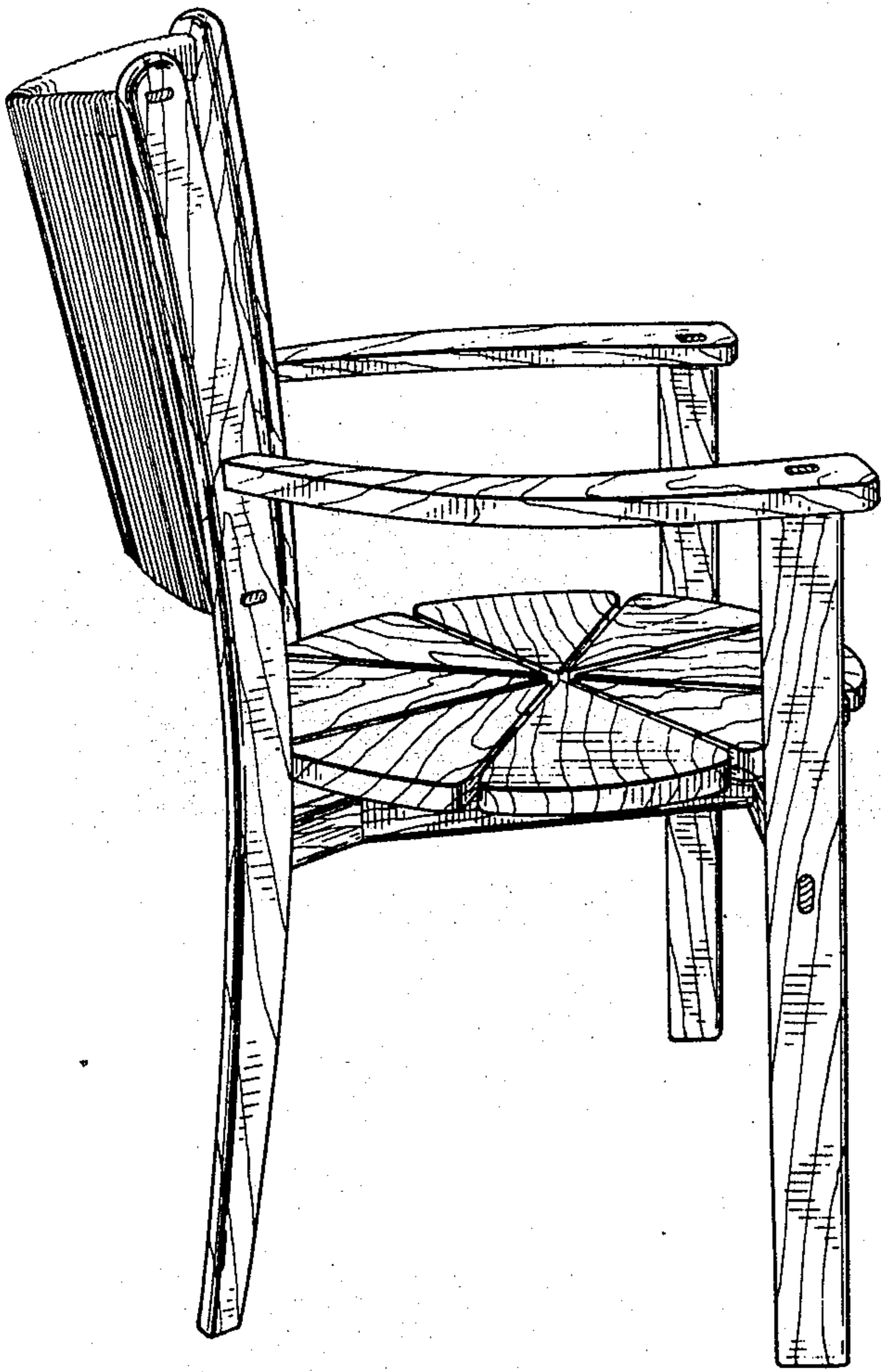

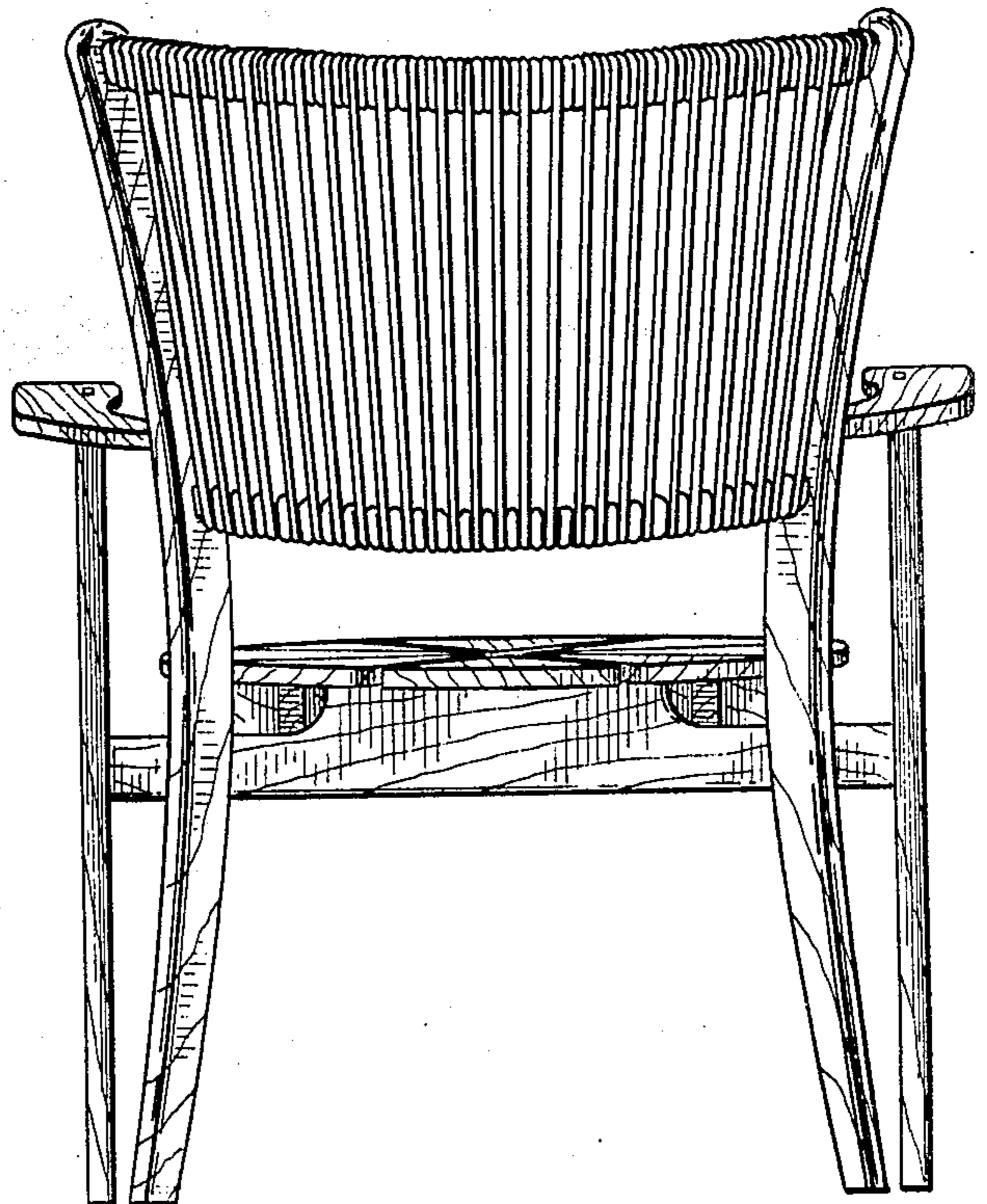

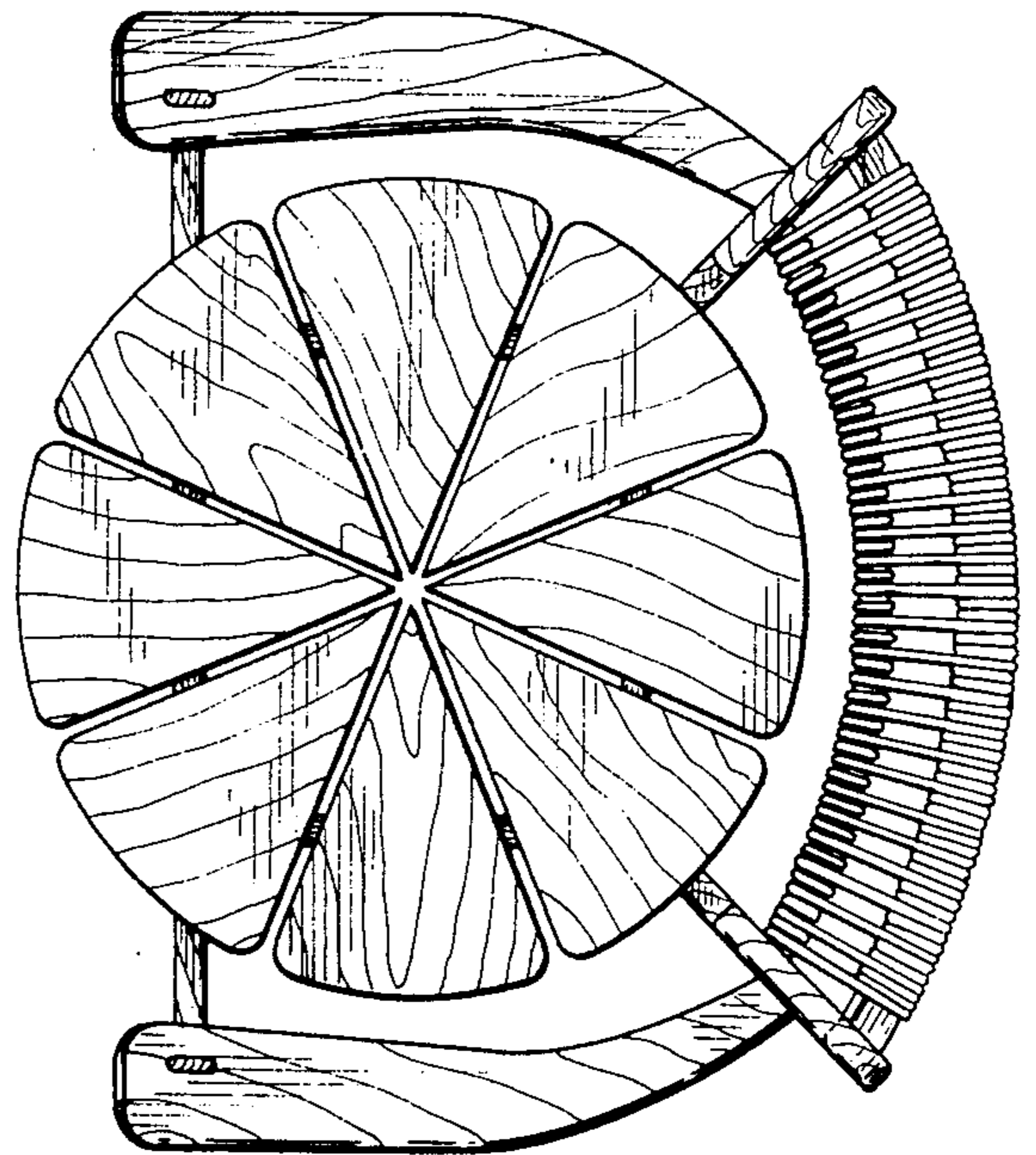

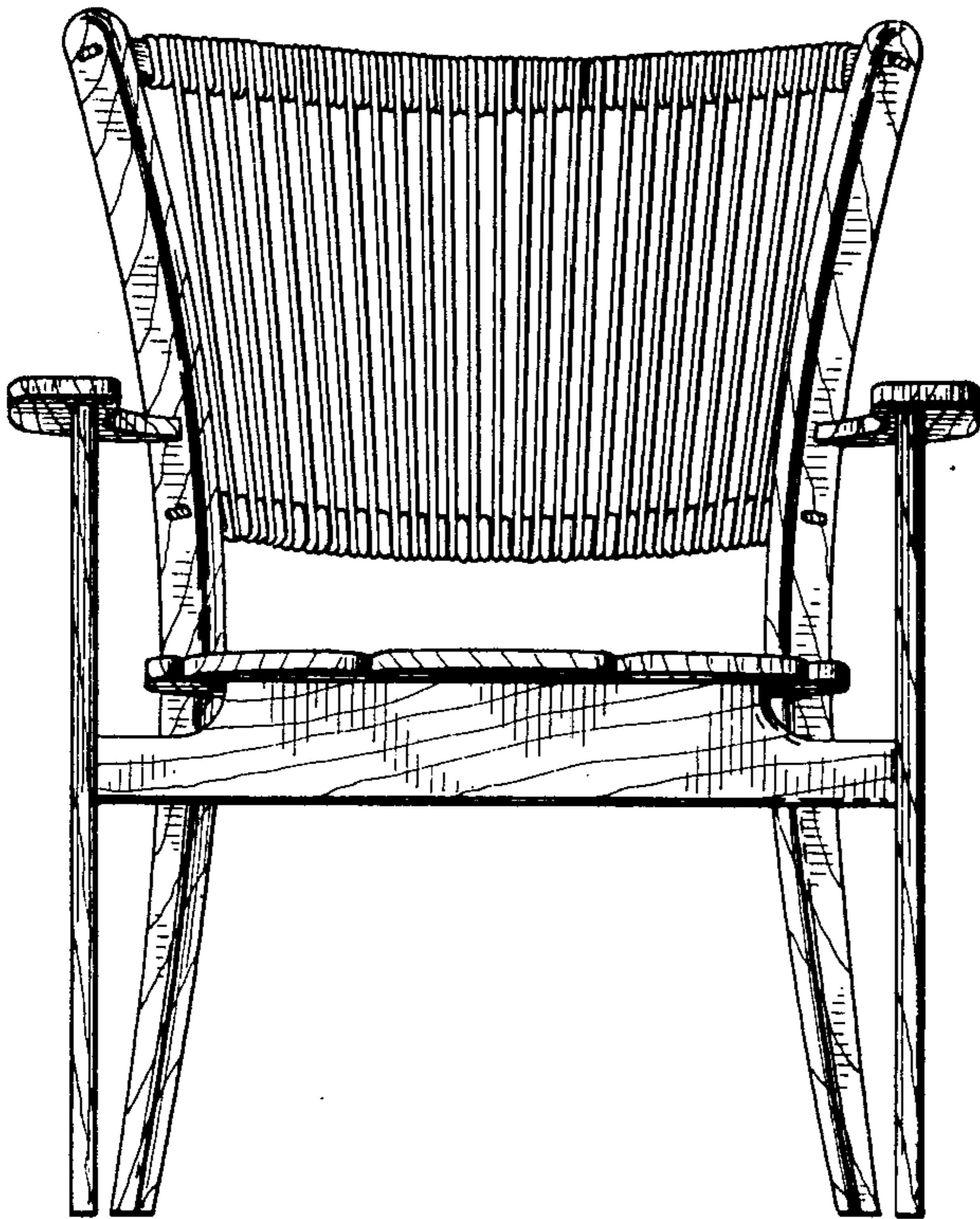
