The ornamental design for a double dresser, substantially as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a double dresser showing my new design.  
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof.  
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof.  
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof.  
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.  
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.  
The dark vertical stripes shown on FIGS. 1, 3 and 4 are representation of color contrast.

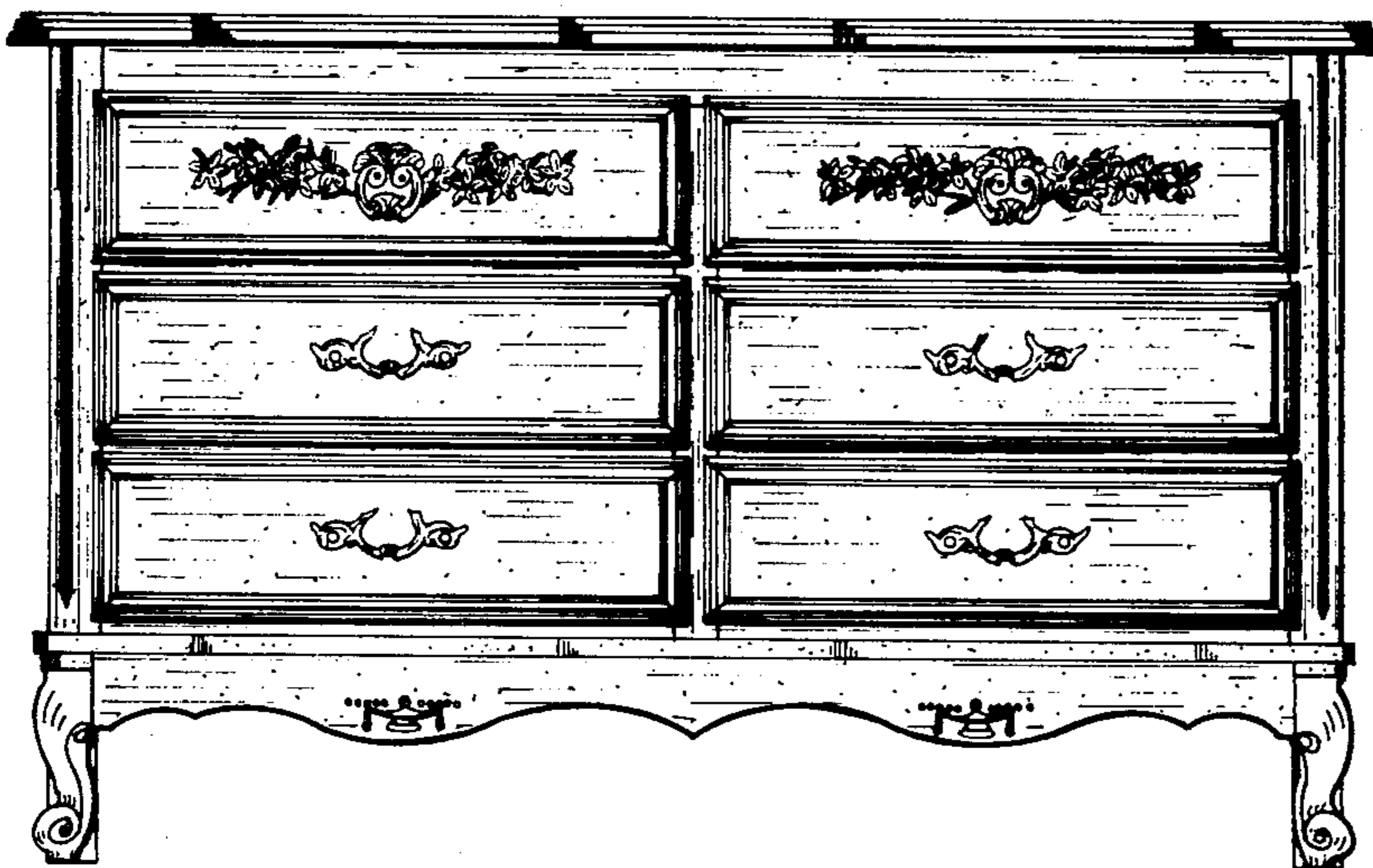
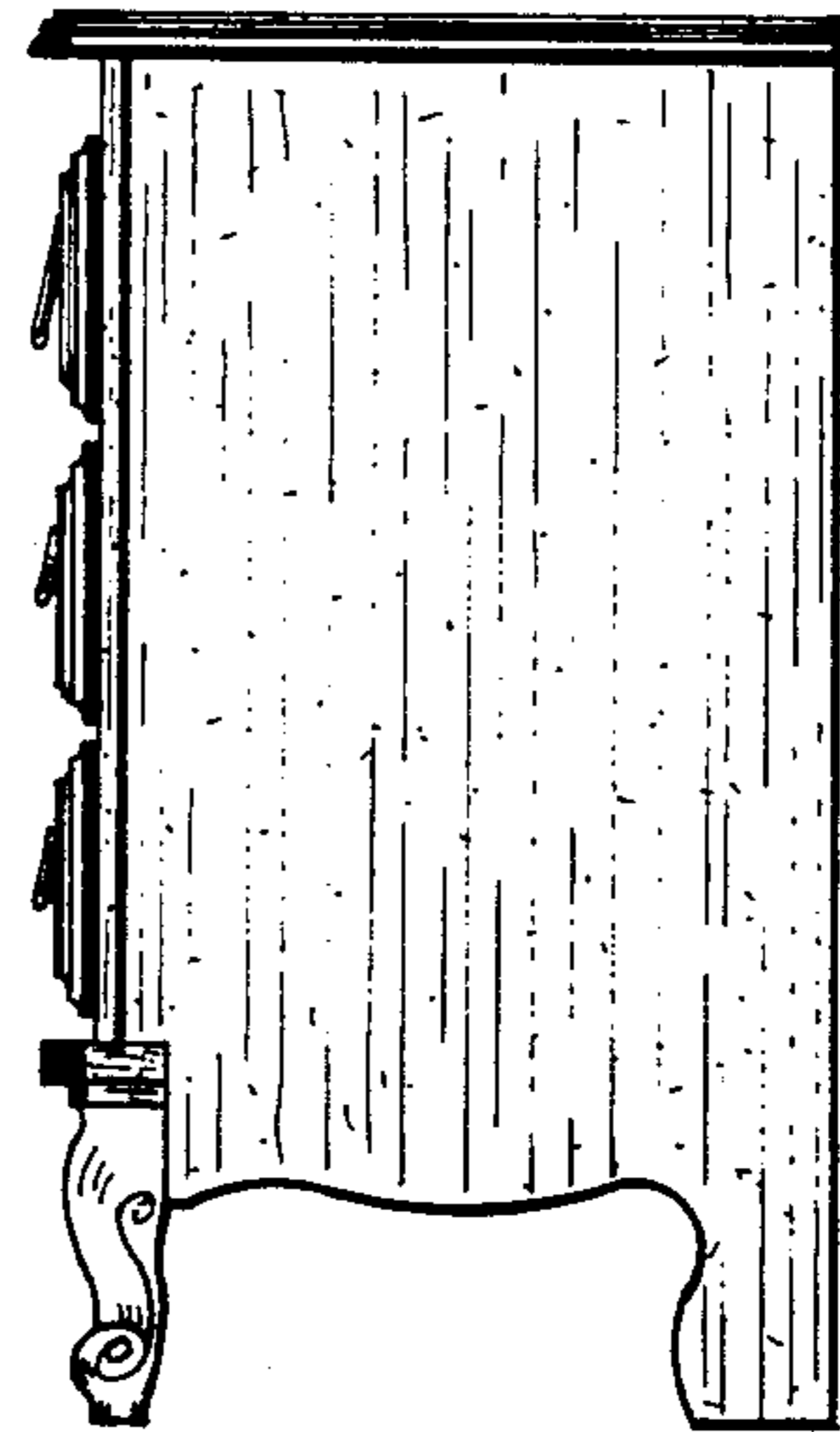

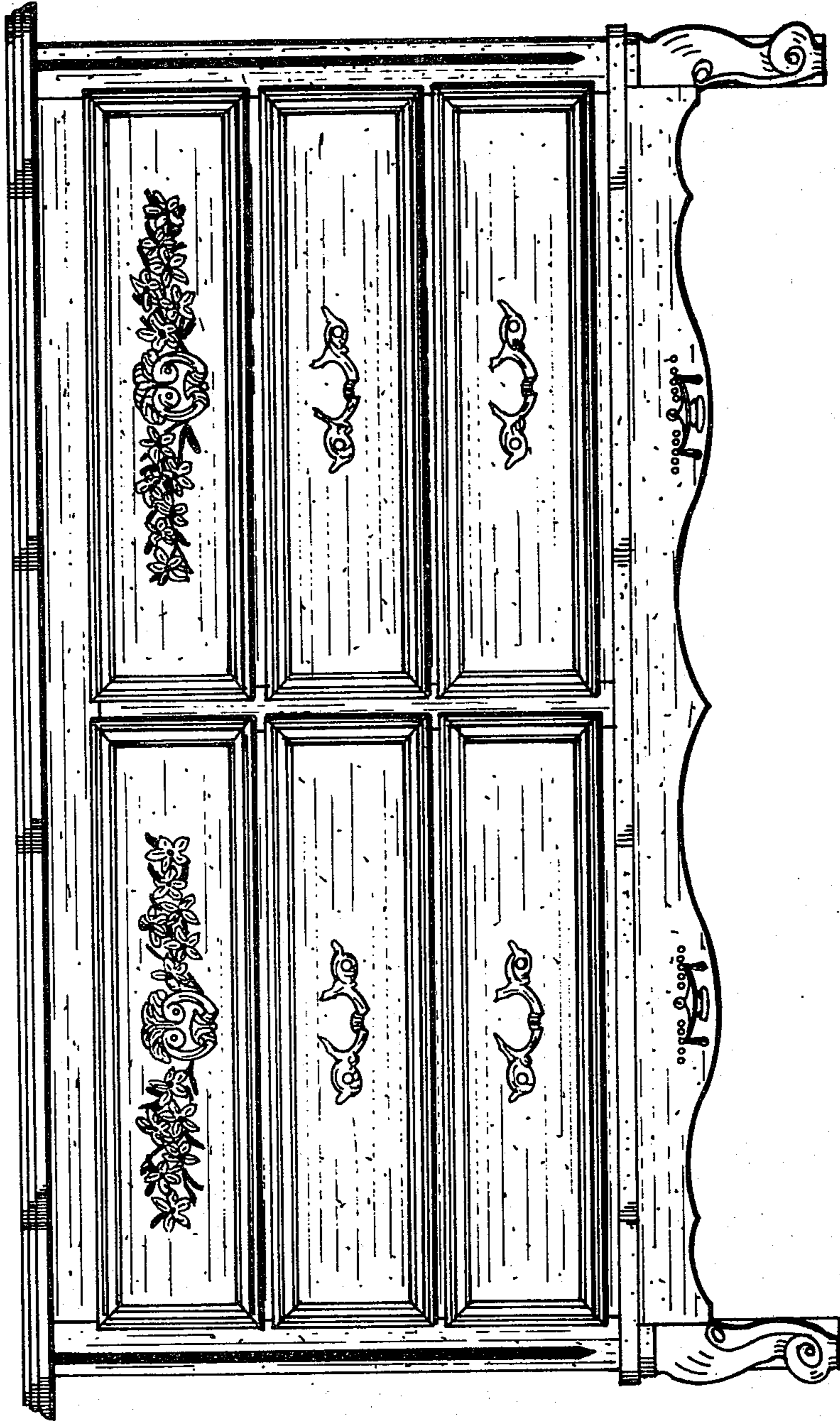

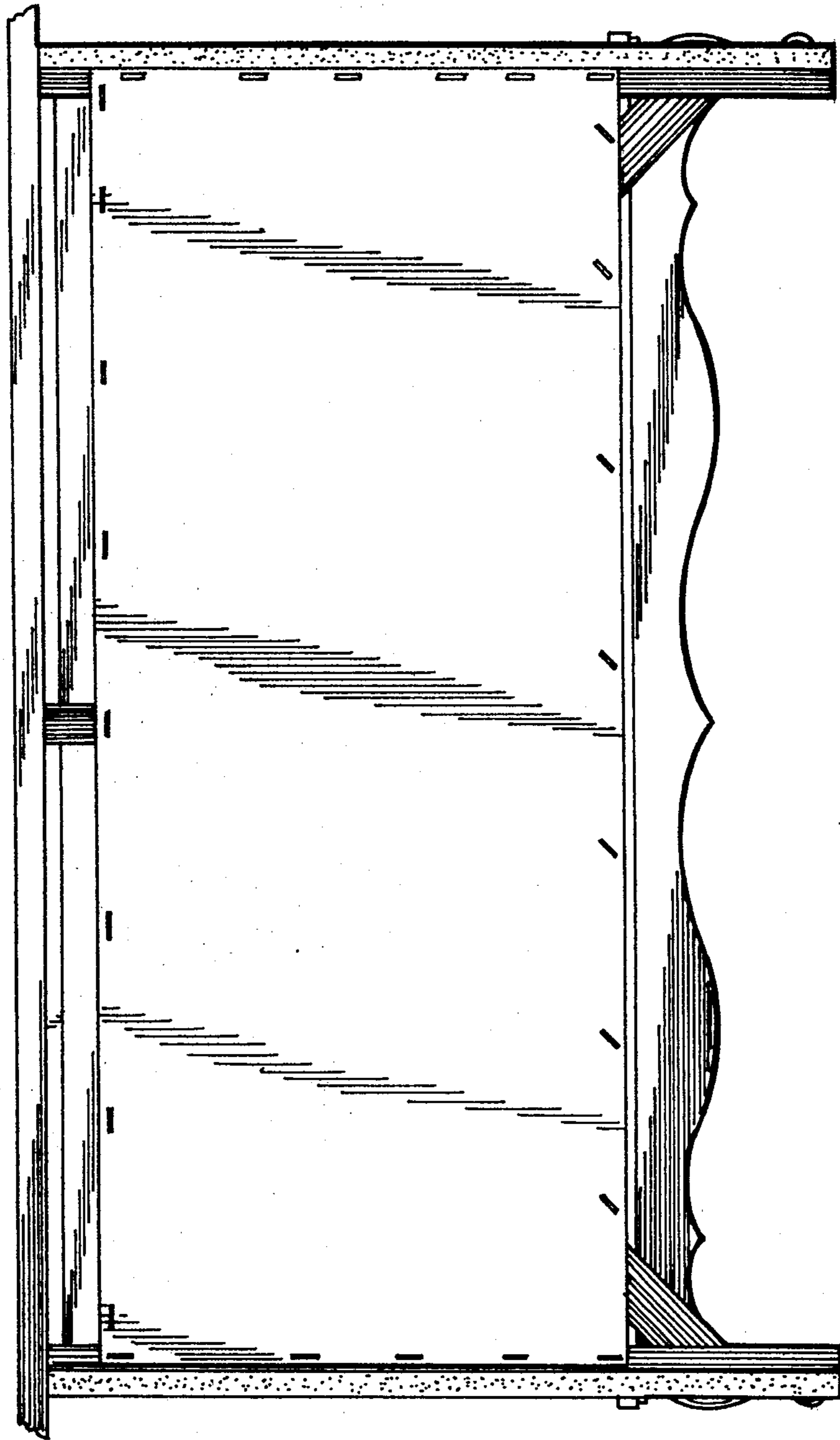

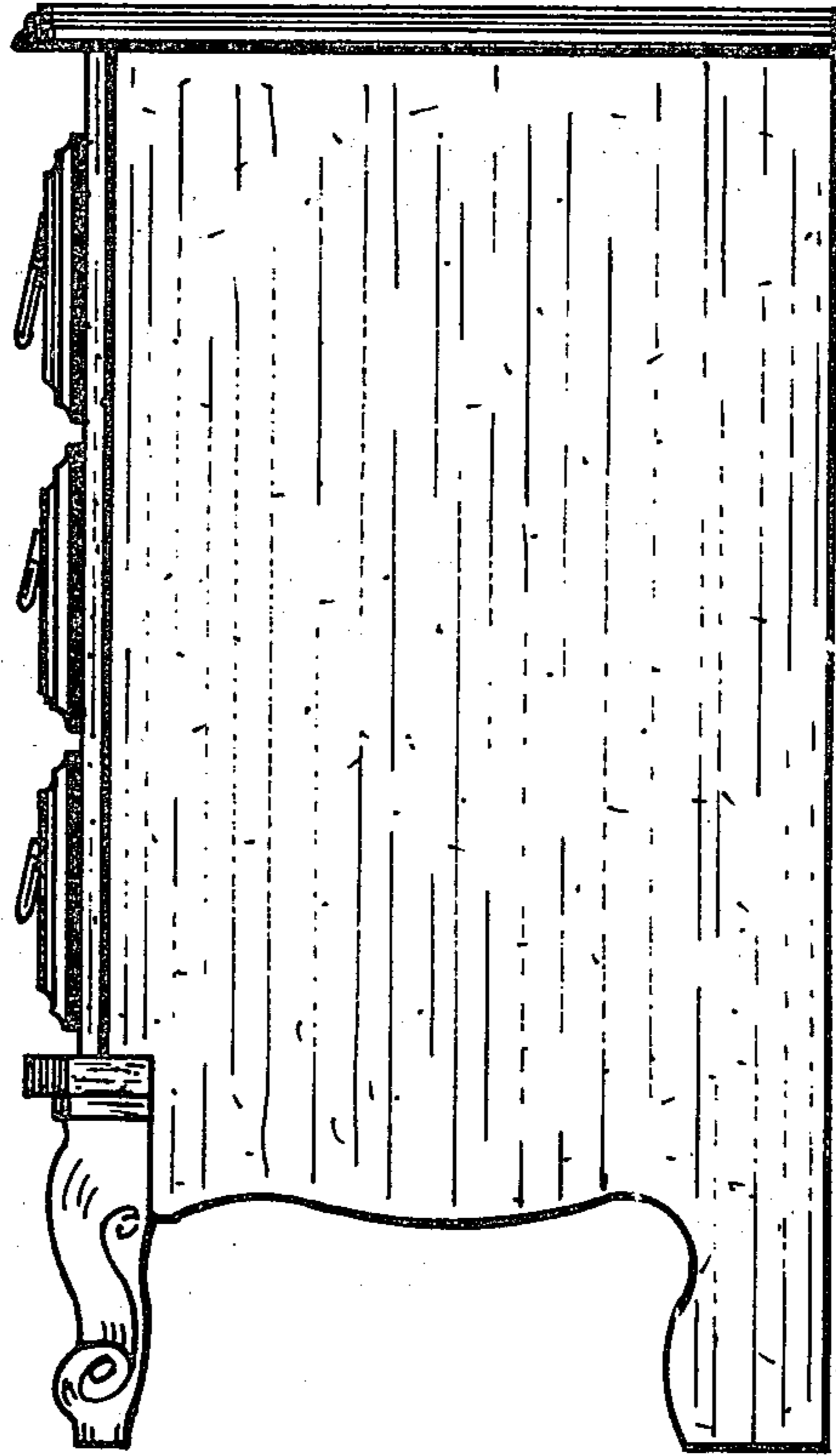
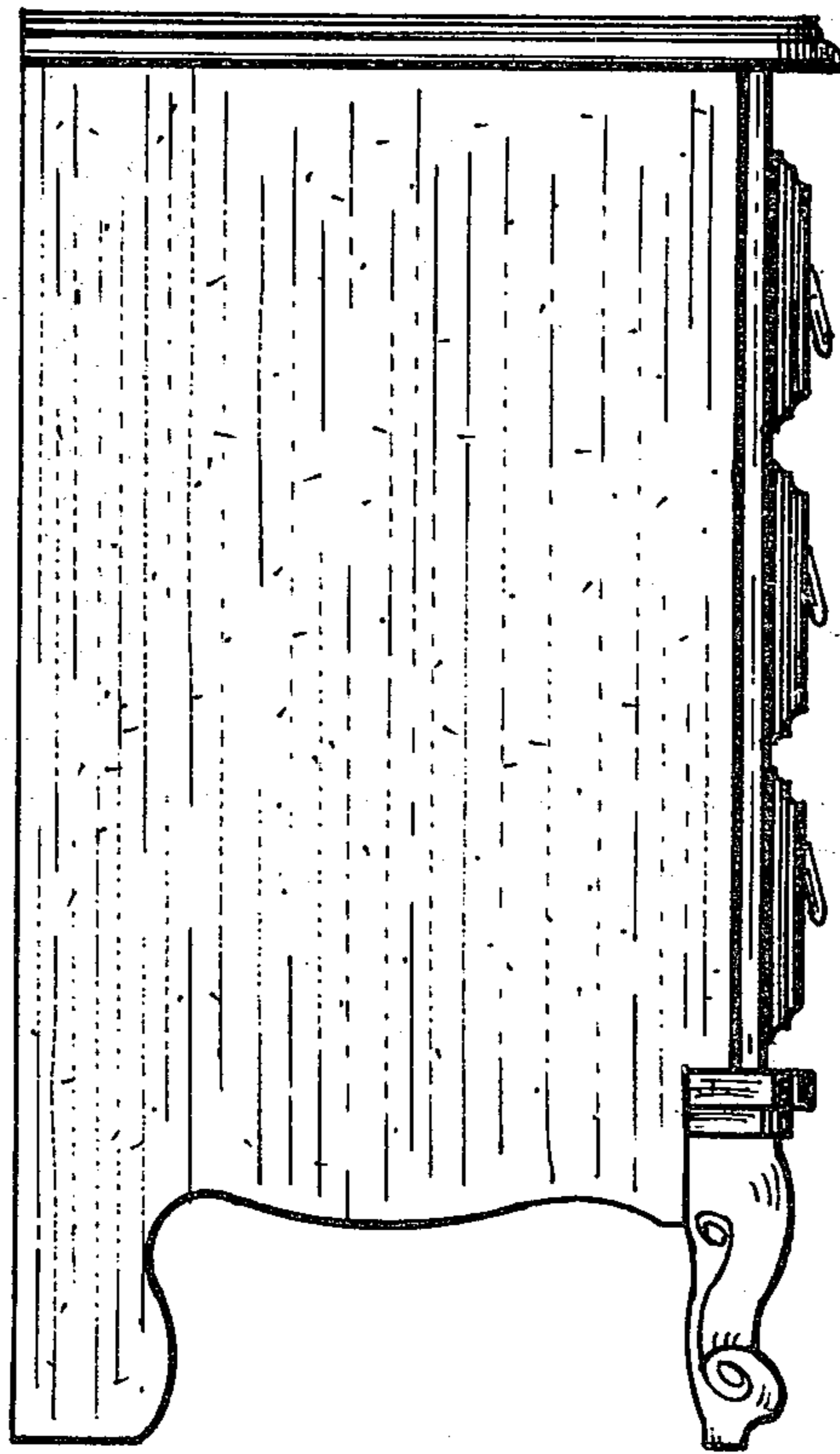

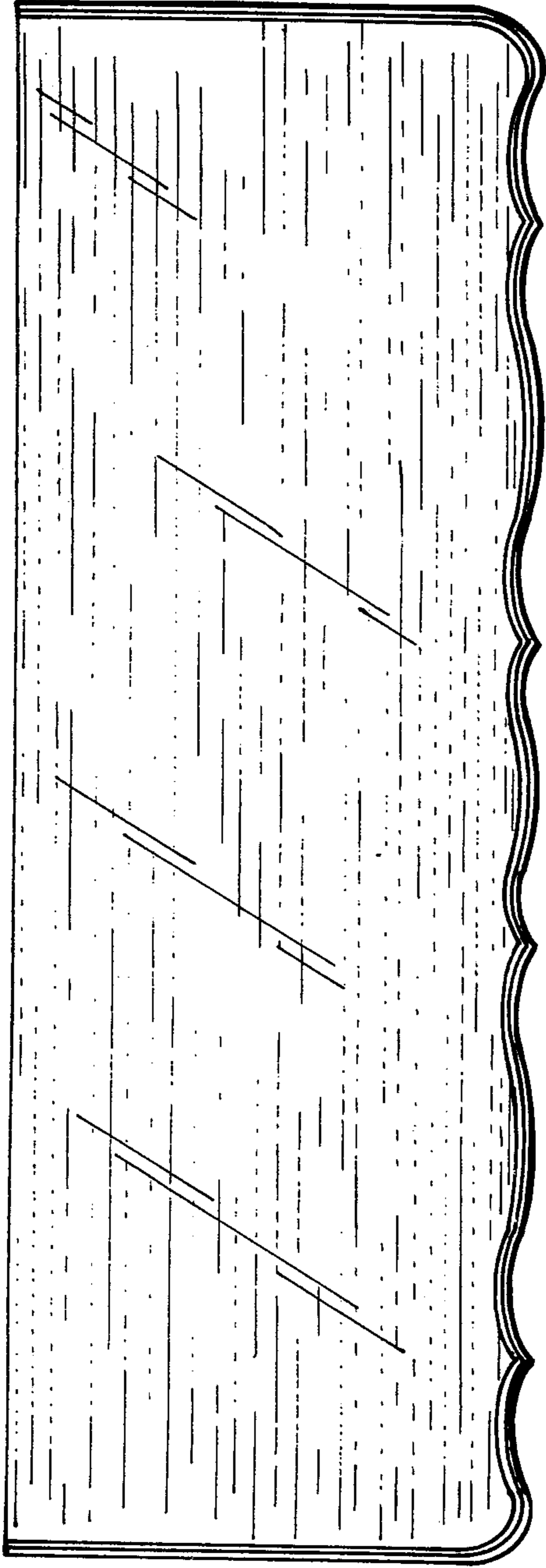

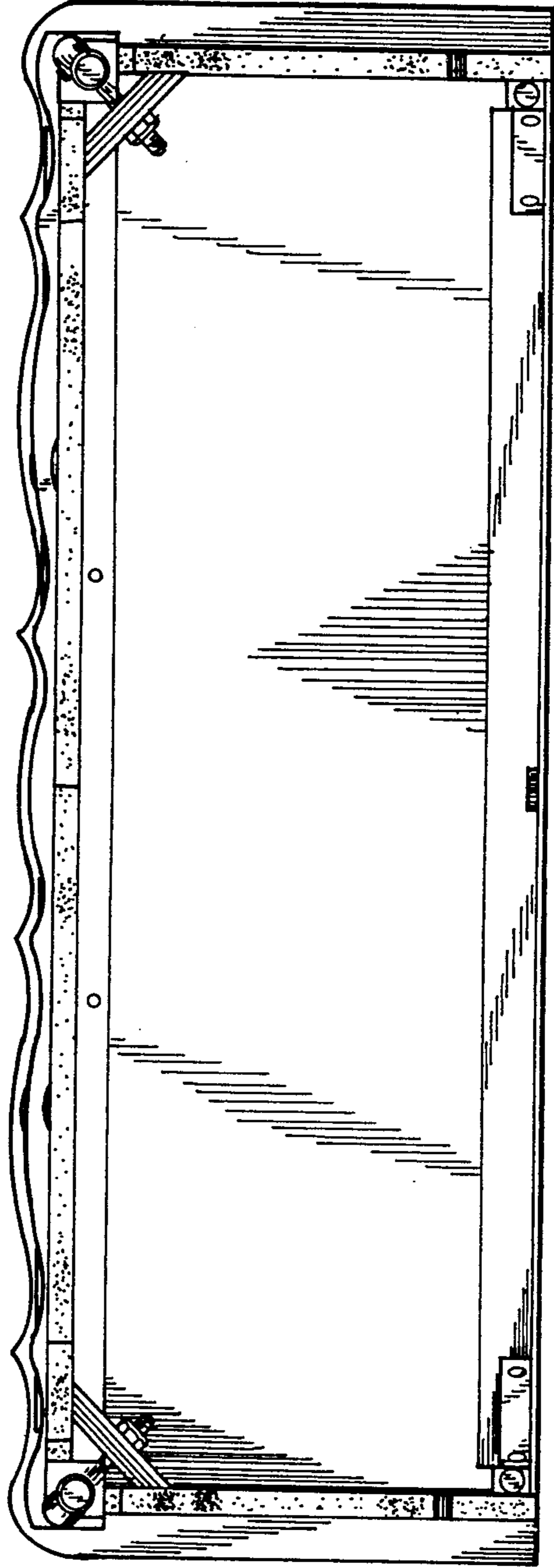
