DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a combined food and beverage tray showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is an end elevational view from the right of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 5 is an end elevational view from the left of FIG. 1; and
 FIG. 6 is a side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being similar thereto.

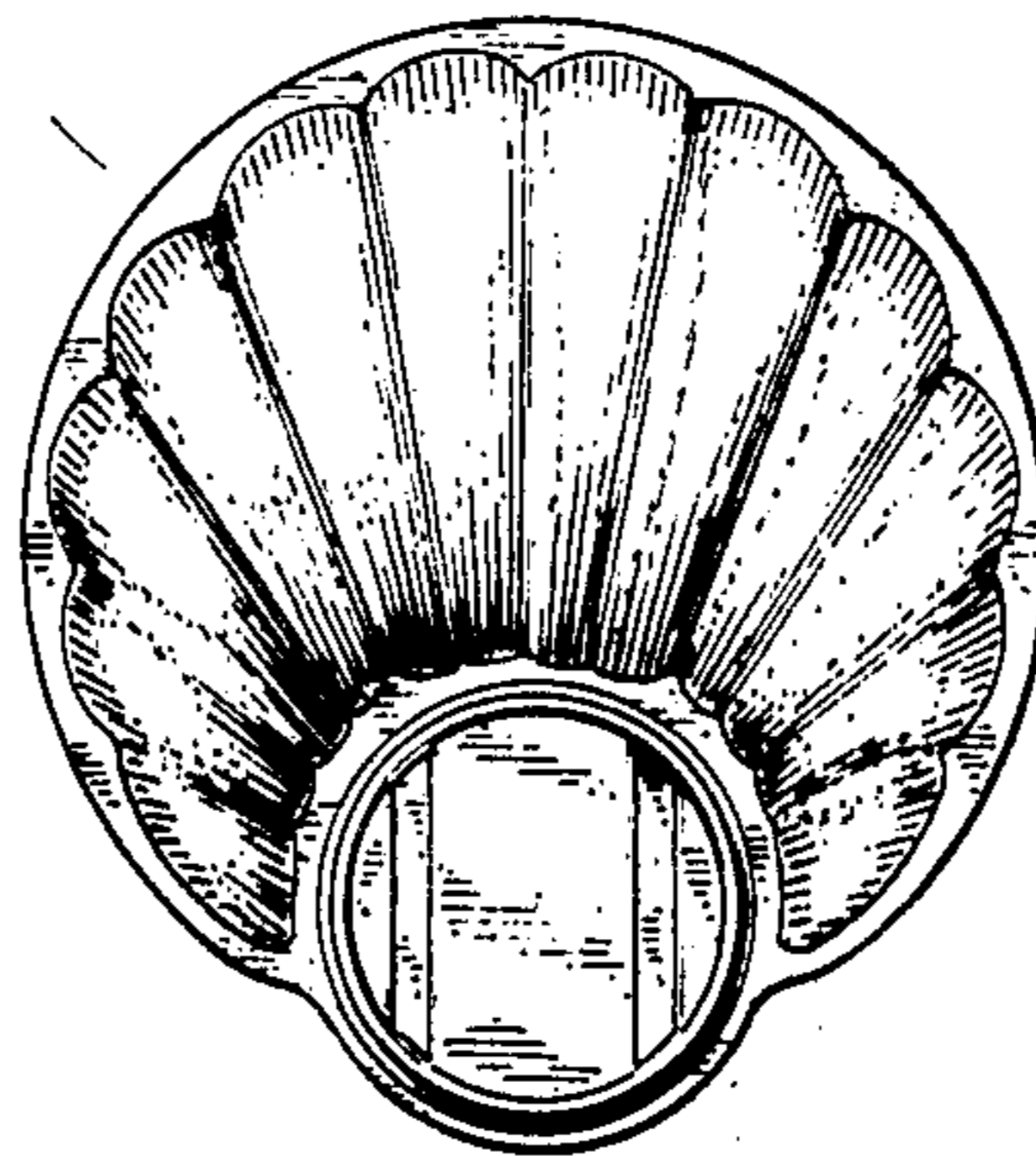
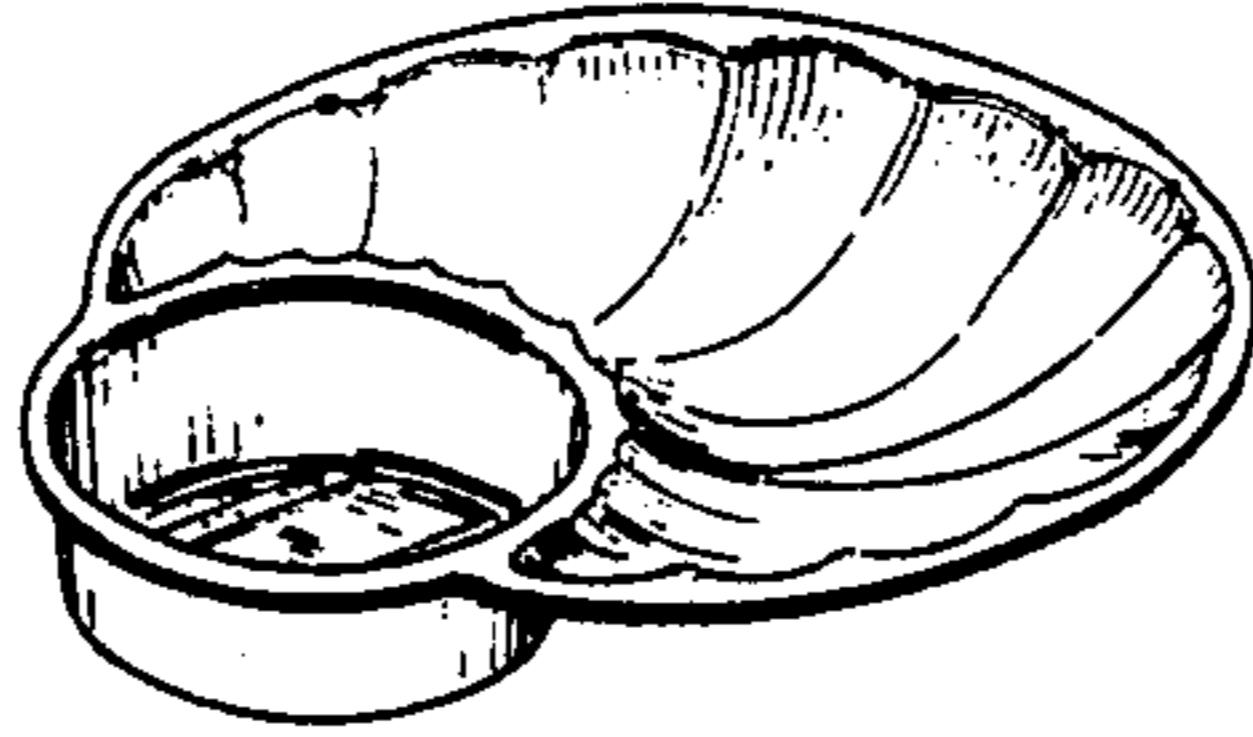

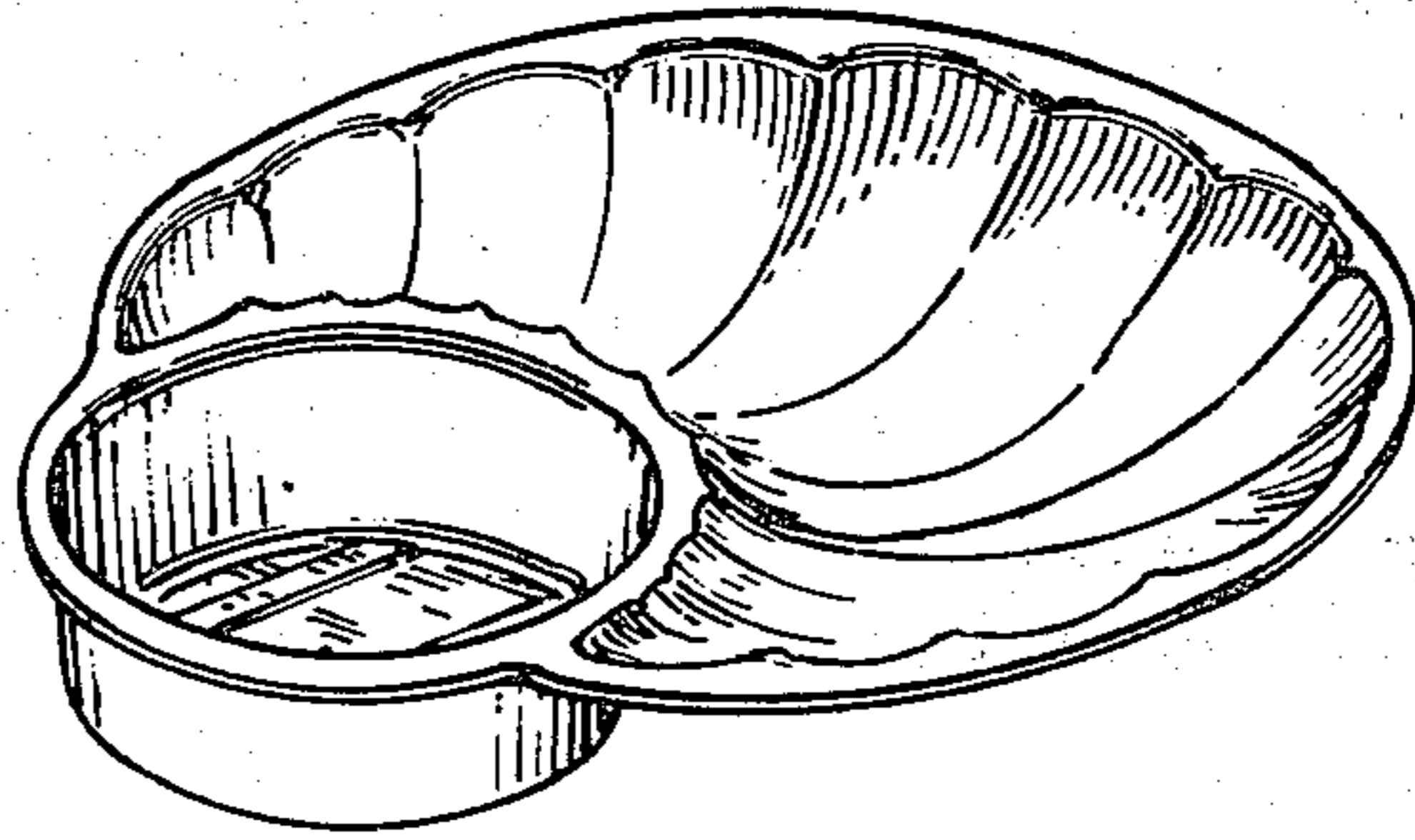

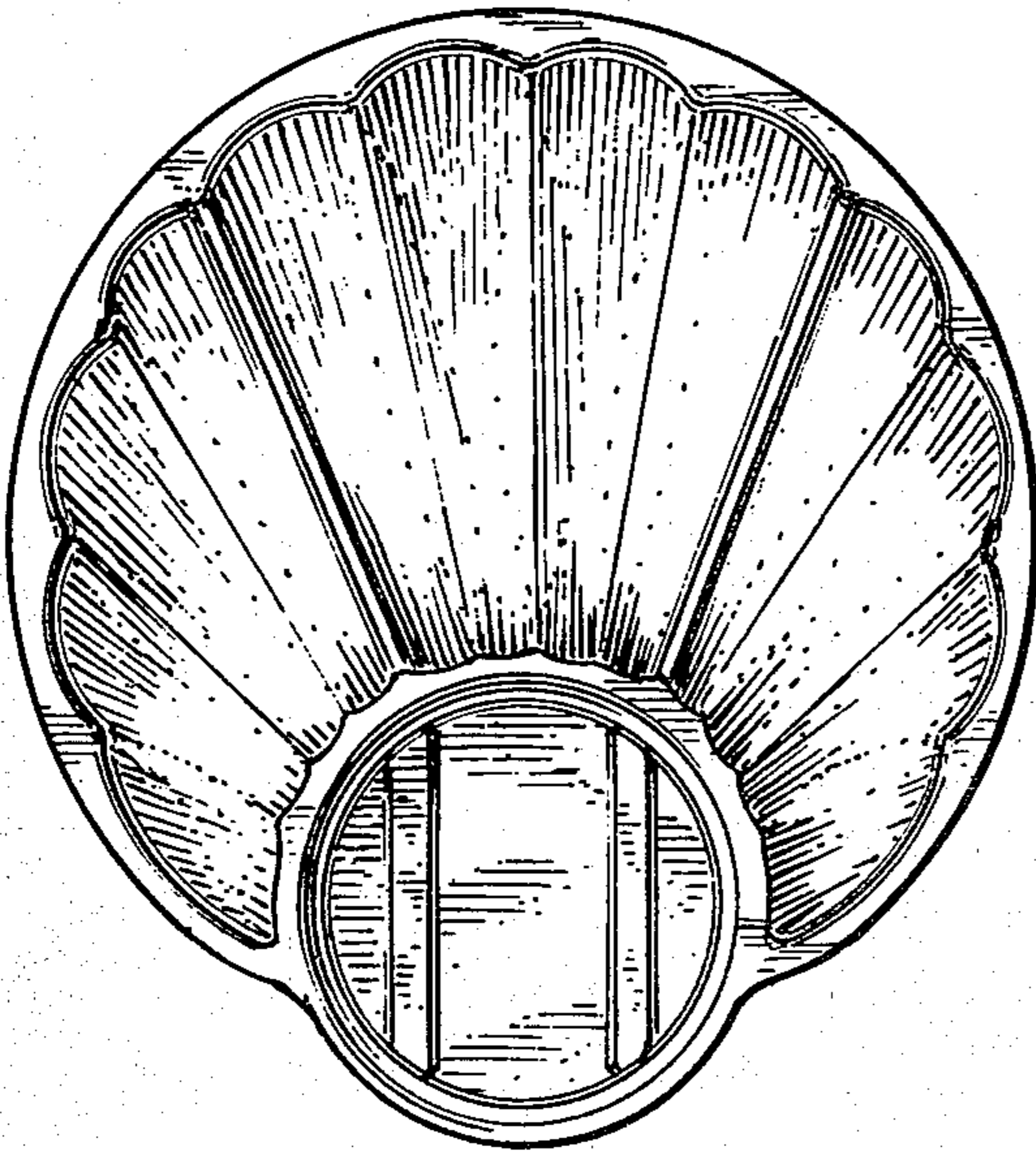

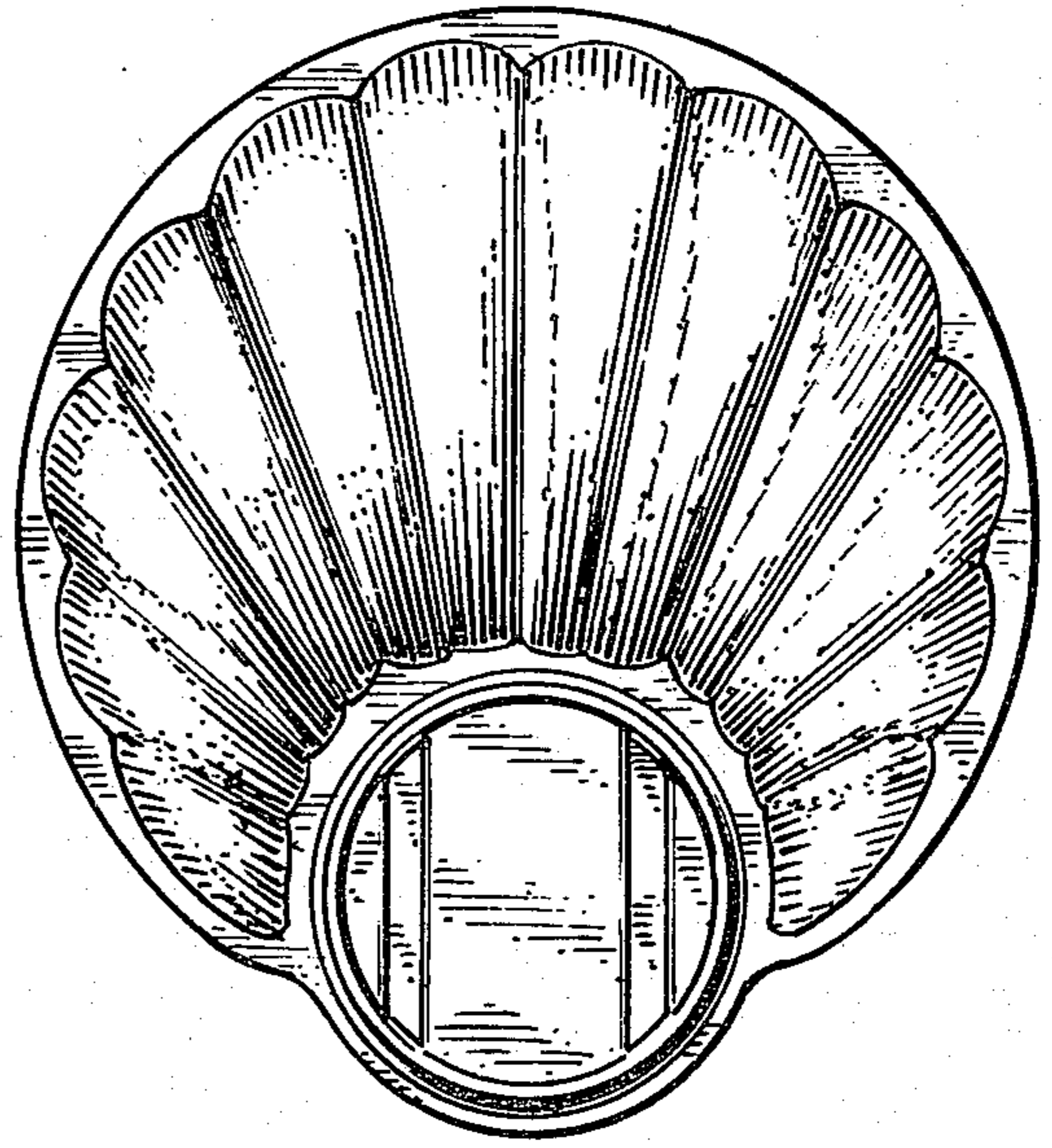

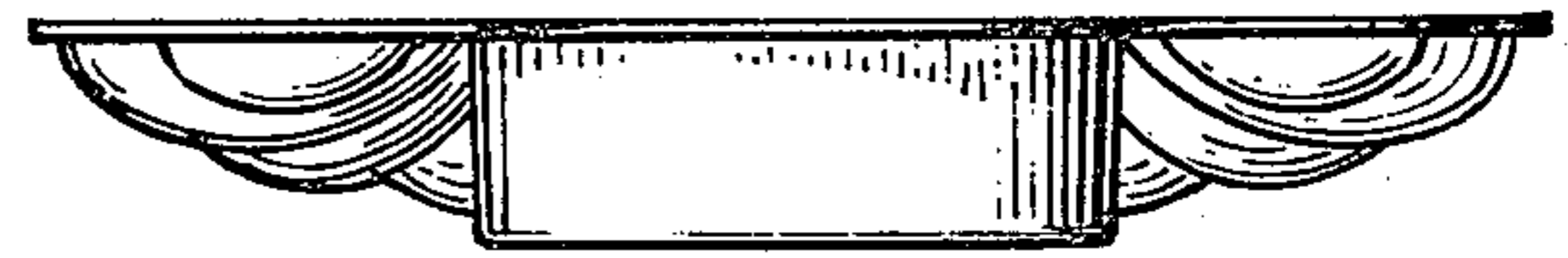
