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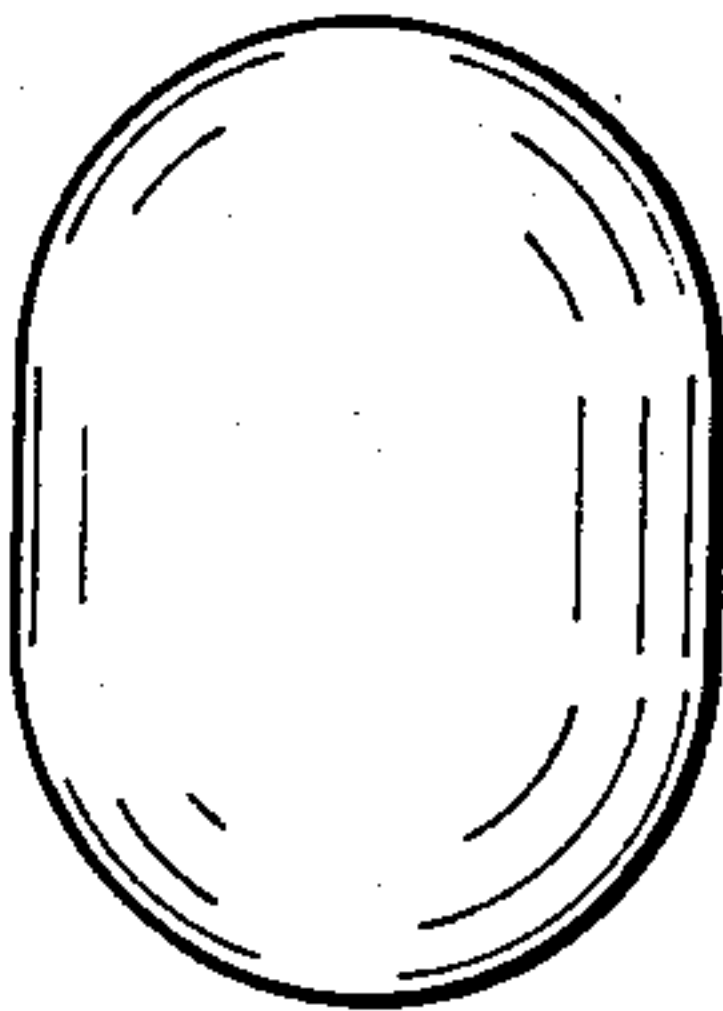
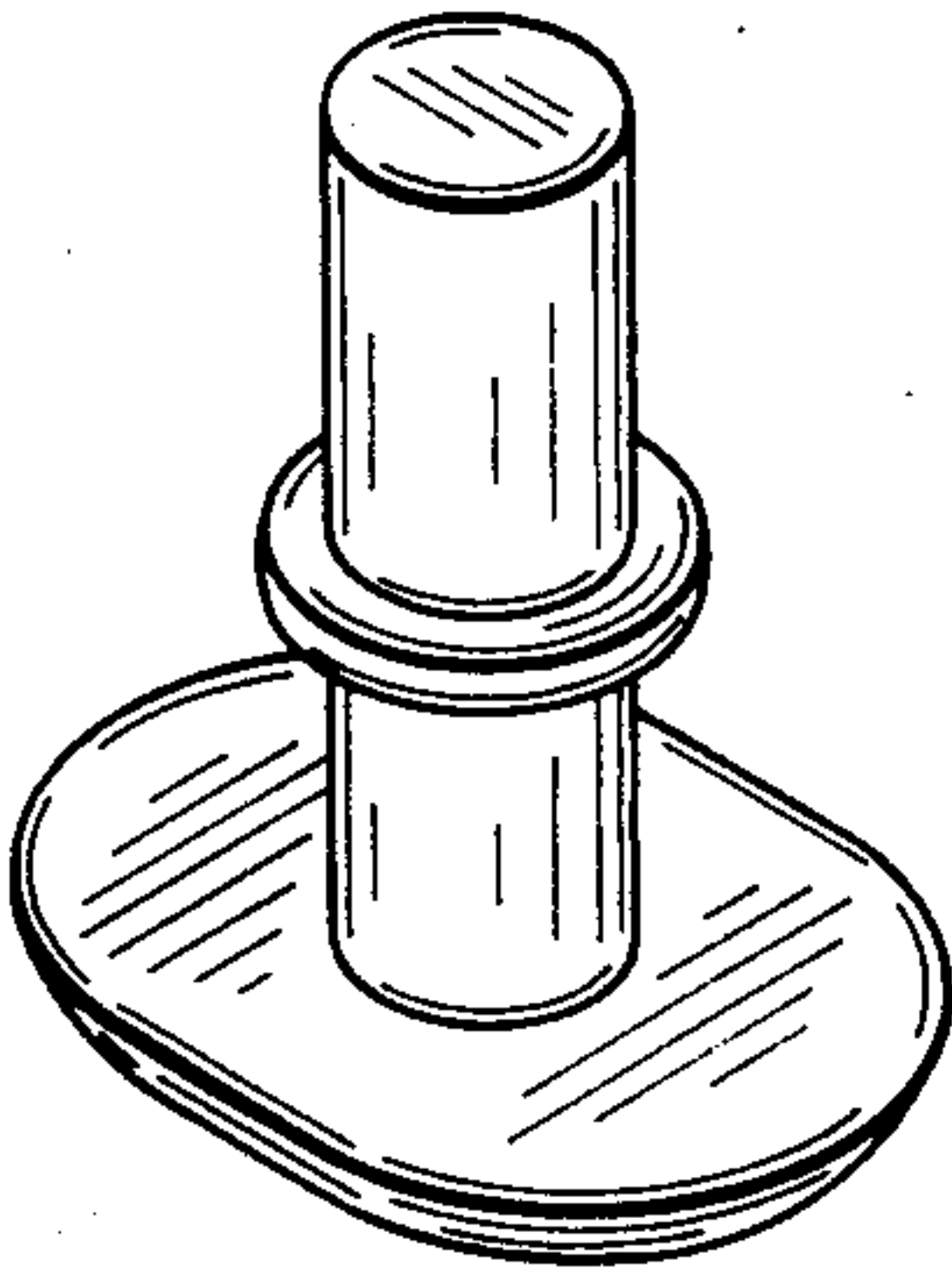

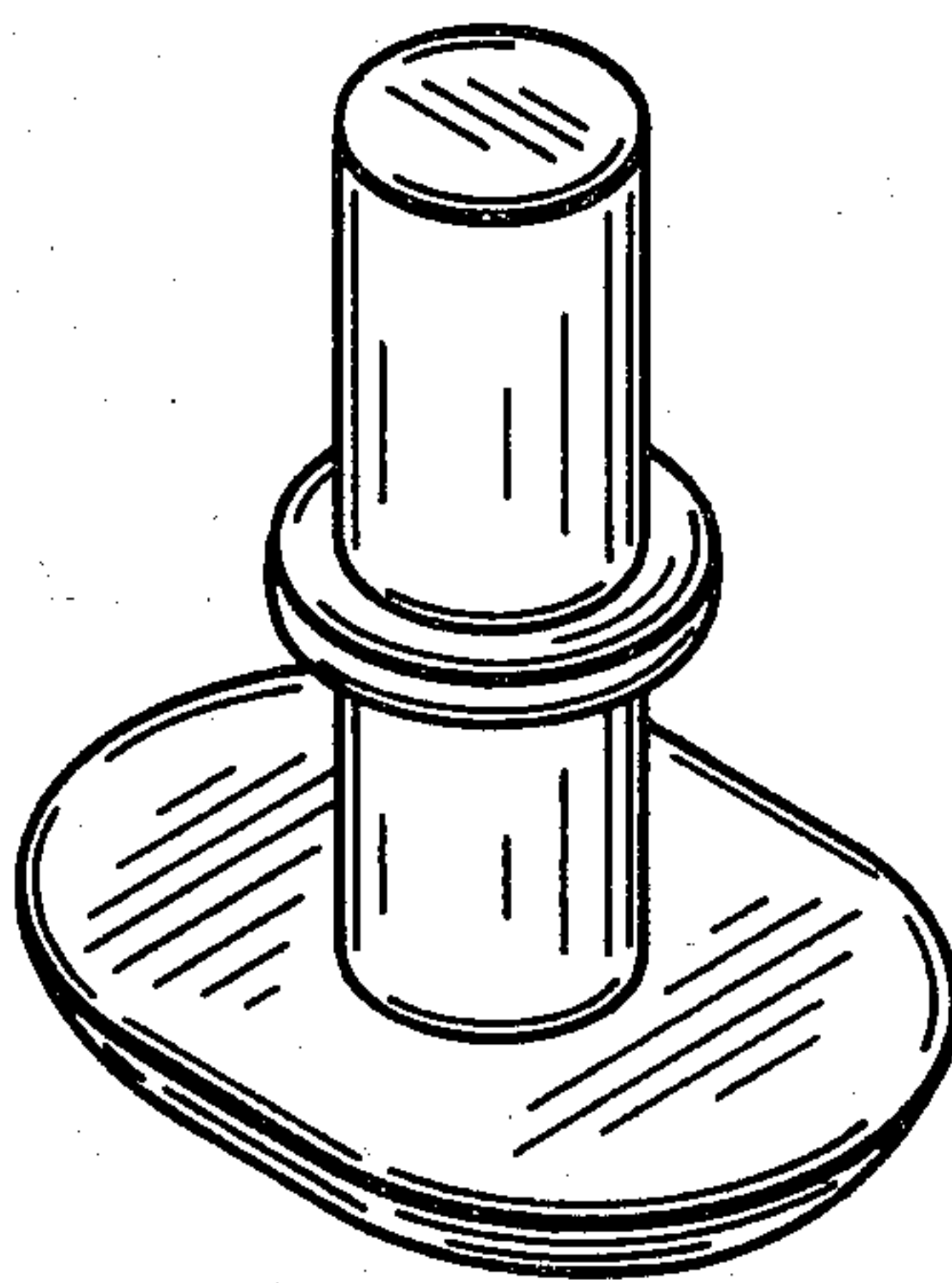

plant, as shown and described.

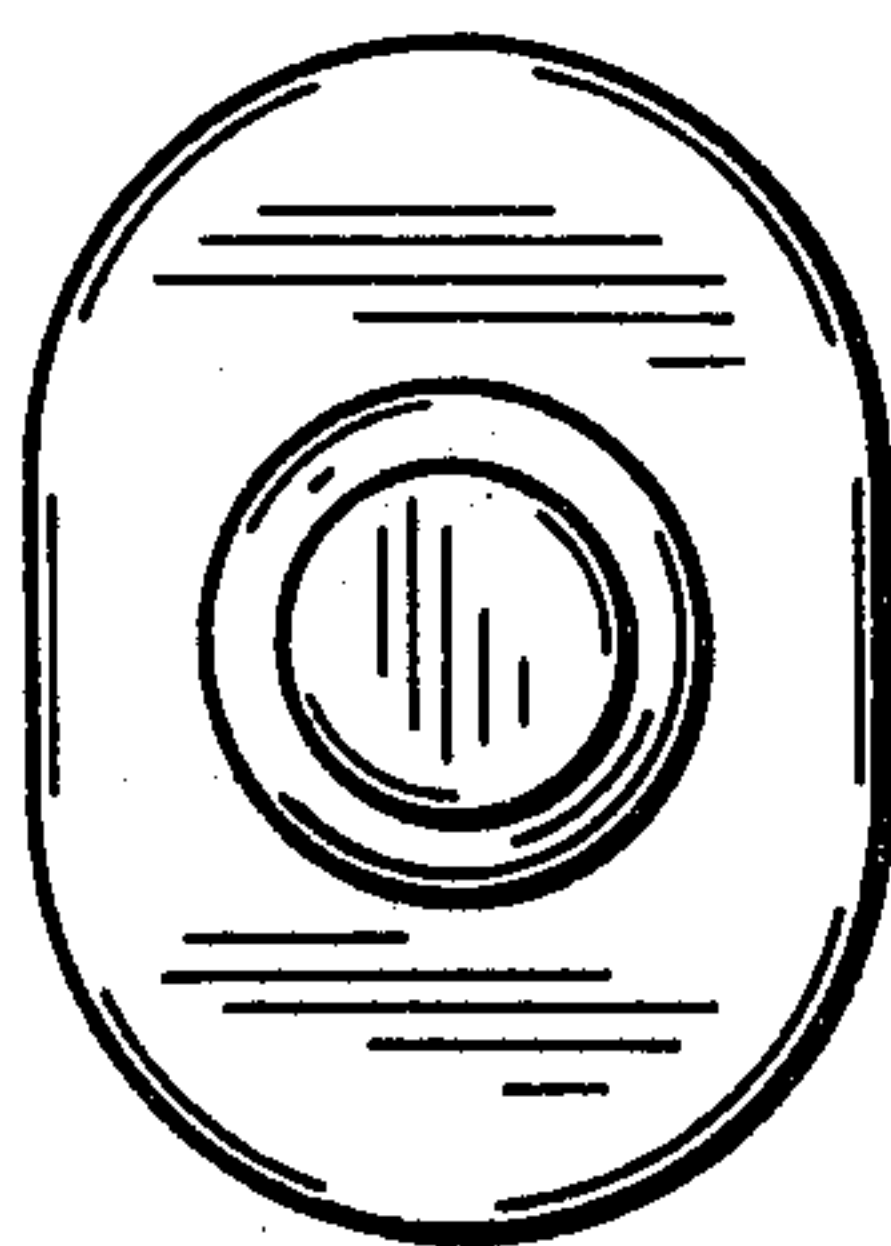
DESCRIPTION

elevational view being identical.

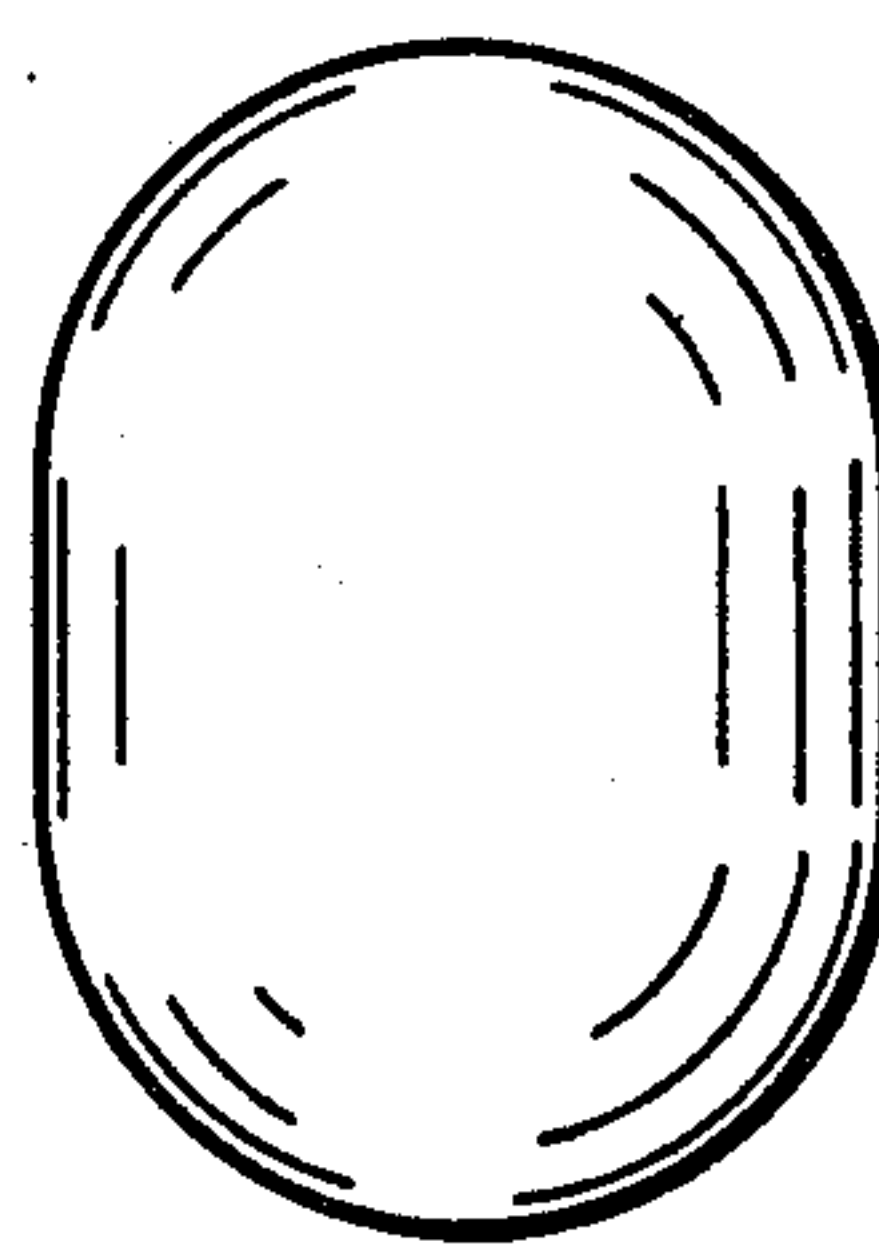




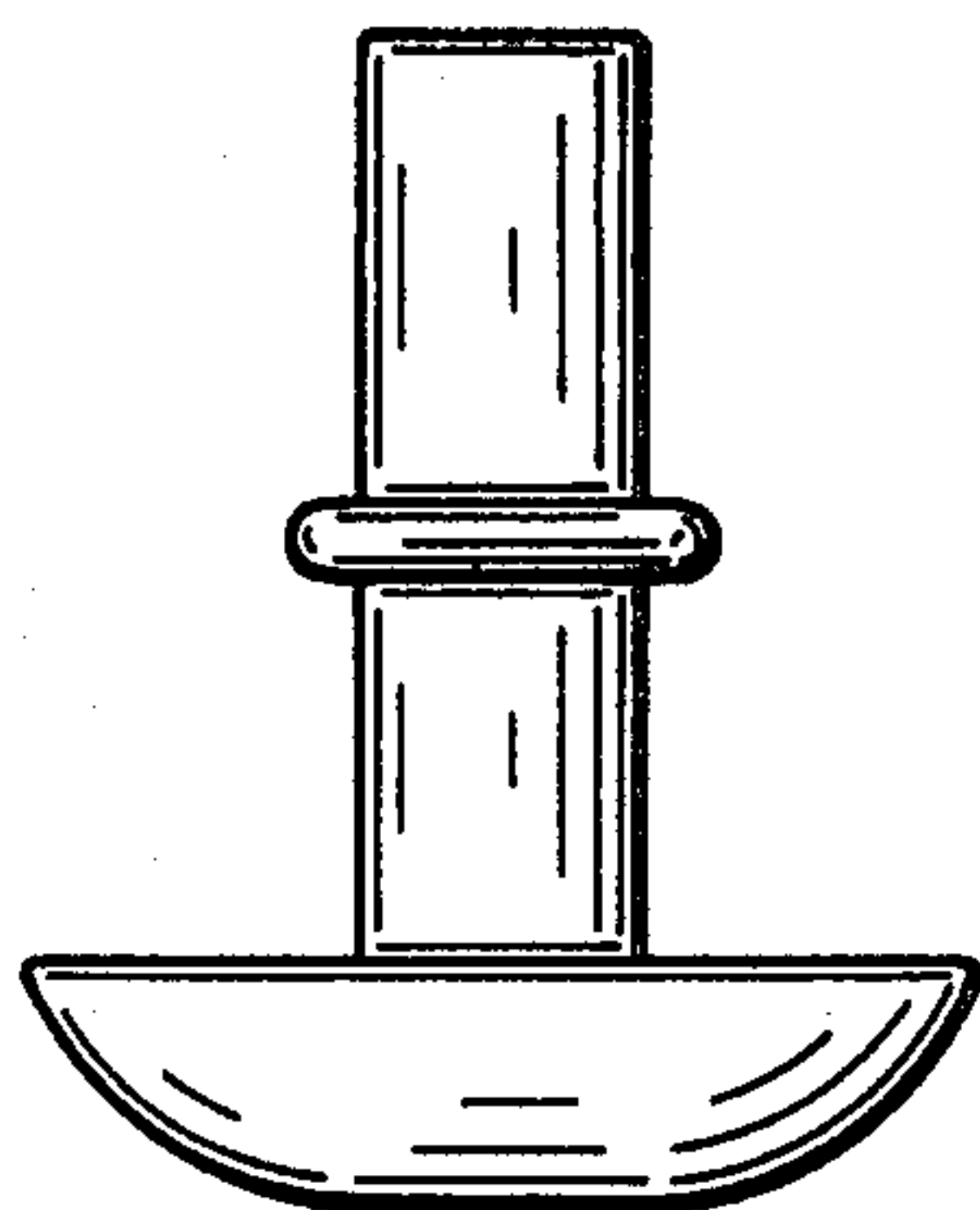

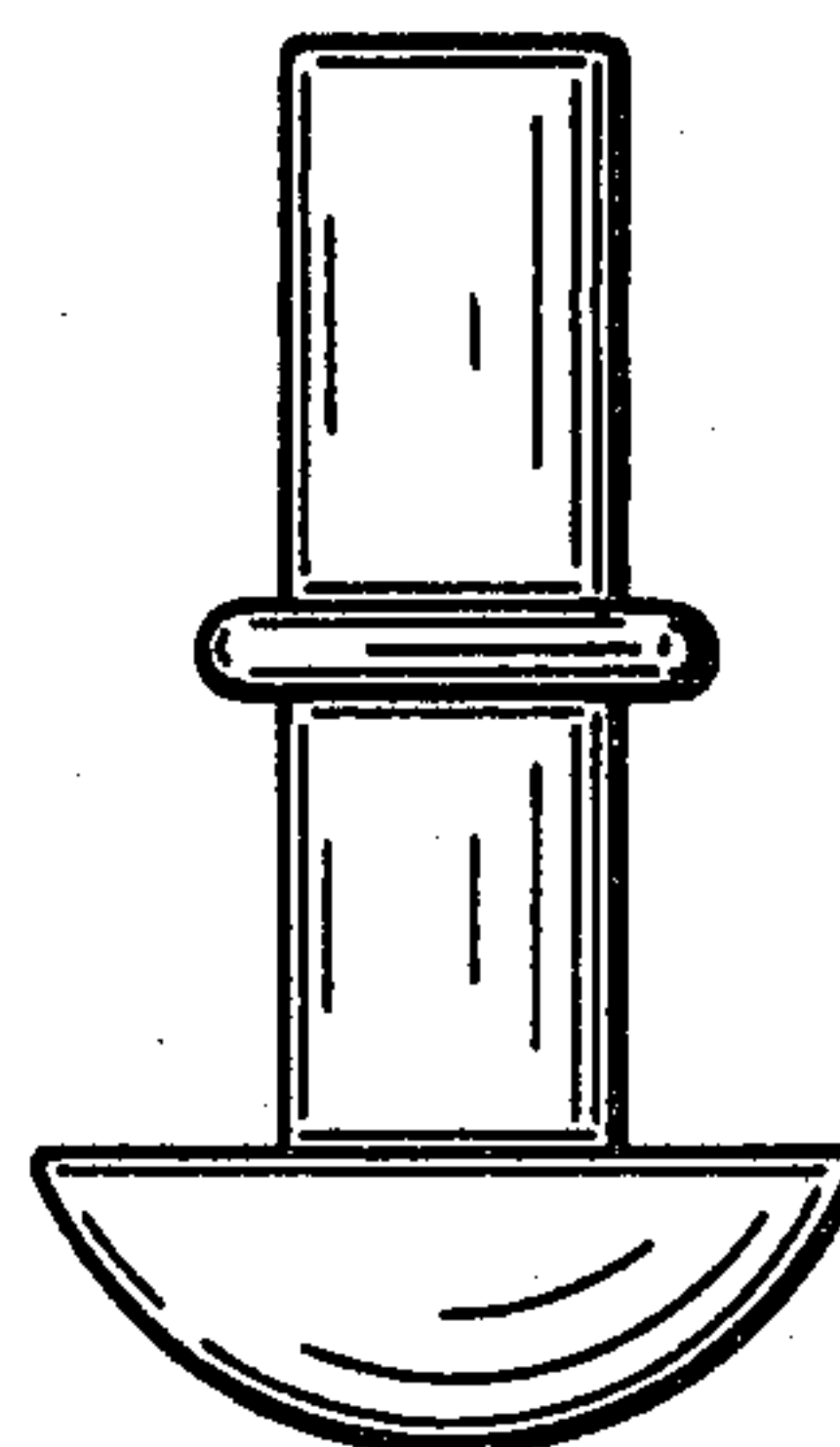
