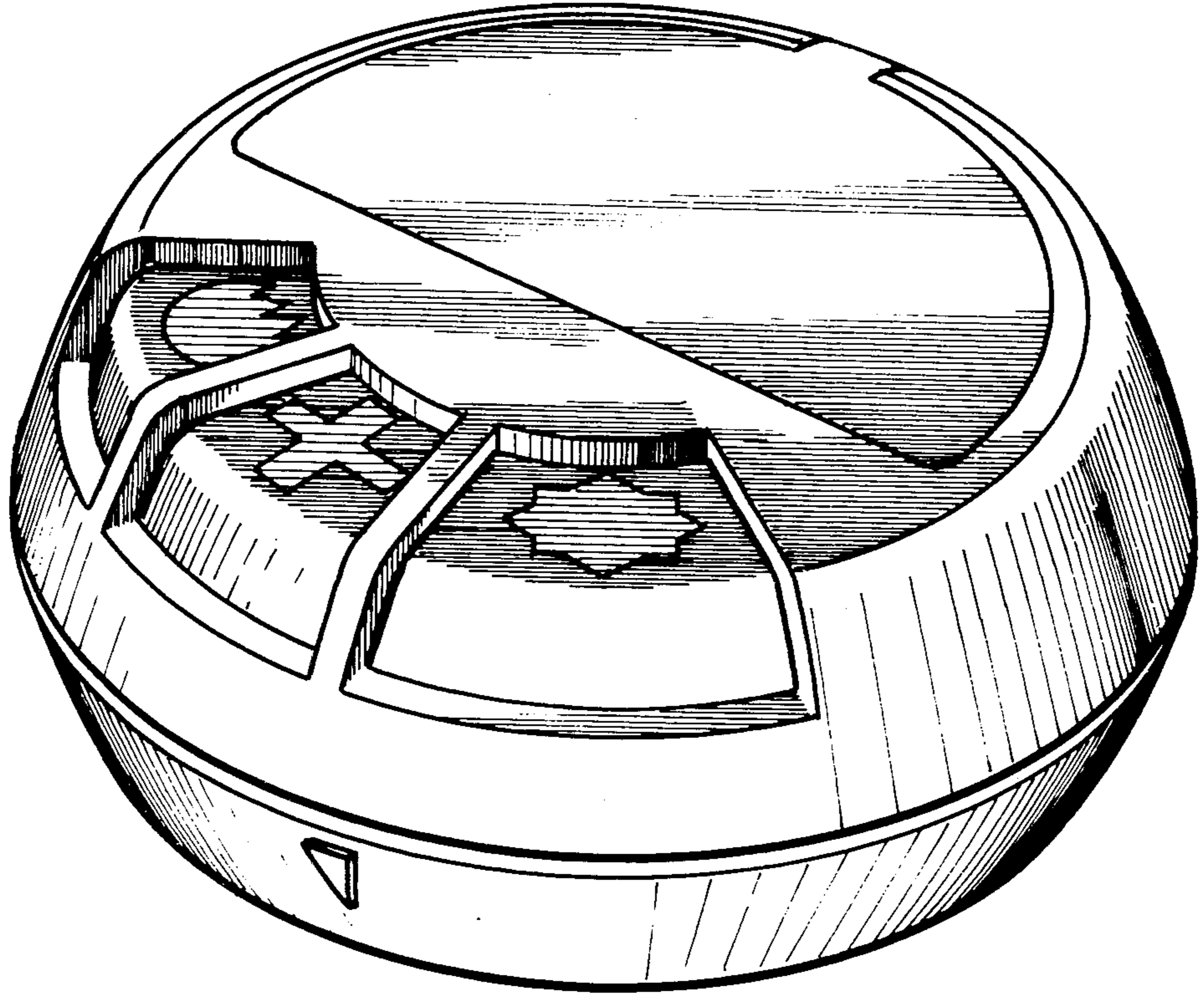
CLAIM

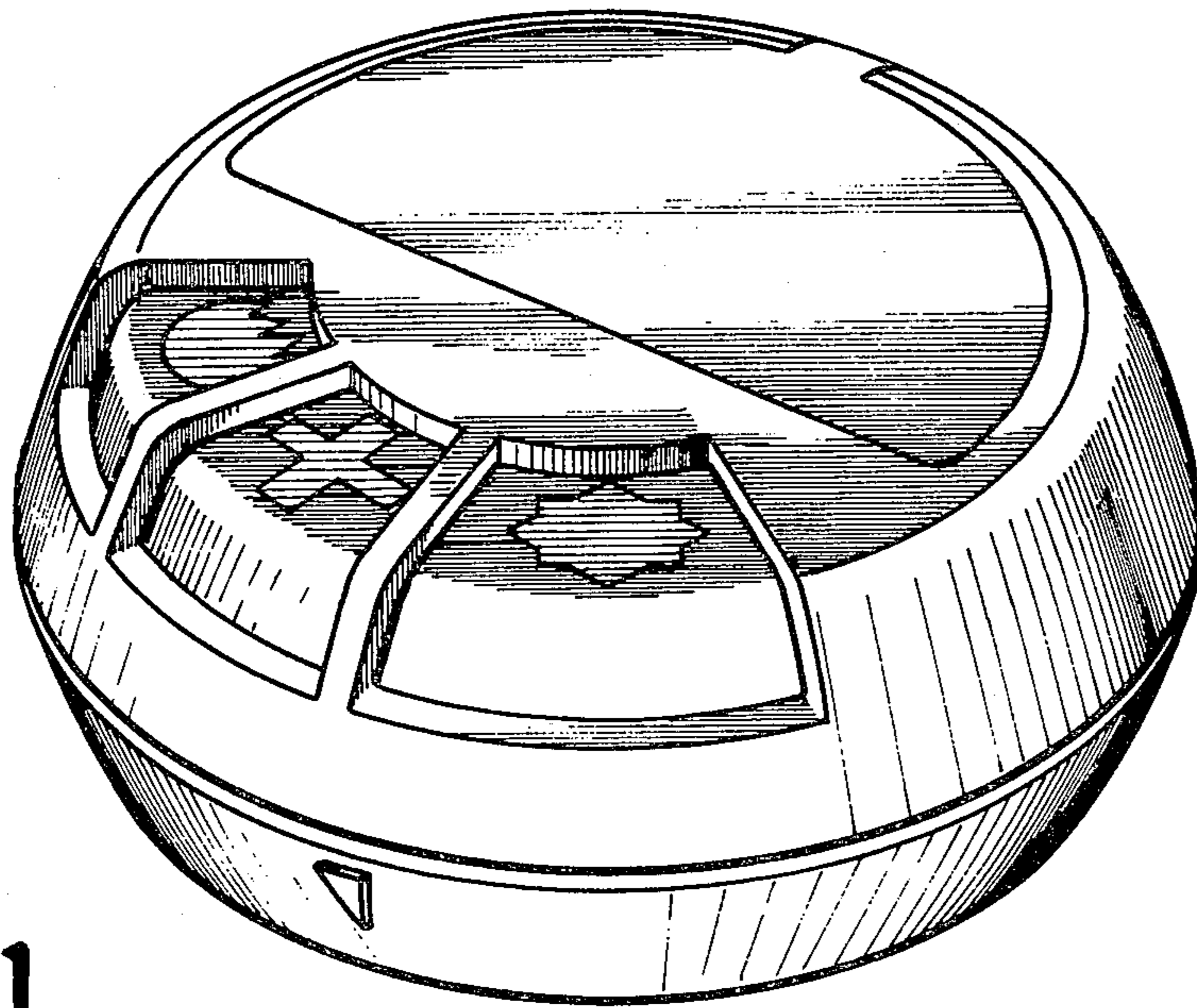

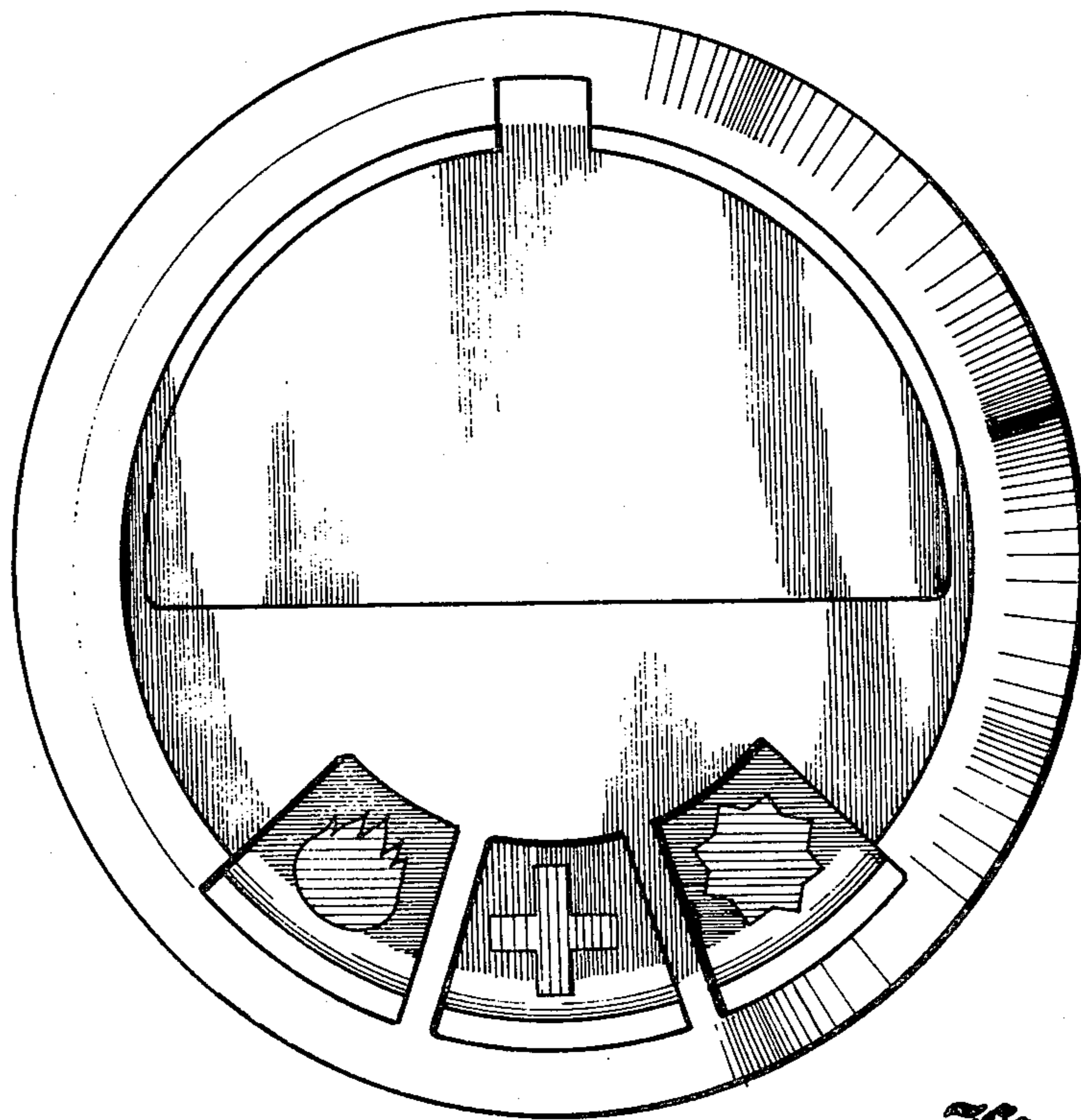

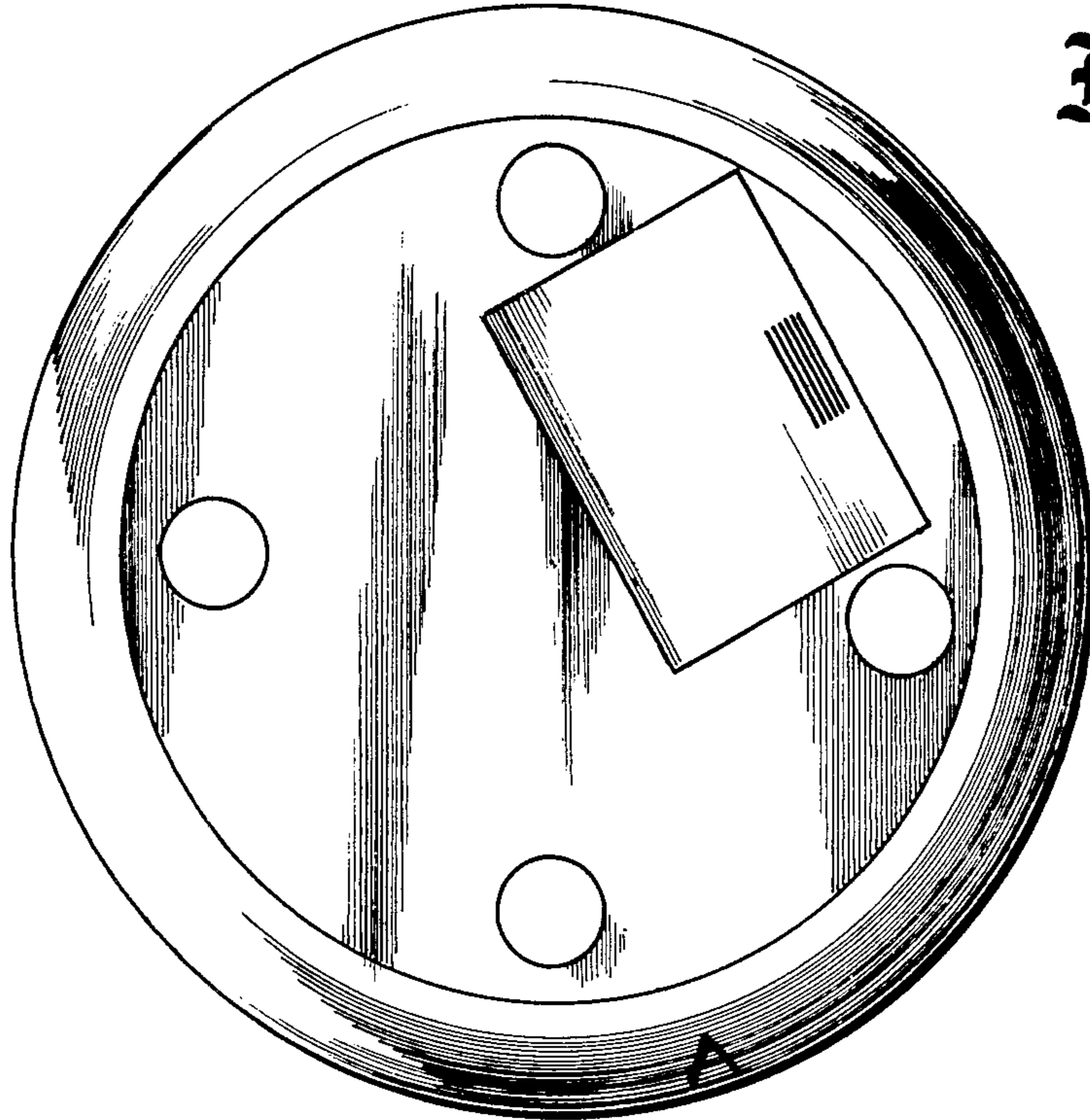

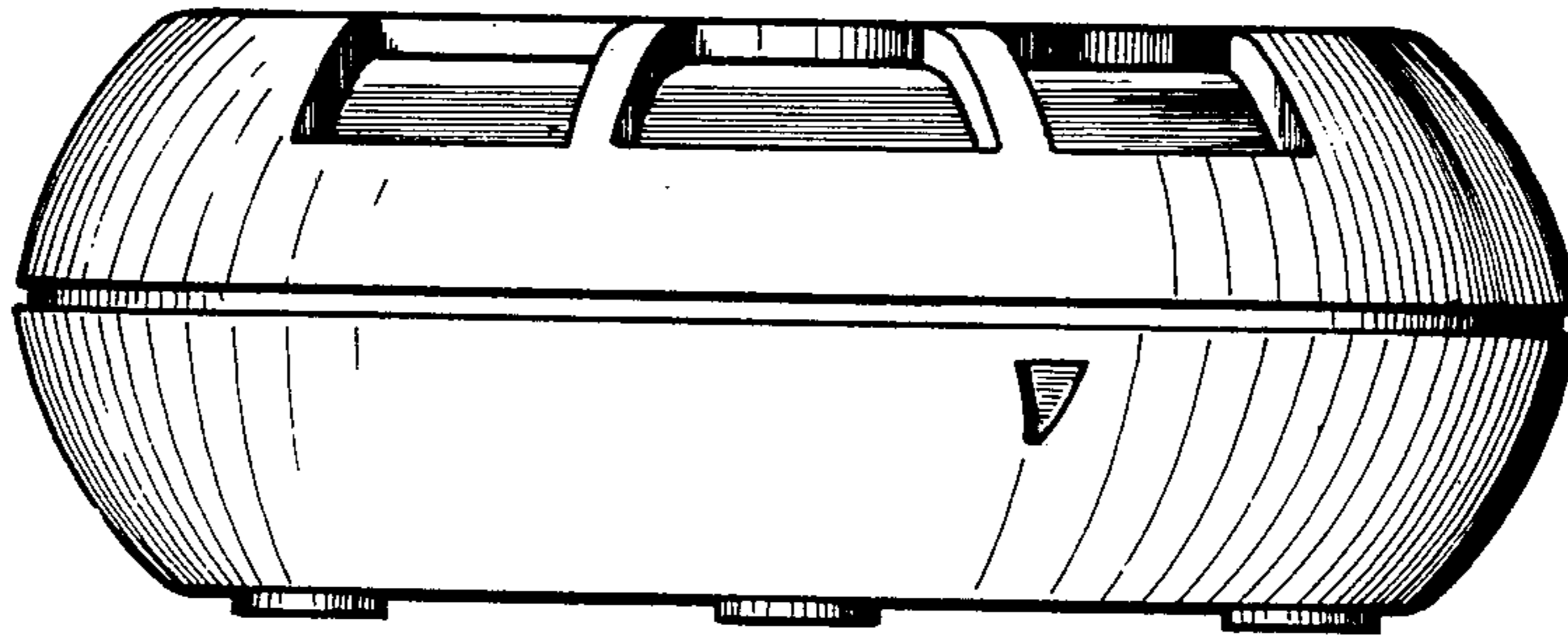

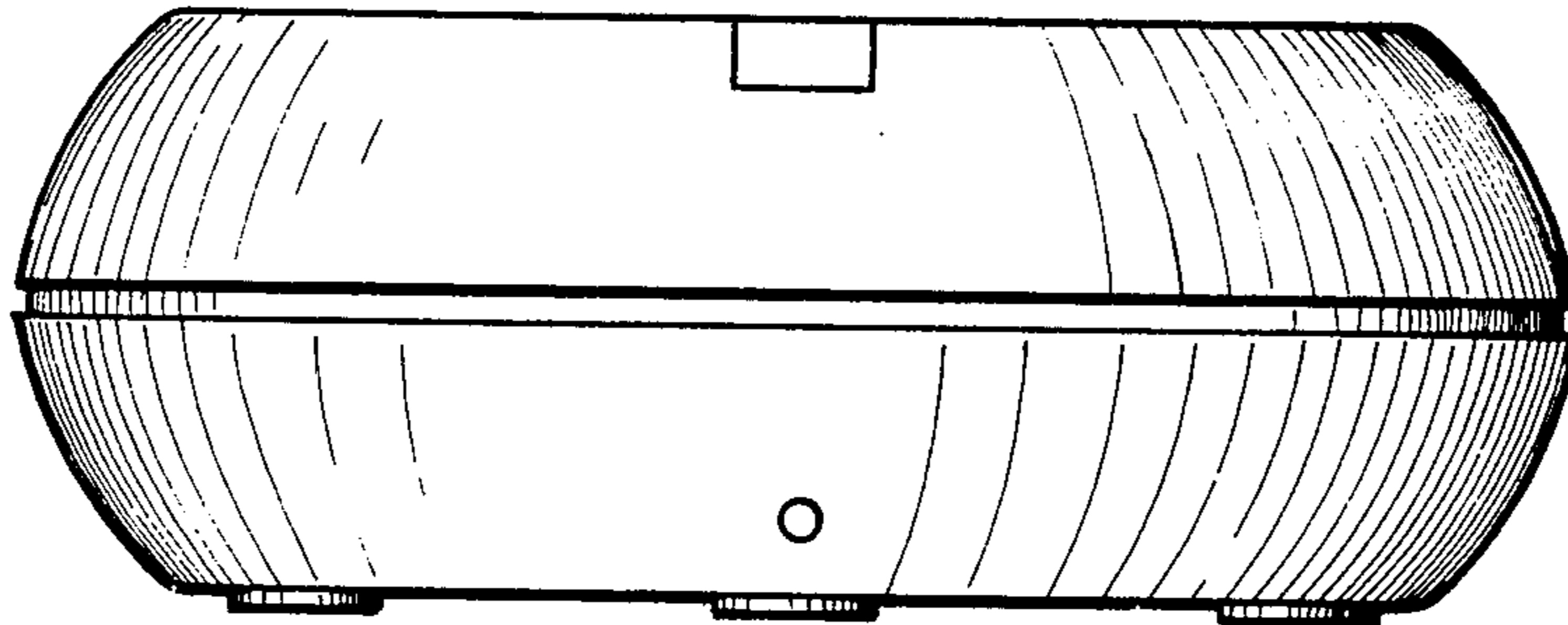
