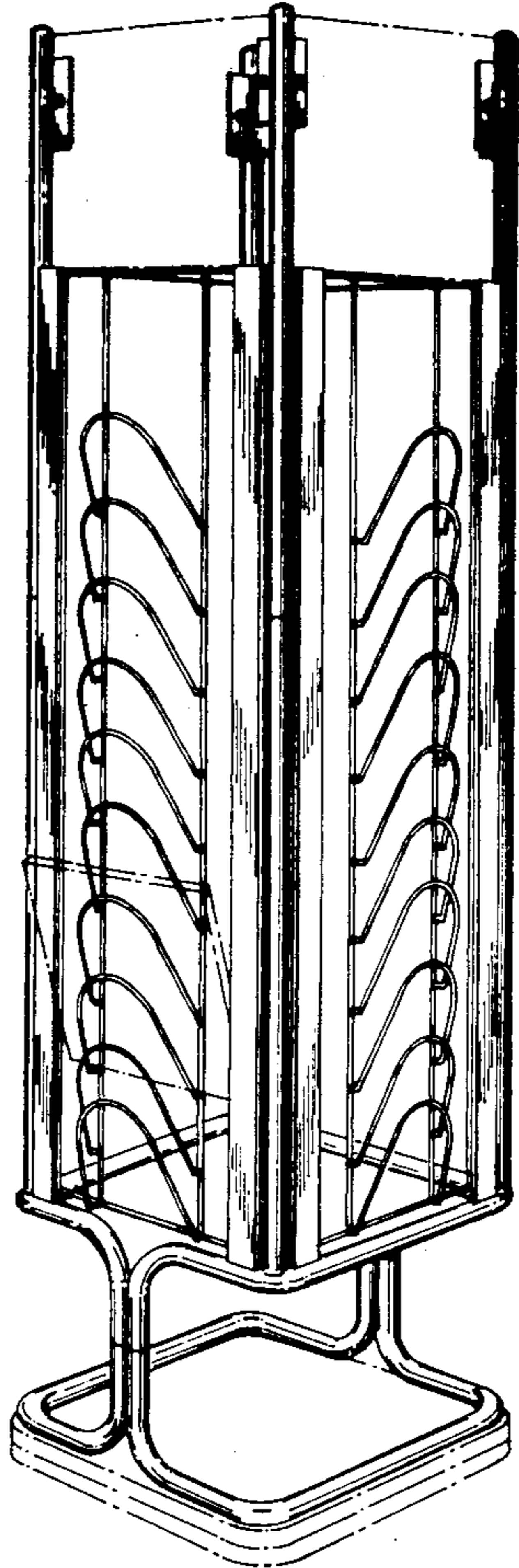

[57] **CLAIM**  
The ornamental design for a display rack for record album, video disc or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a display rack for record album, video disc or similar article showing my new design, the opposite sides not shown being identical thereto;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; and  
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof.

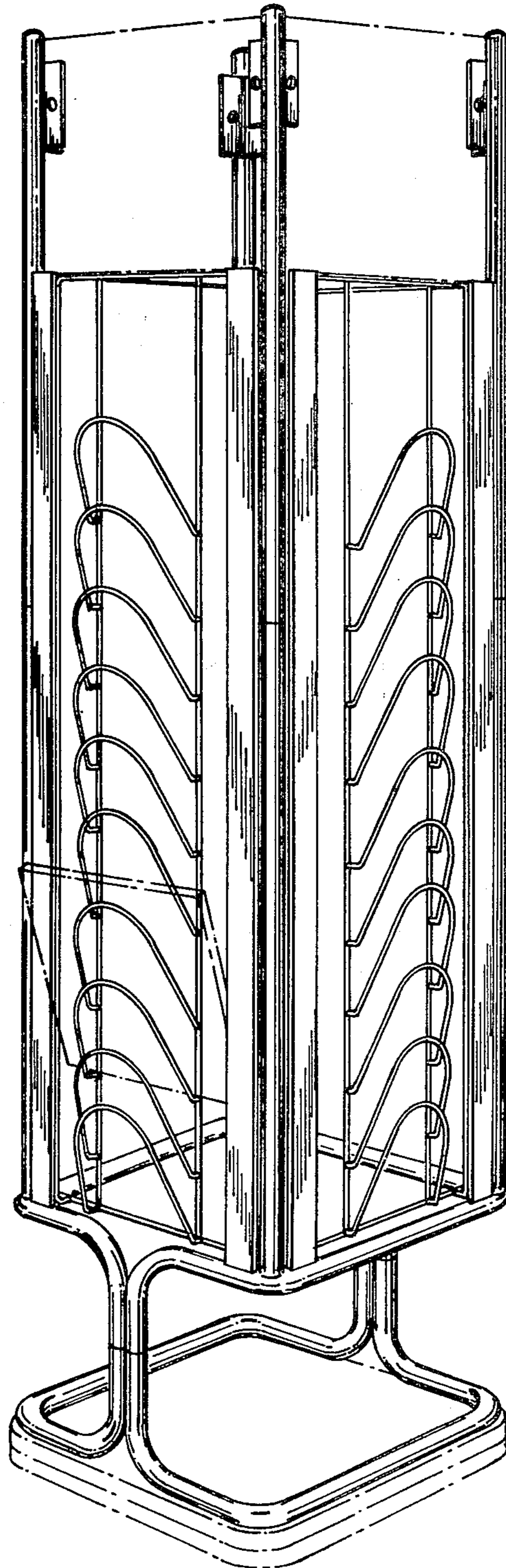

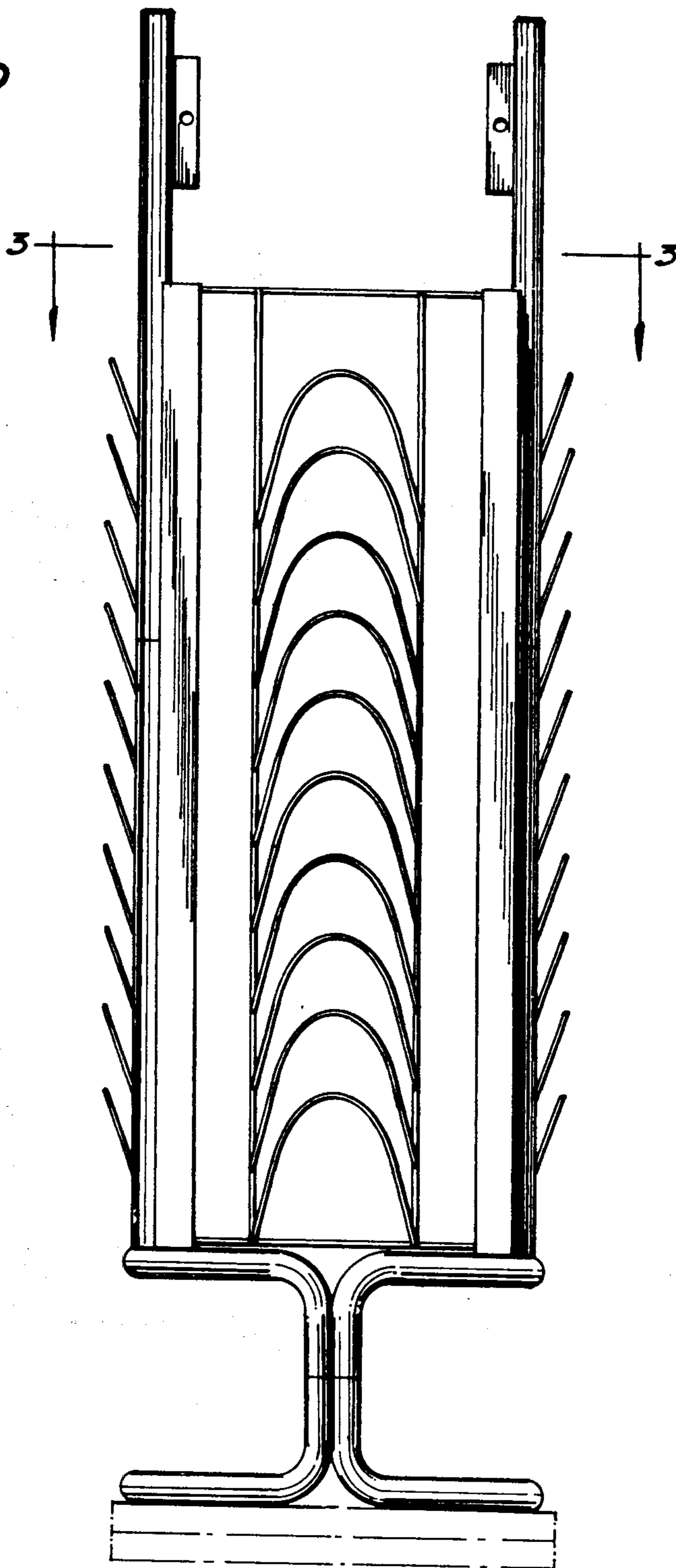
