The ornamental design for a coffee maker, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left-side perspective view of a coffee maker showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left-side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right-side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.
The shading on the upright housing portion is intended to show translucency.

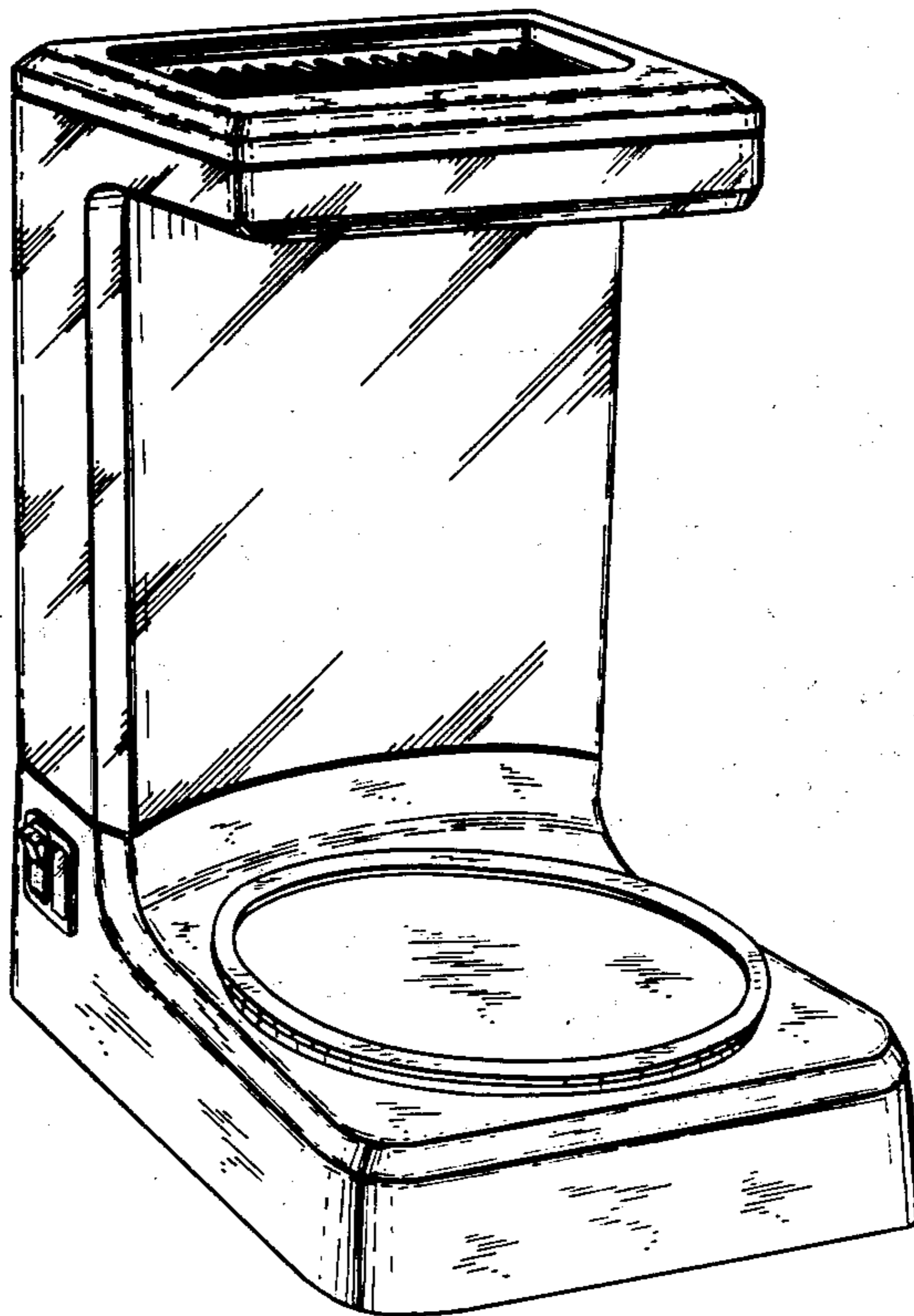

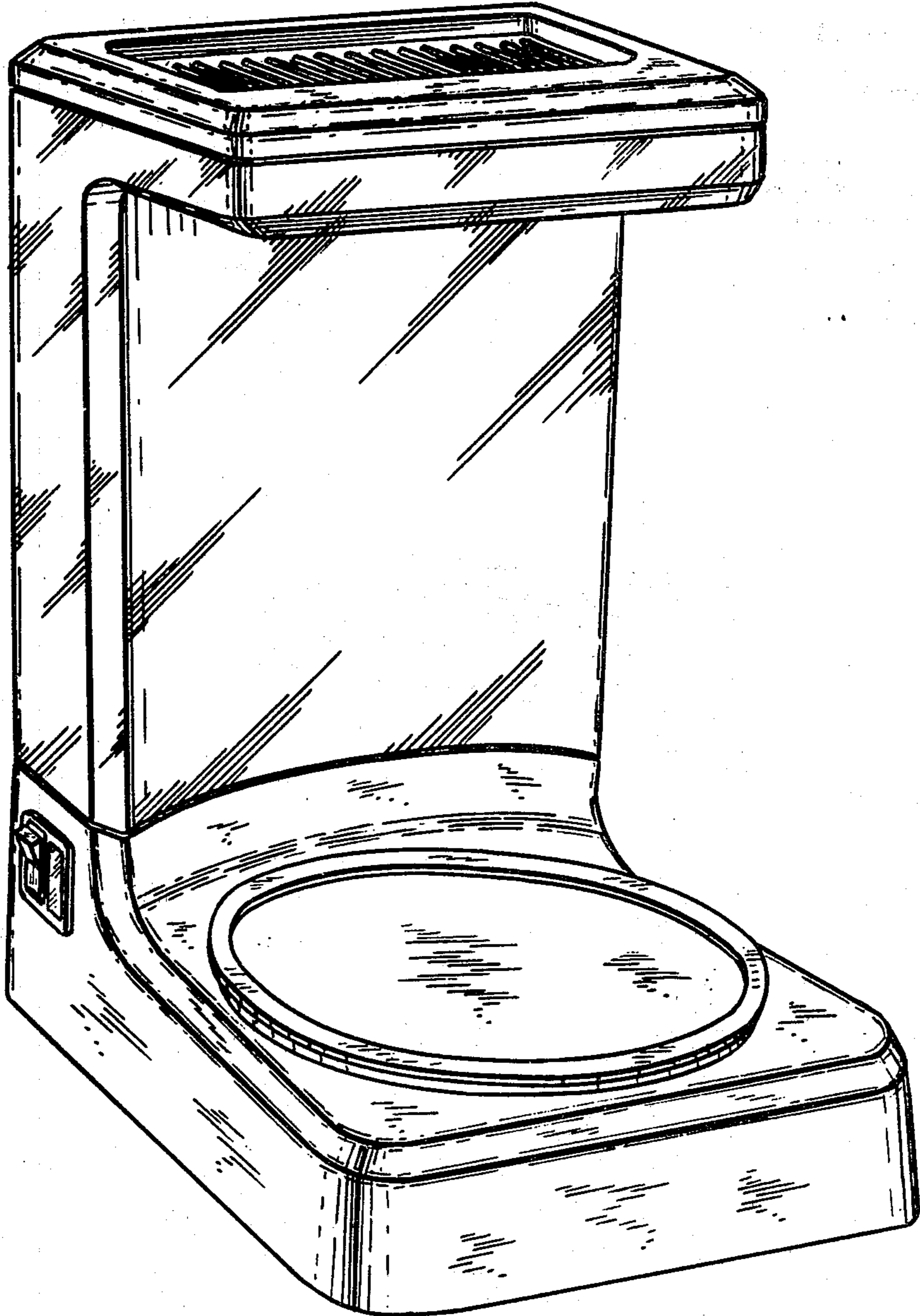

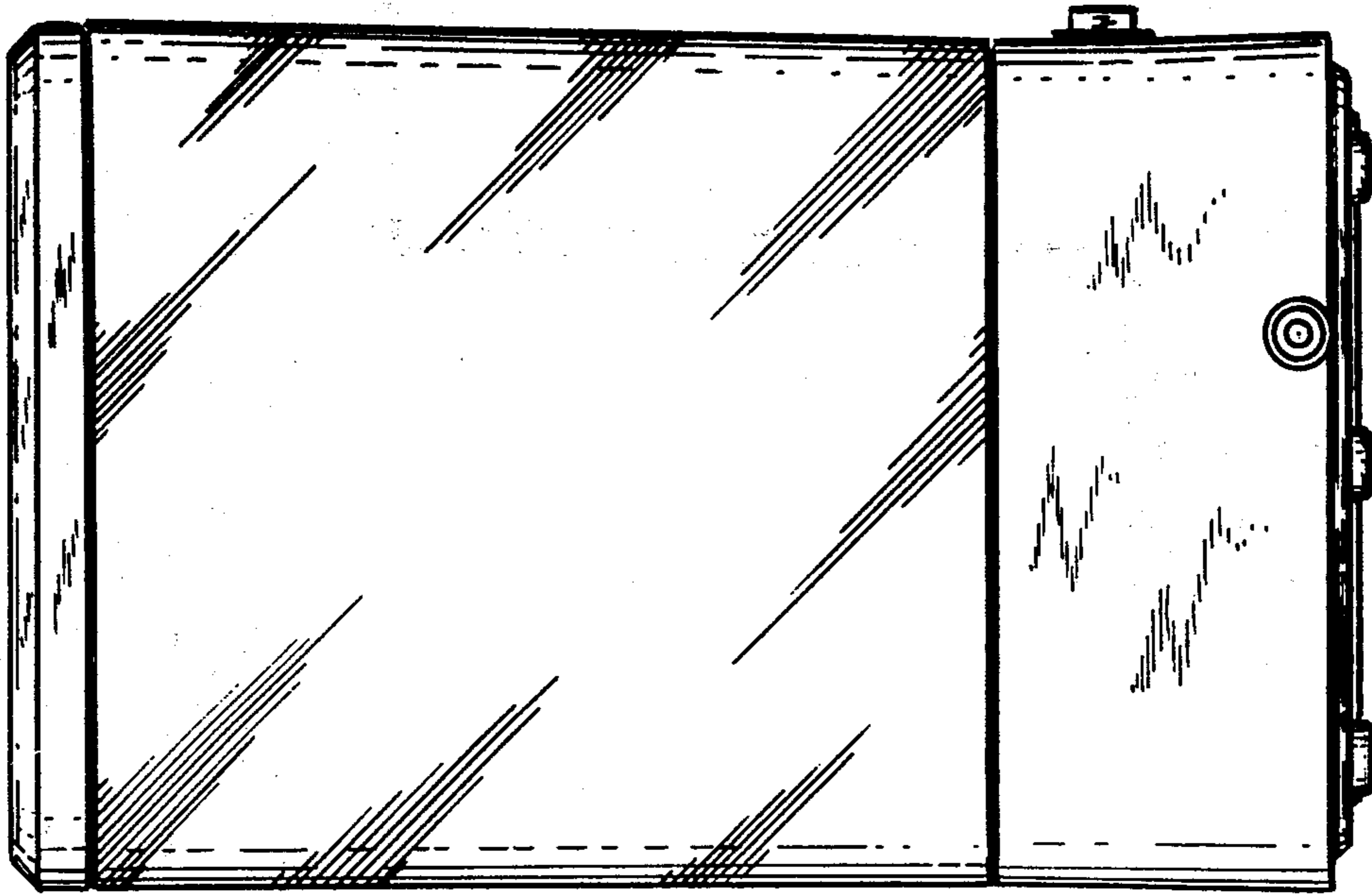

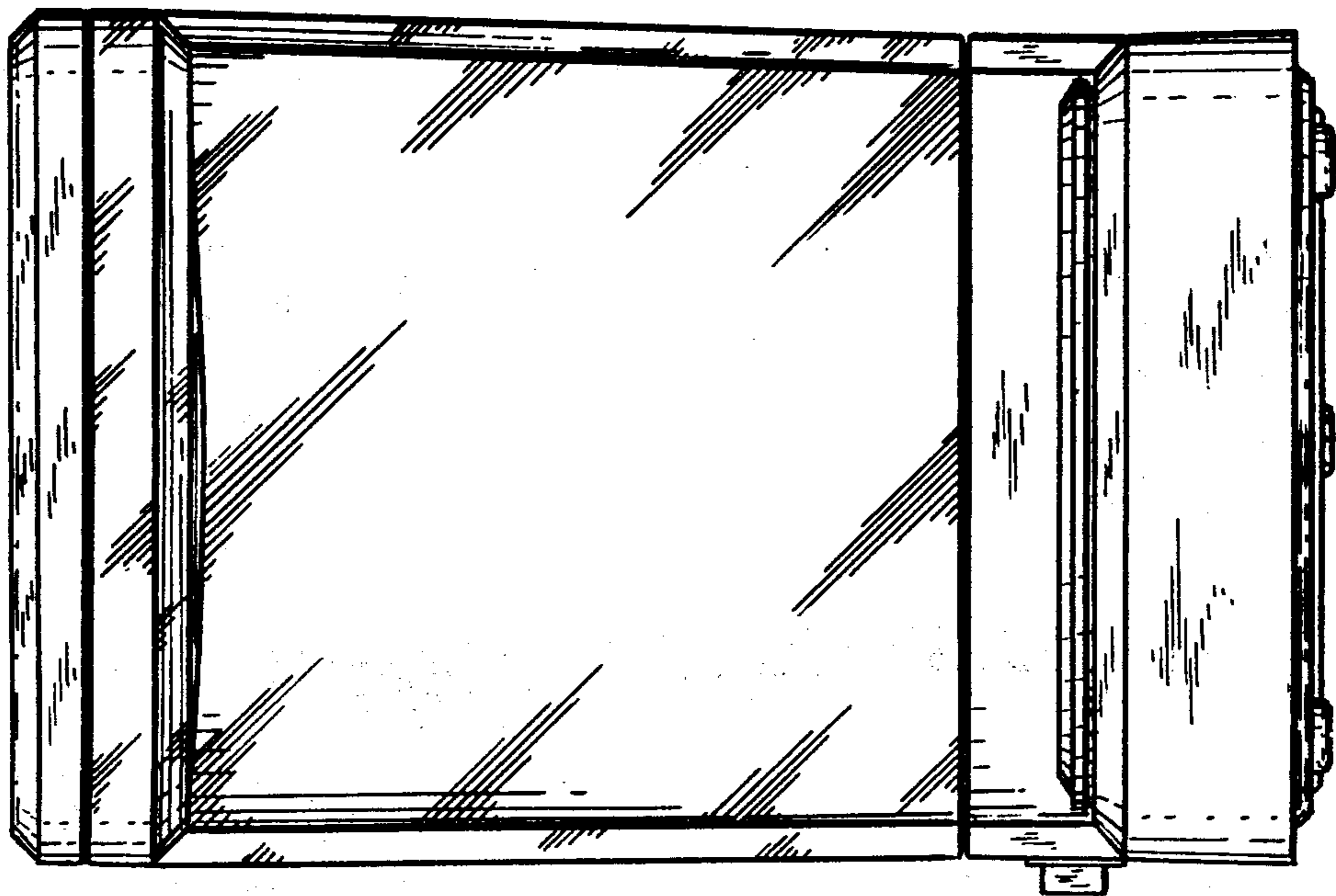

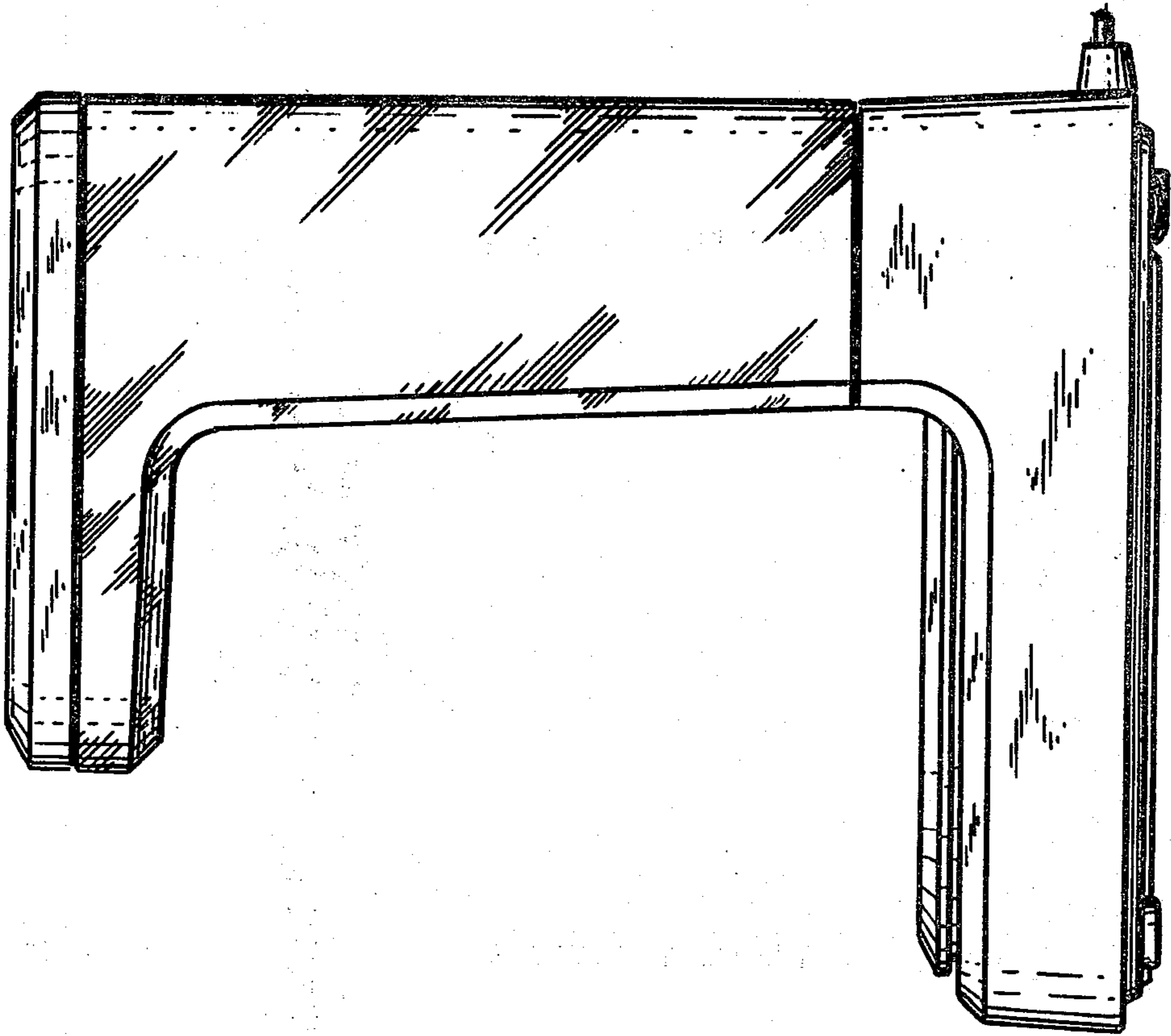

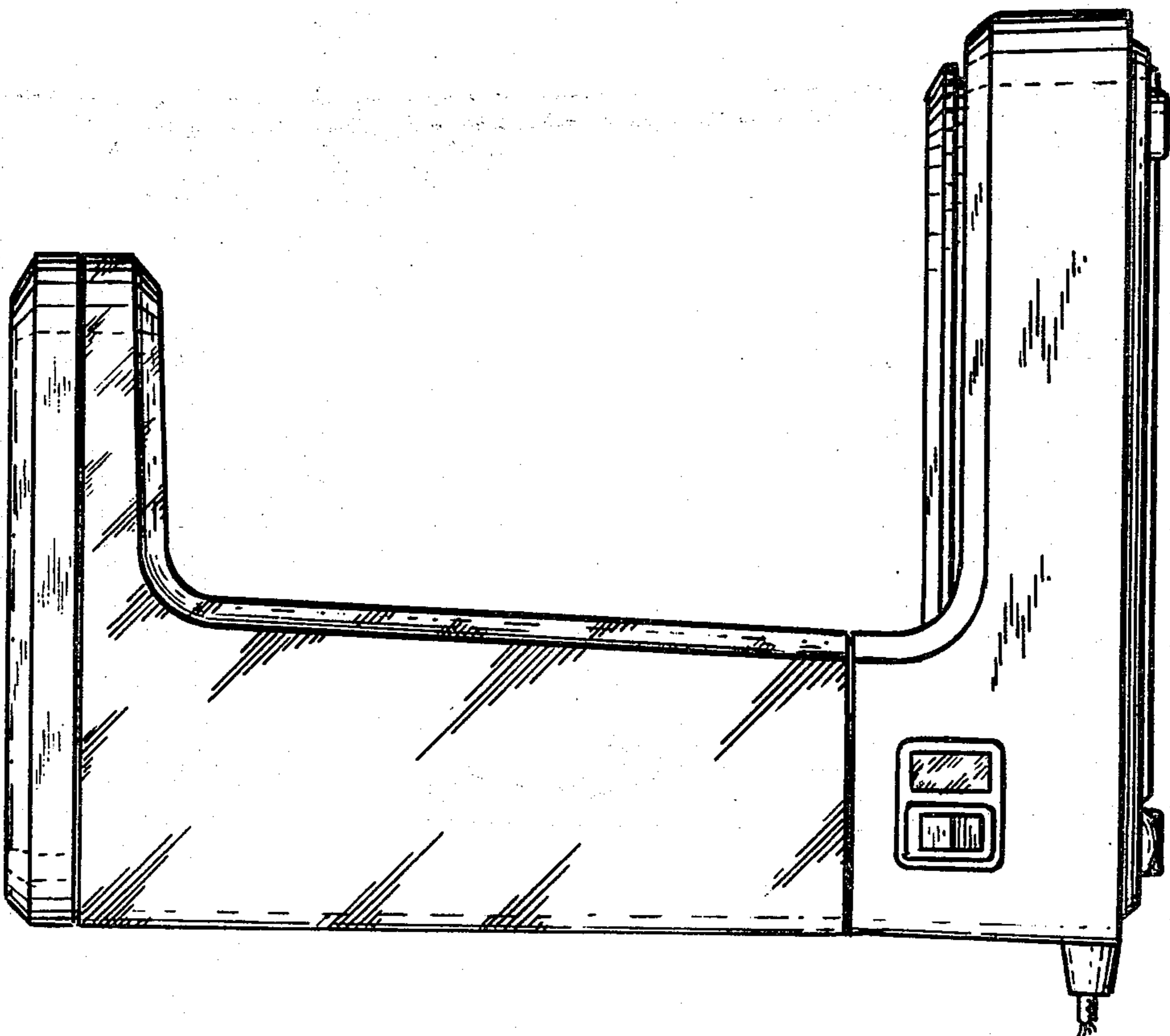

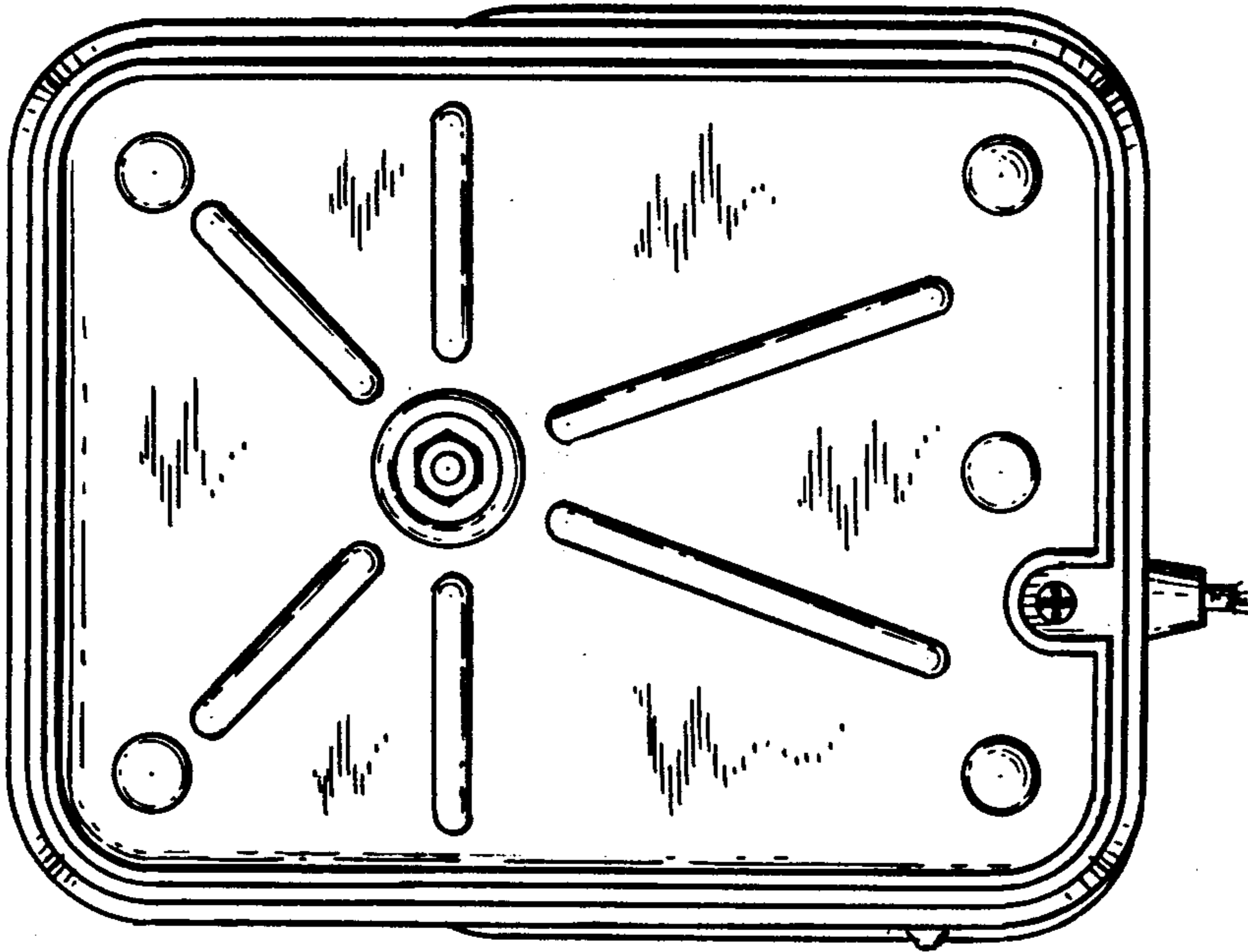
