FIG. 1 is a top view of our new and ornamental design for a mallet style putter head;

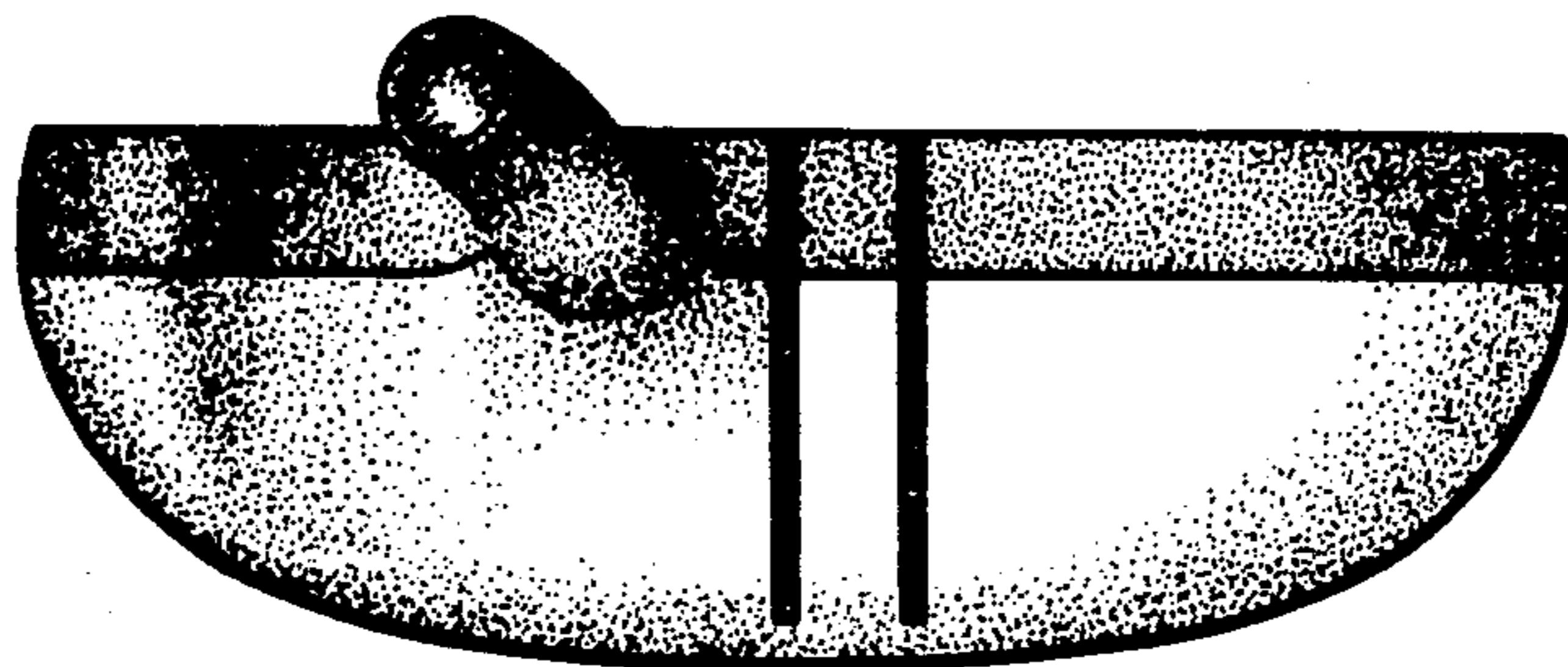
FIG. 2 is a bottom view of the mallet style putter head of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a view from the toe end of the mallet style putter head of FIG. 1.



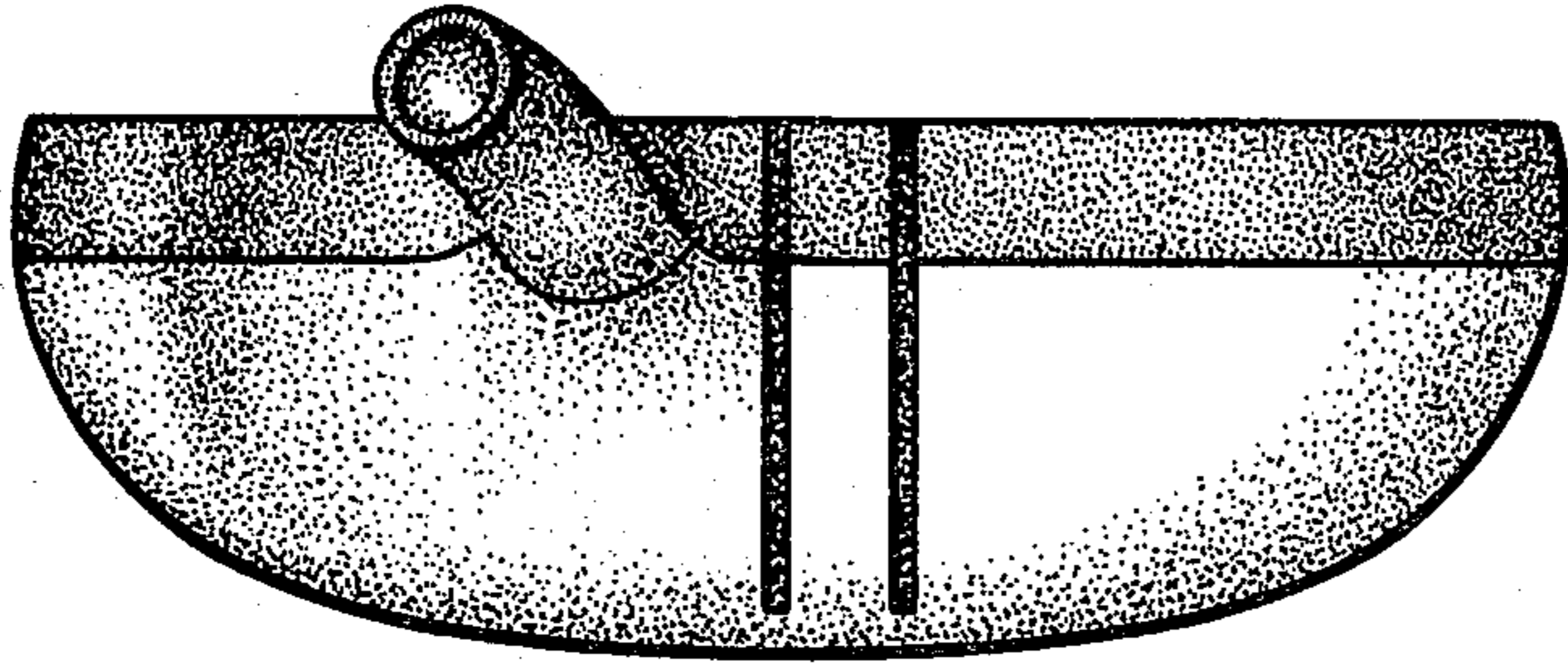

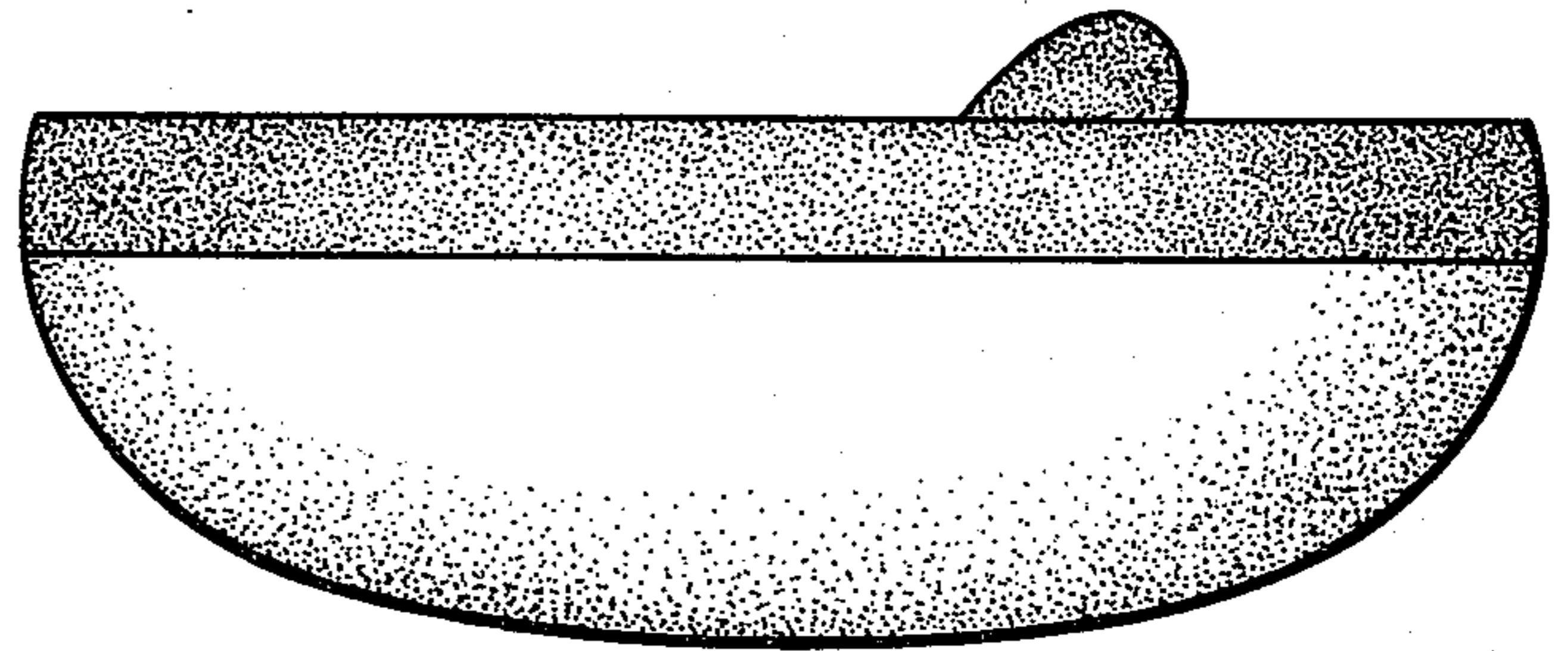

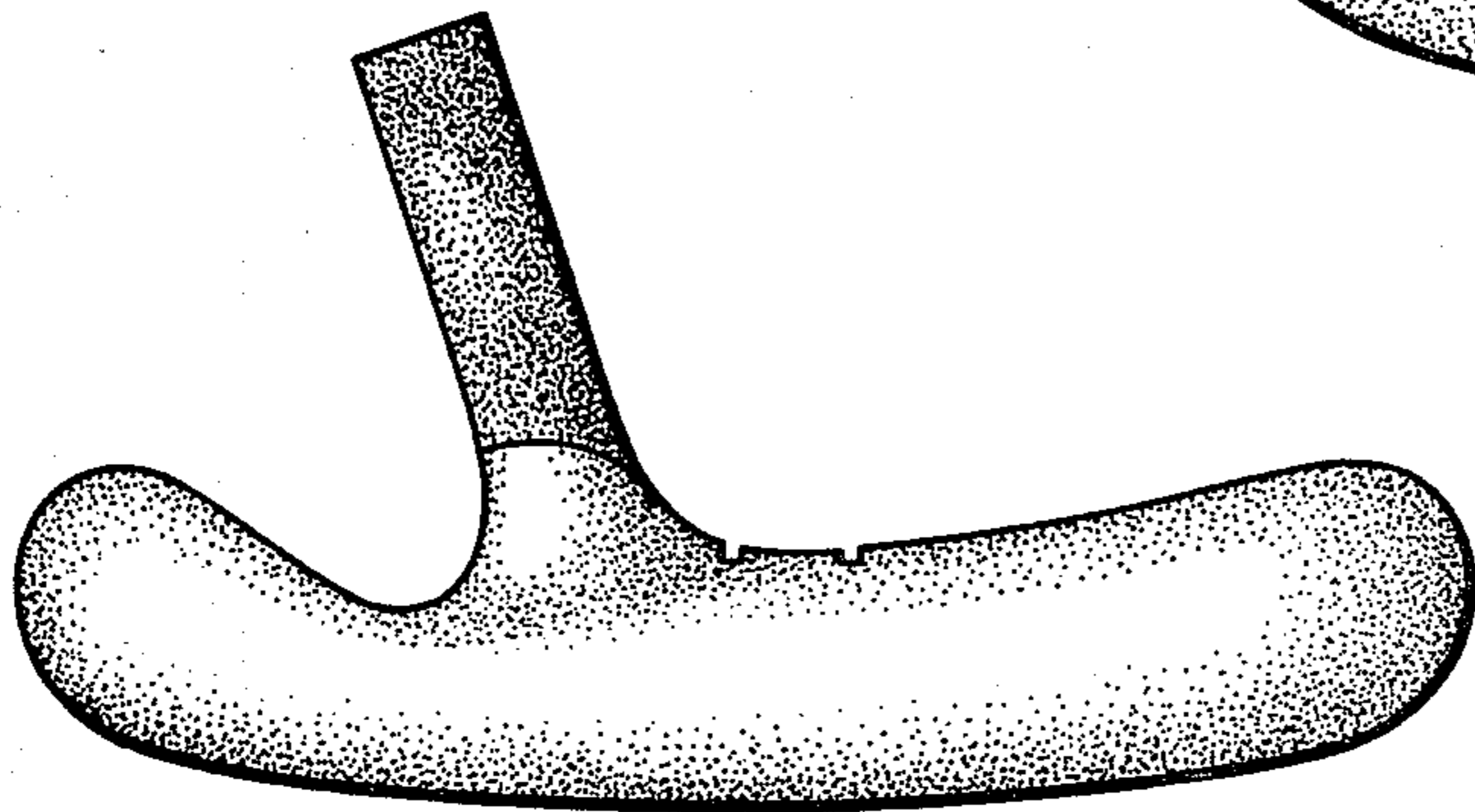

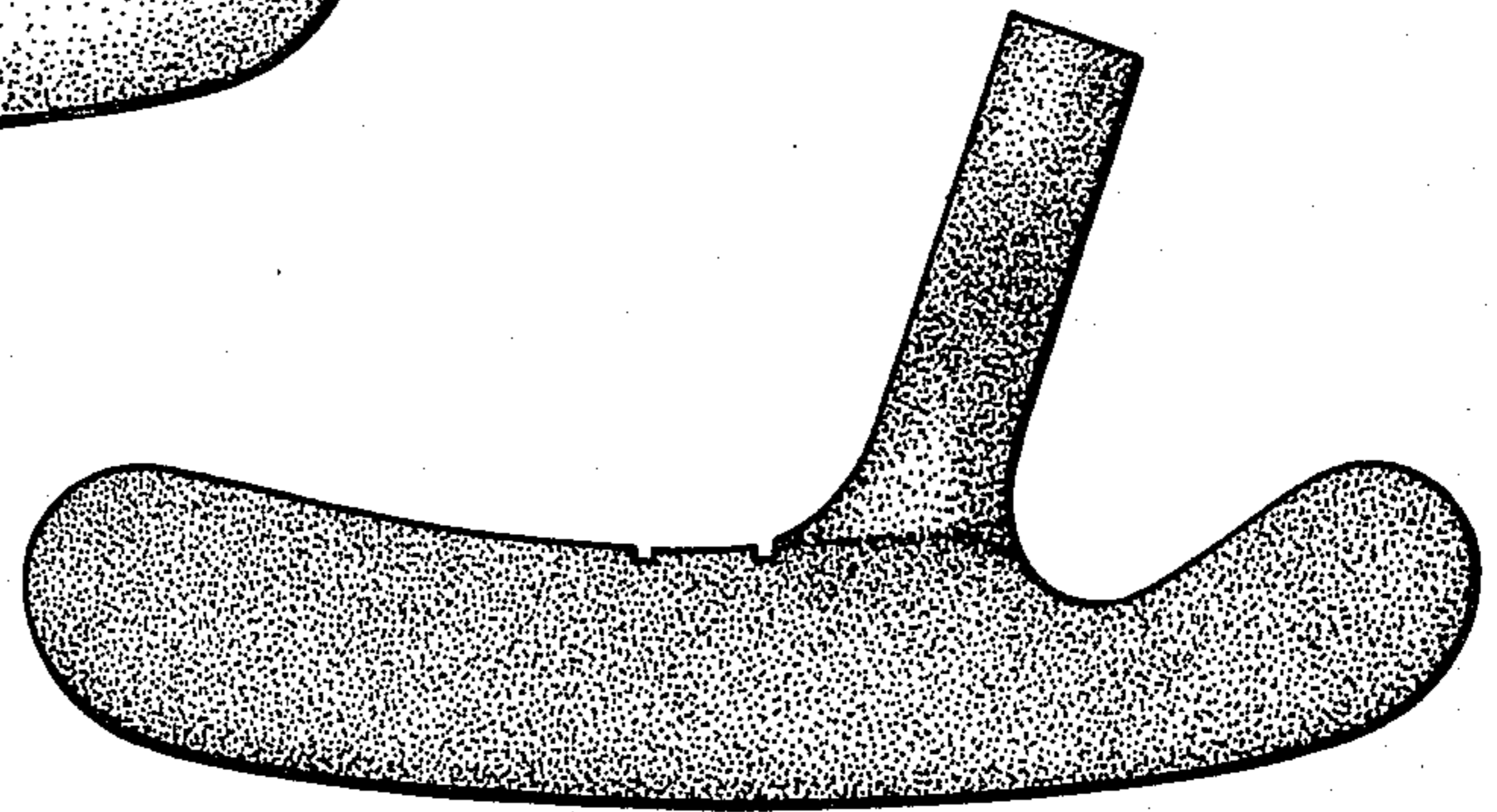

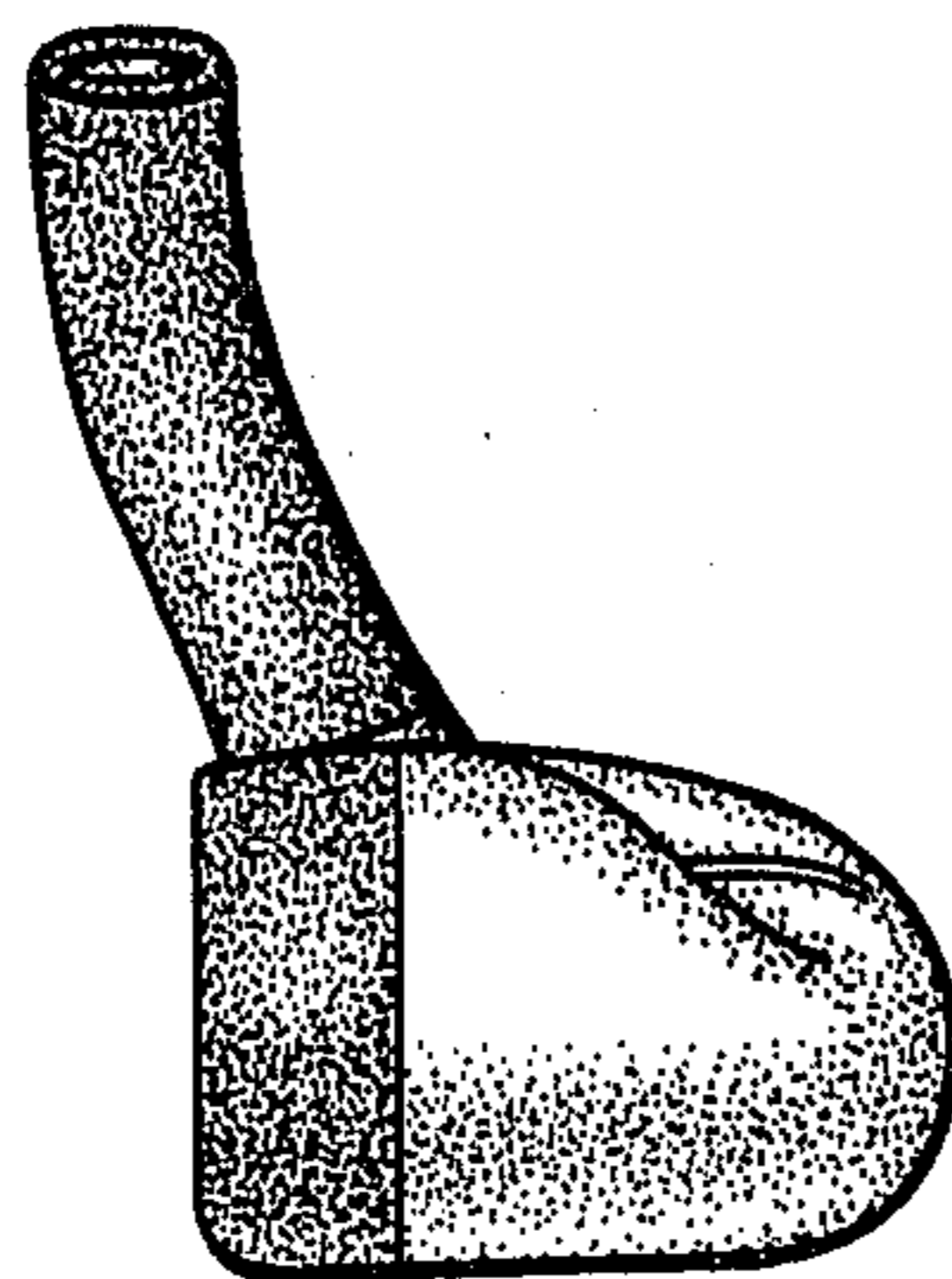

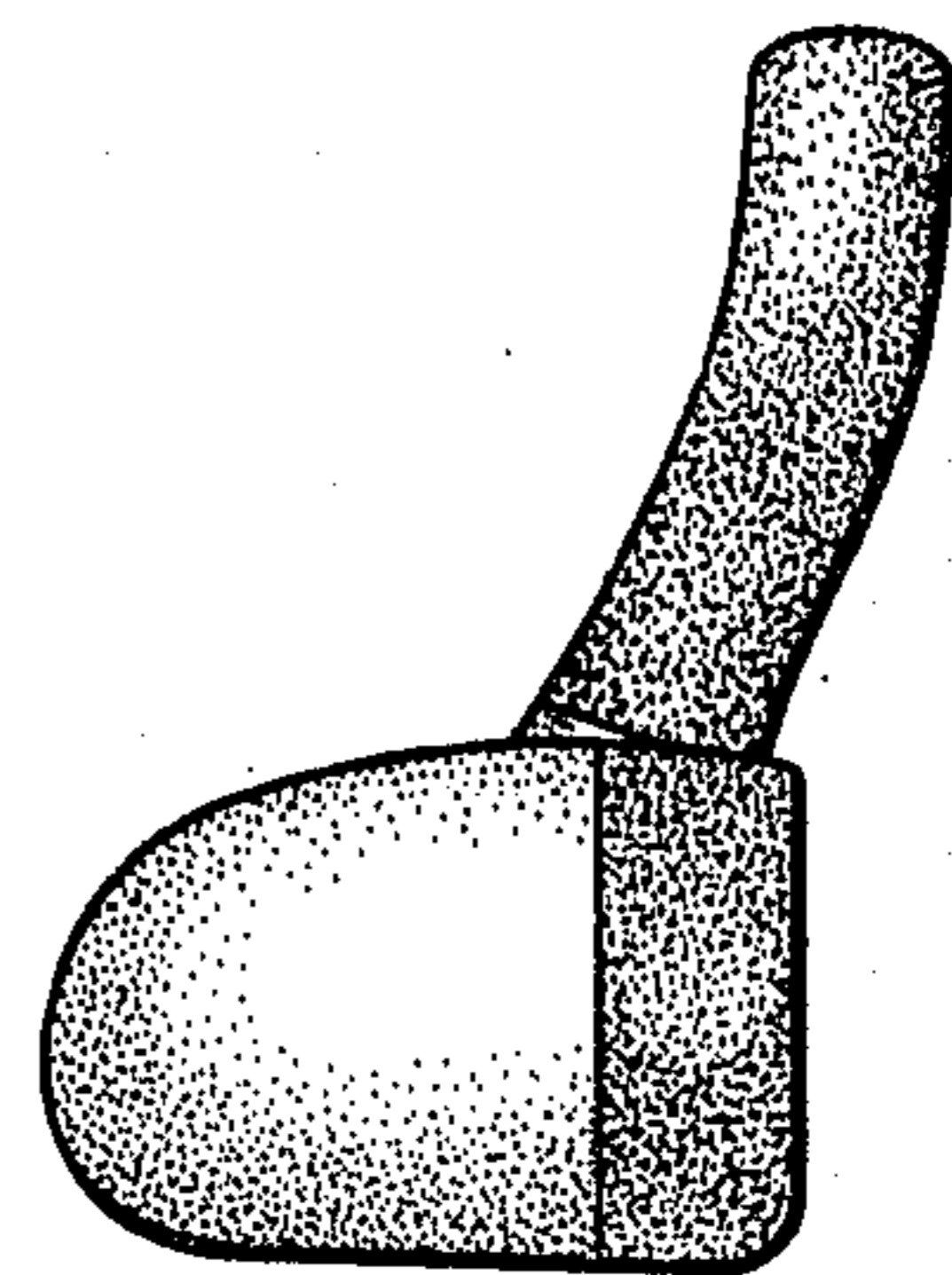
