DESCRIPTION


FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a spoiler showing my new design;


FIG. 2 is a front perspective view thereof, it being understood that the broken lines are for illustrative purposes only;

FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 5—5 in FIG. 4.









