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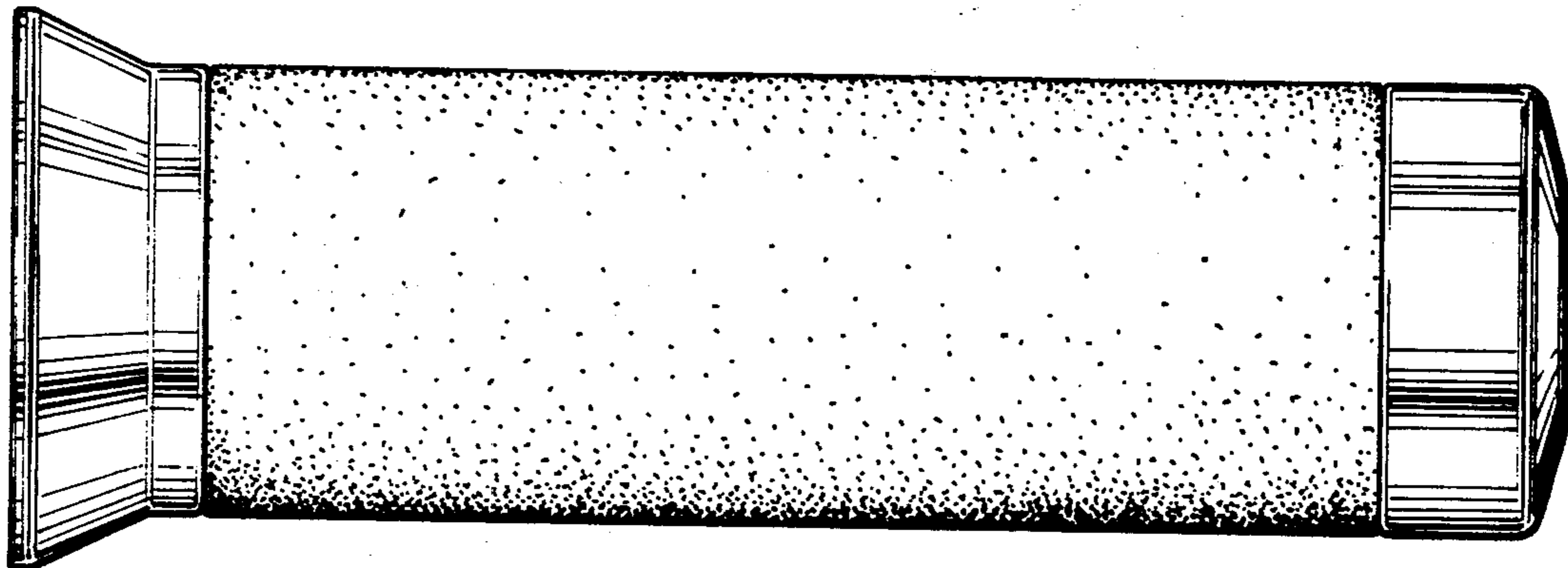

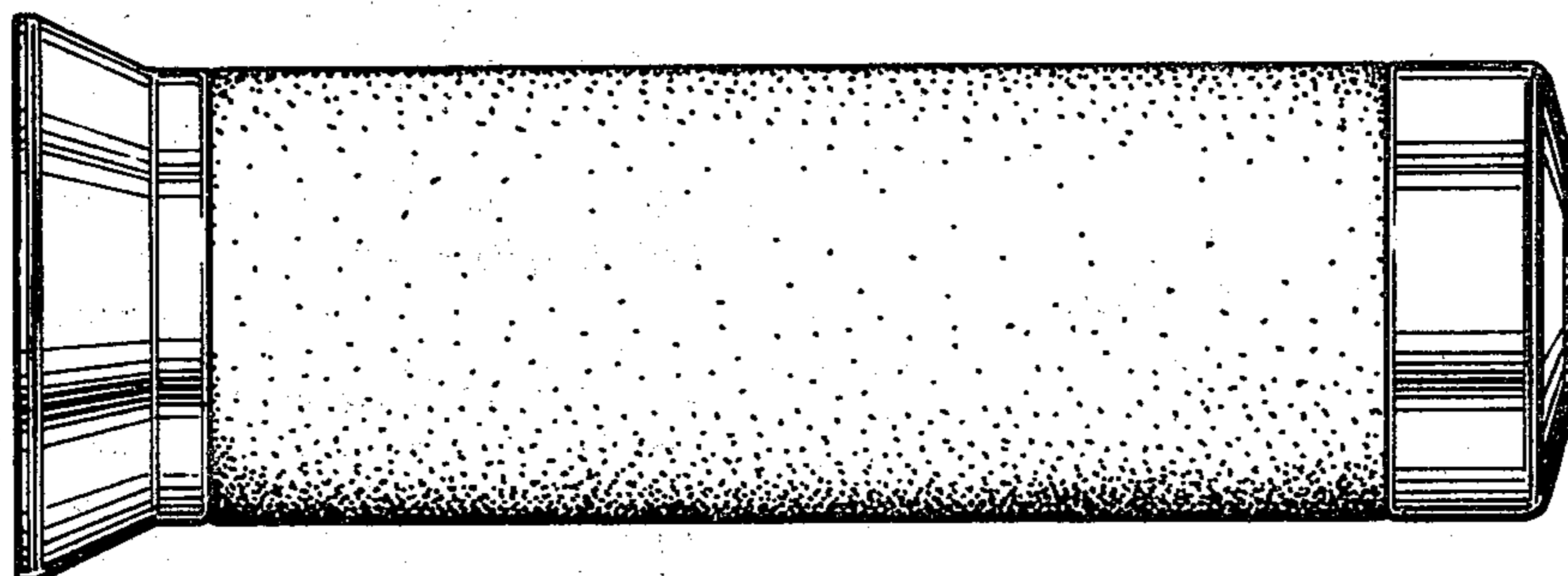
The ornamental design for a motorcycle handlebar grip, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

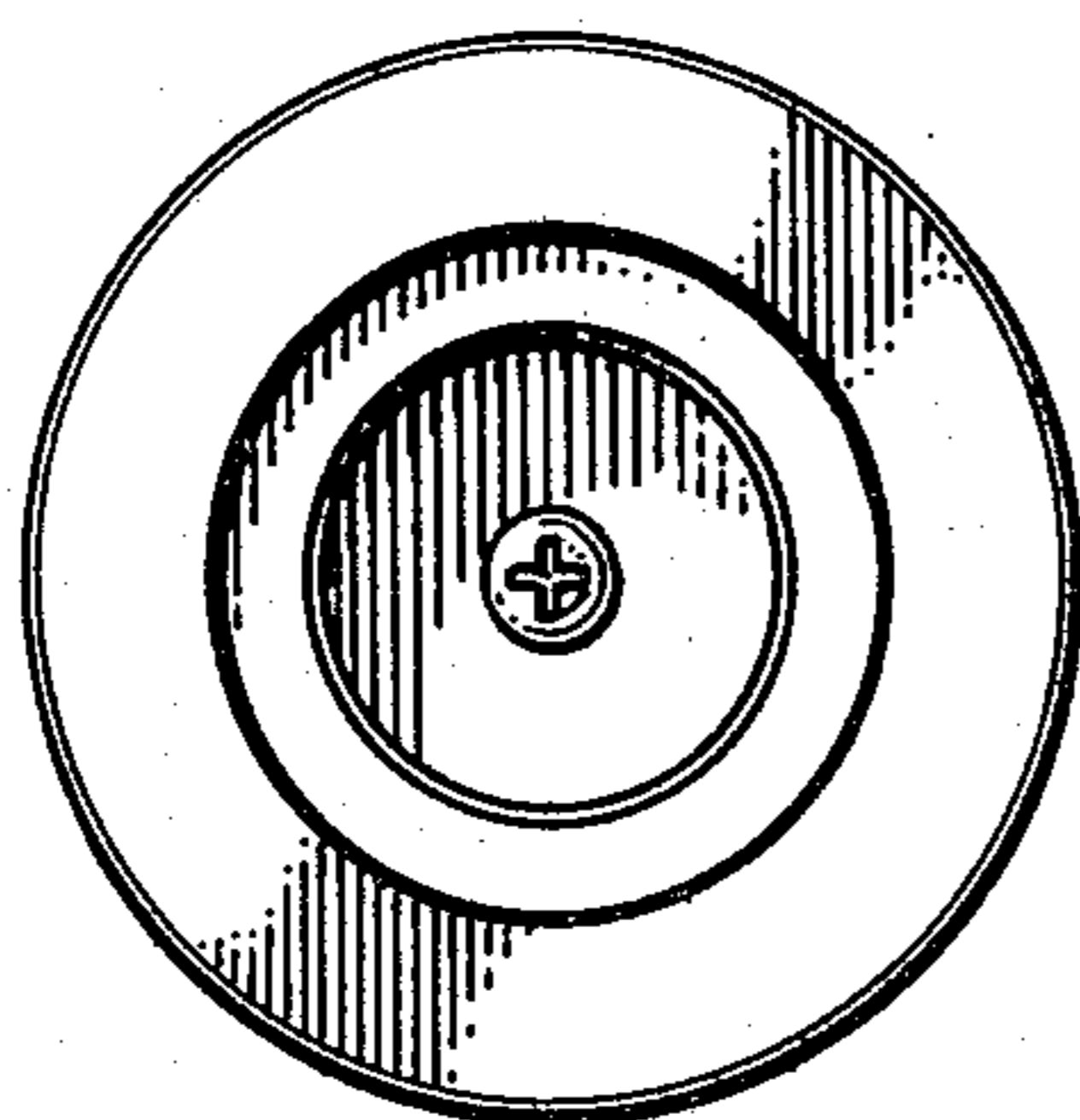
