DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an abdominal  
exerciser for attachment to chair or the like, showing  
my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,  
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof, the side  
opposite being substantially a mirror image;  
Portions of the strap members in FIGS. 2-4 have been  
amended for ease of illustration.









