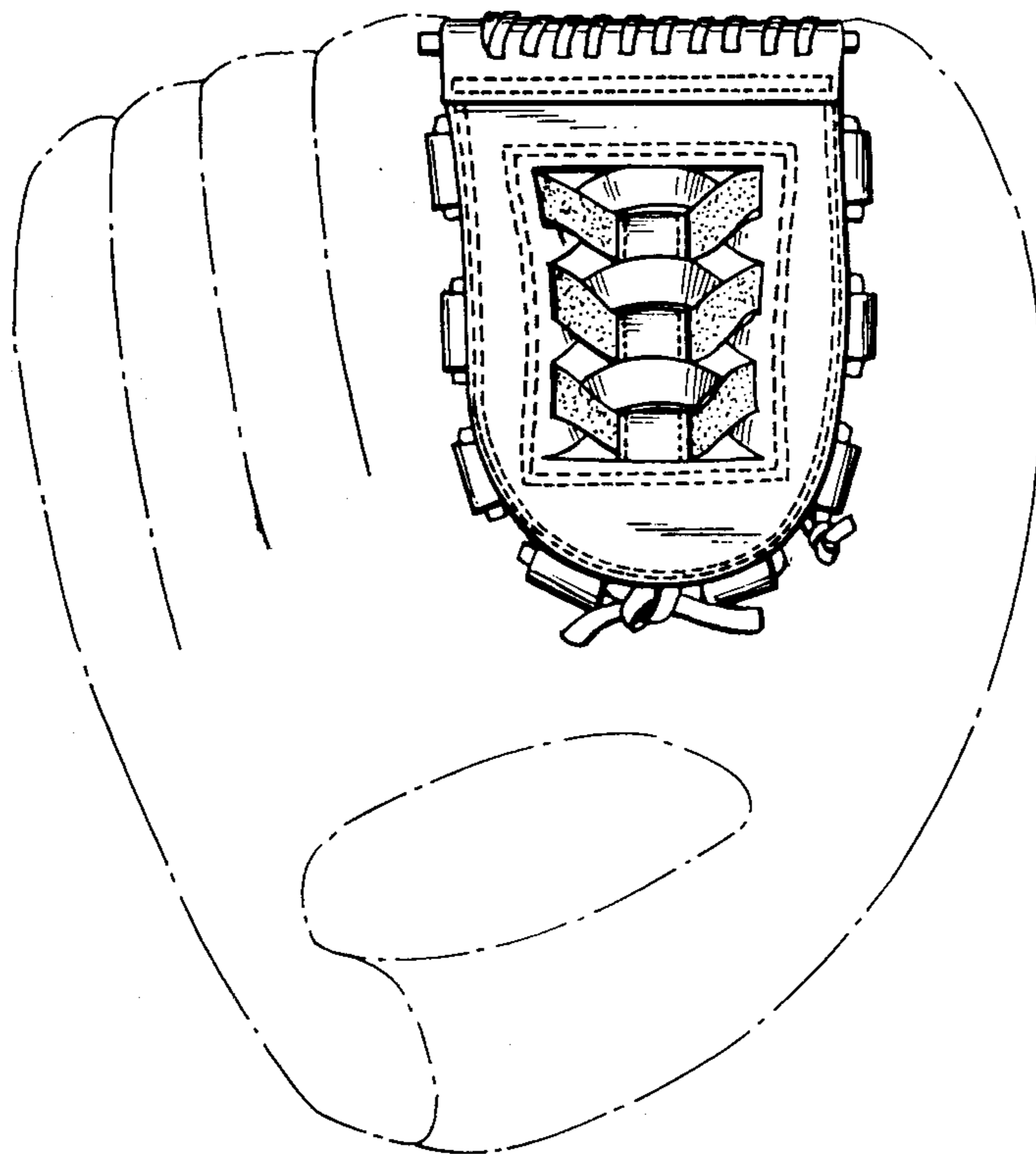
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a backstop for a

The backstop is of conventional thickness.



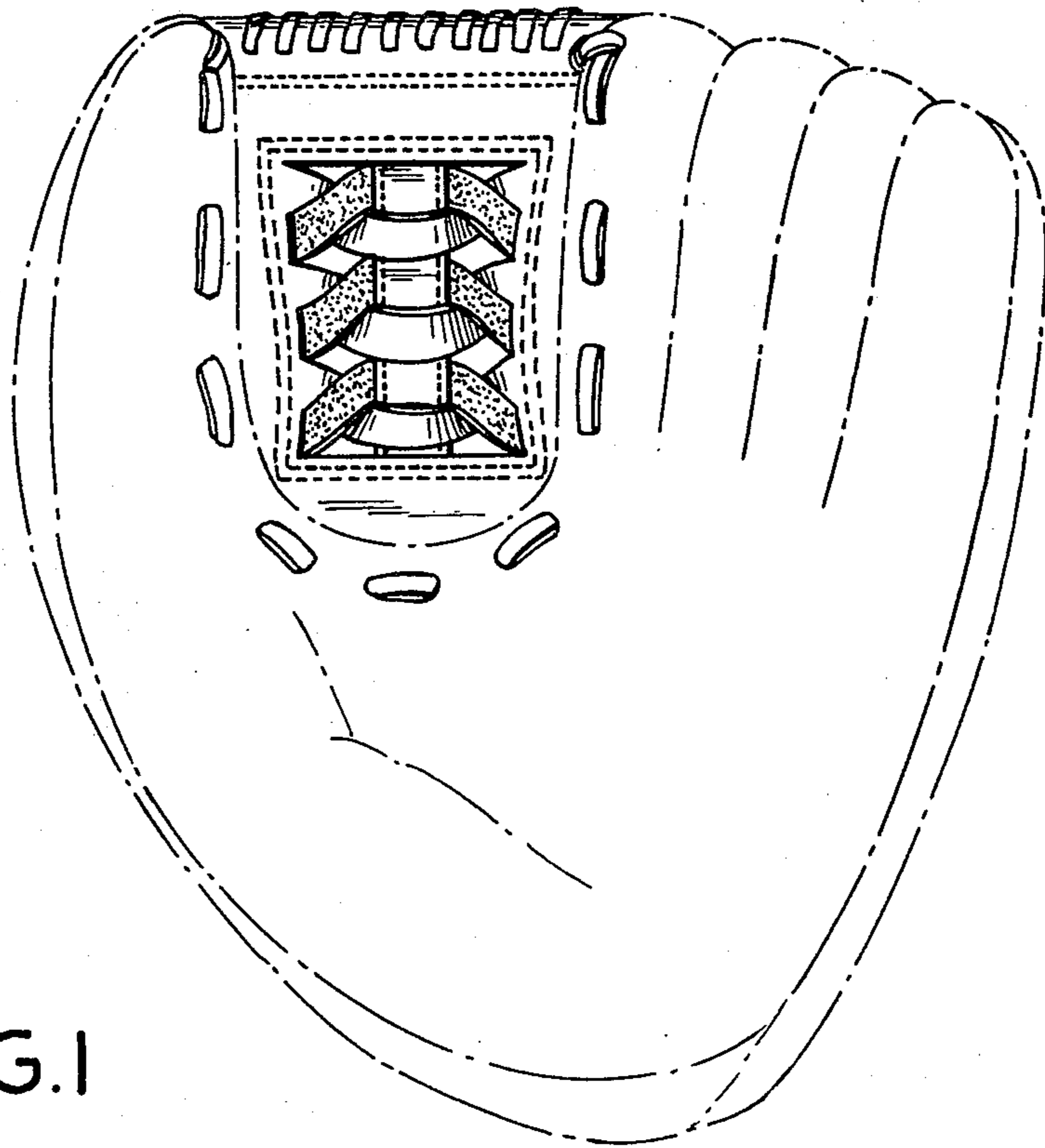

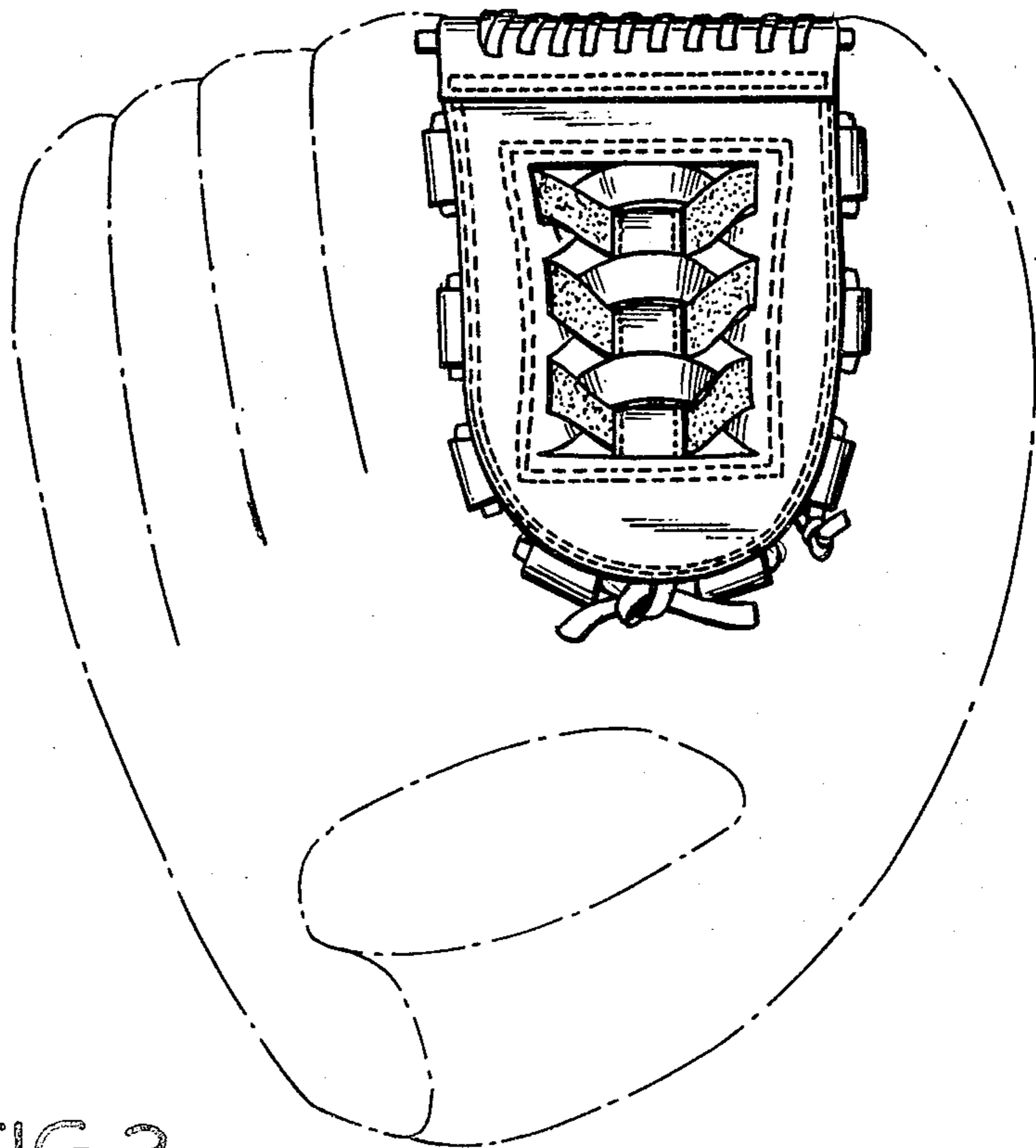
