[57] The ornamental design for a surgical forceps, substantially as shown and described.

FIG. 1 is a perspective view showing the front, left side and top of a surgical forceps;

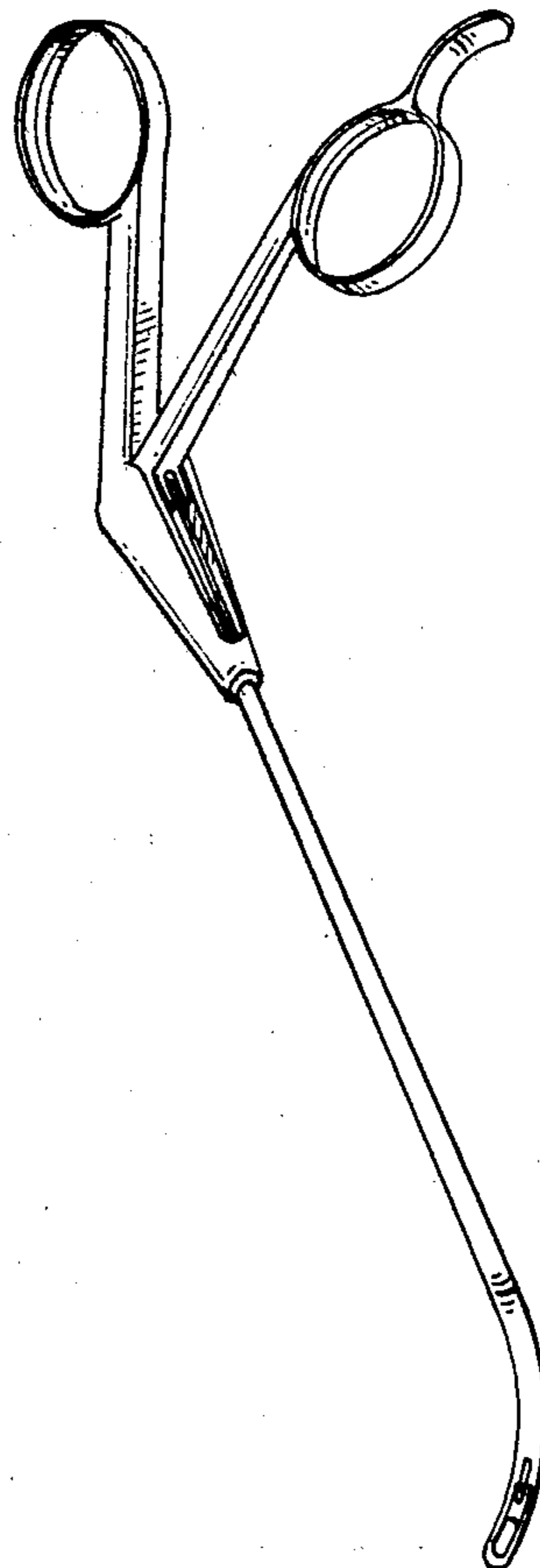

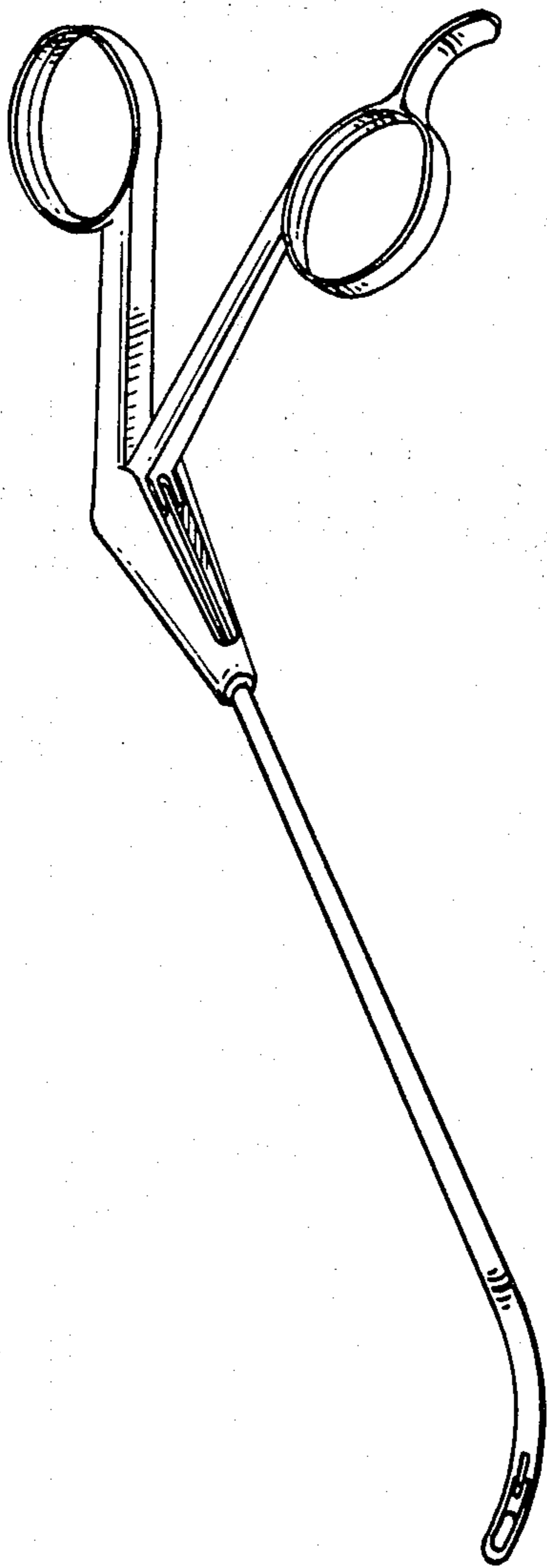

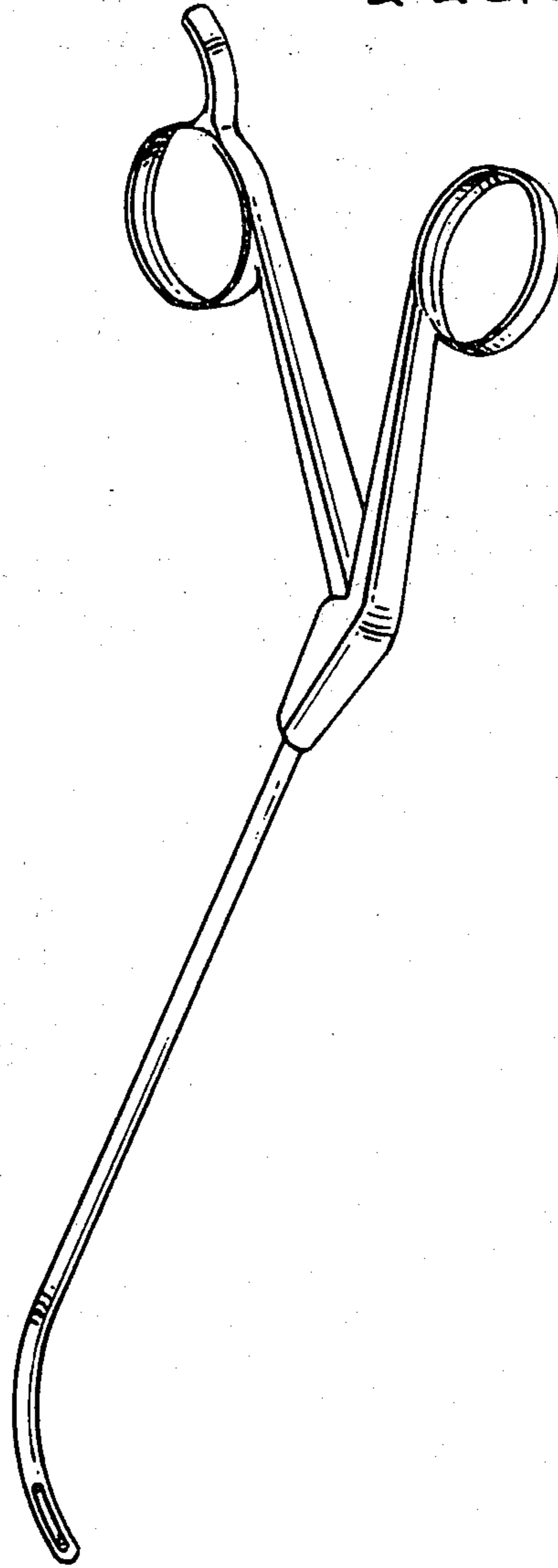
