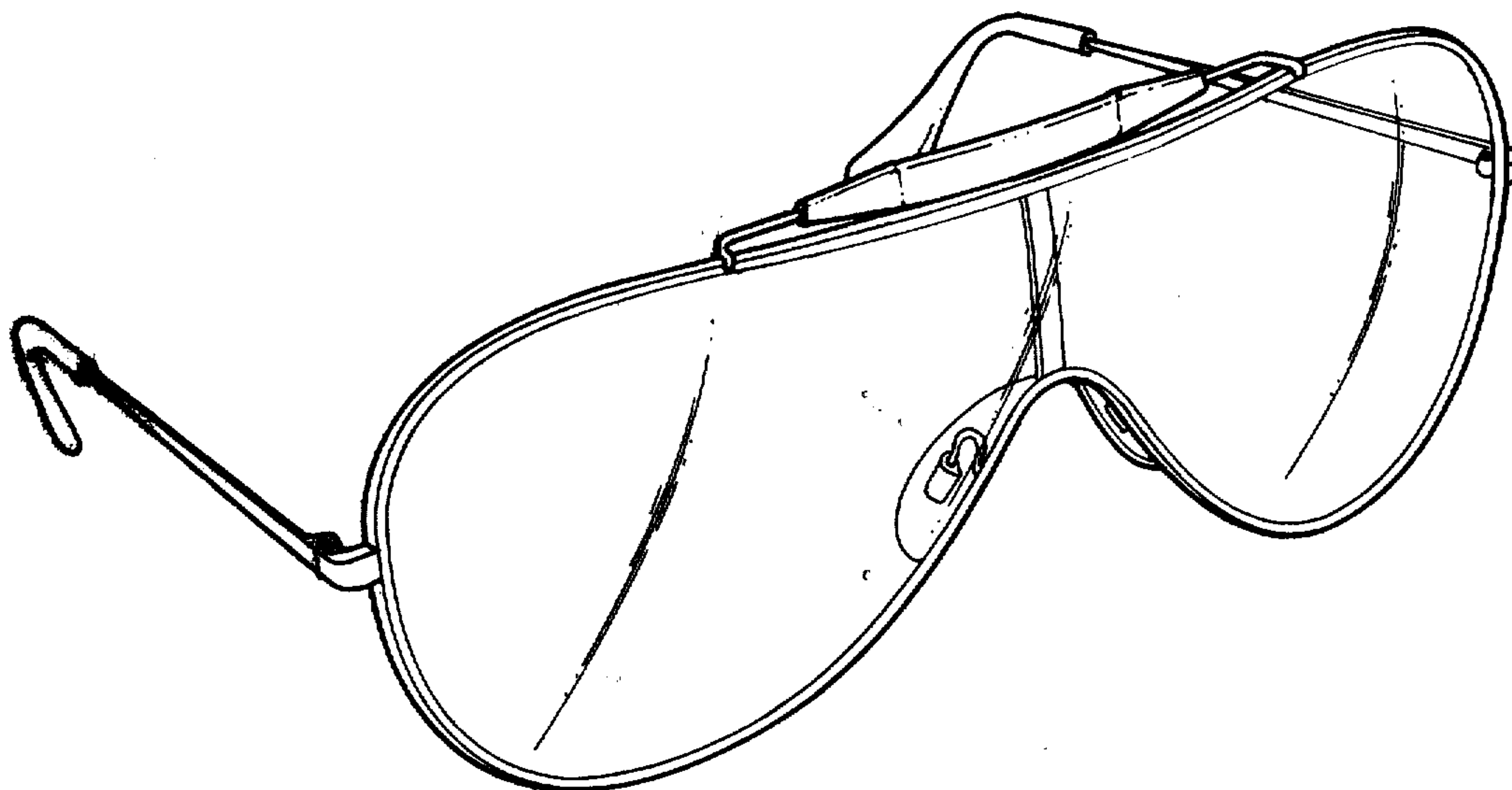
The ornamental design for a pair of sunglasses, substantially as shown and described.

FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view of the design shown in FIGS. 1 and 2.



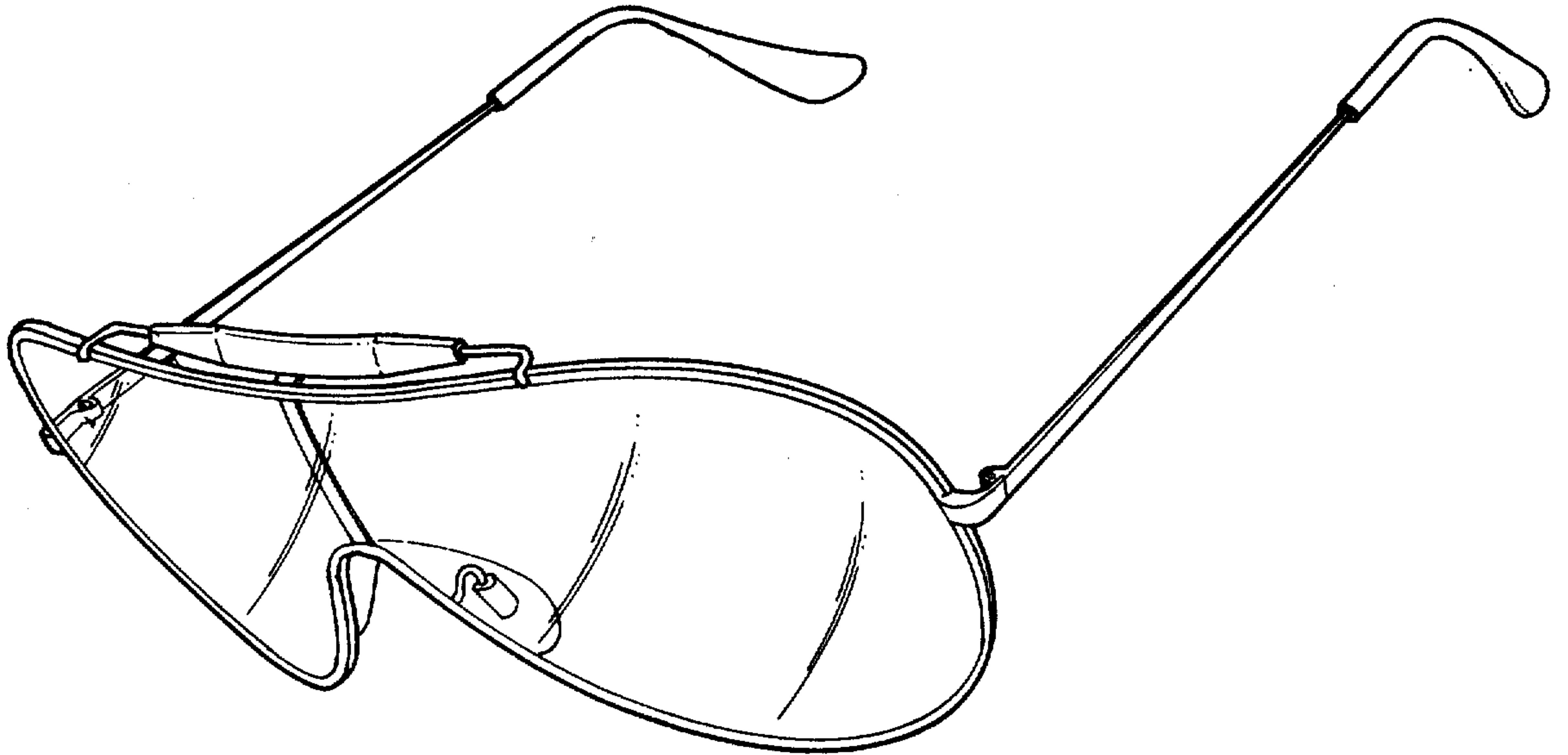

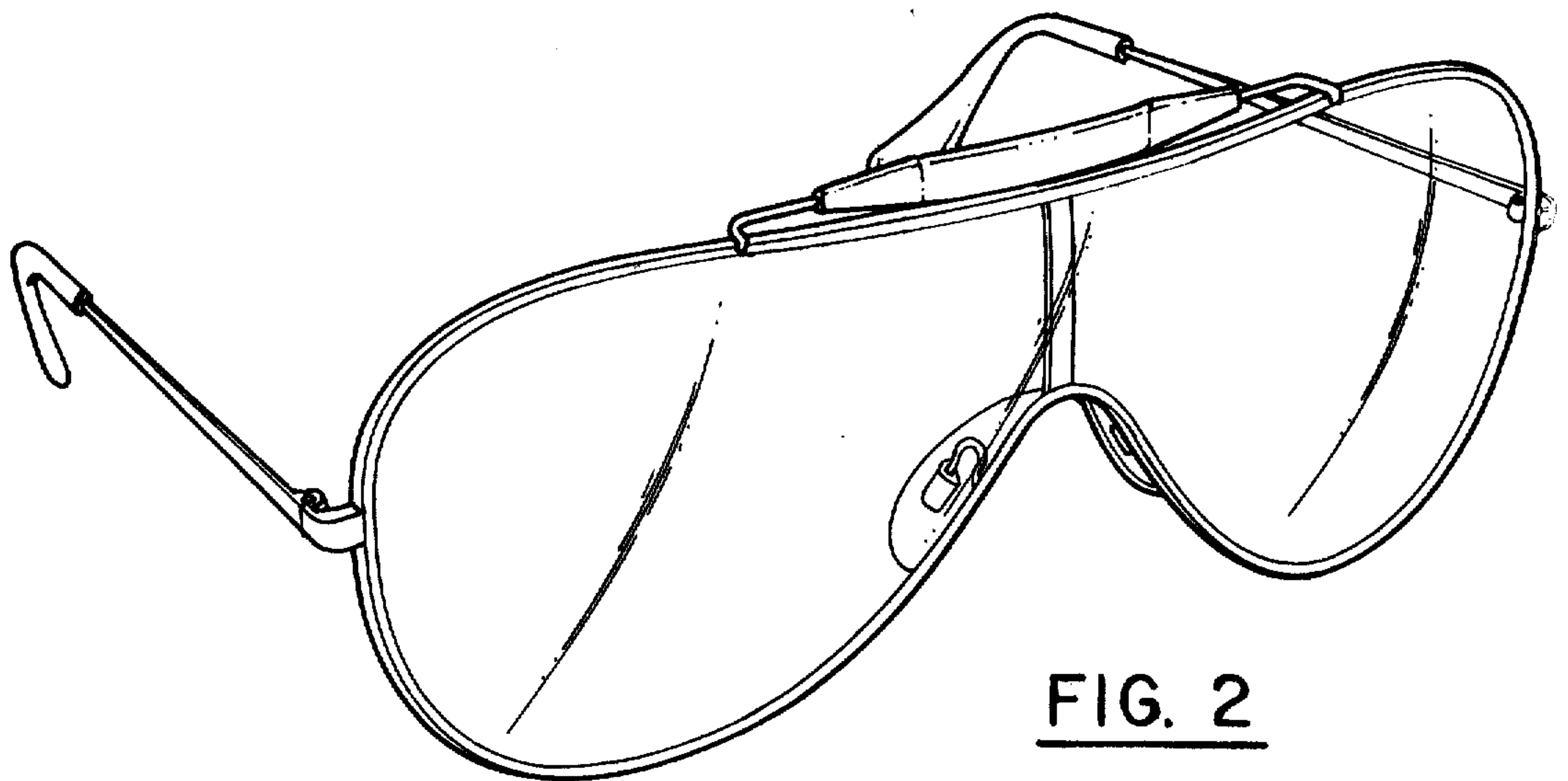

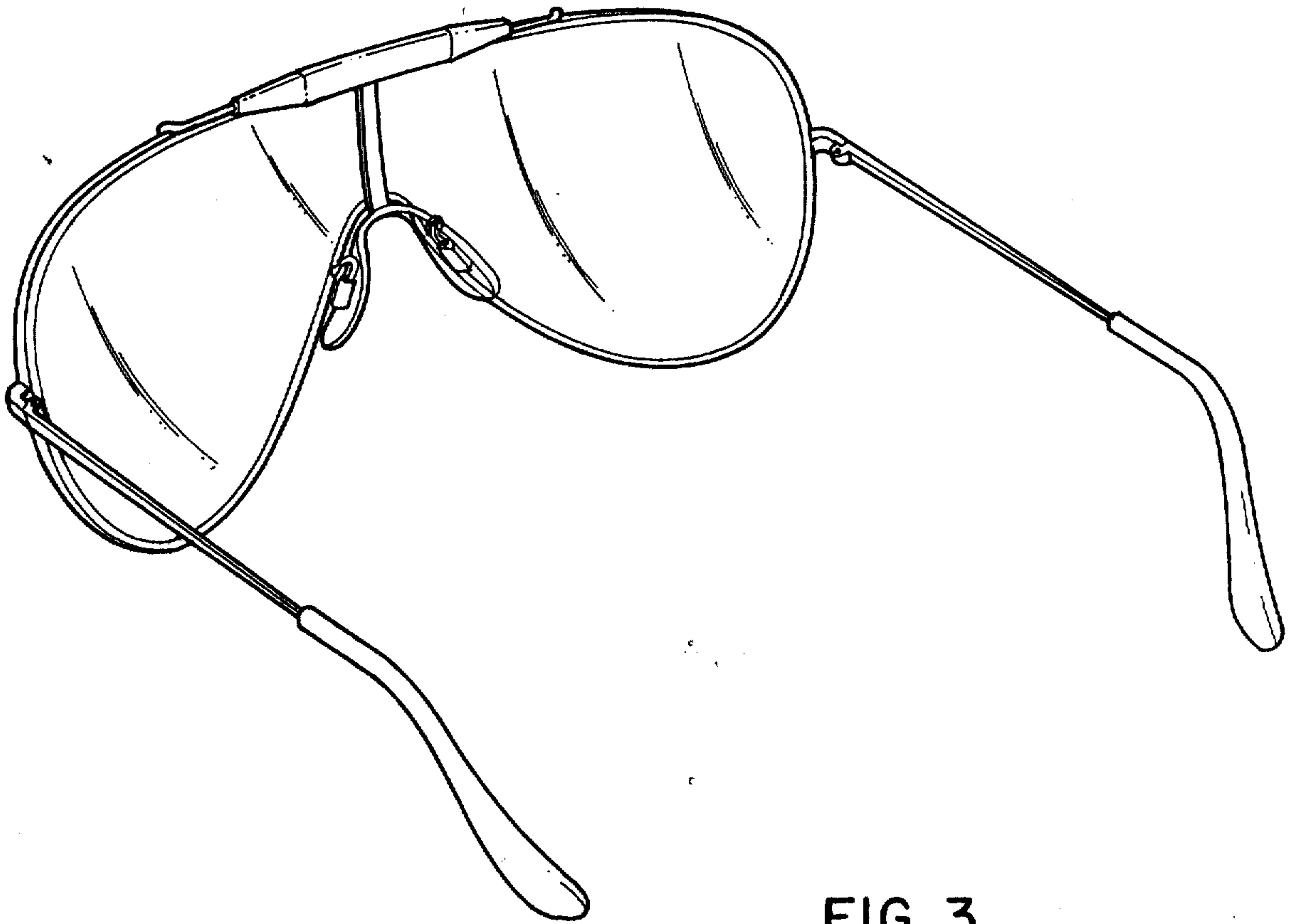
