ated case is closed.

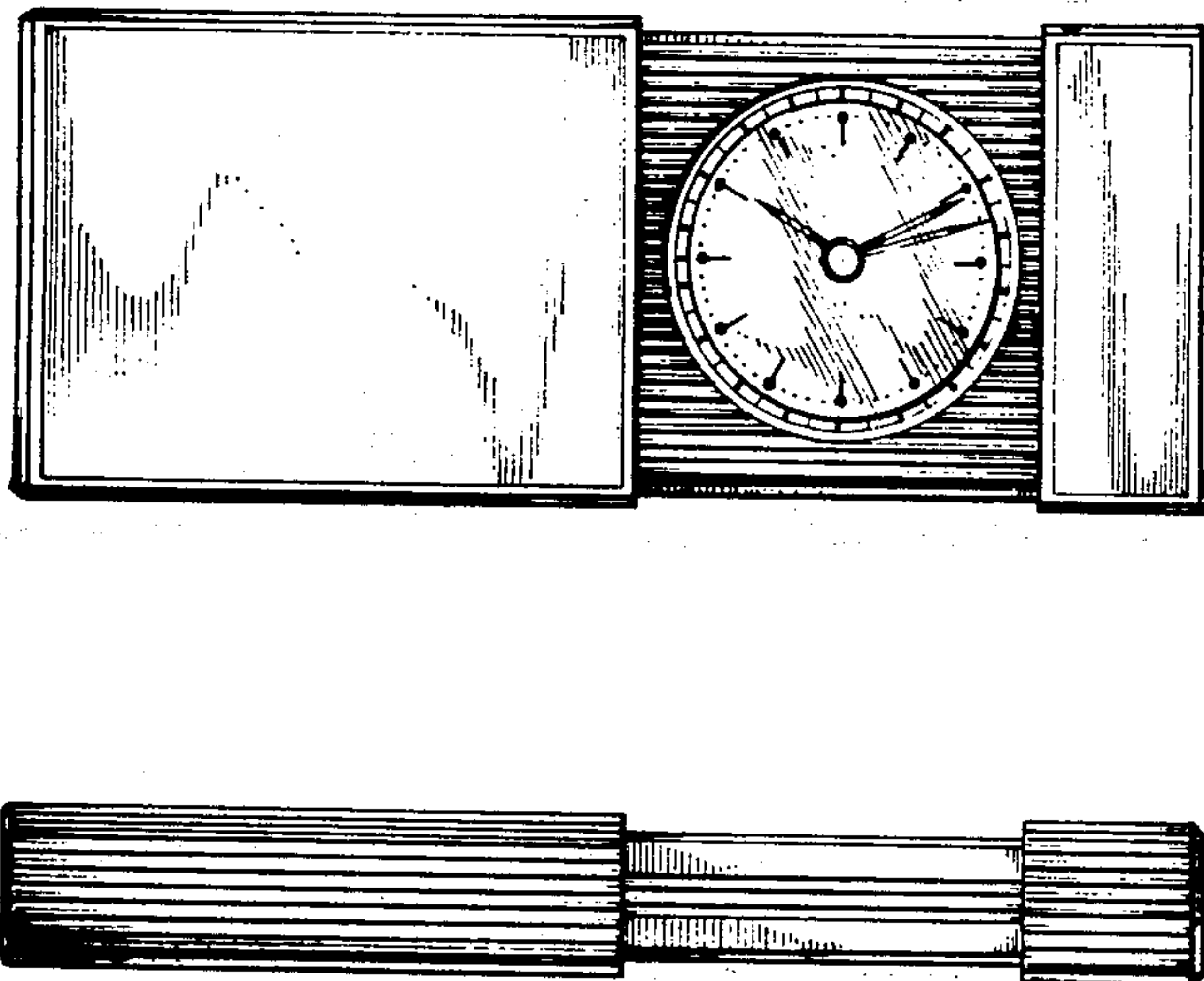

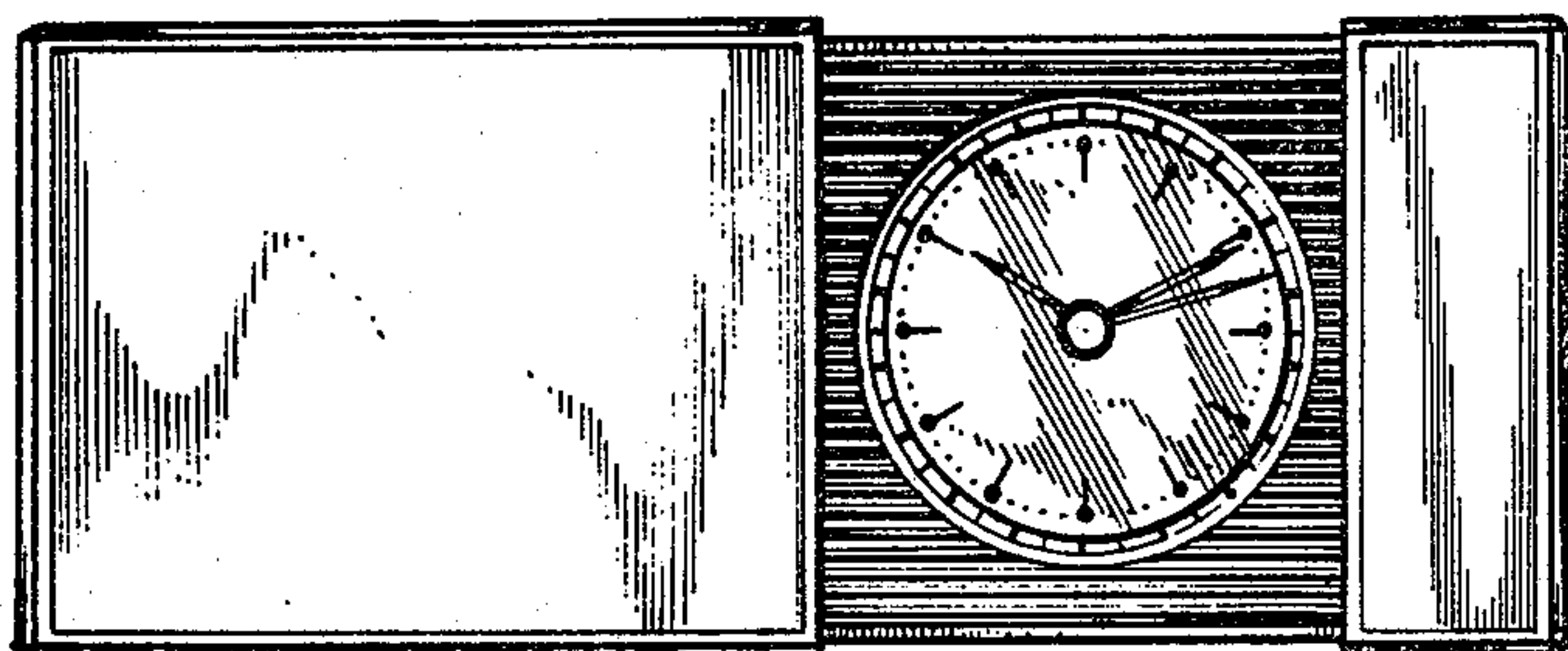

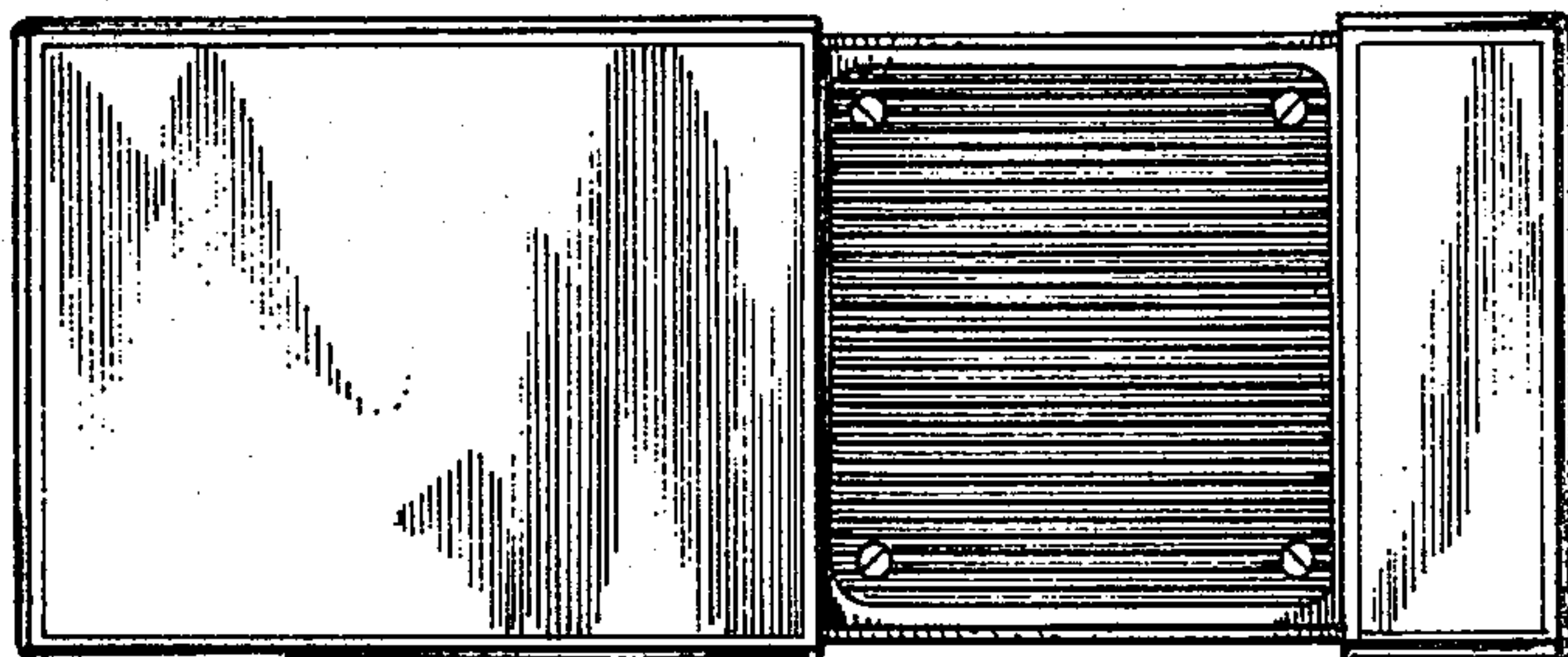
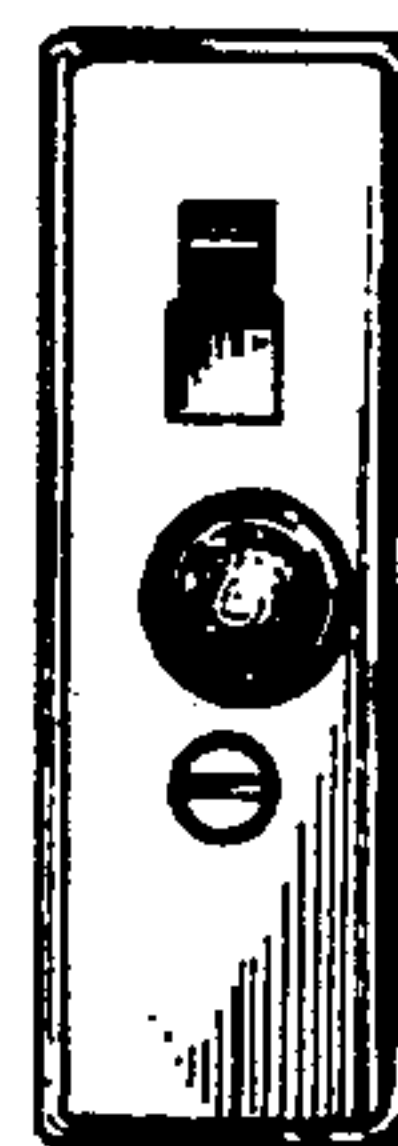
