The circuit breaker is shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only.

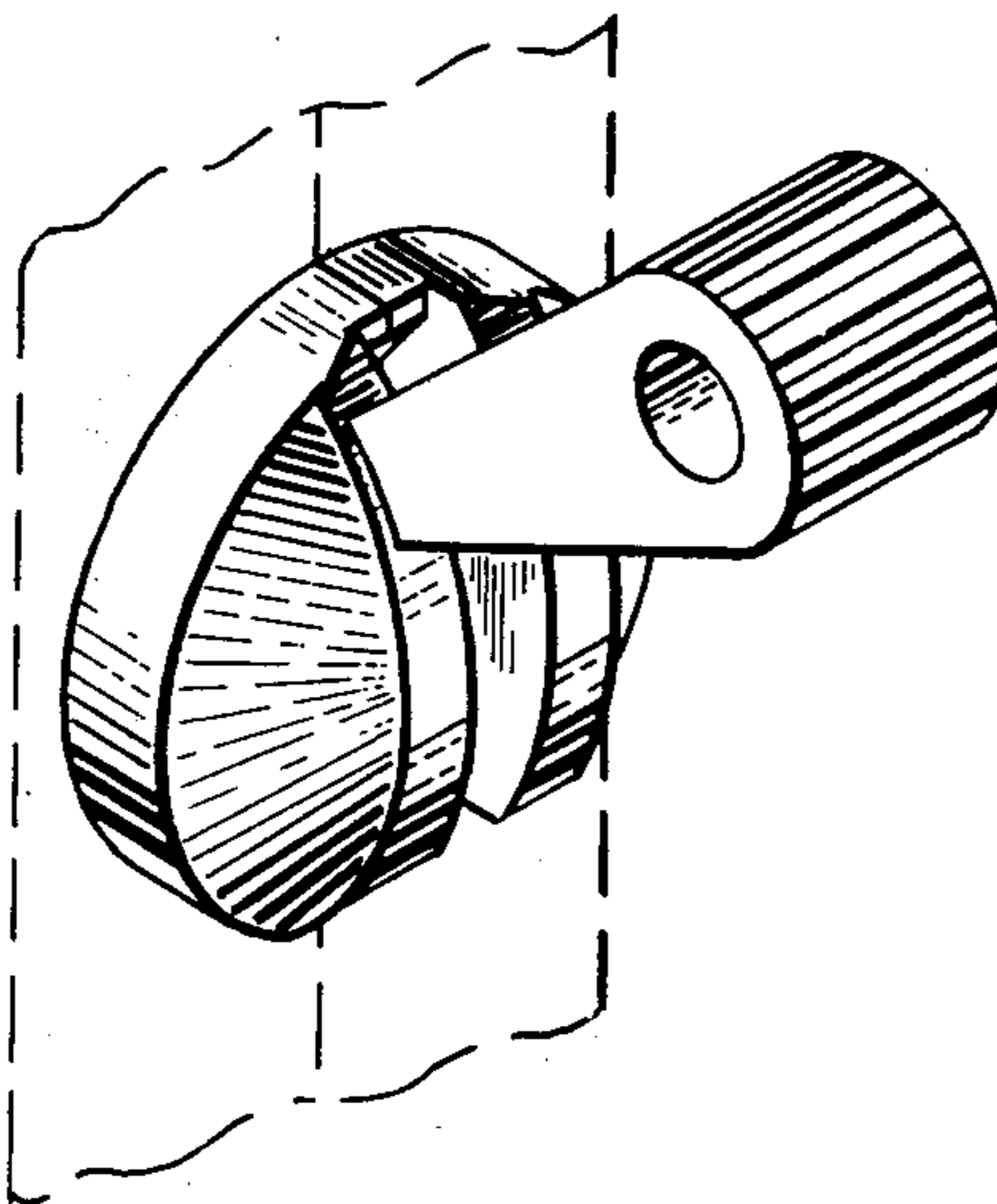

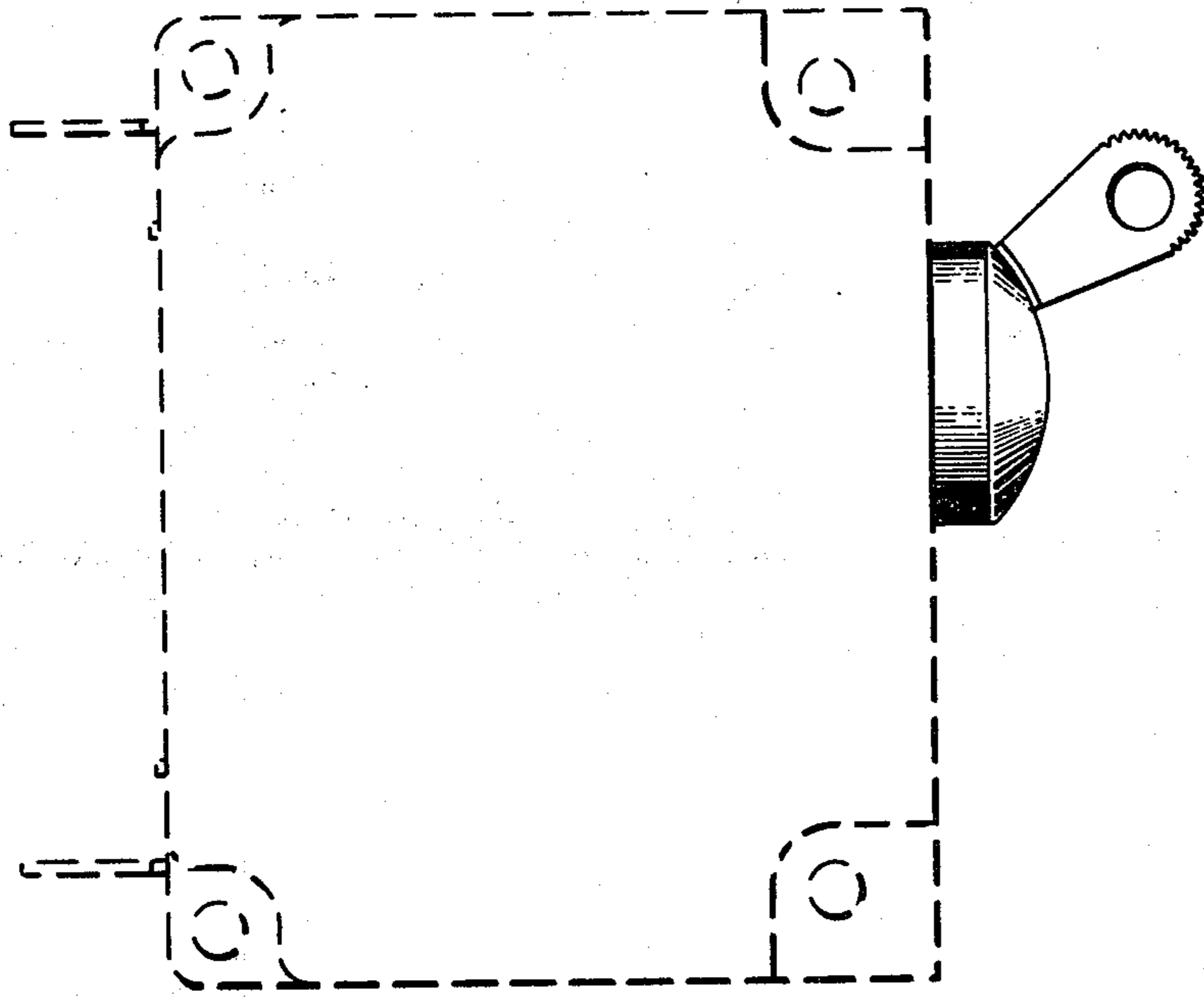

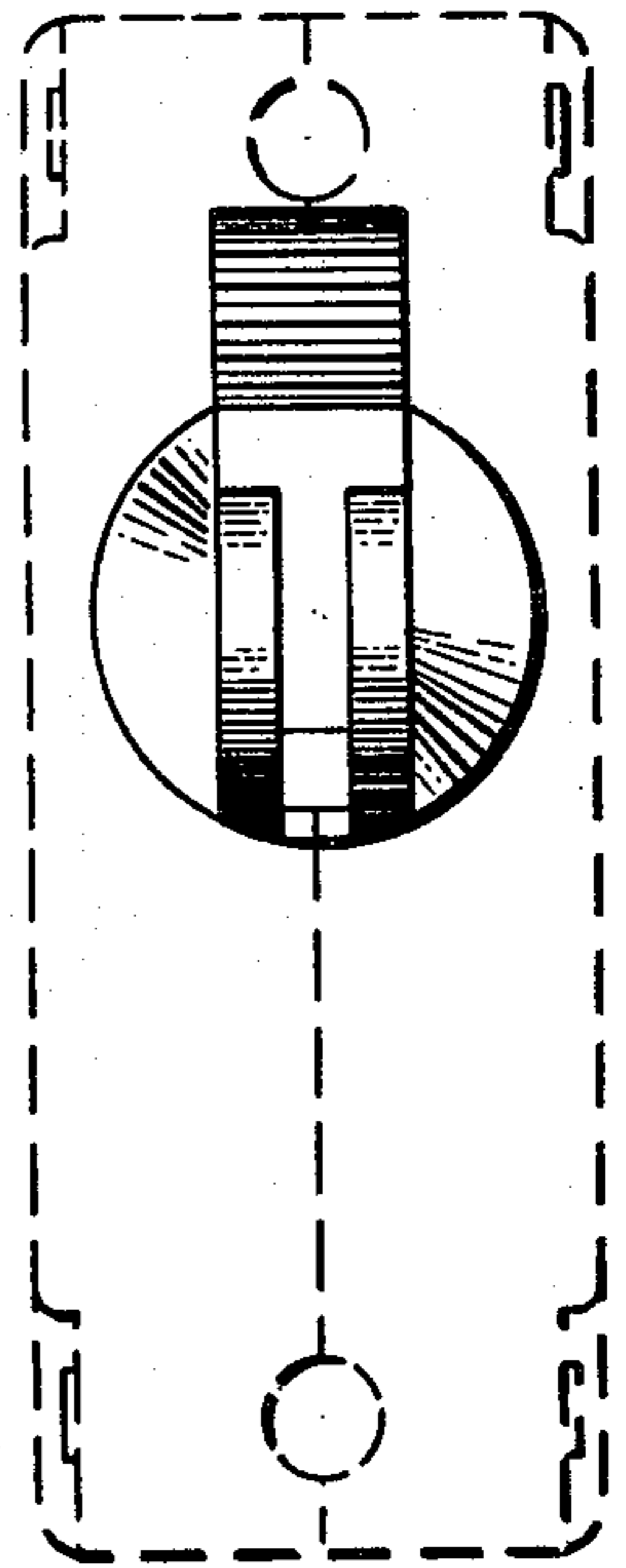

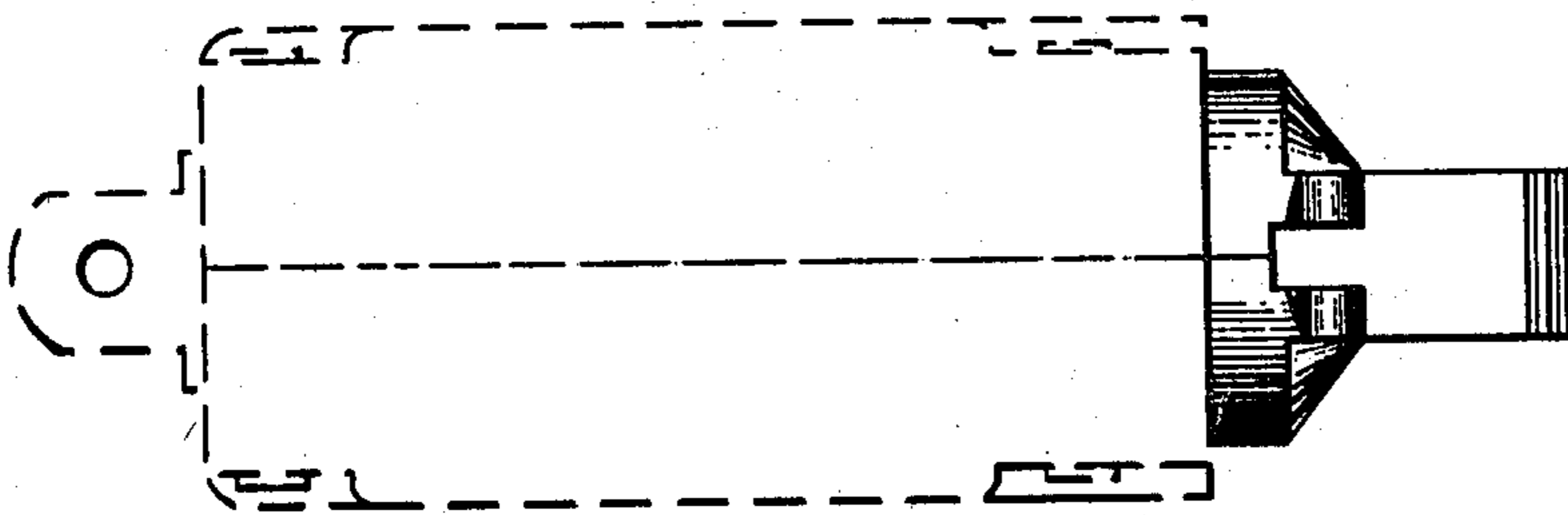
