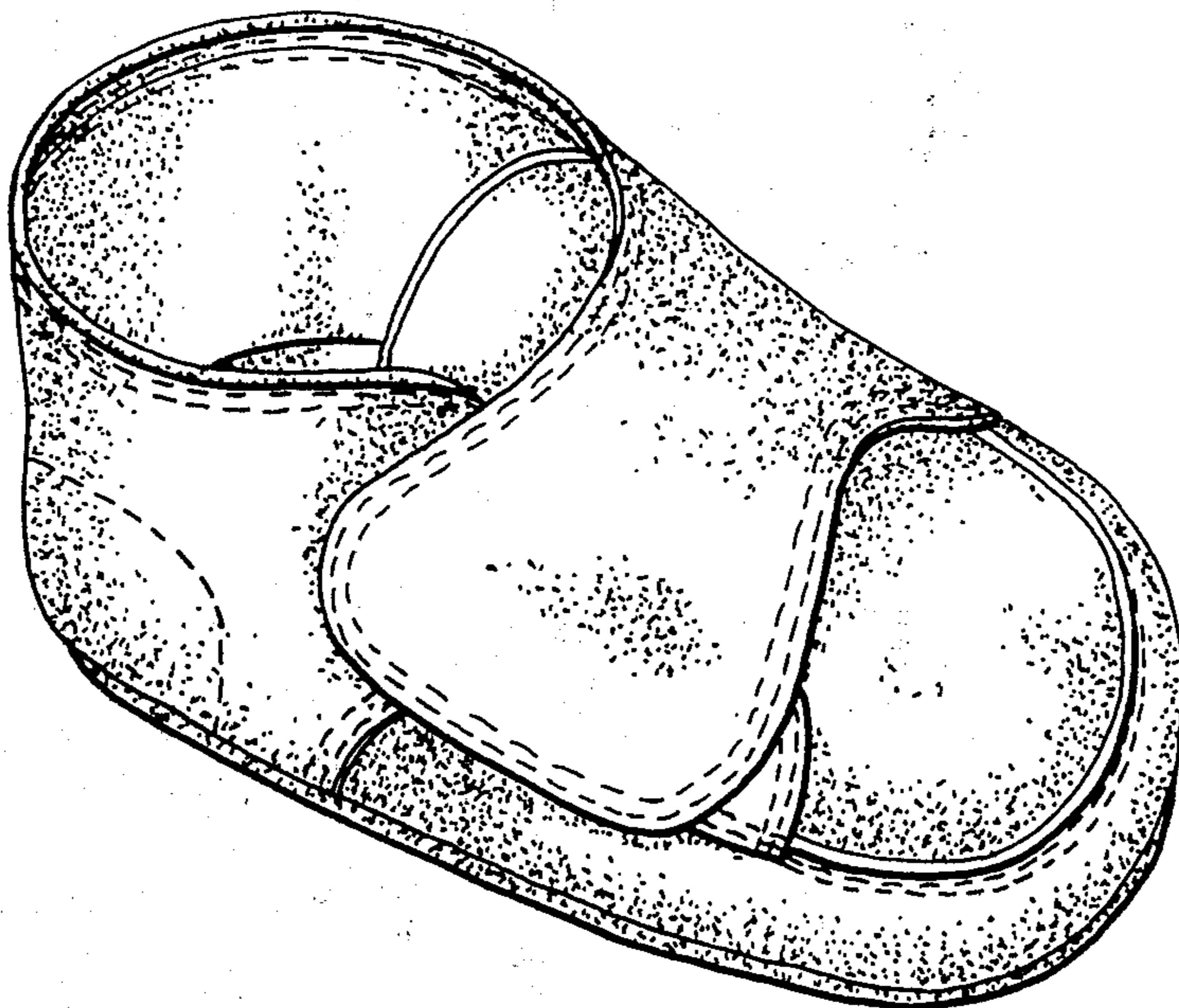
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a baby shoe, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top and left front perspective view of a baby shoe showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; the bottom, not shown, being flat, plain and unornamented;  
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a perspective view of FIG. 1 wherein the fastener strap is in an open position.

A baby shoe of the type shown and described that gives a distinct visual impression wherein the particular type of closure flap is attached to the side panel of the wrap-around portion on one side and removably associatable and attached to the side panel of the wrap-around portion on the other side whereby the side panels of the wrap-around portions are caused to wrap-around the ankle by means of the flap holding the two side panels together.



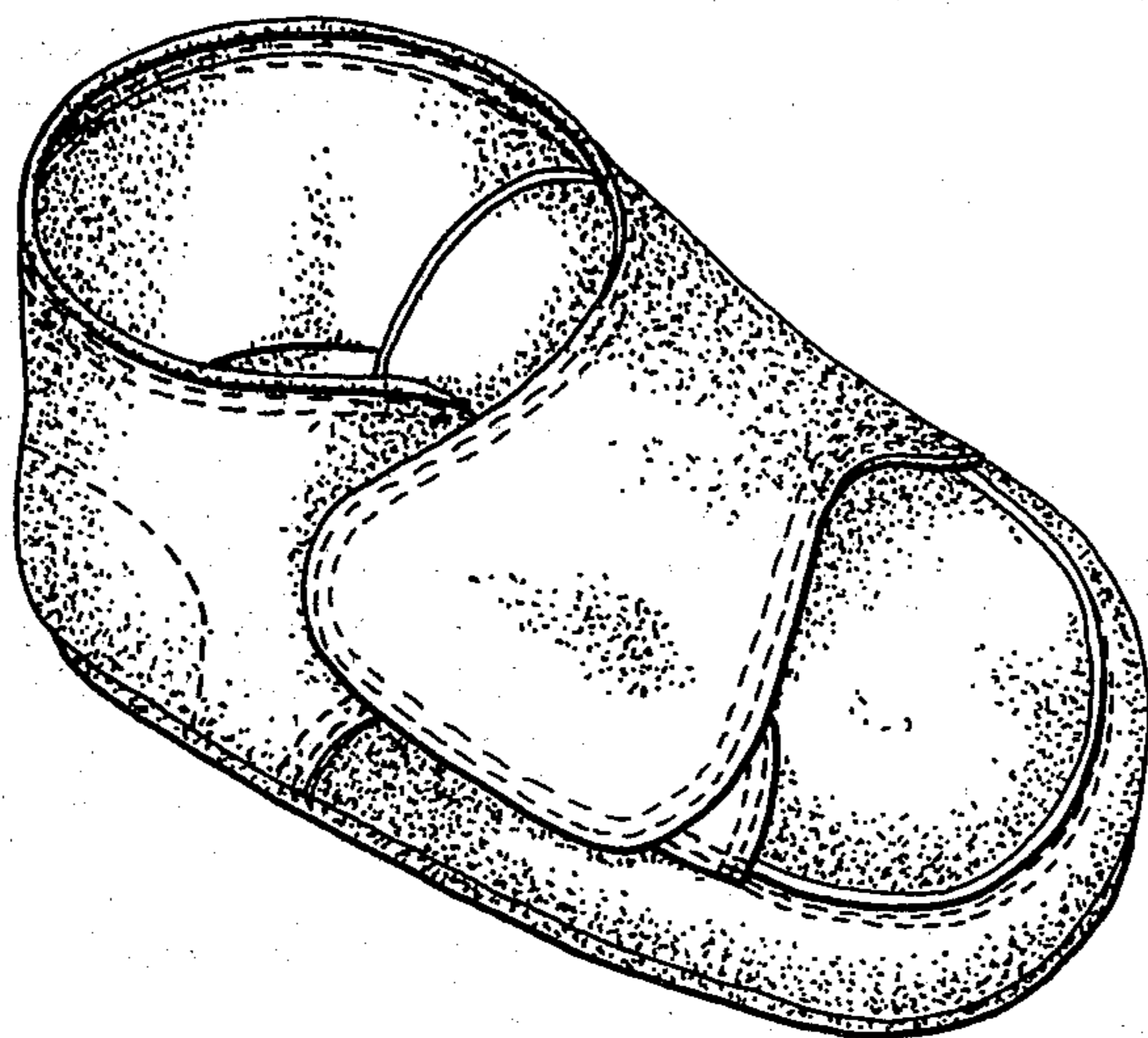

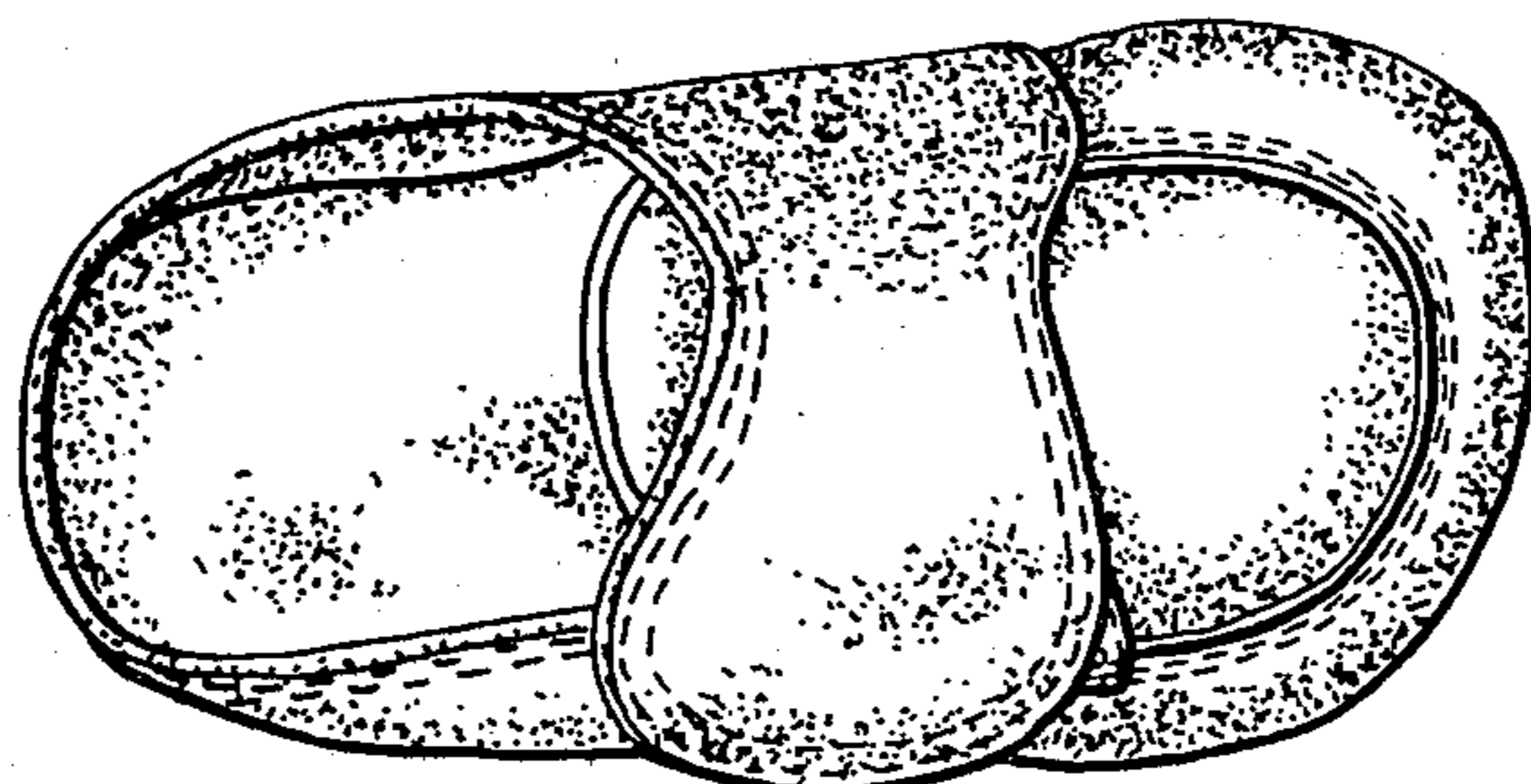

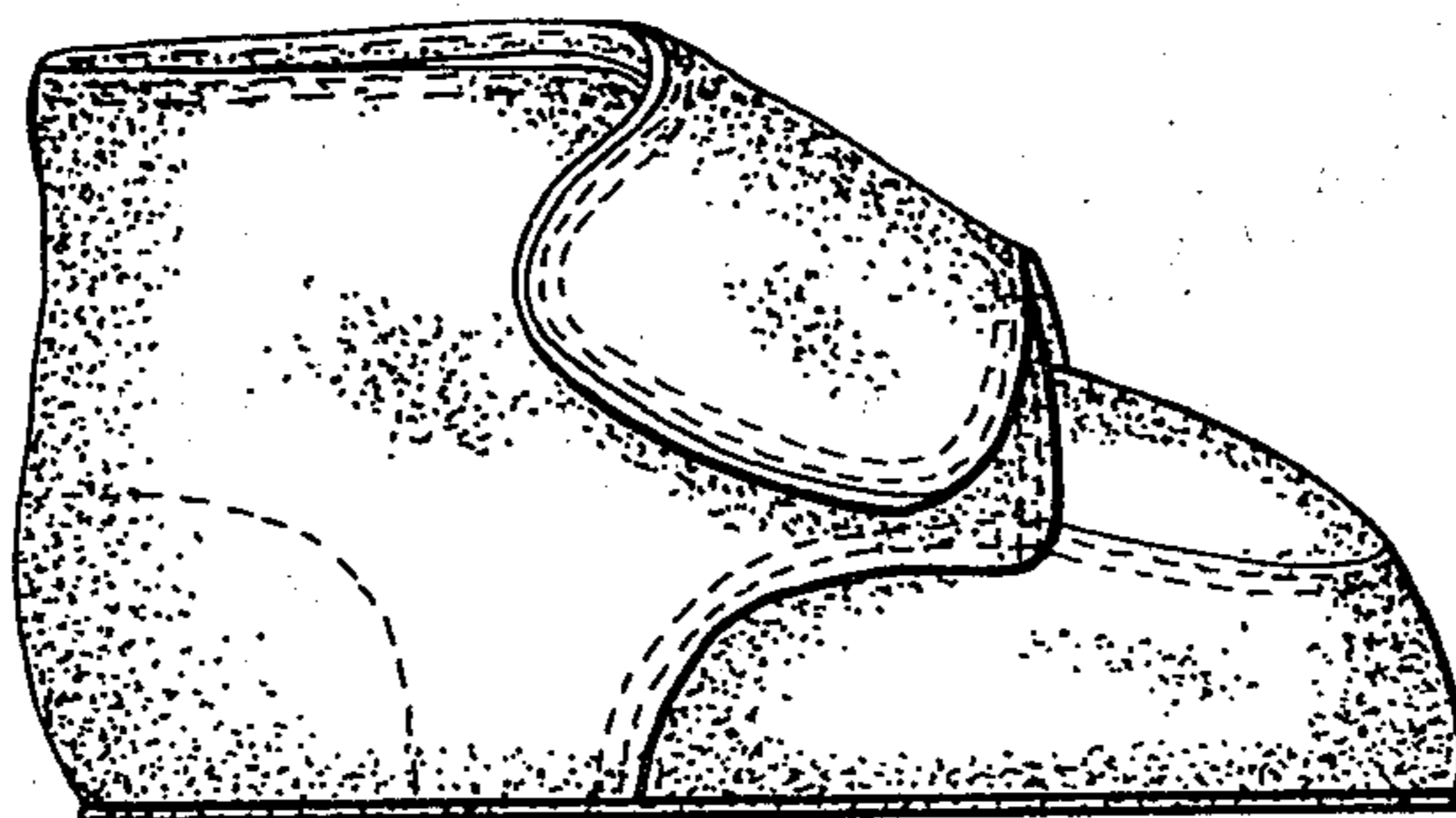

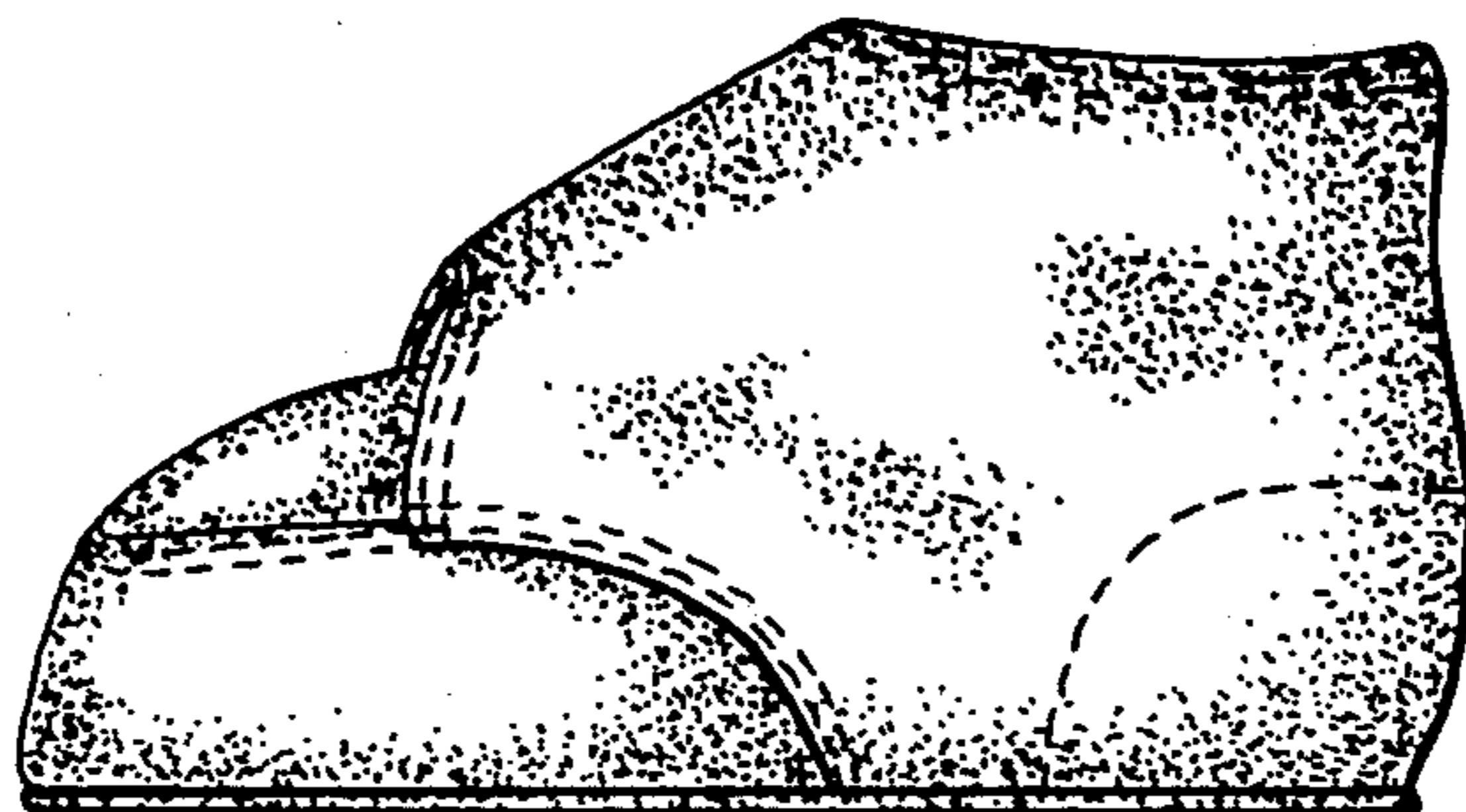

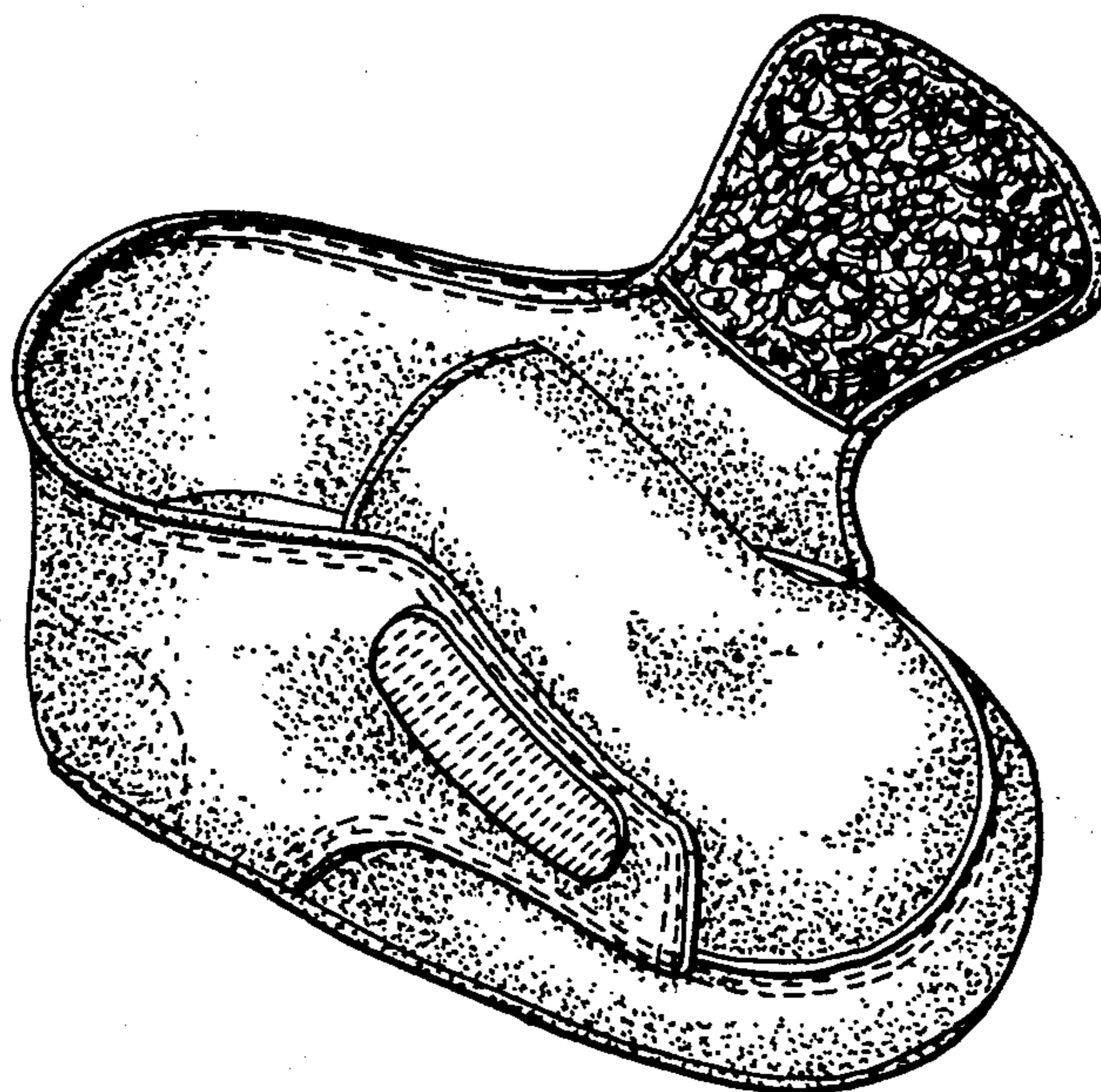
