FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

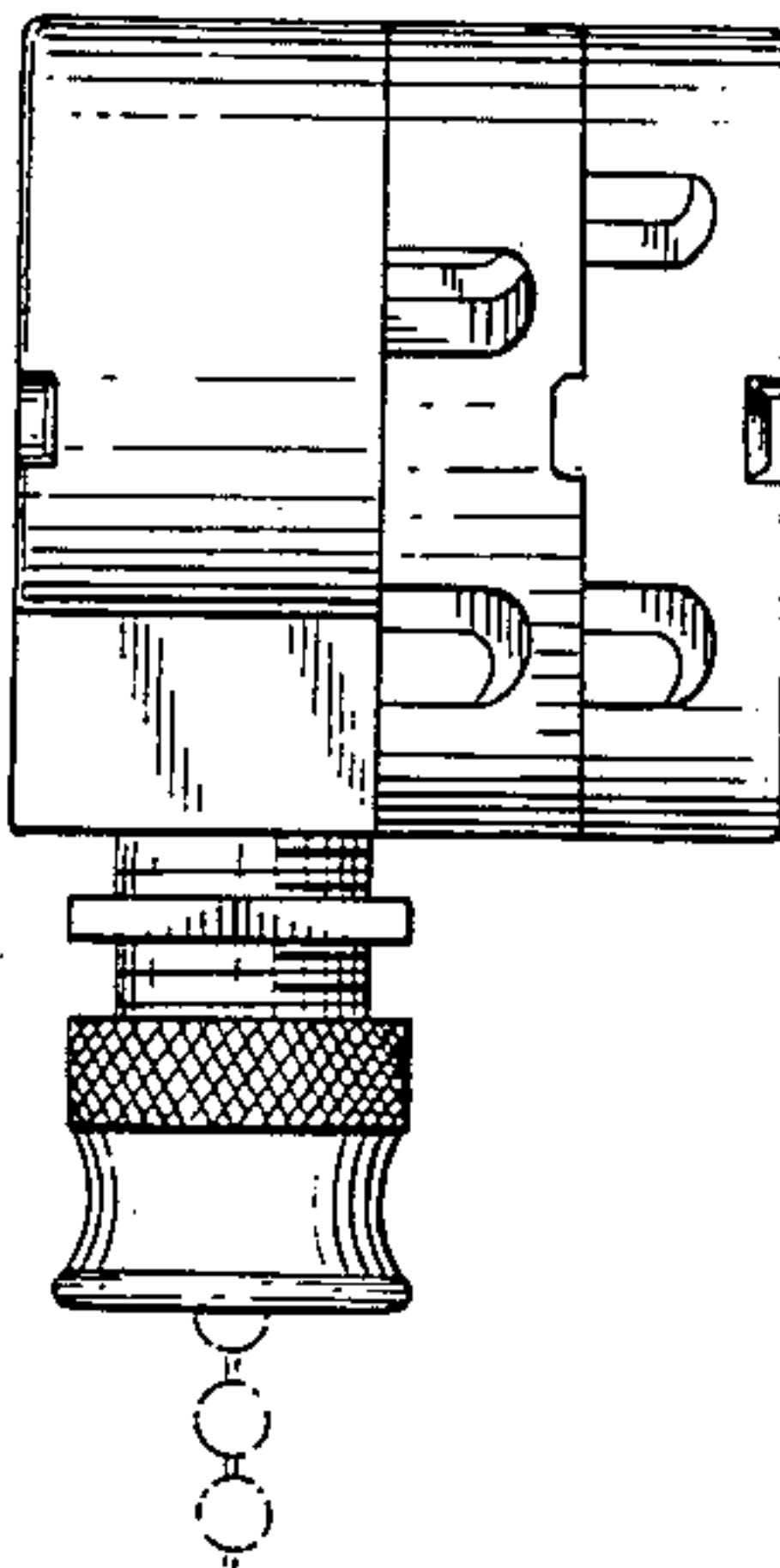
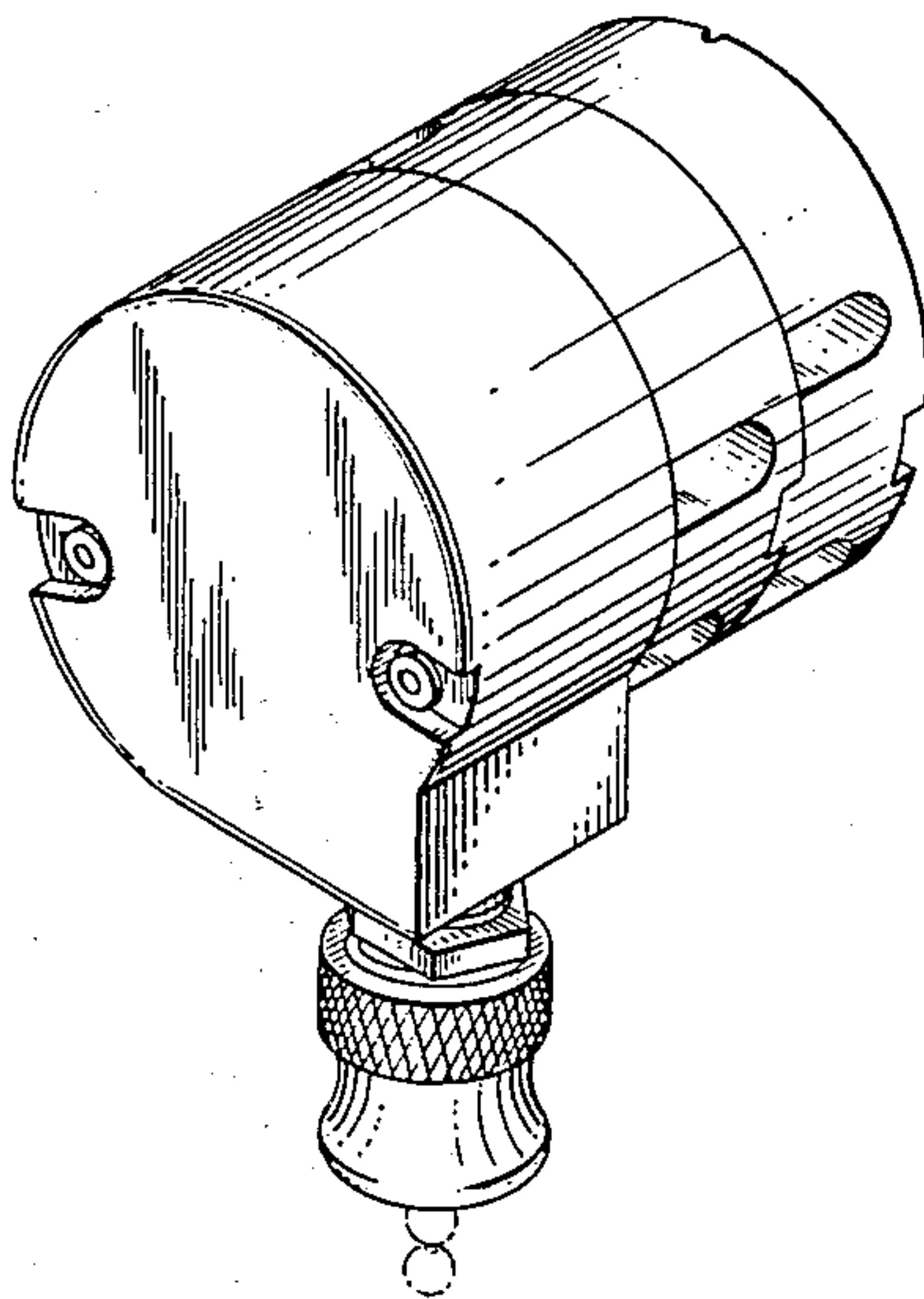
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

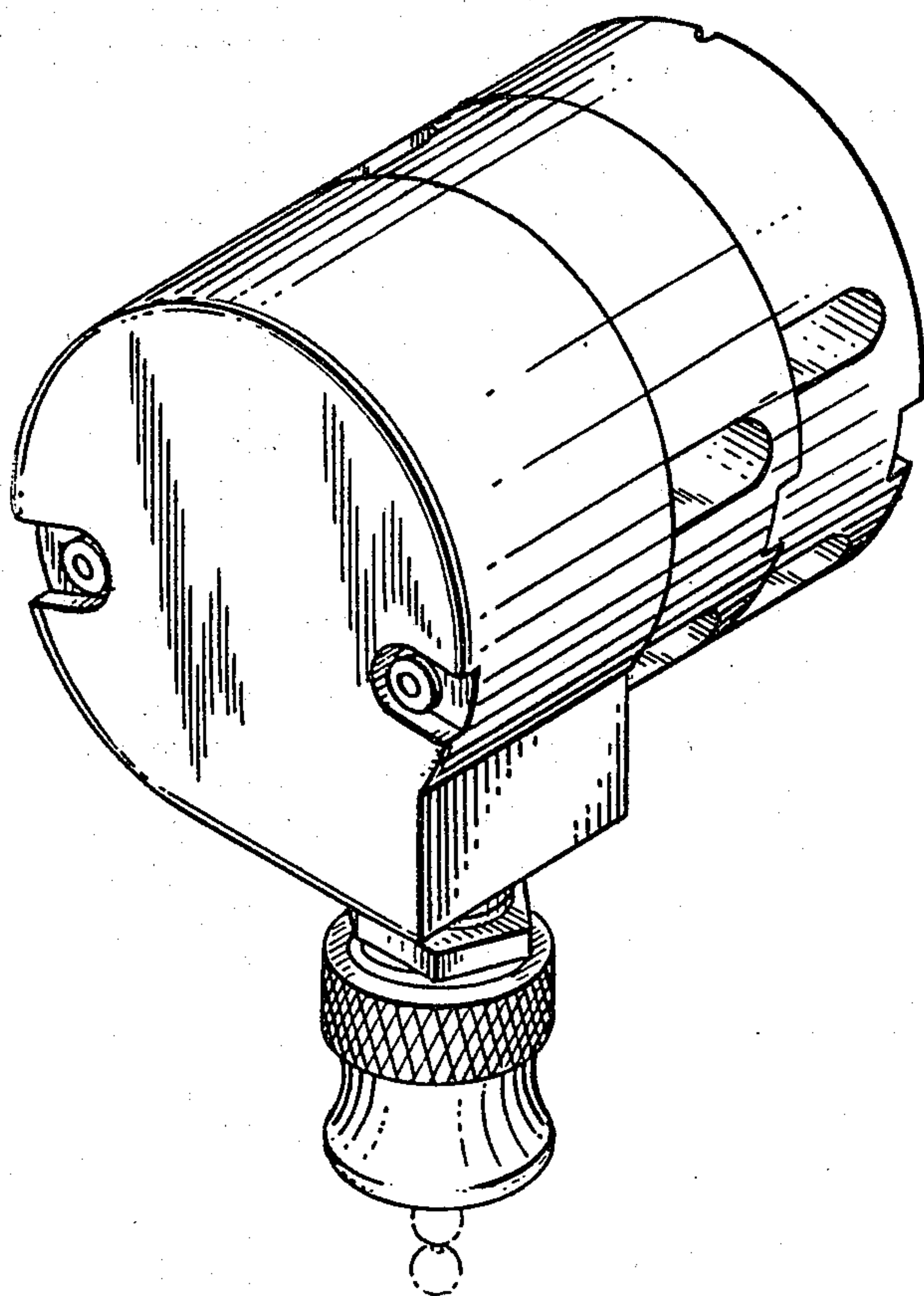

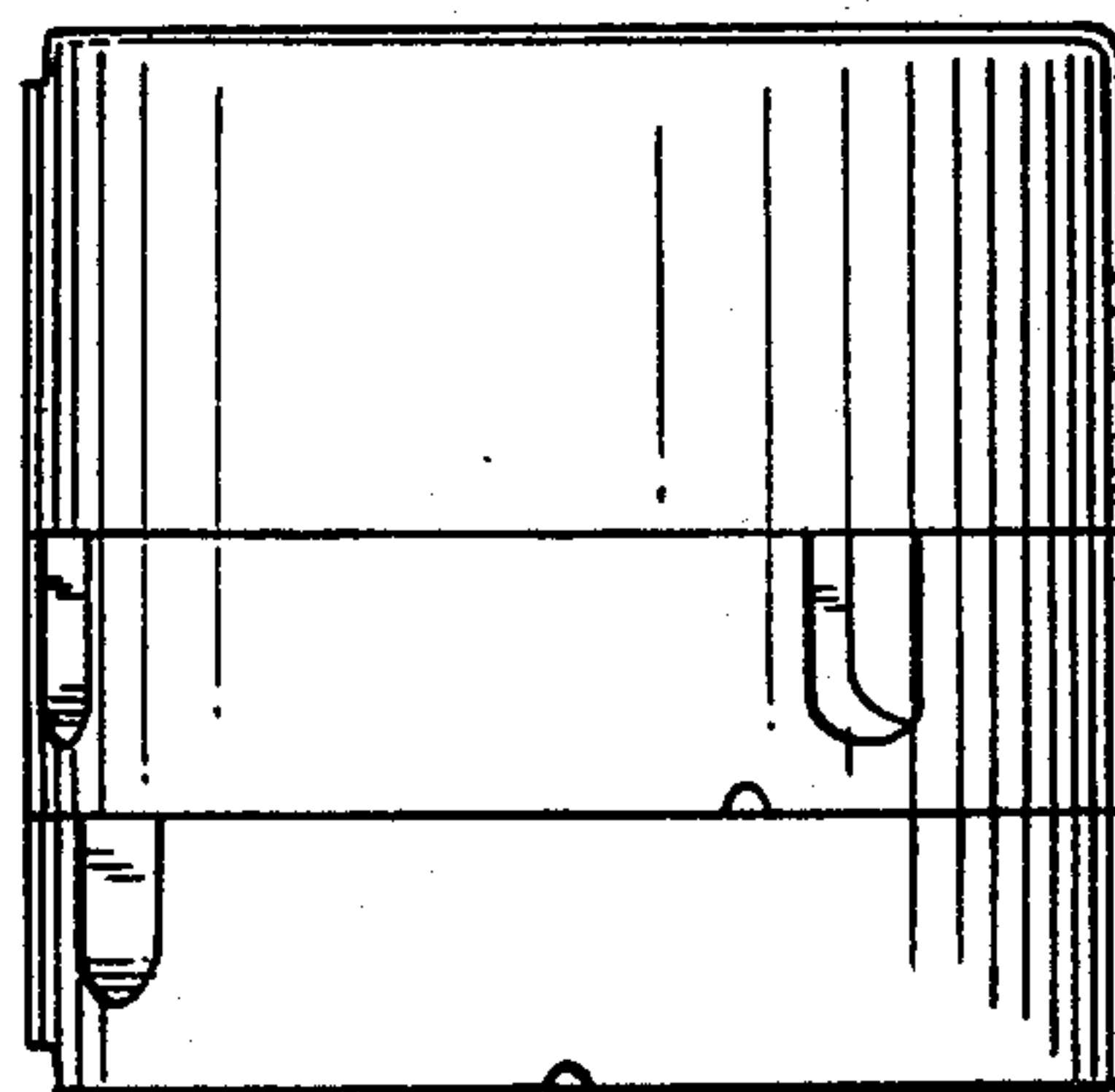

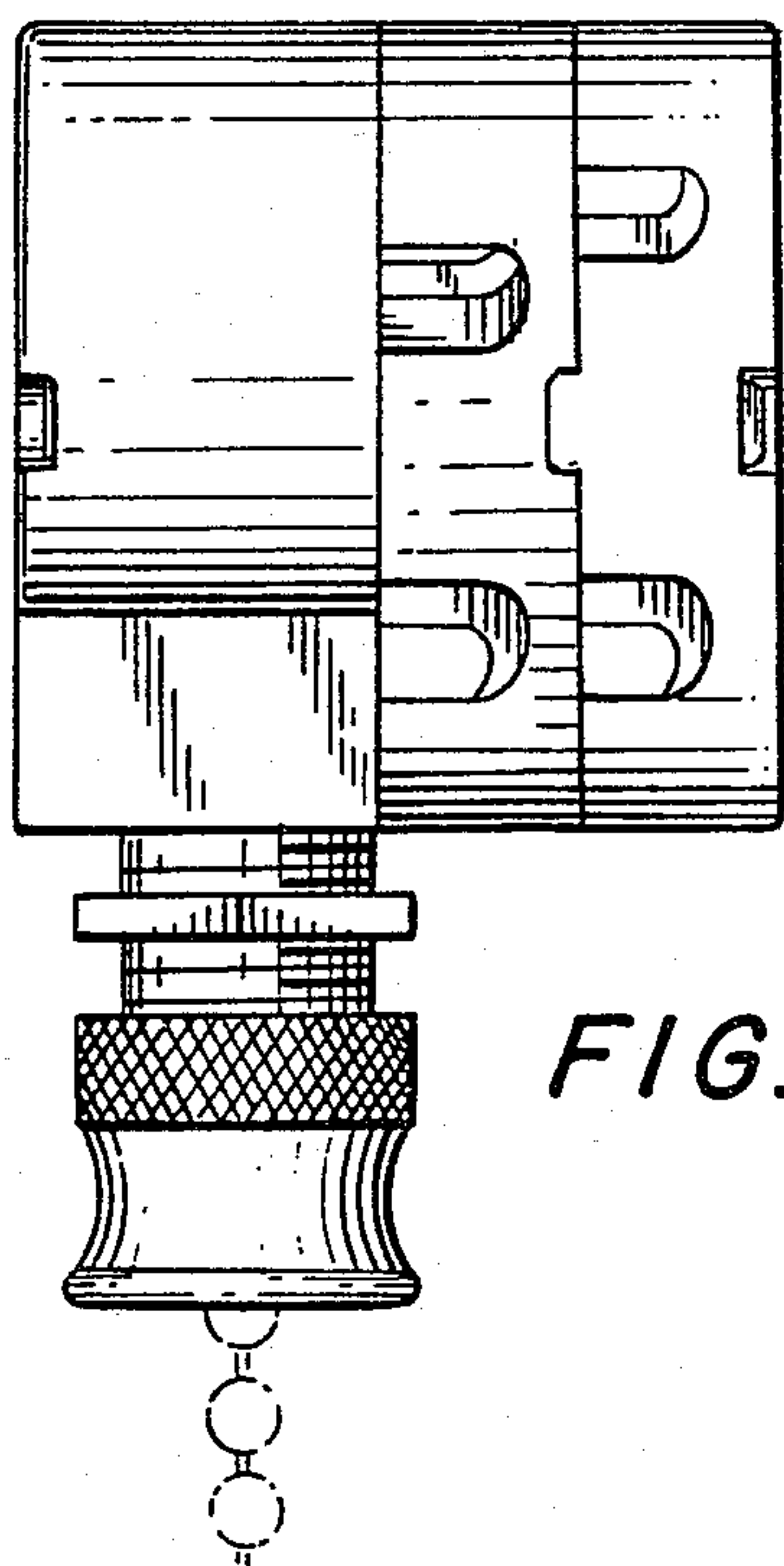

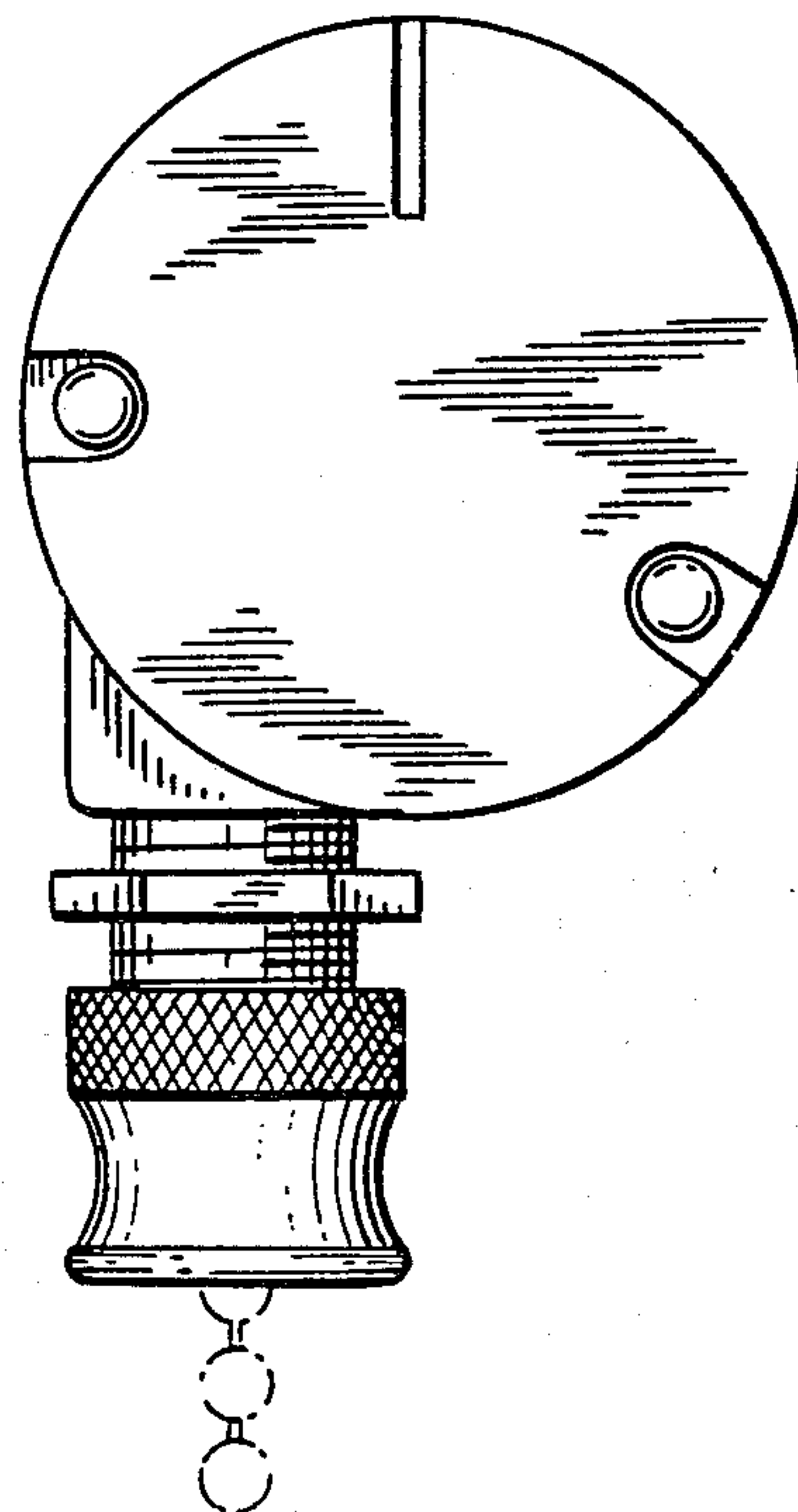

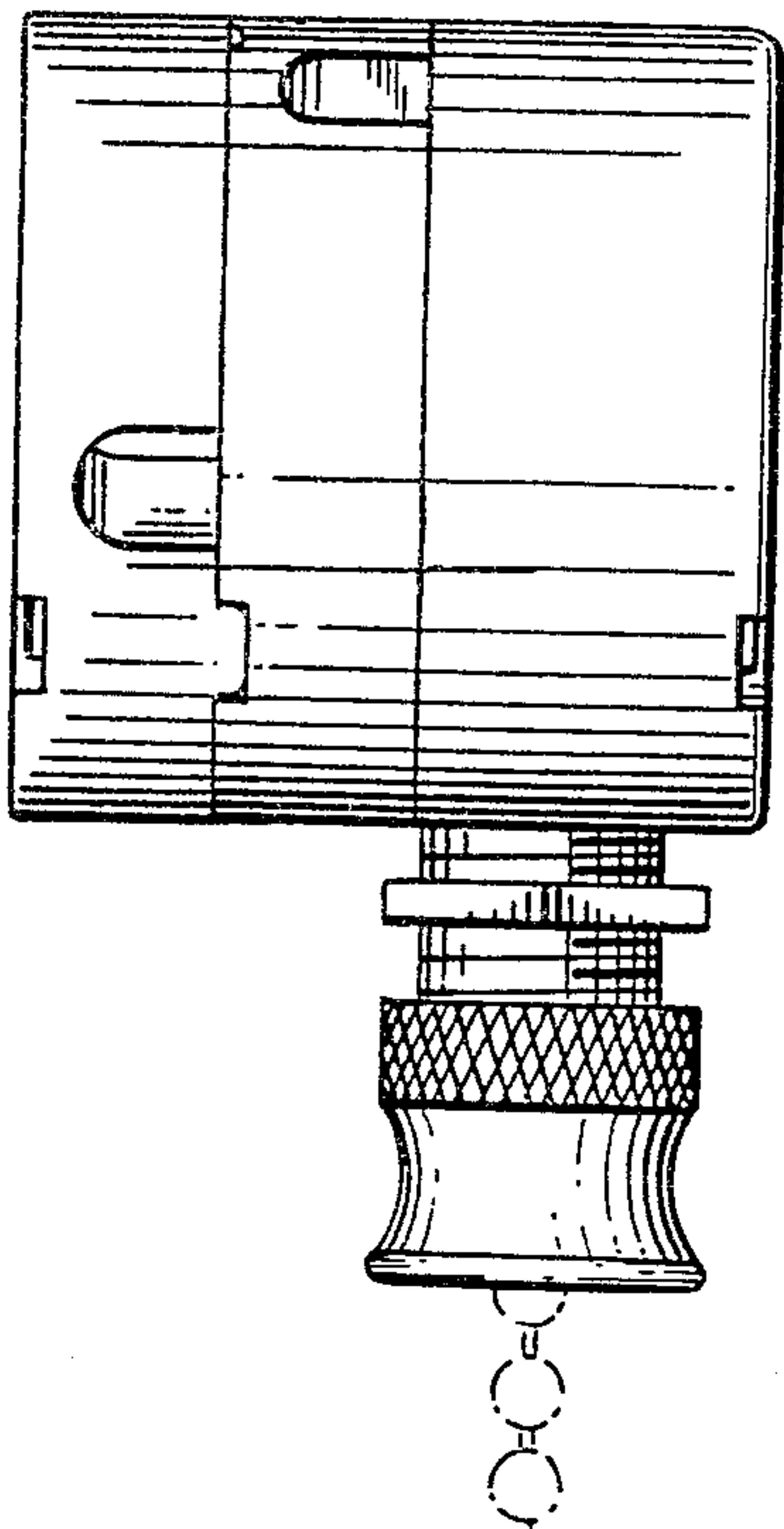

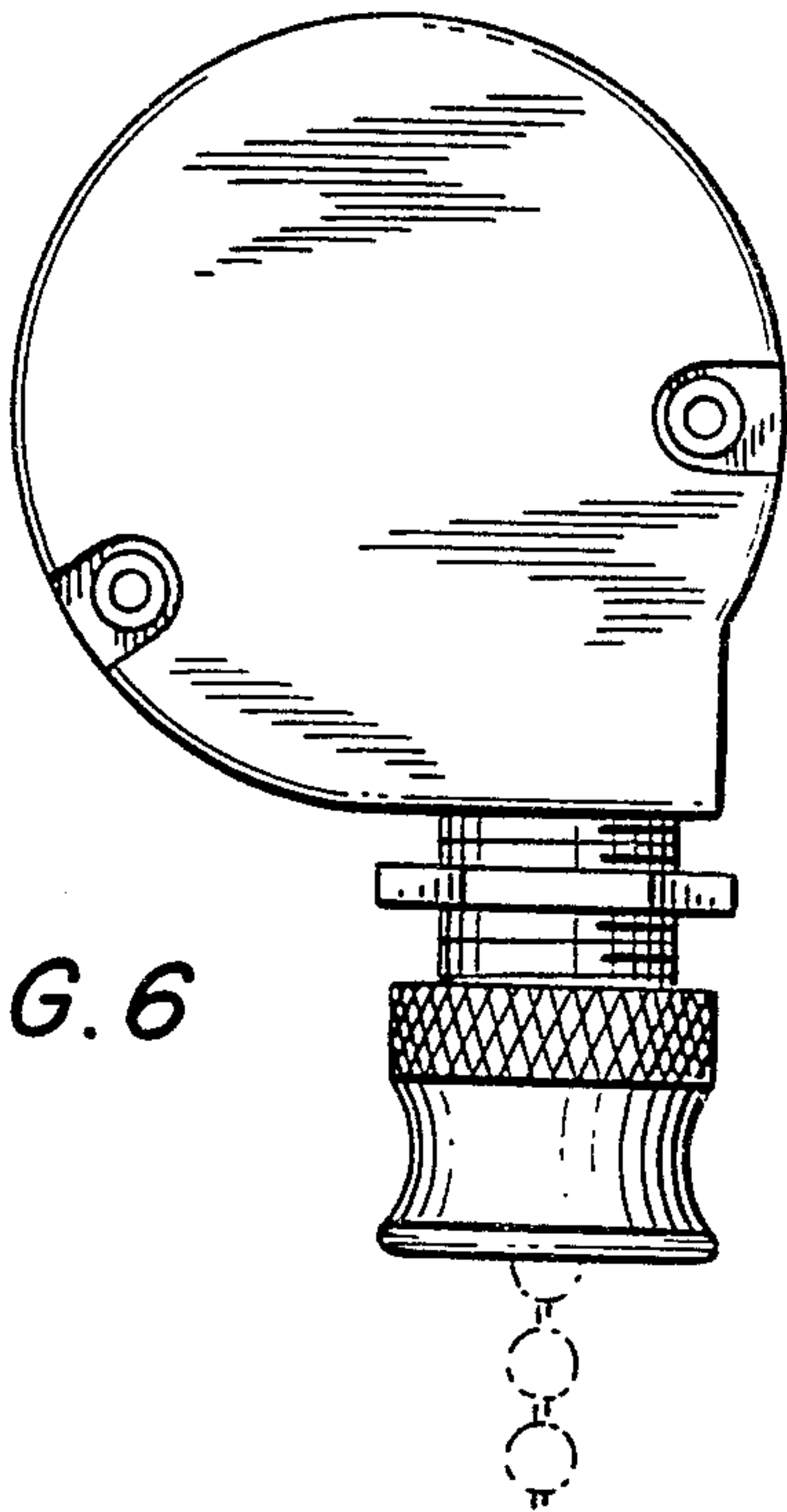
