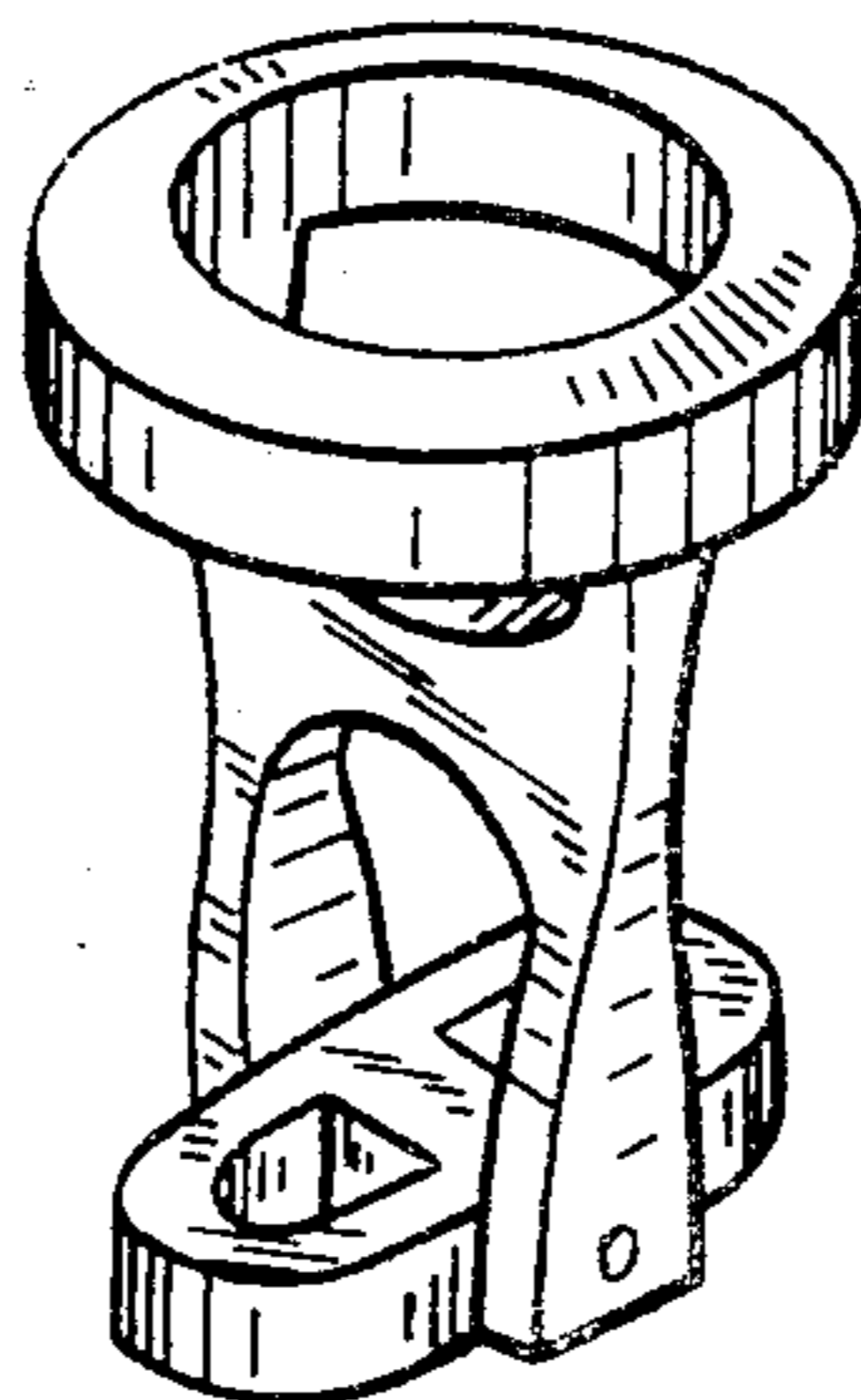

FIG. 3 is a side-elevational view thereof.



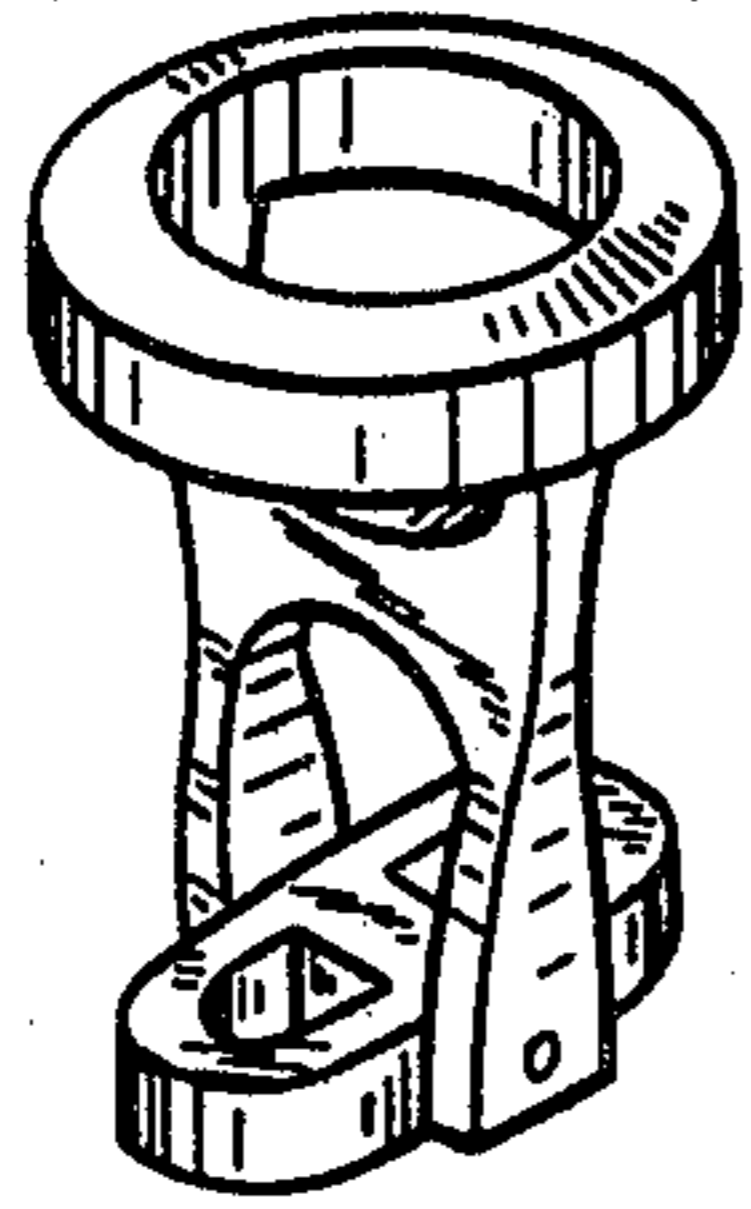

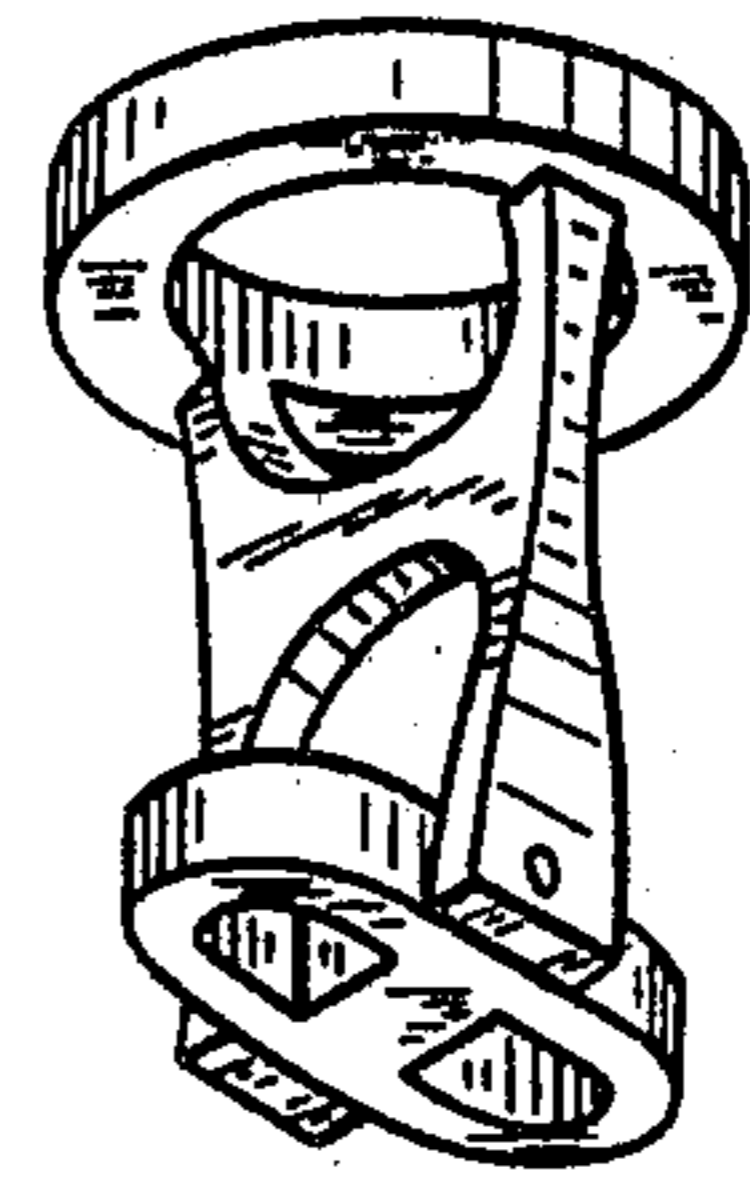

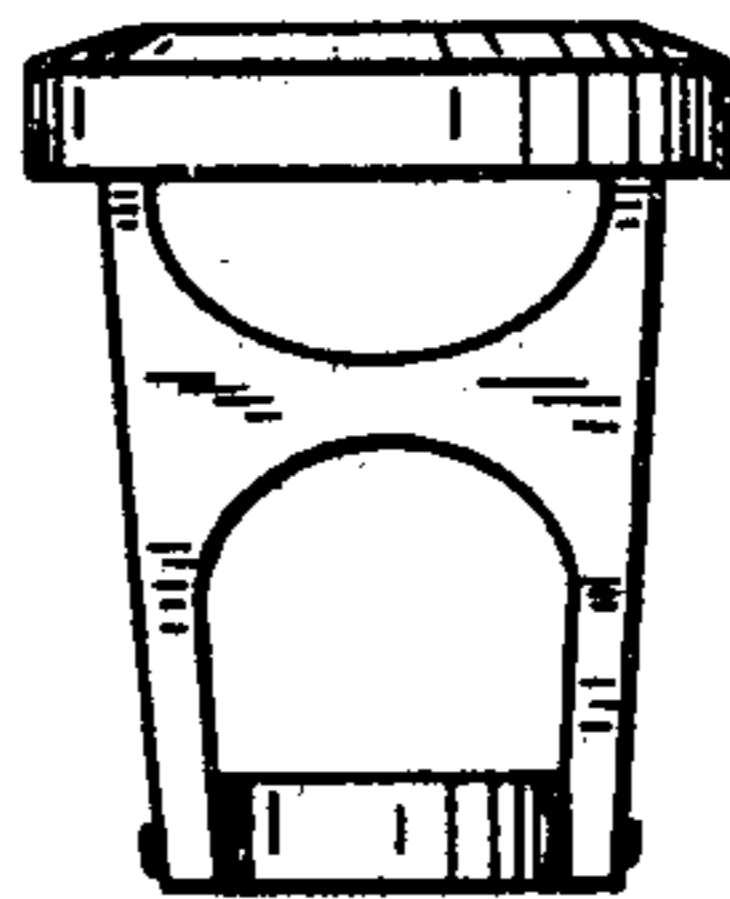
