CLAIM

The ornamental design for a scoring device for games,
substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view from the front left of a
scoring device for games showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of my design as viewed
from the front right.

FIG. 3 is a perspective view of the under side of my
design as viewed from the front.

FIG. 4 is a perspective view of the under side of my
design as viewed from the rear.
