[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a telephone equipment female connector for mounting in apertured escutcheon plate, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION** 

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a telephone equipment female connector for mounting in apertured escutcheon plate showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.

The front surface of the connector is textured. The escutcheon plate is shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only.
