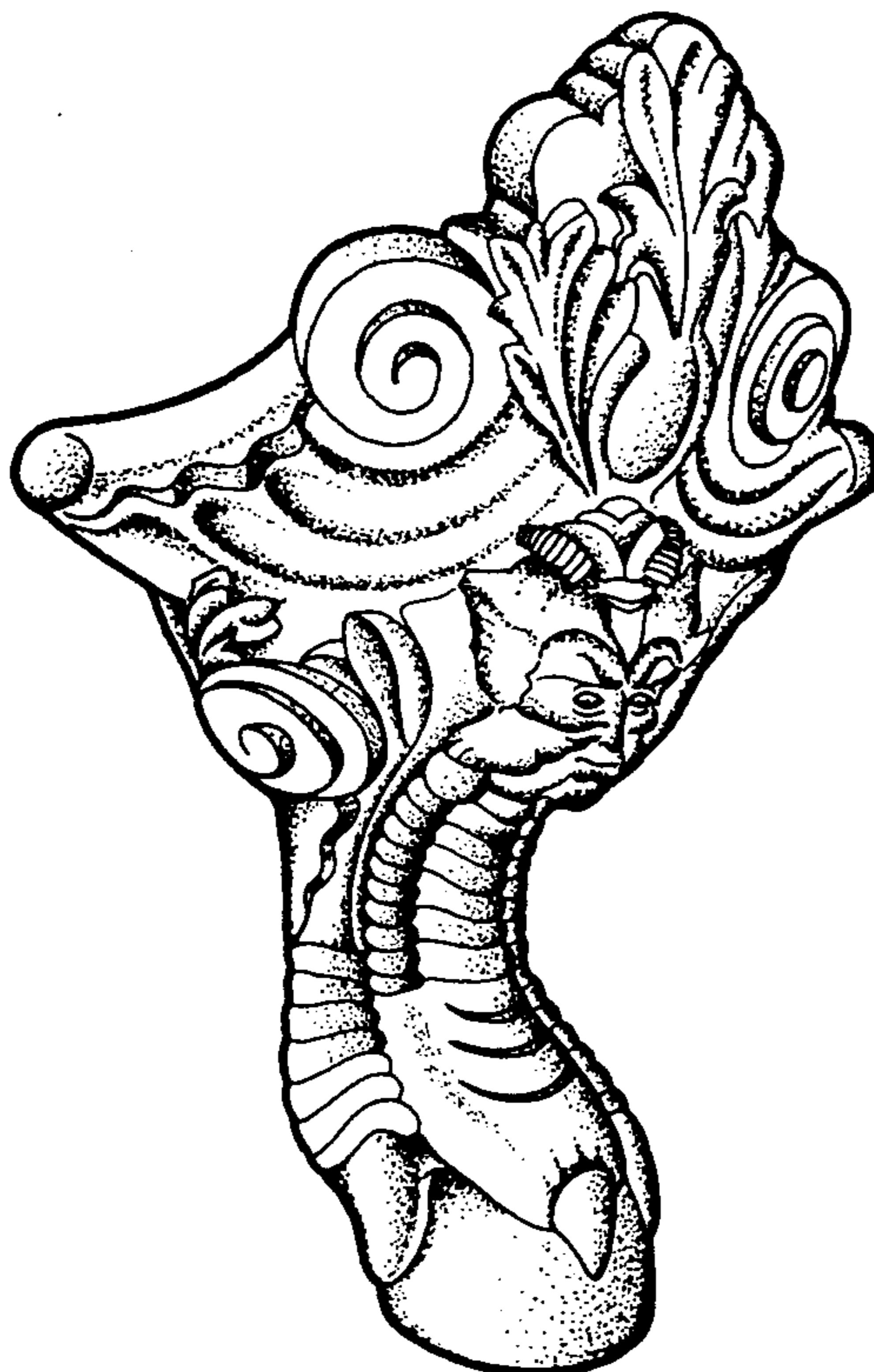

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, elevational view of the bathtub leg, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and left side thereof; and
FIG. 3 is a perspective view taken from the left side thereof.



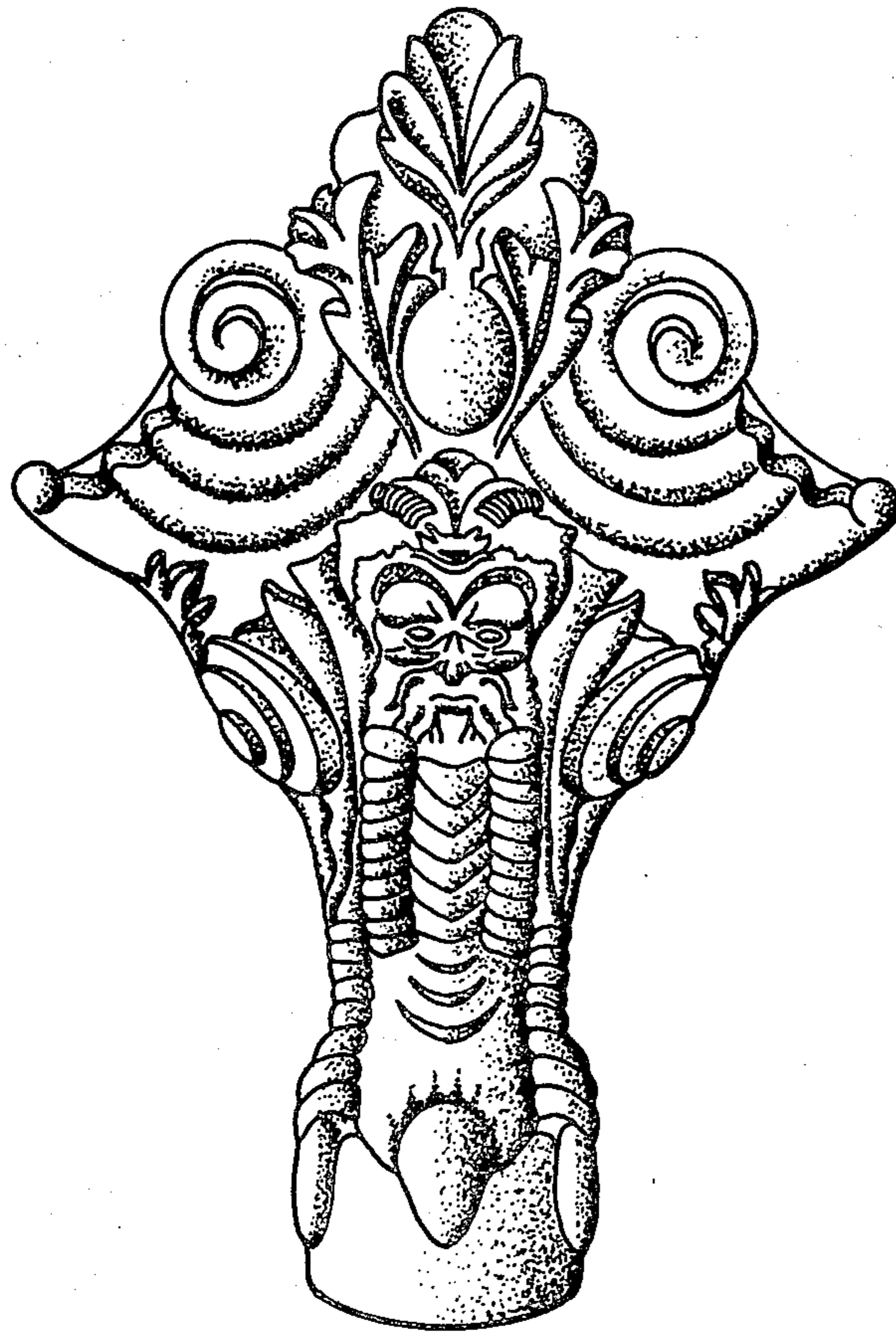

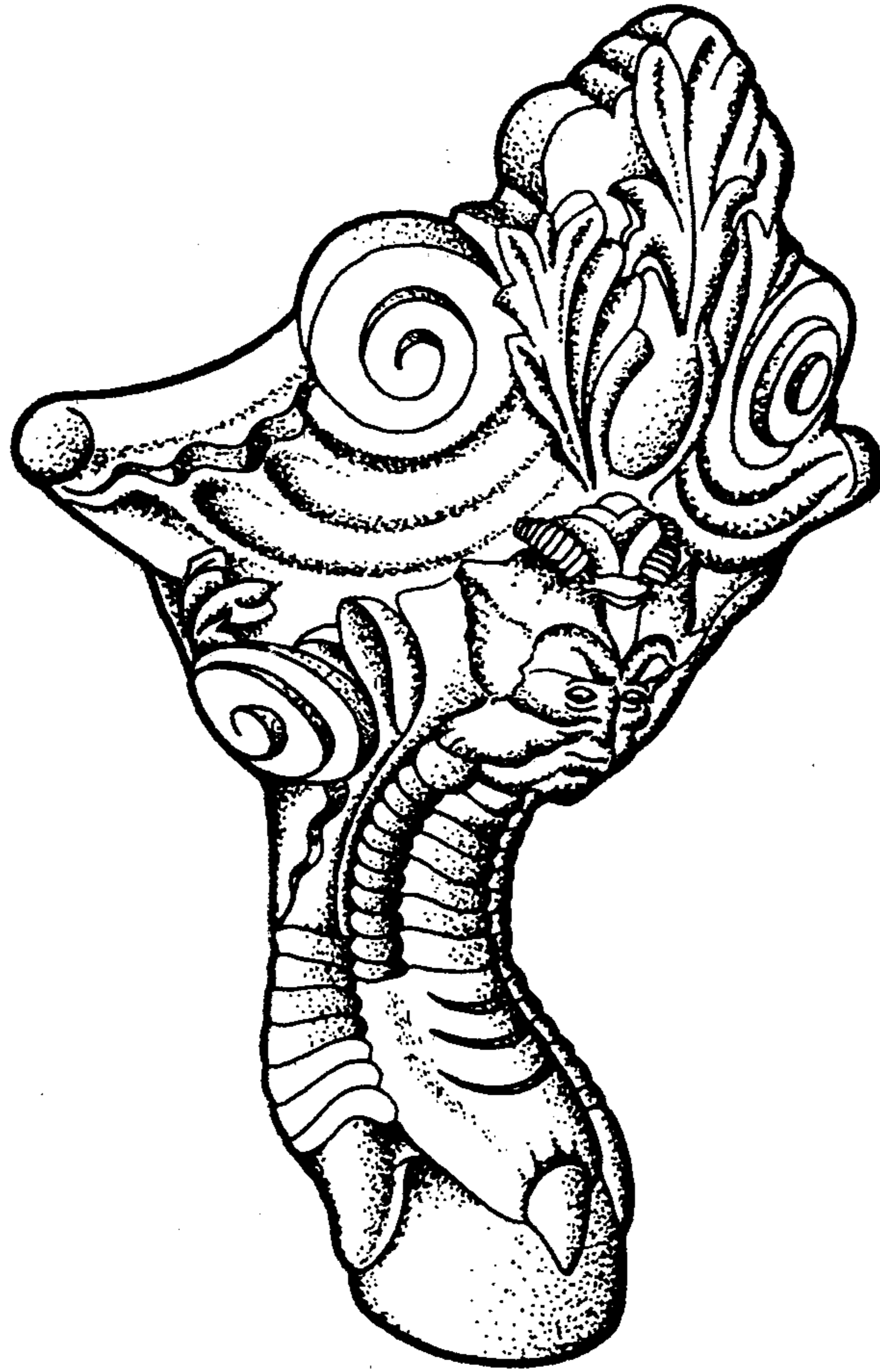
