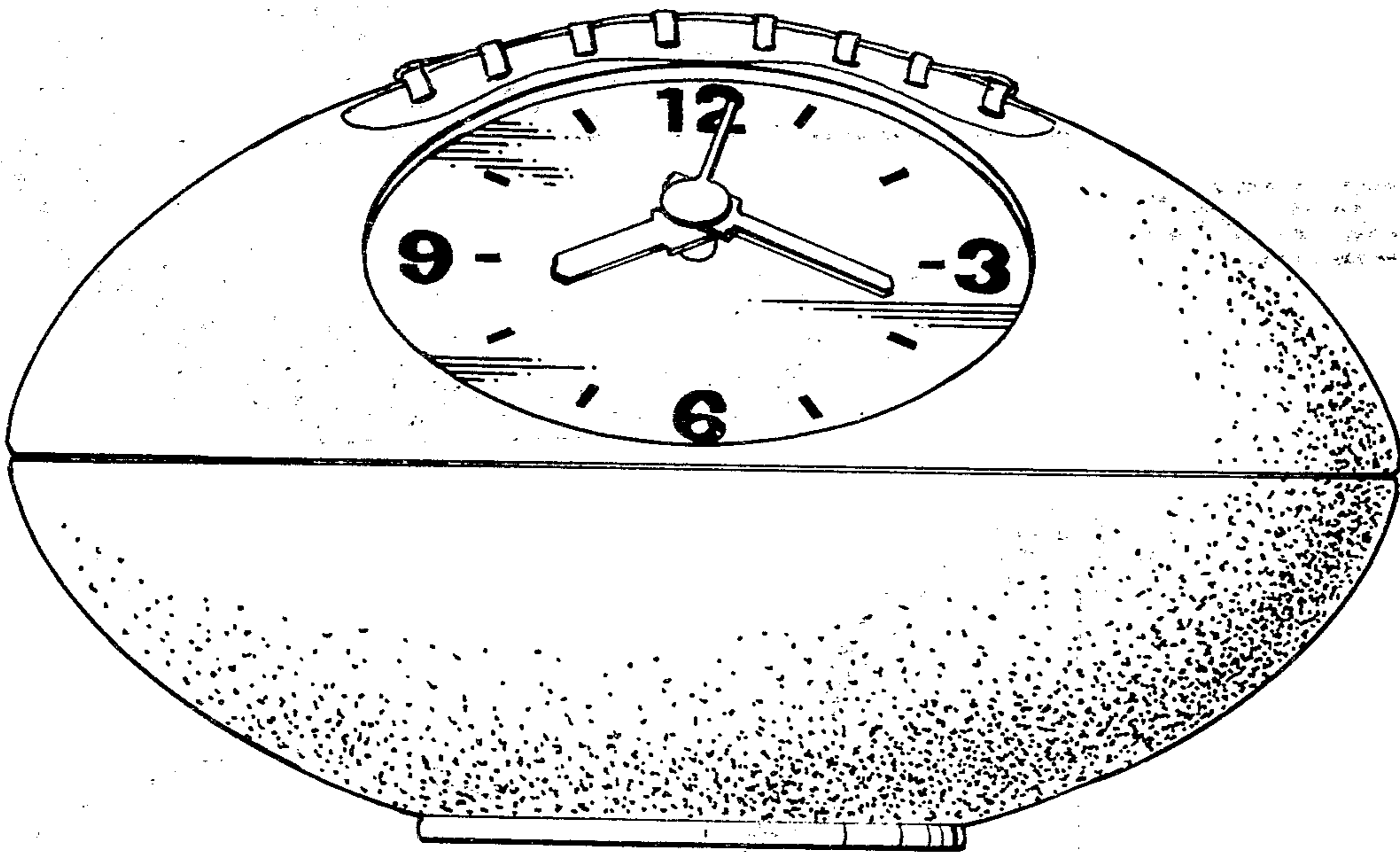

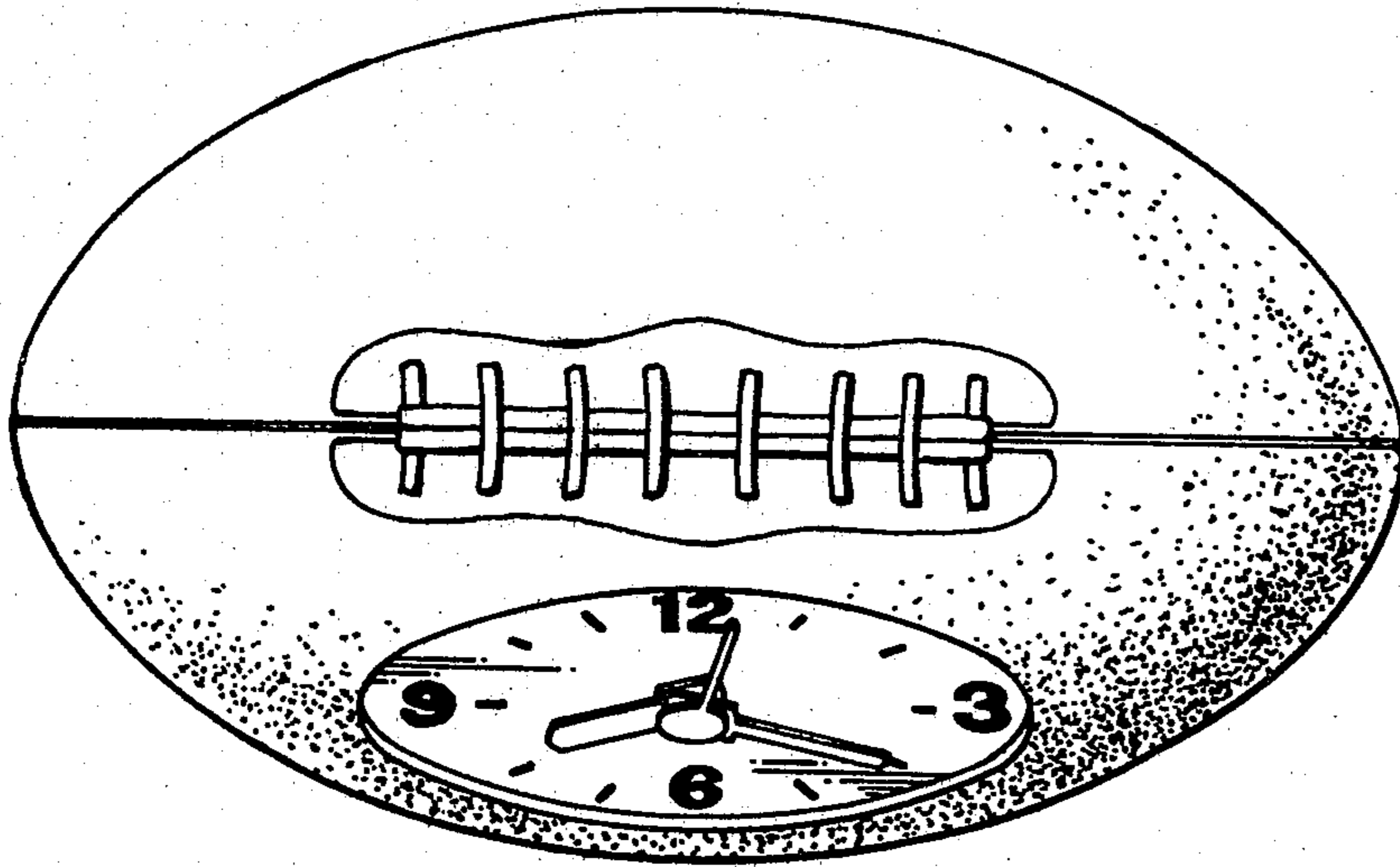
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a clock, as shown and described.

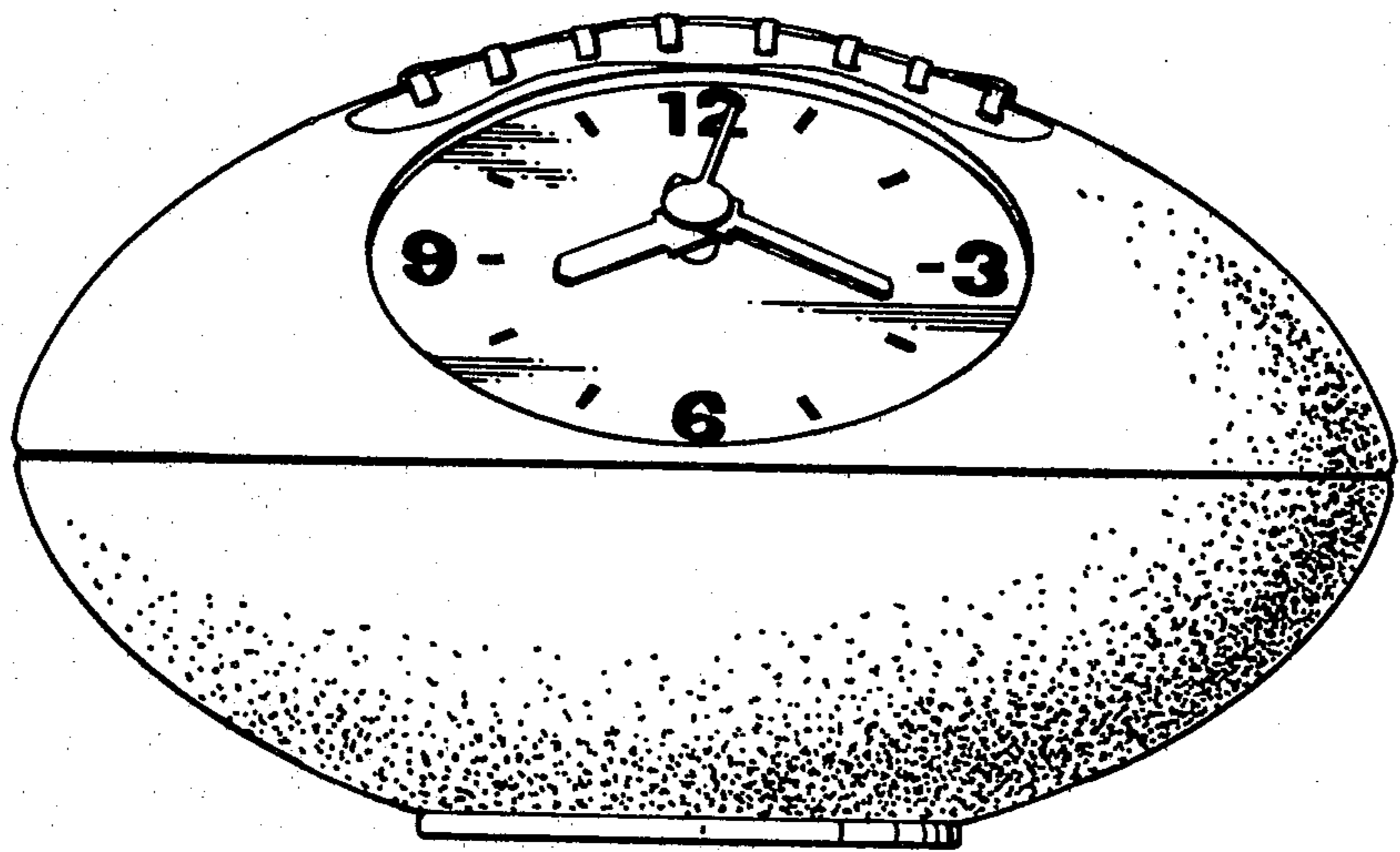
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof on a reduced scale.

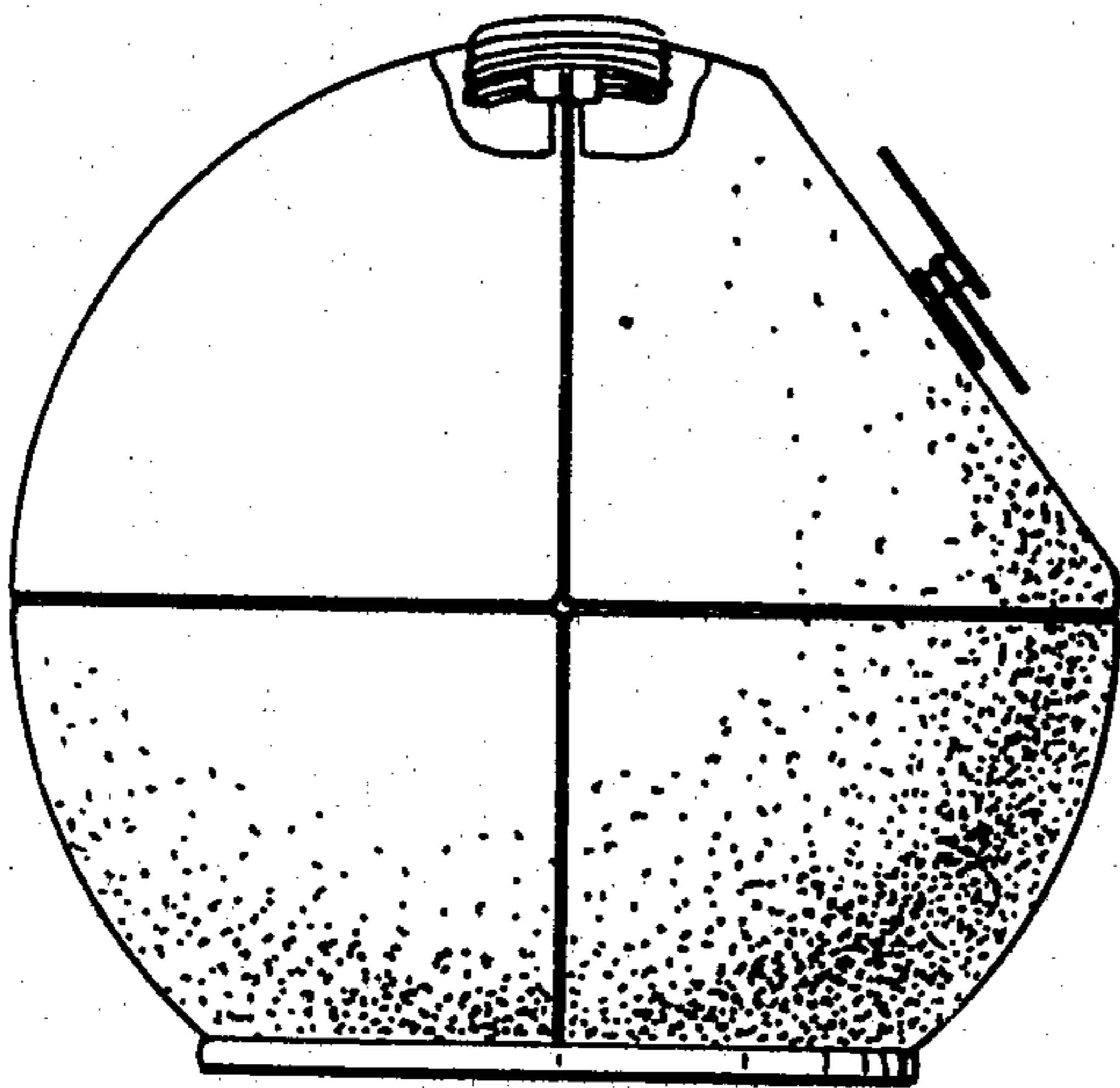




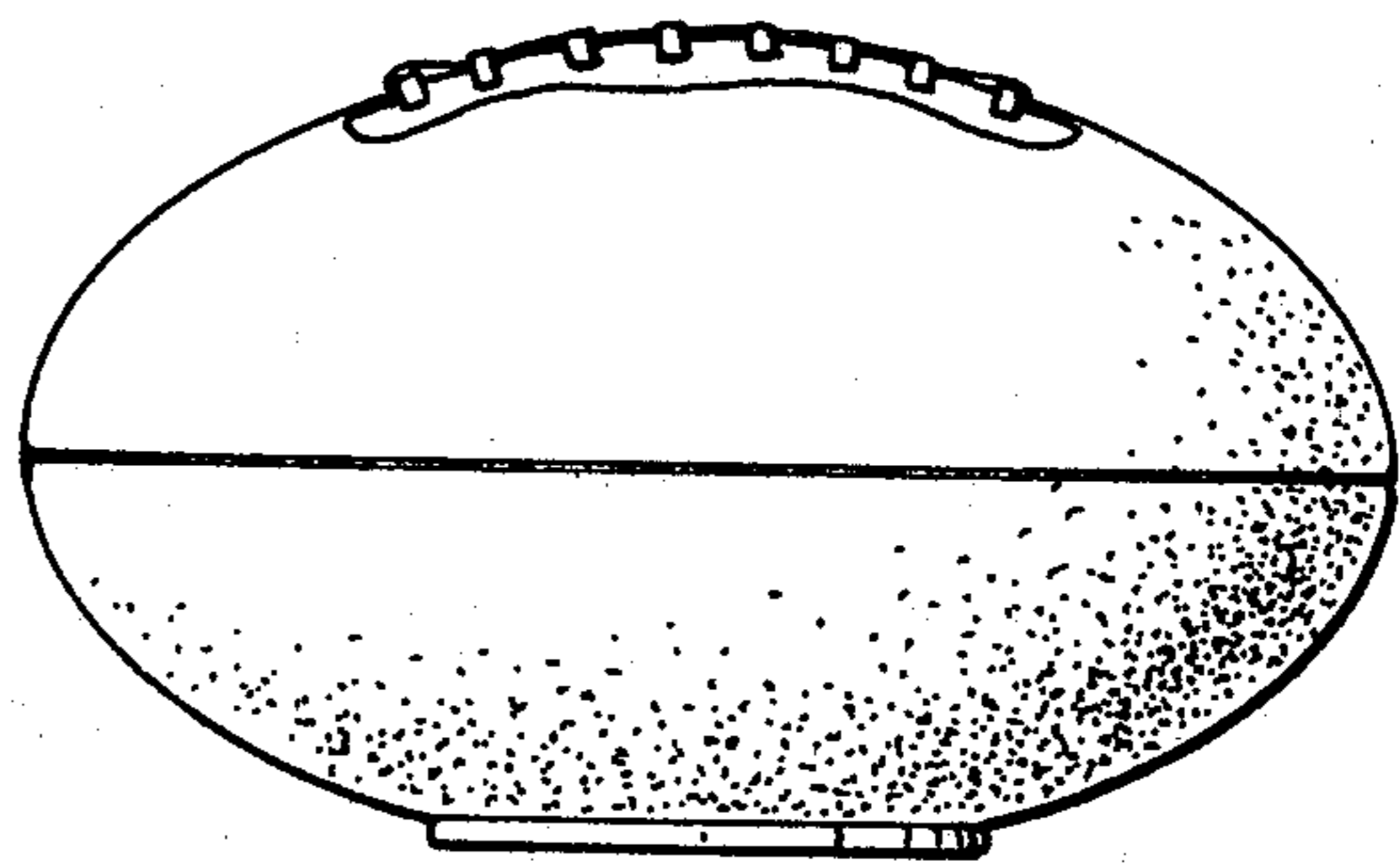
