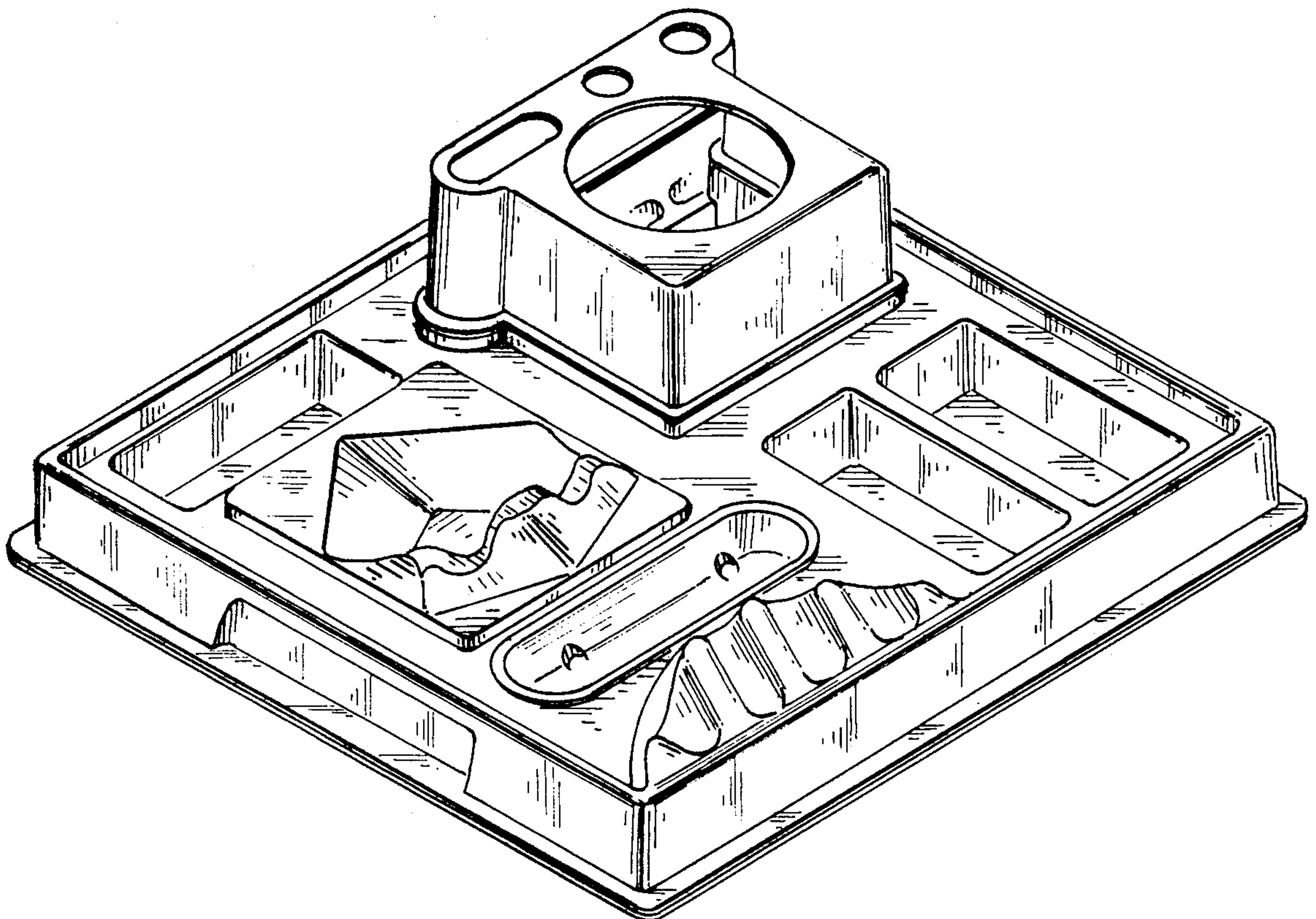

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a nail treatment tray, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a nail treatment tray showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is an exploded right side elevational view thereof with one part lifted therefrom;
FIG. 8 is a top plan view thereof as seen along lines 8-8 in FIG. 7;
FIG. 9 is a top plan view of the portion removed from the tray as seen in FIG. 7;
FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 11 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 12 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 13 is a bottom plan view of the nail treatment tray of FIG. 1 on a reduced scale.



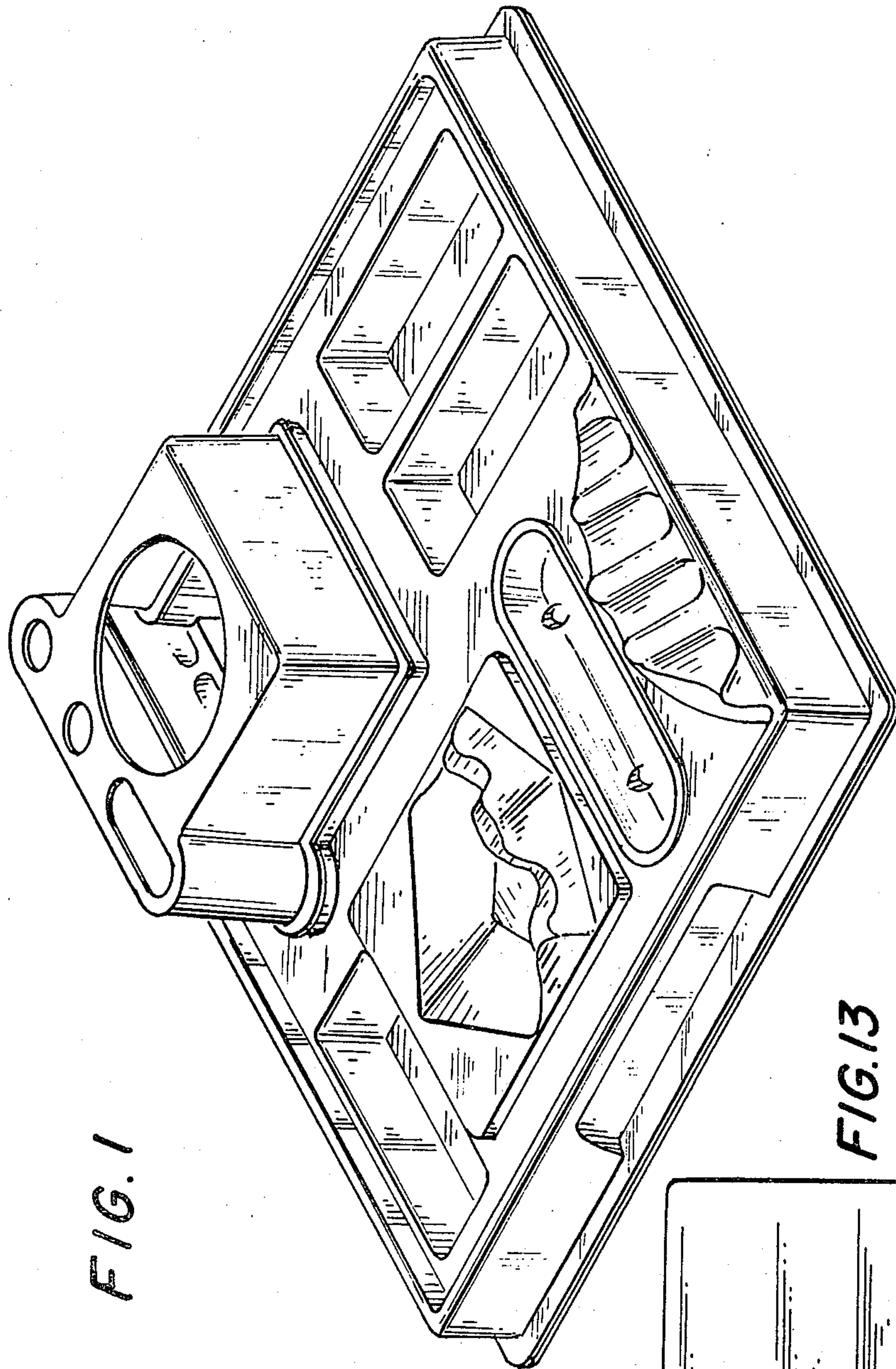

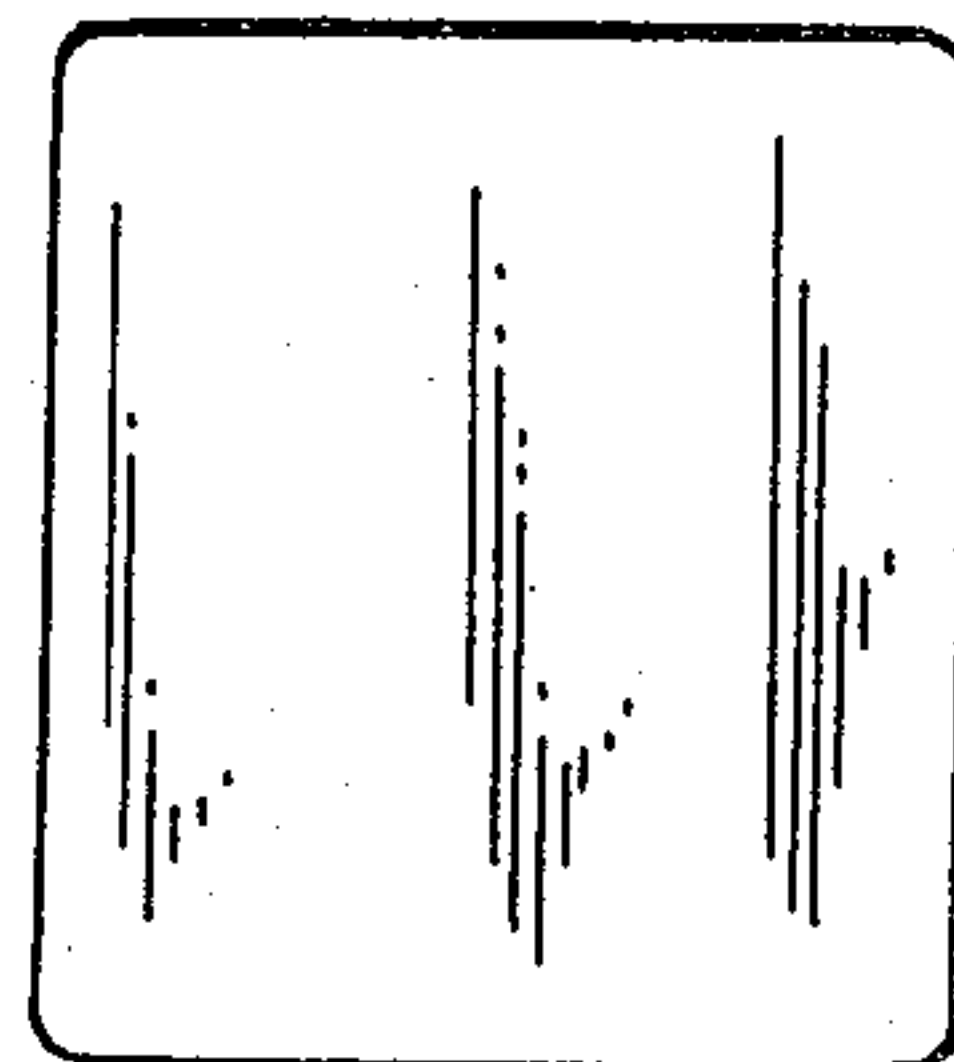

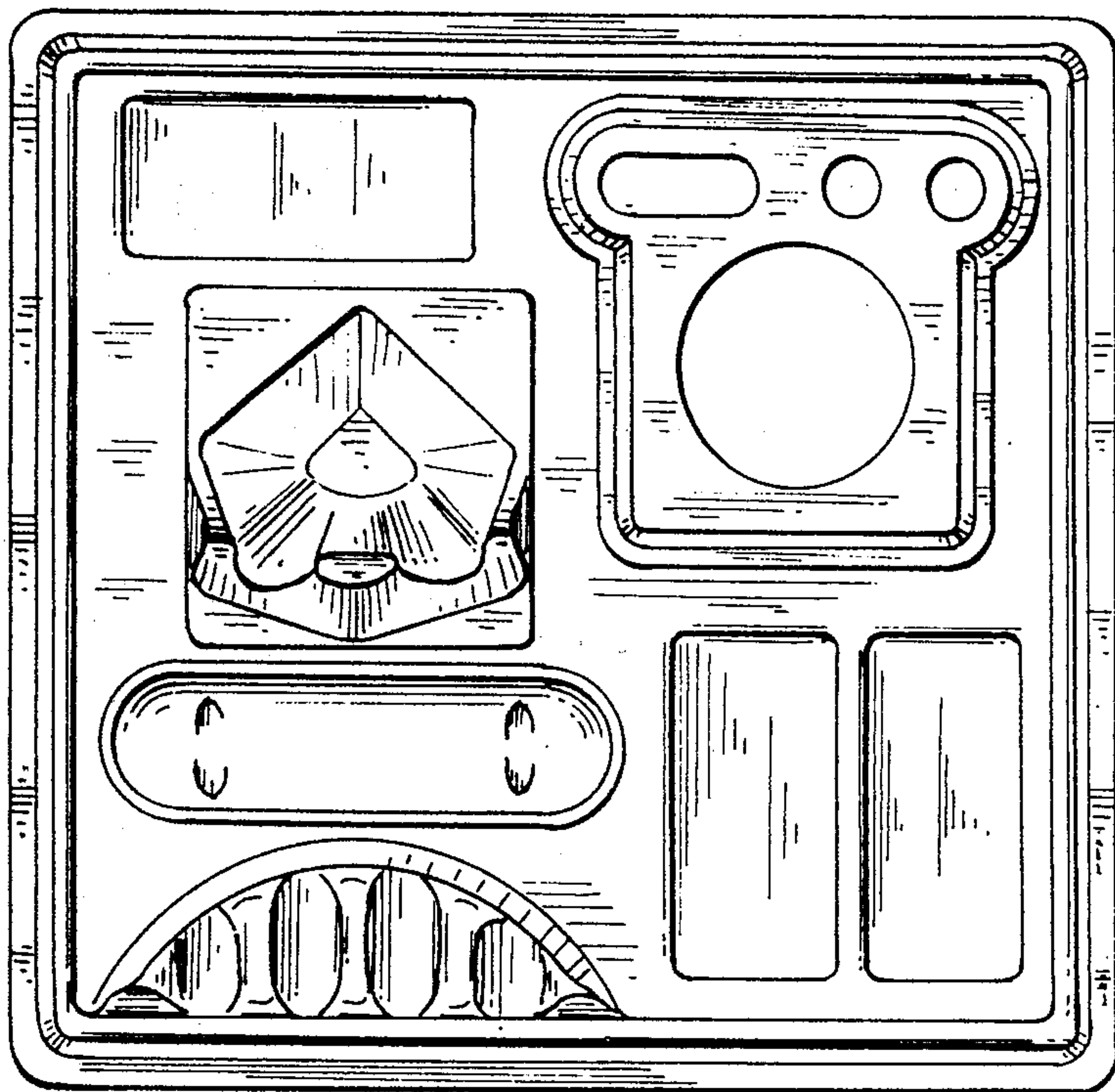

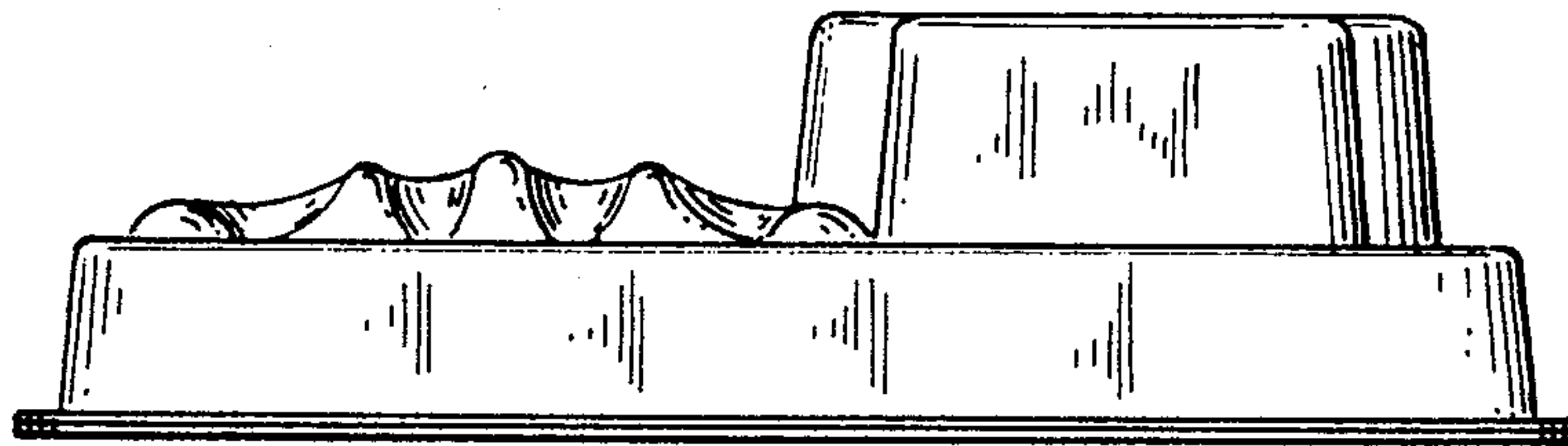

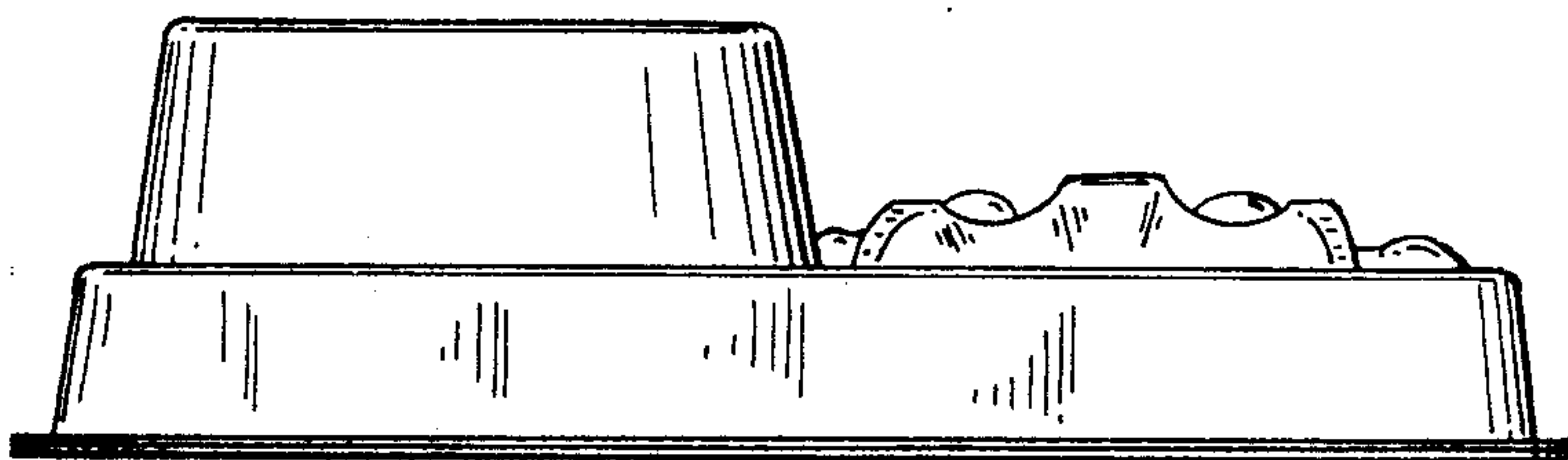

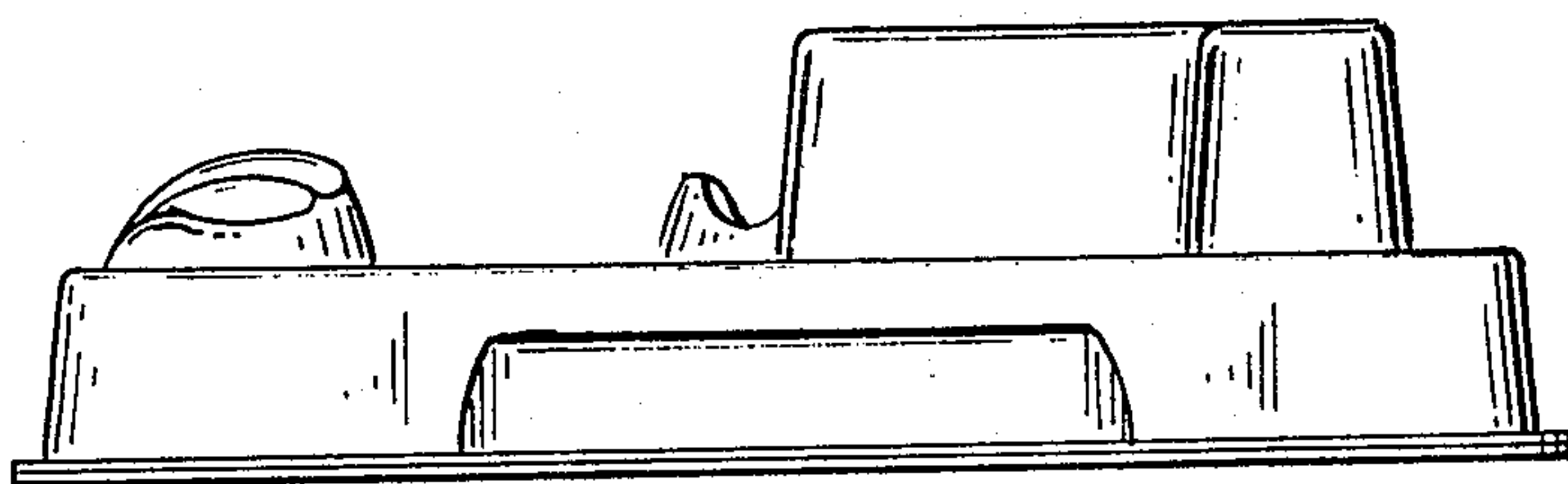

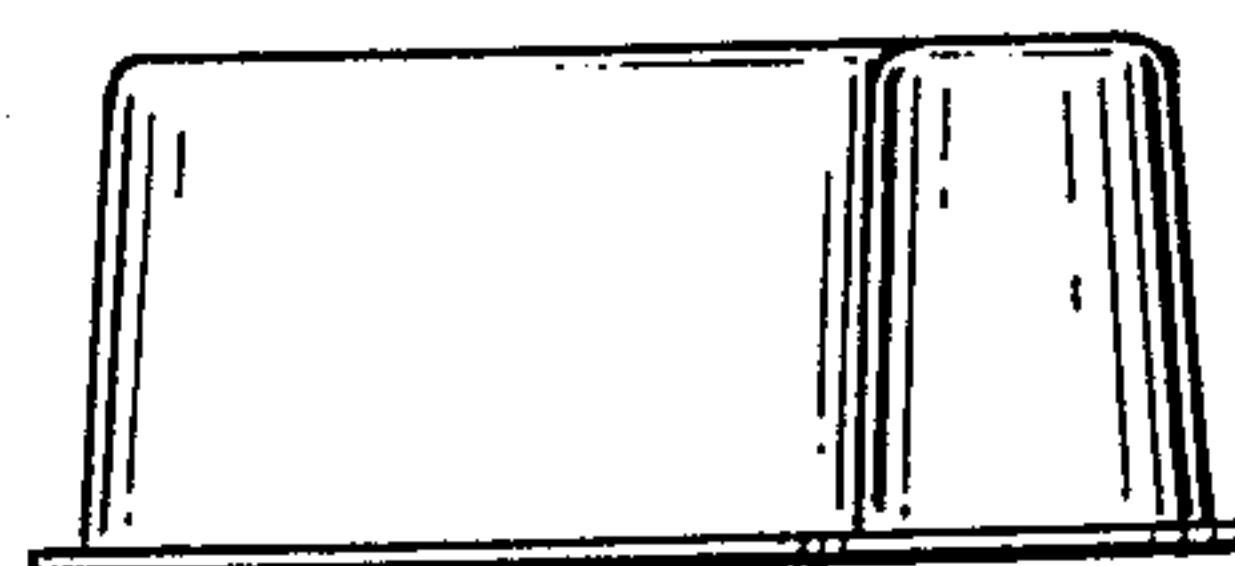
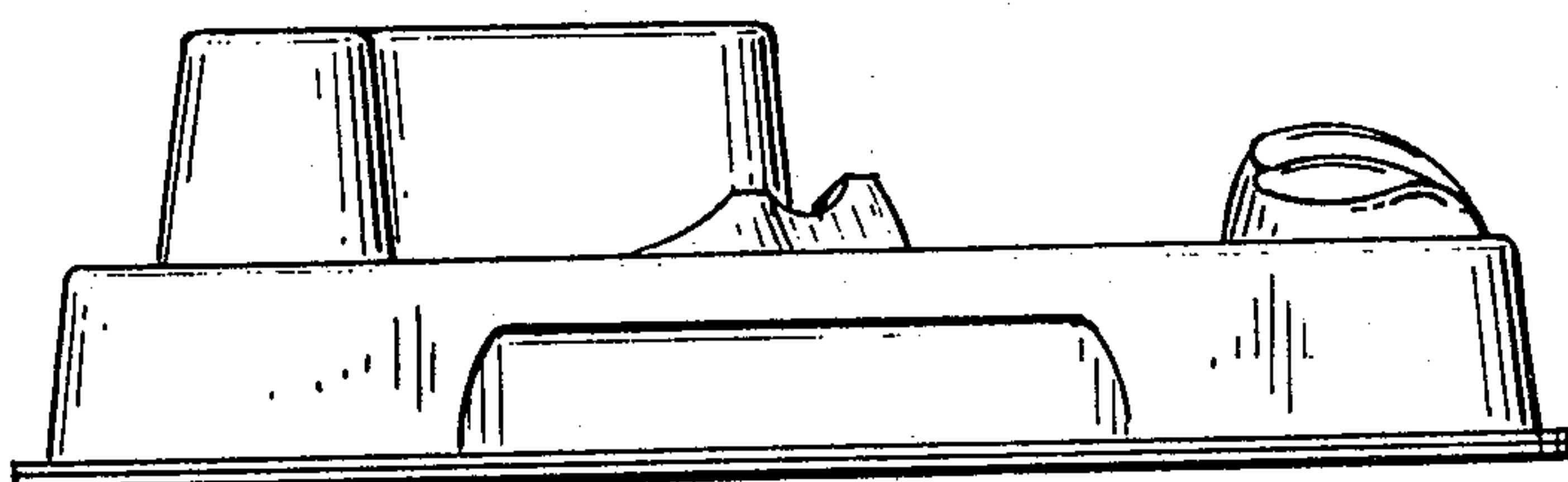
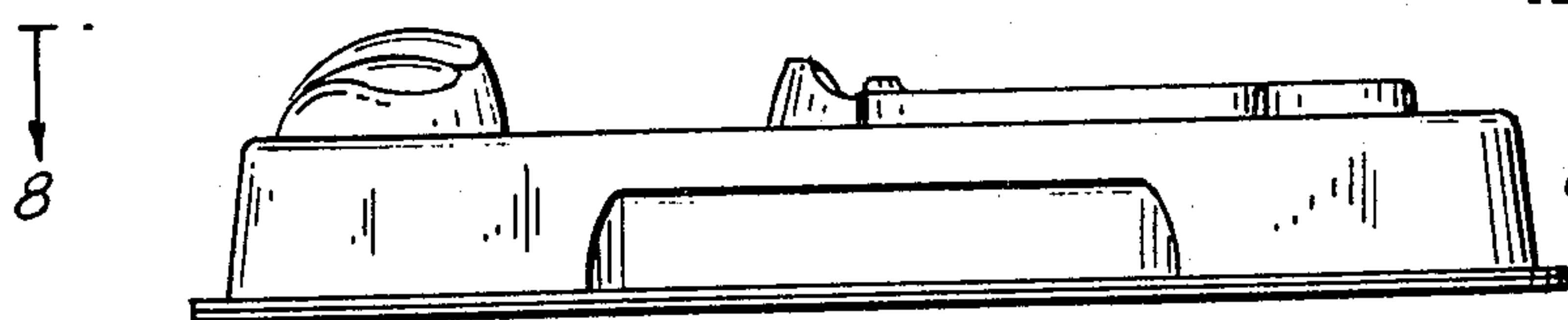

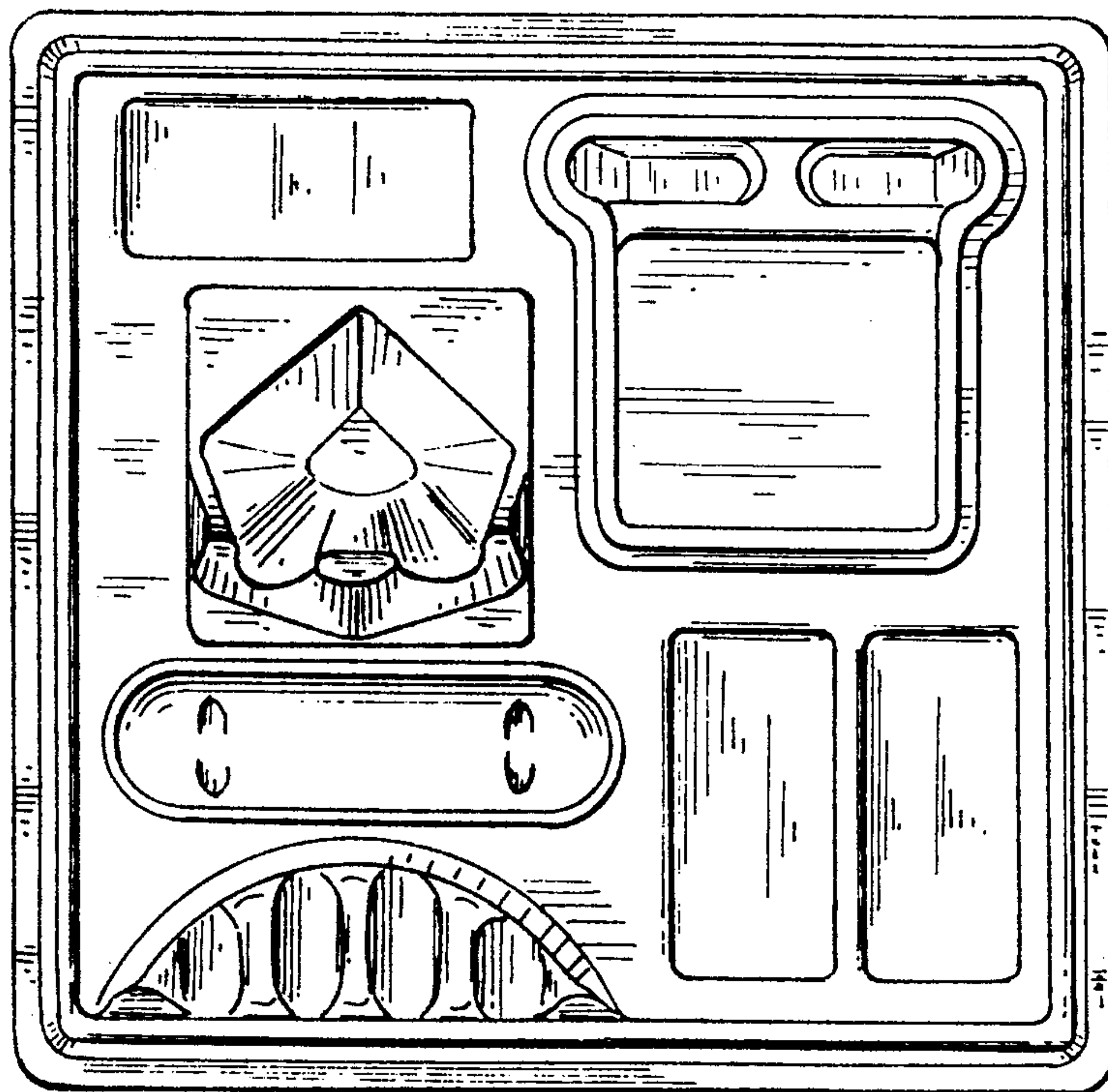

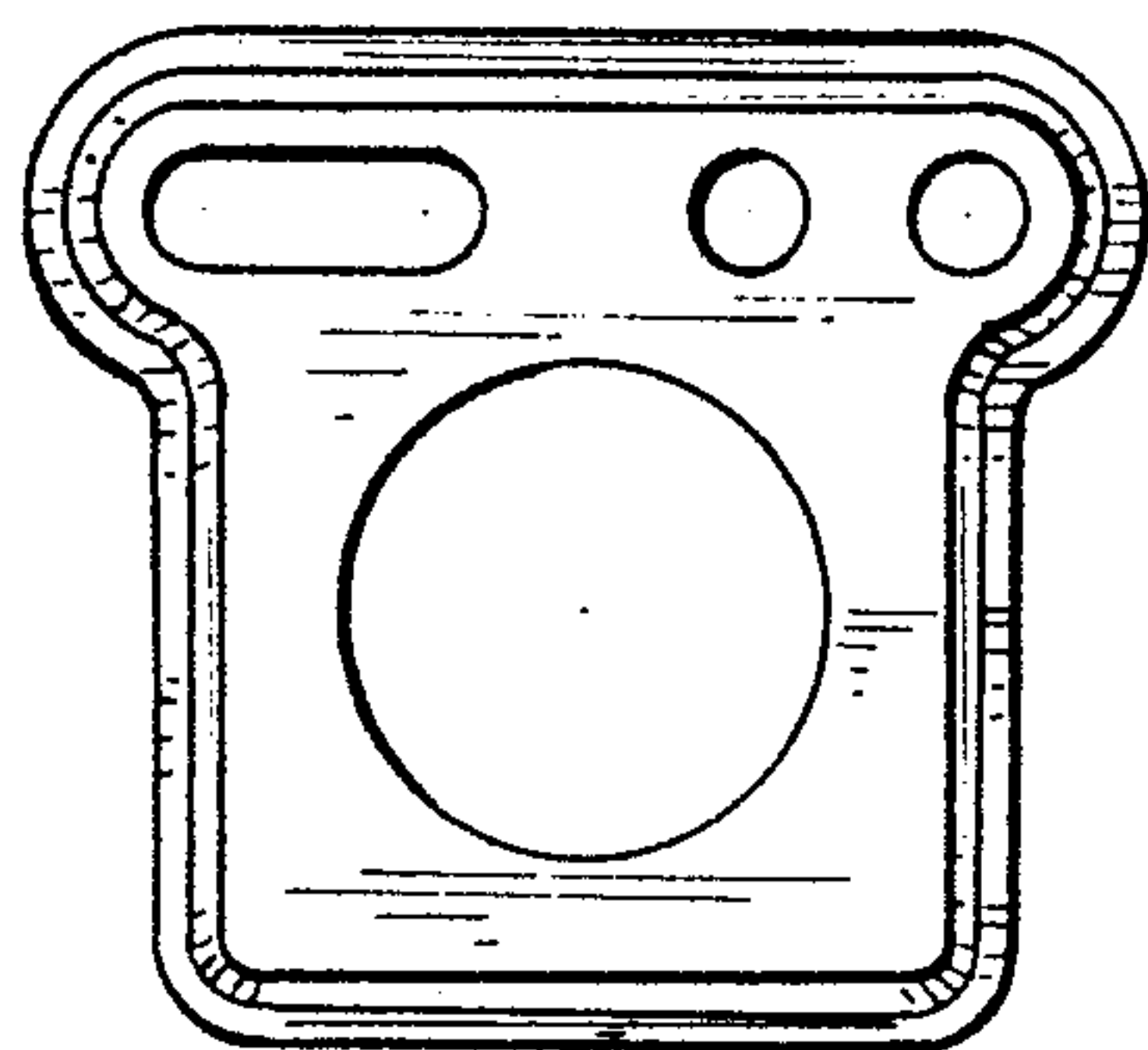

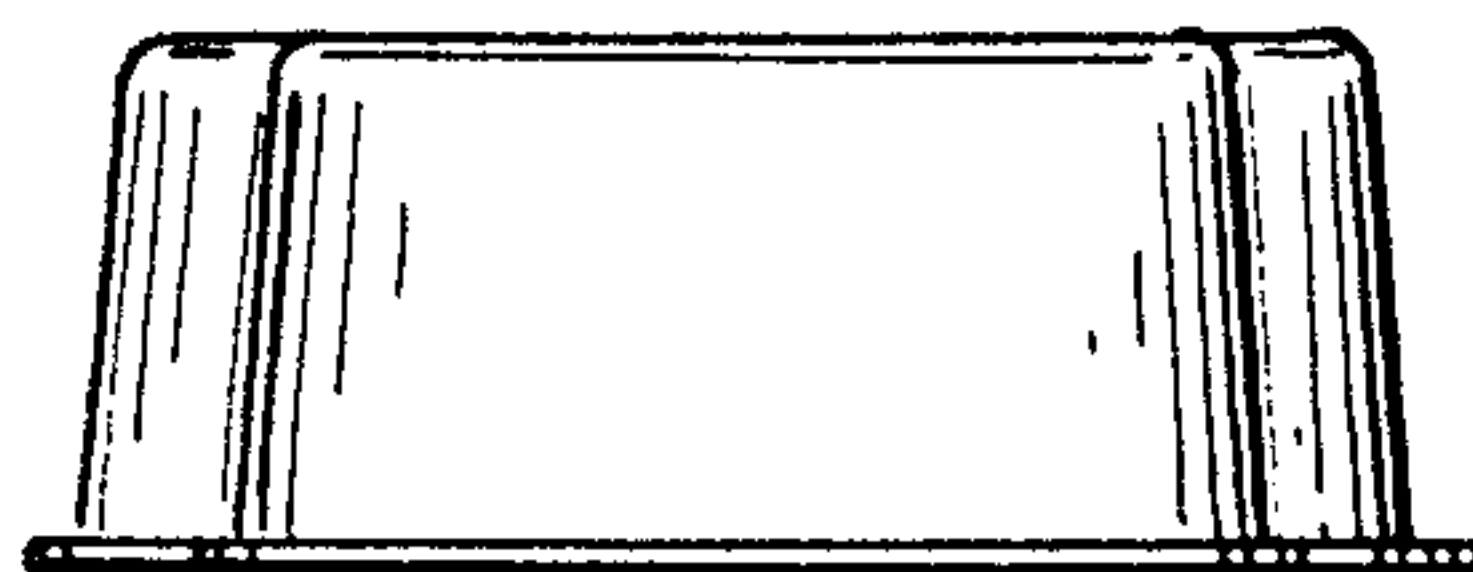
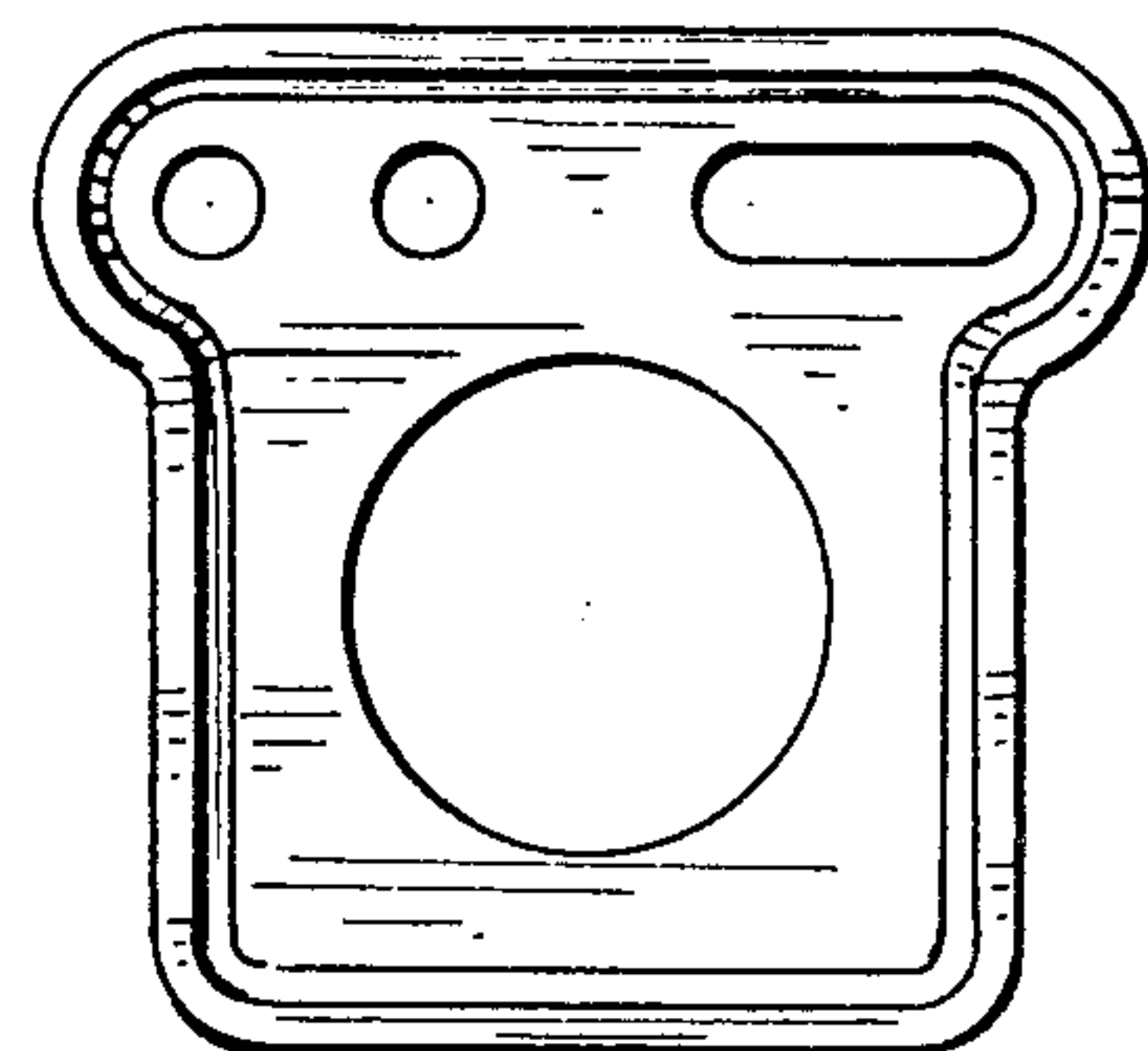
