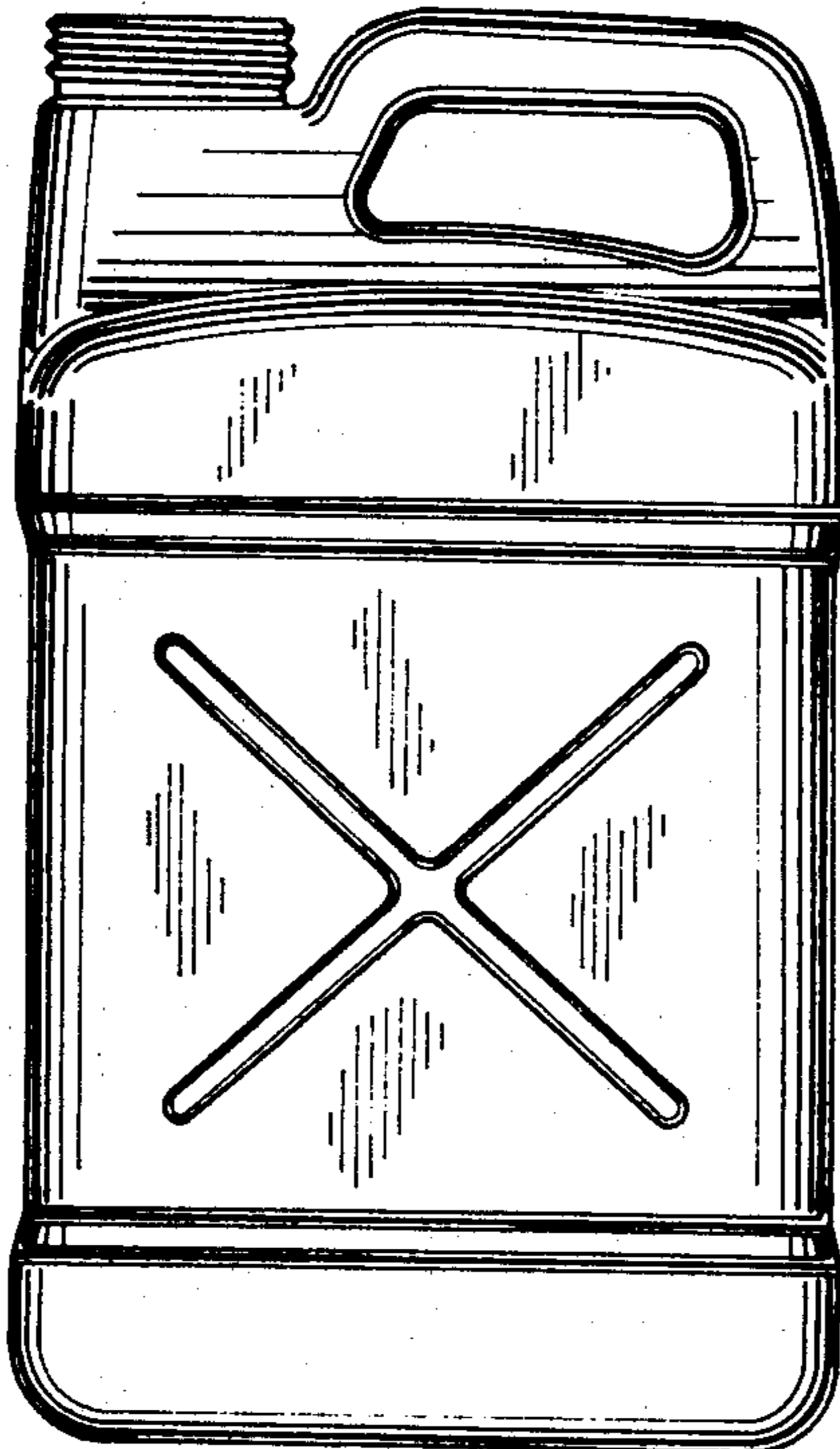

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a jug showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is an elevational view showing the side opposite that shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view;
 FIG. 5 is an elevational view looking from the left of FIG. 2;

 FIG. 7 is a fragmentary sectional view taken along plane VII—VII in FIG. 4.



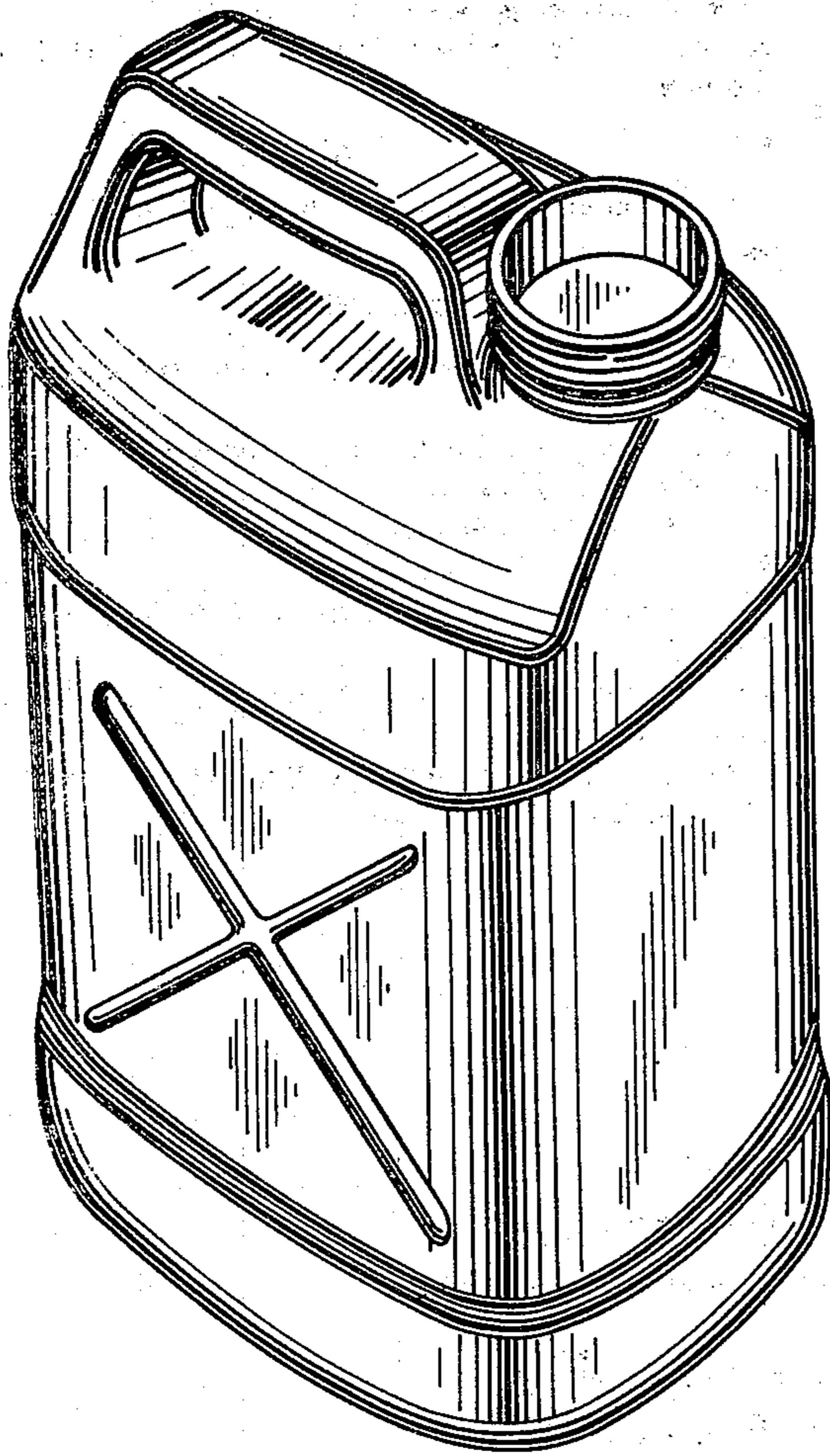

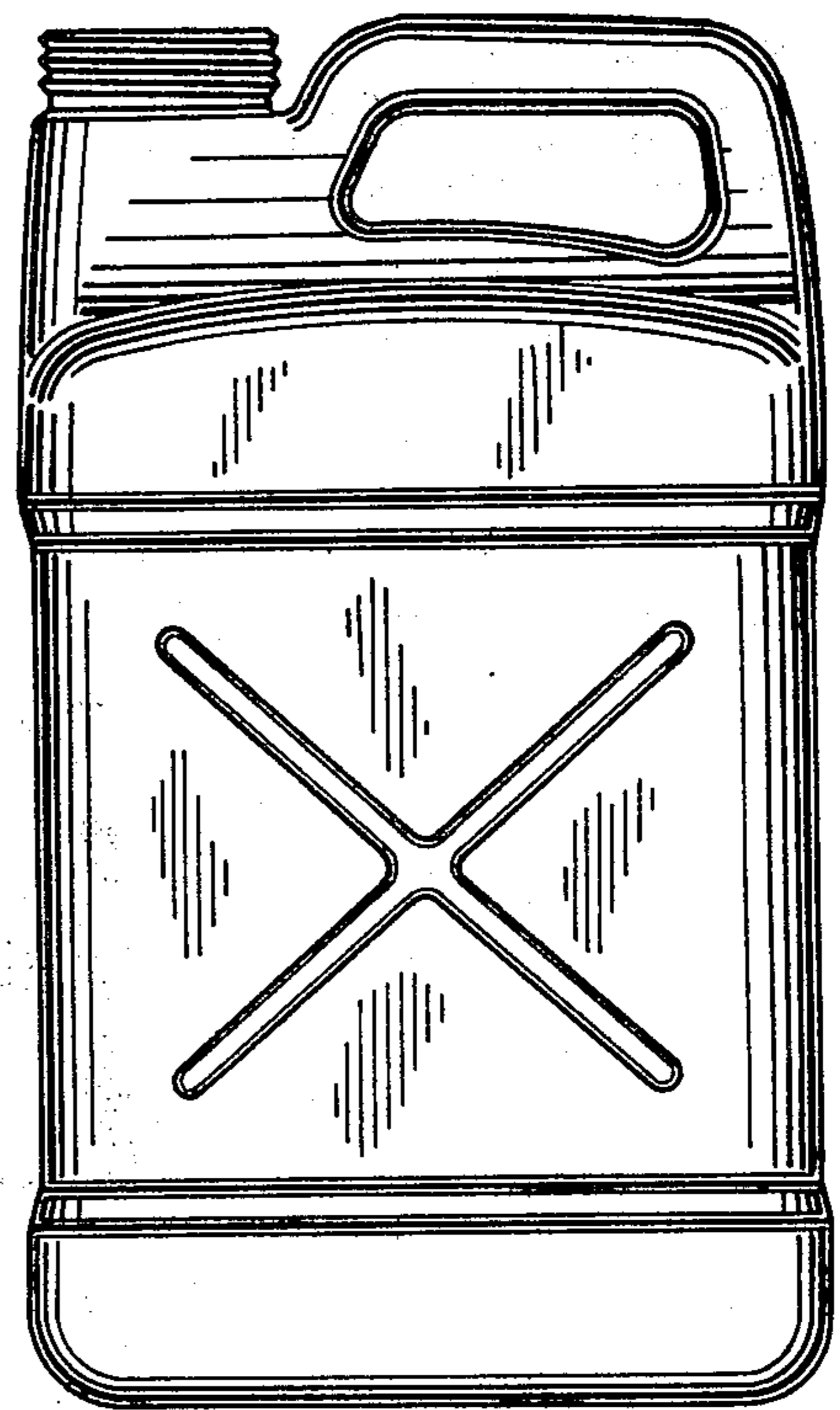

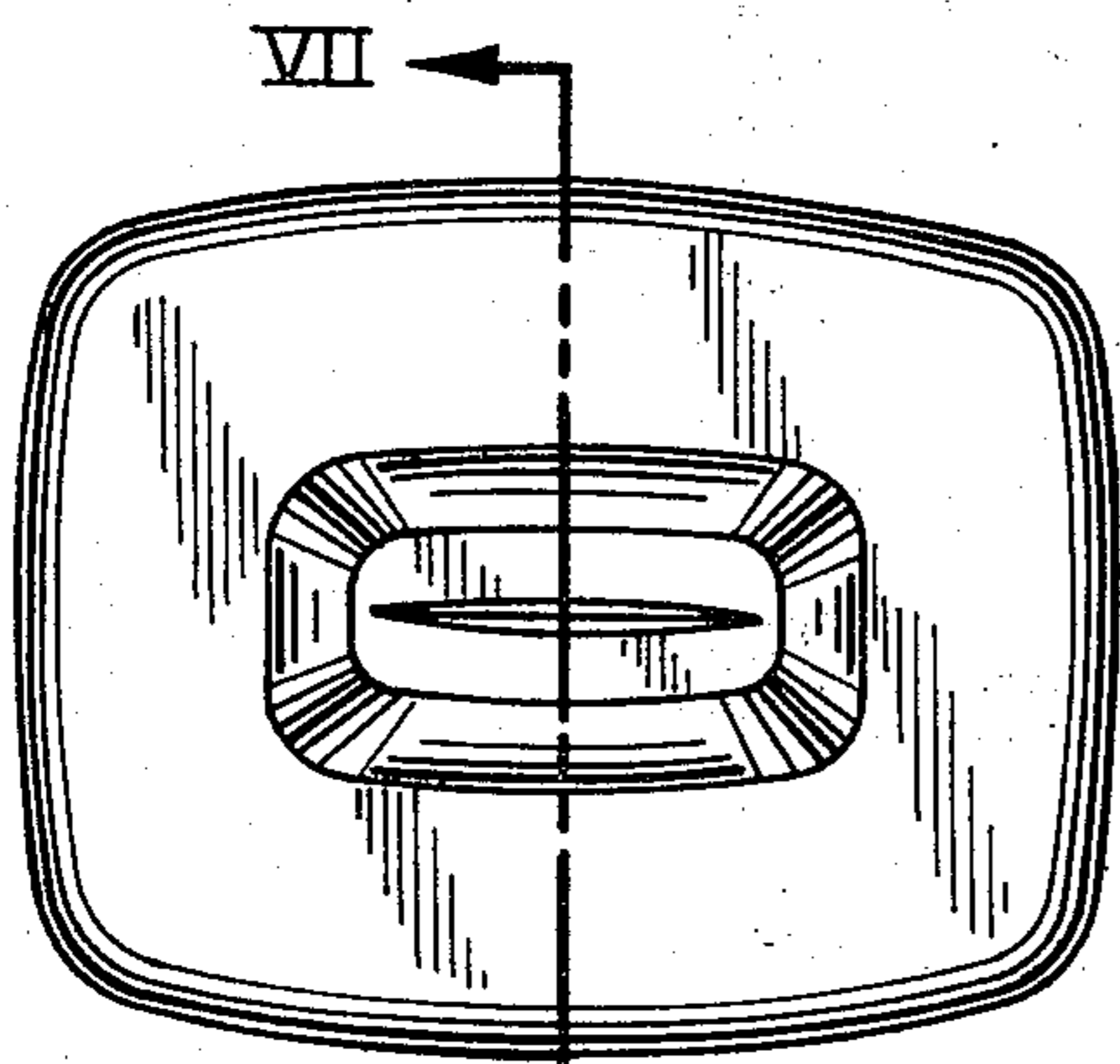

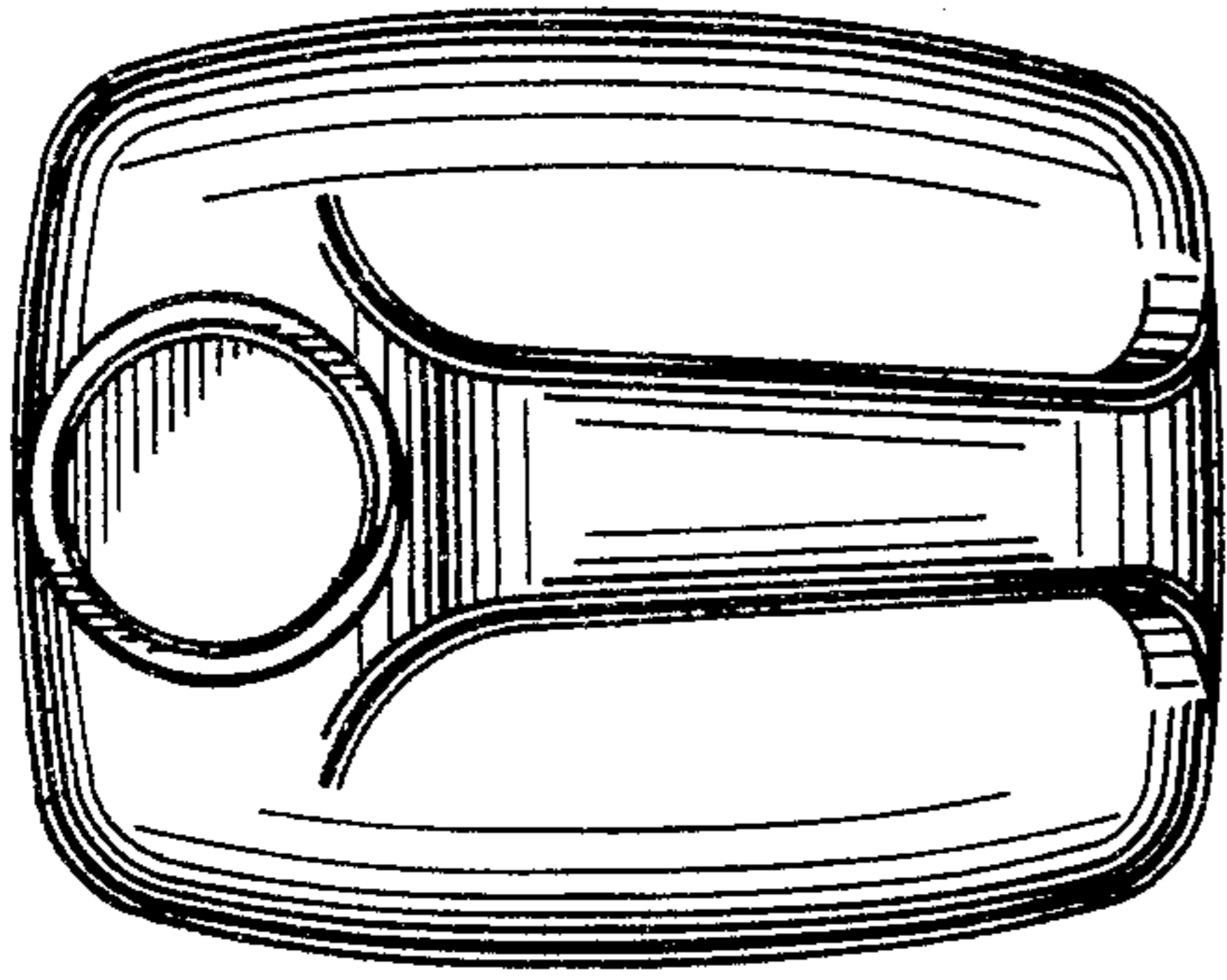

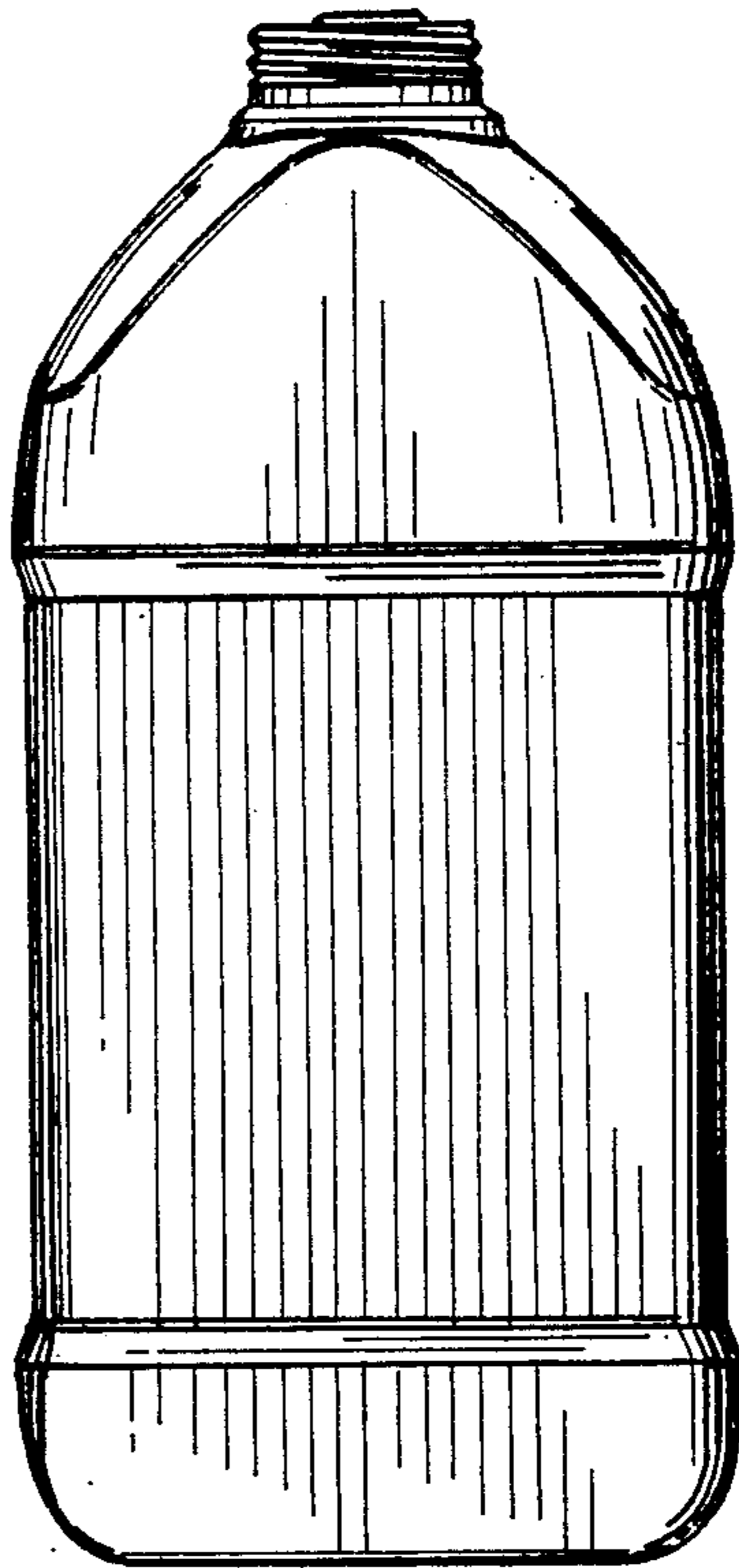

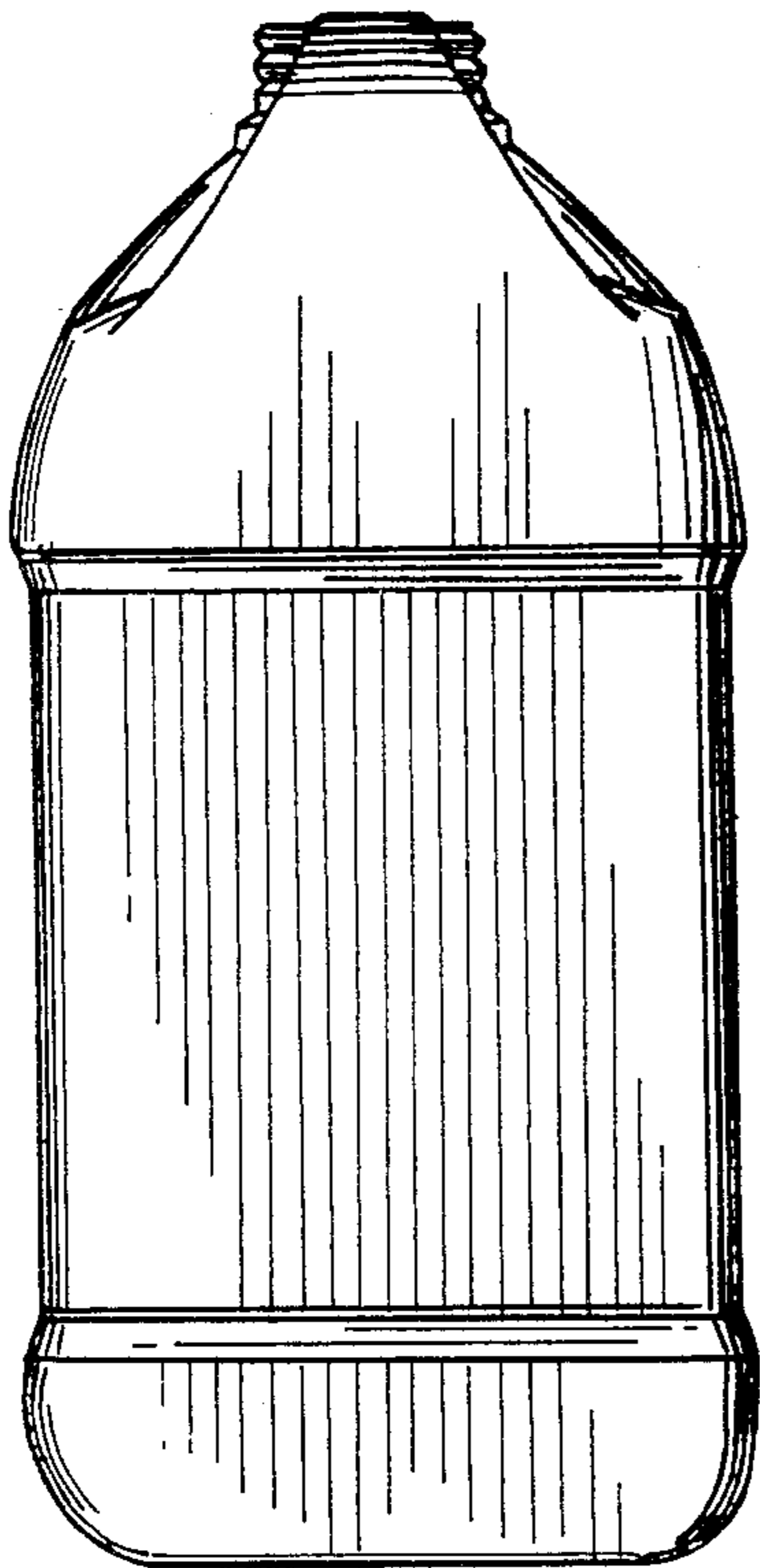
