DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a credit card terminal showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.
The unshown rear of the design is substantially flat, plain and unornamented.

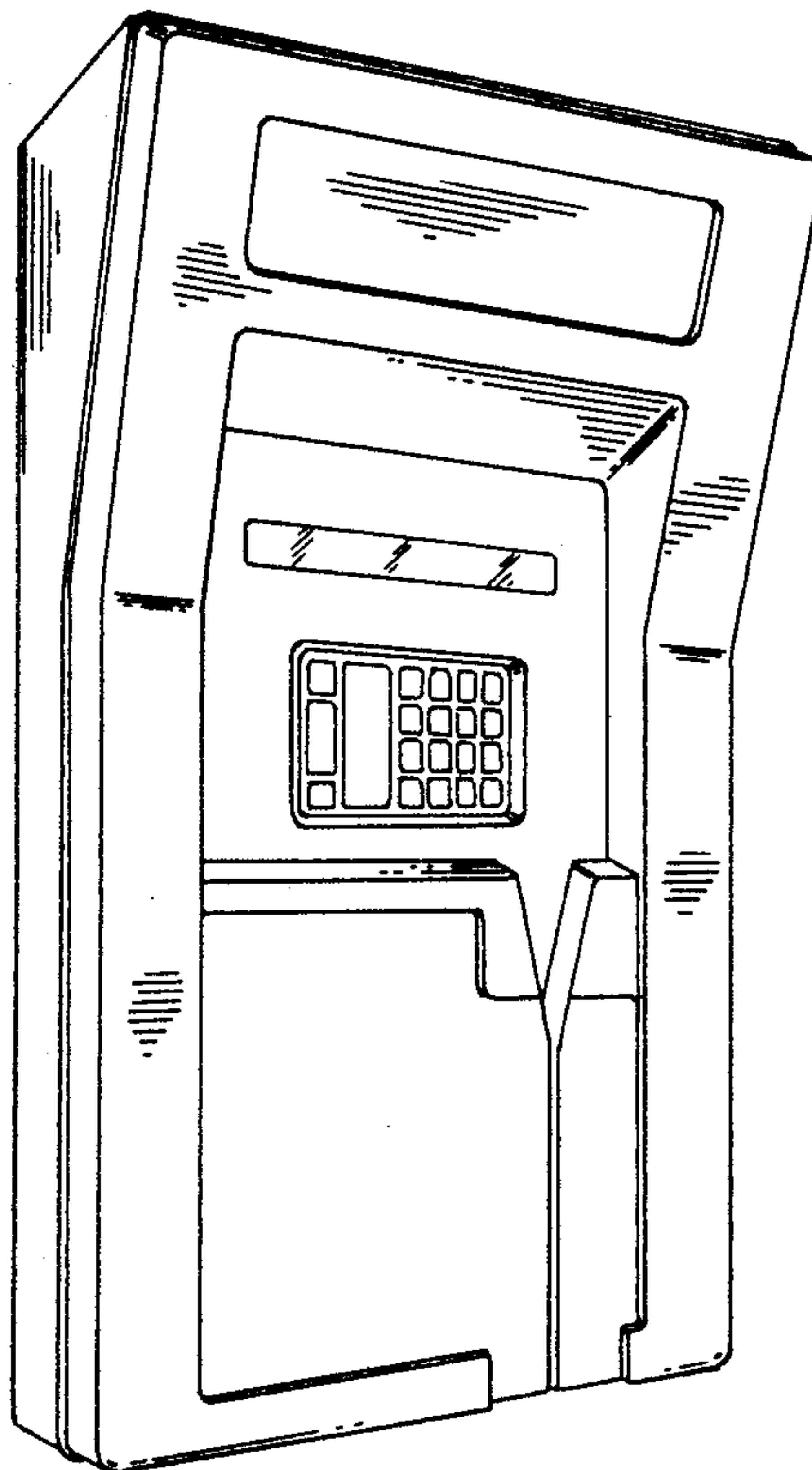

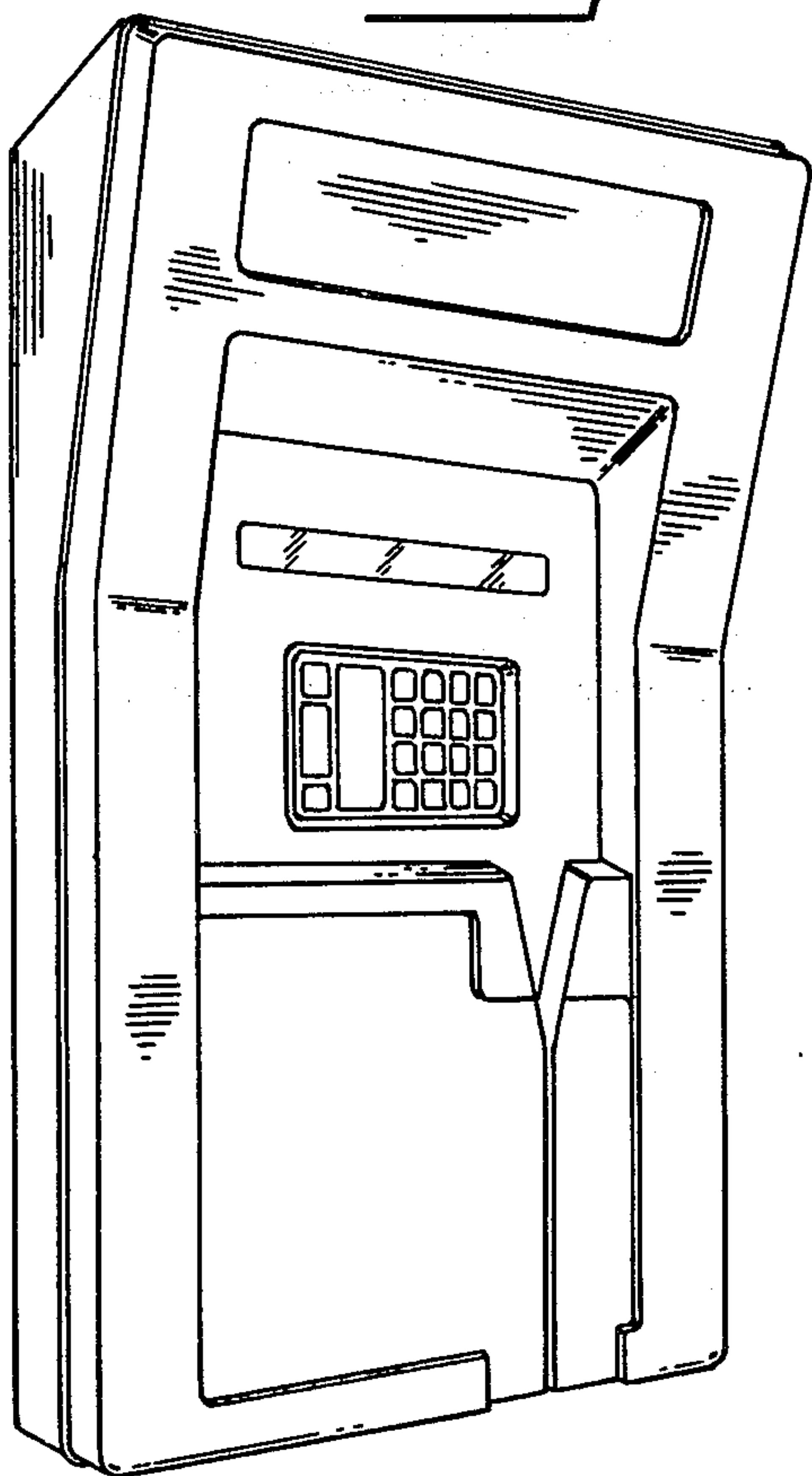

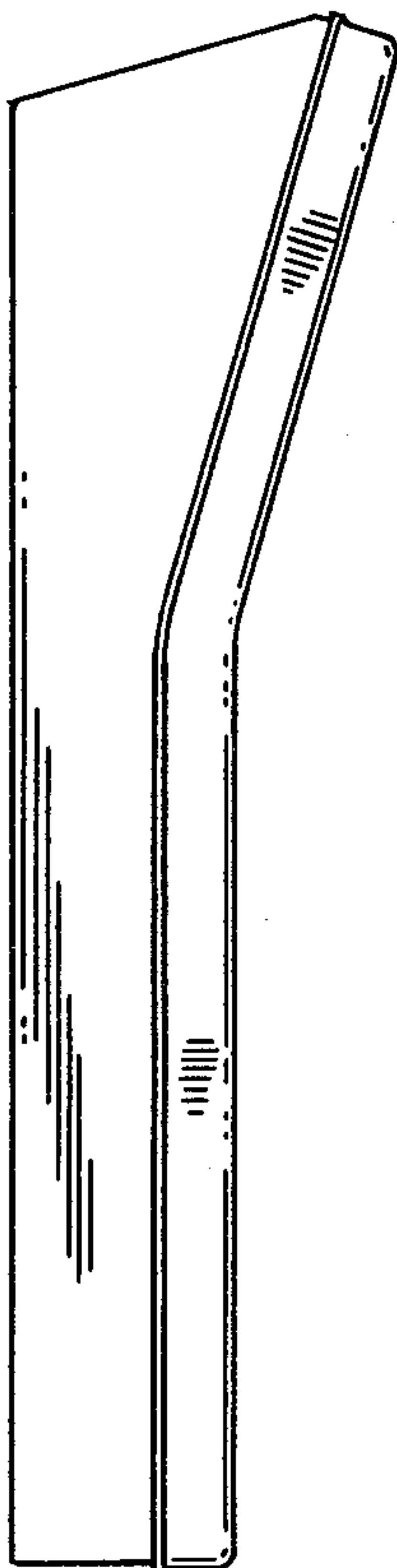
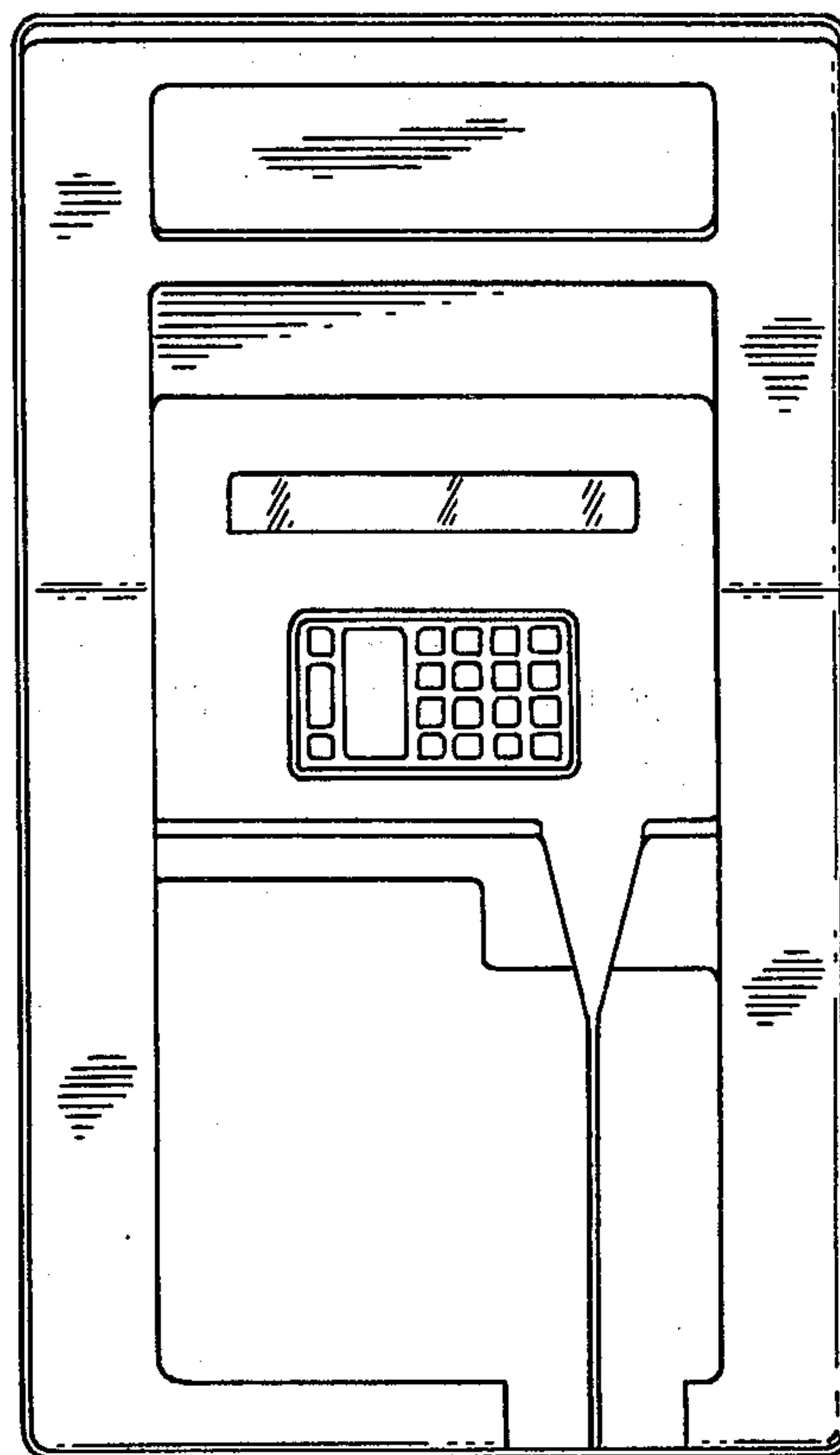

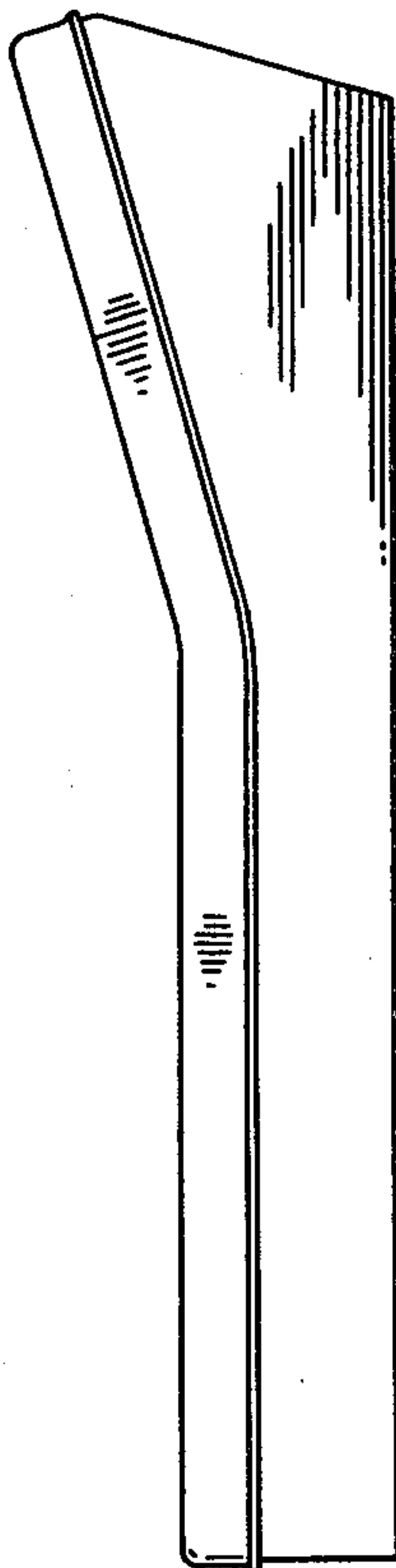

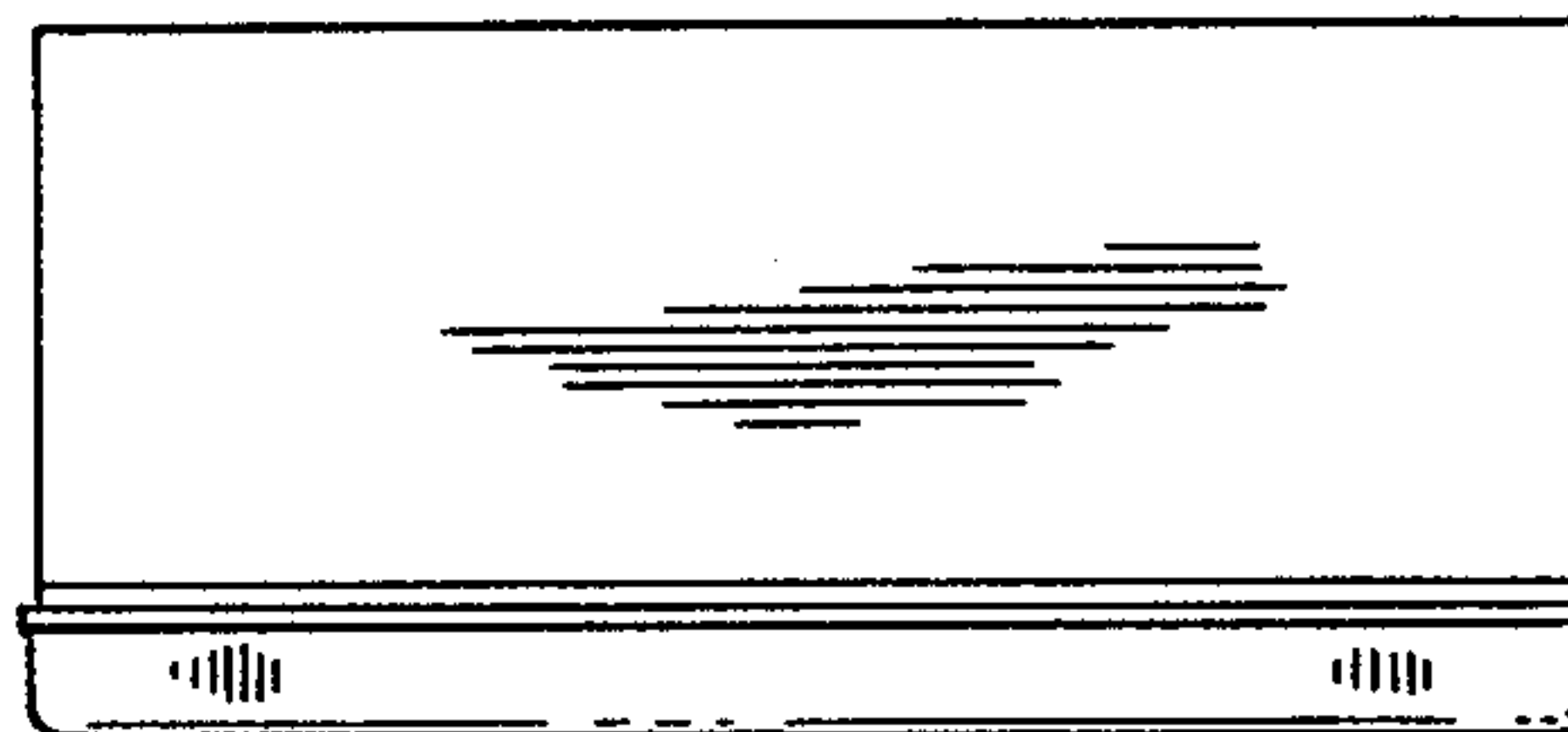

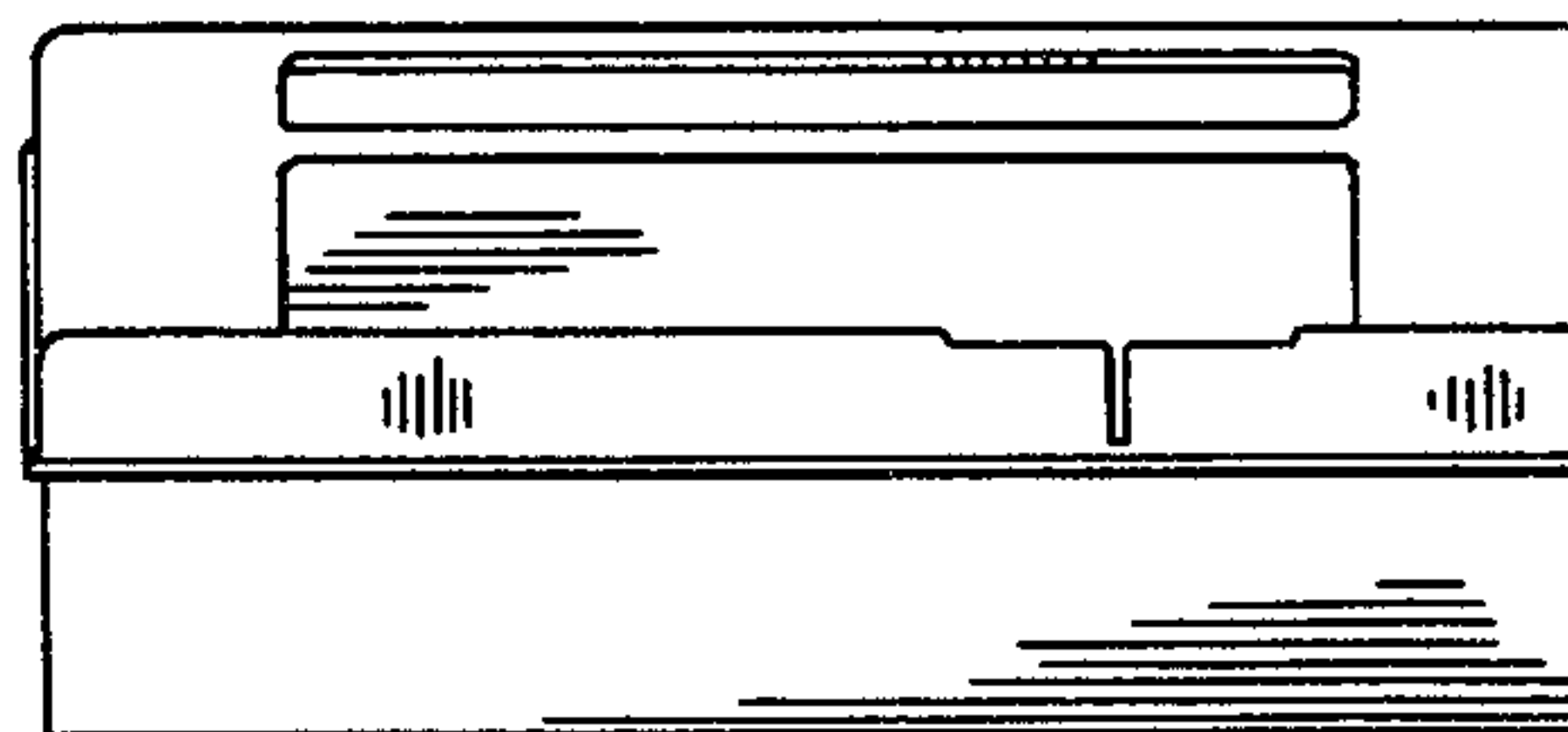
