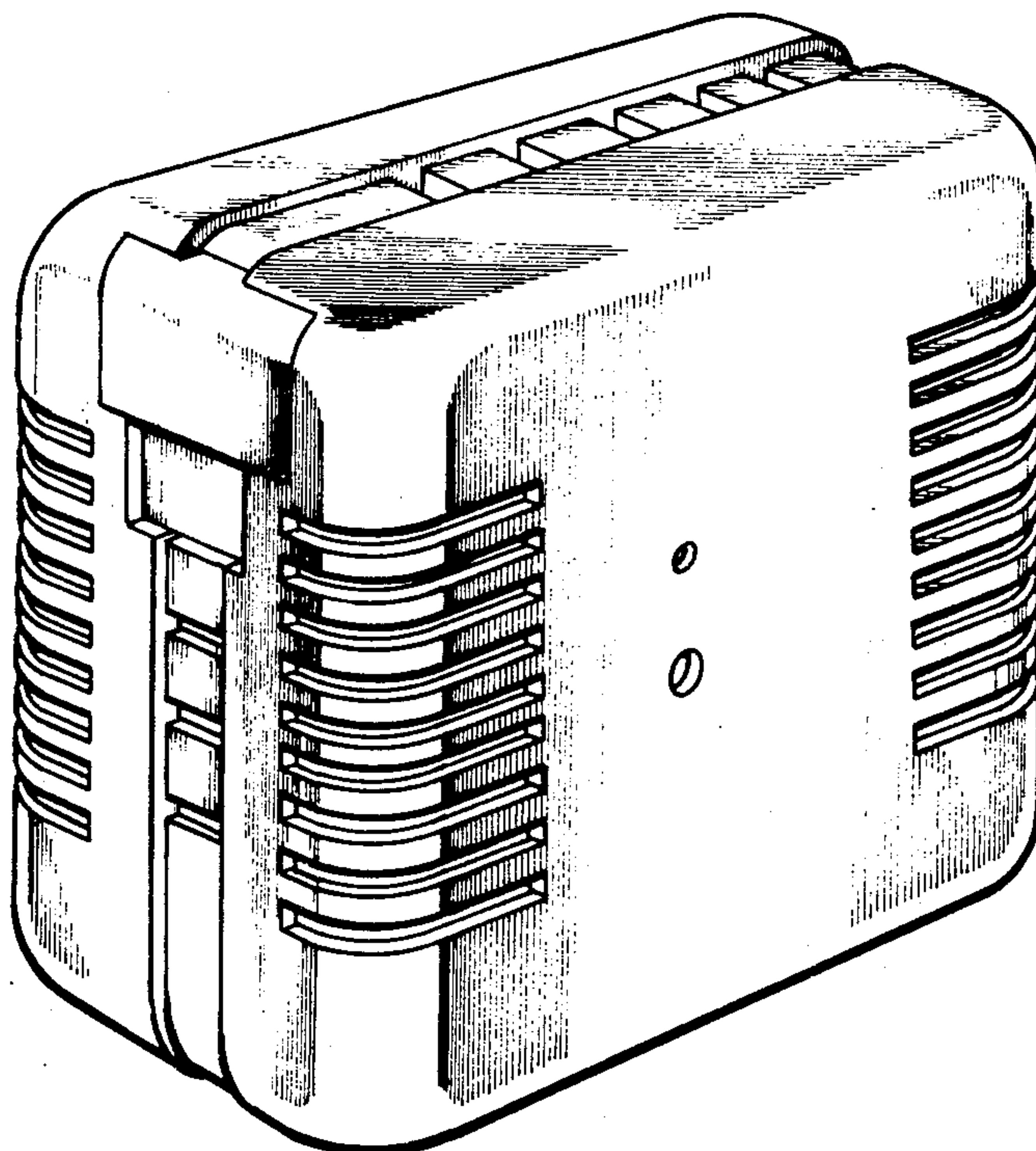

The ornamental design for a portable smoke detector or similar article, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a portable smoke detector or similar article showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left-side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a right-side elevational view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.



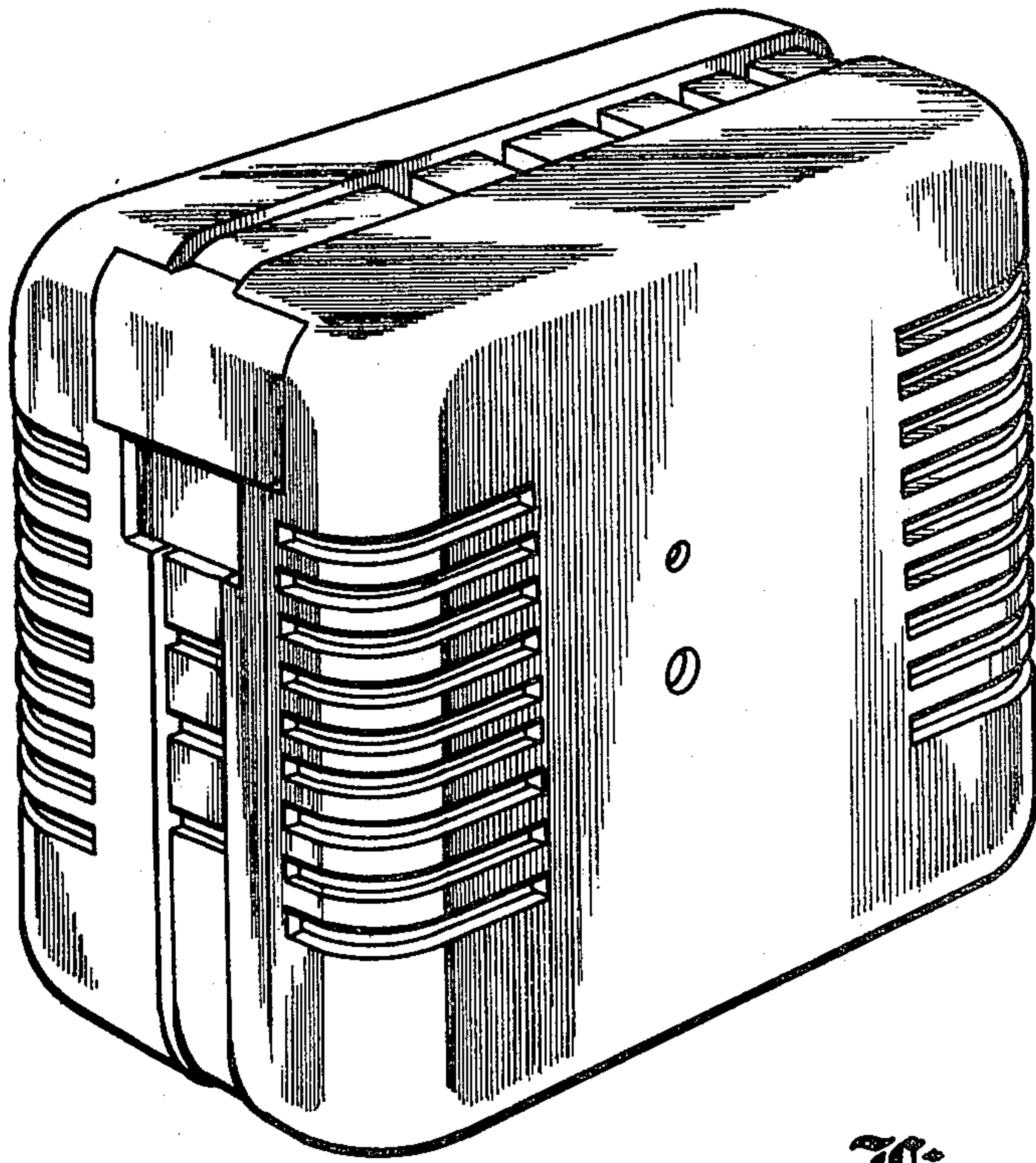

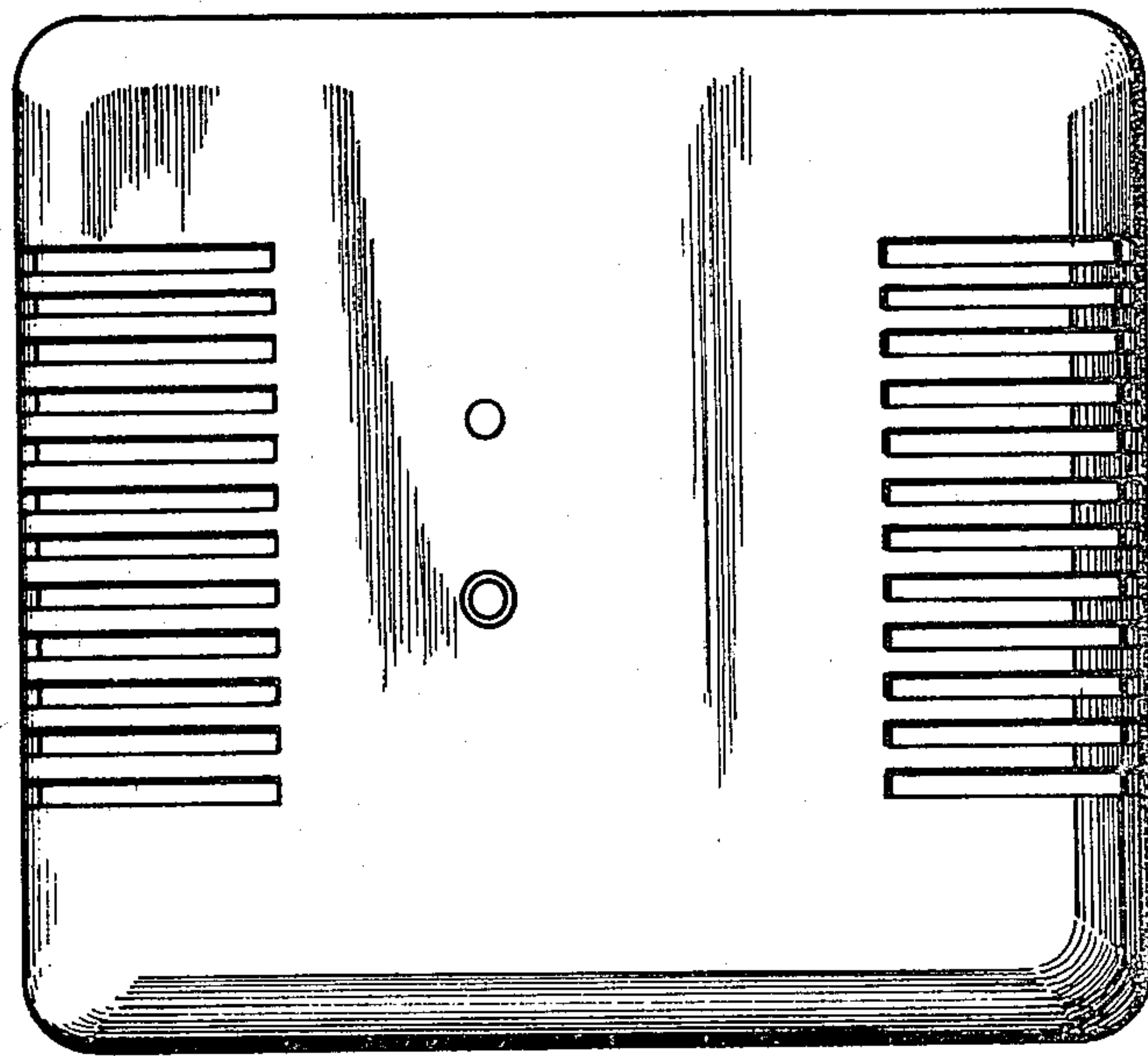

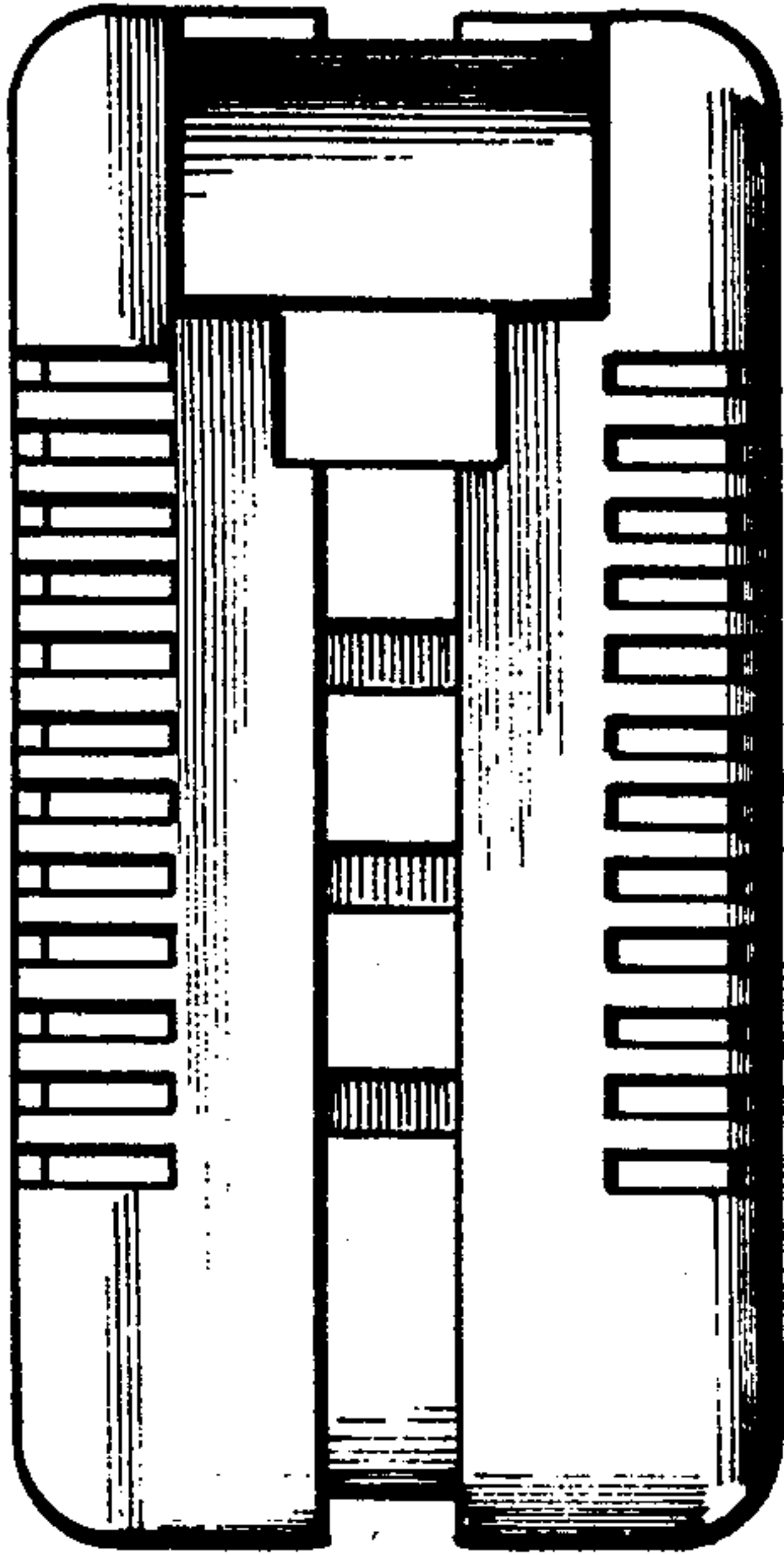

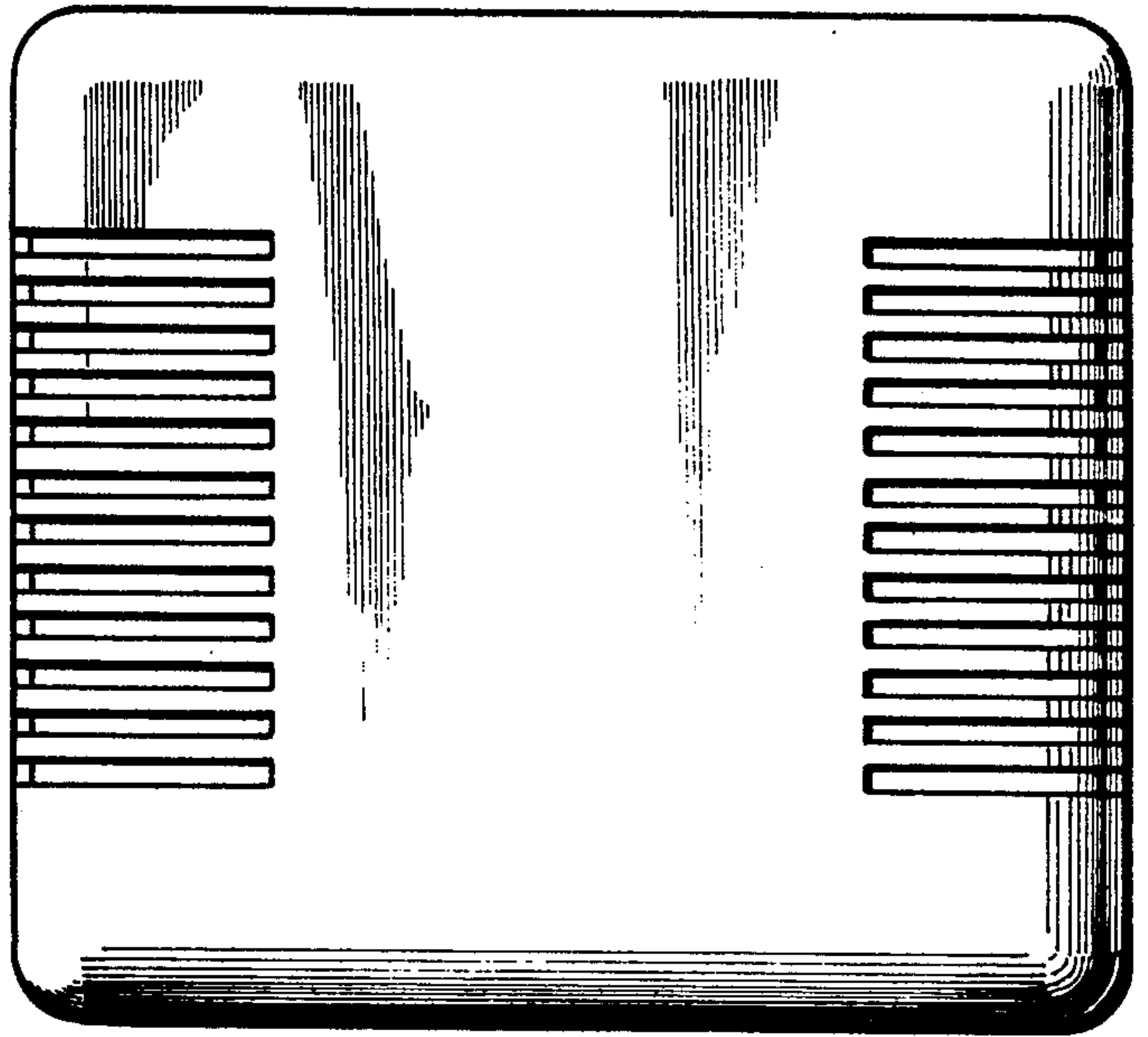

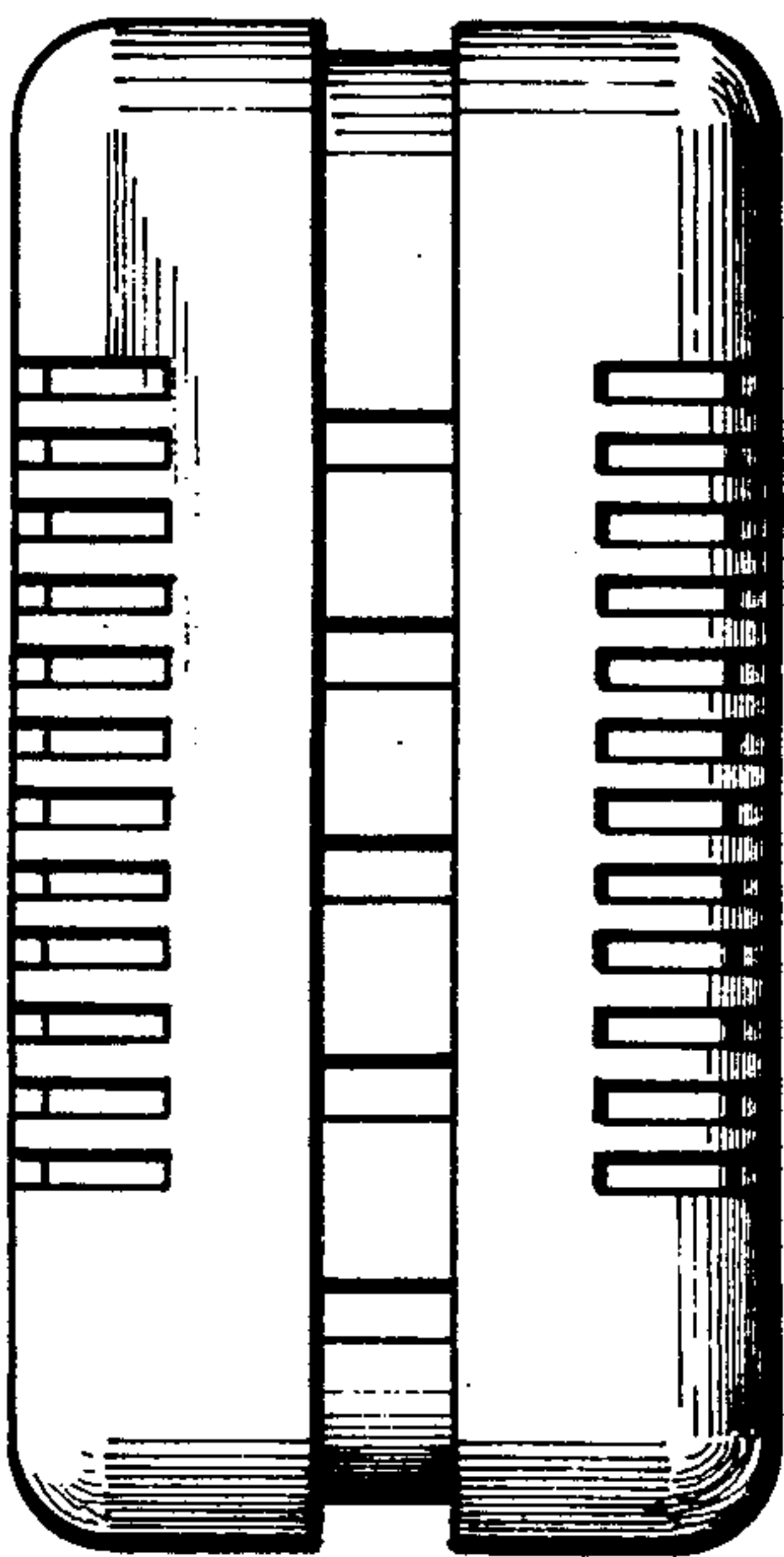

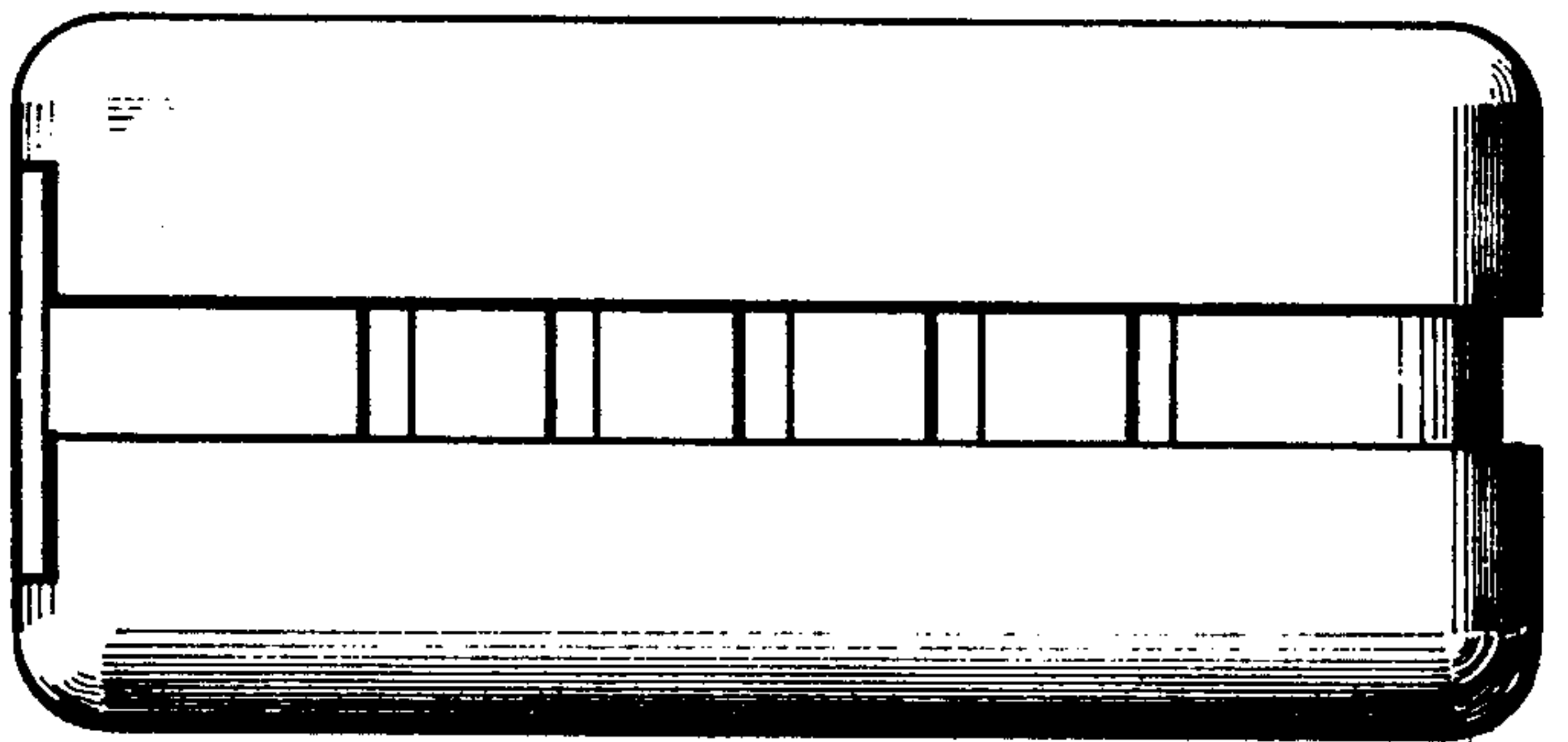

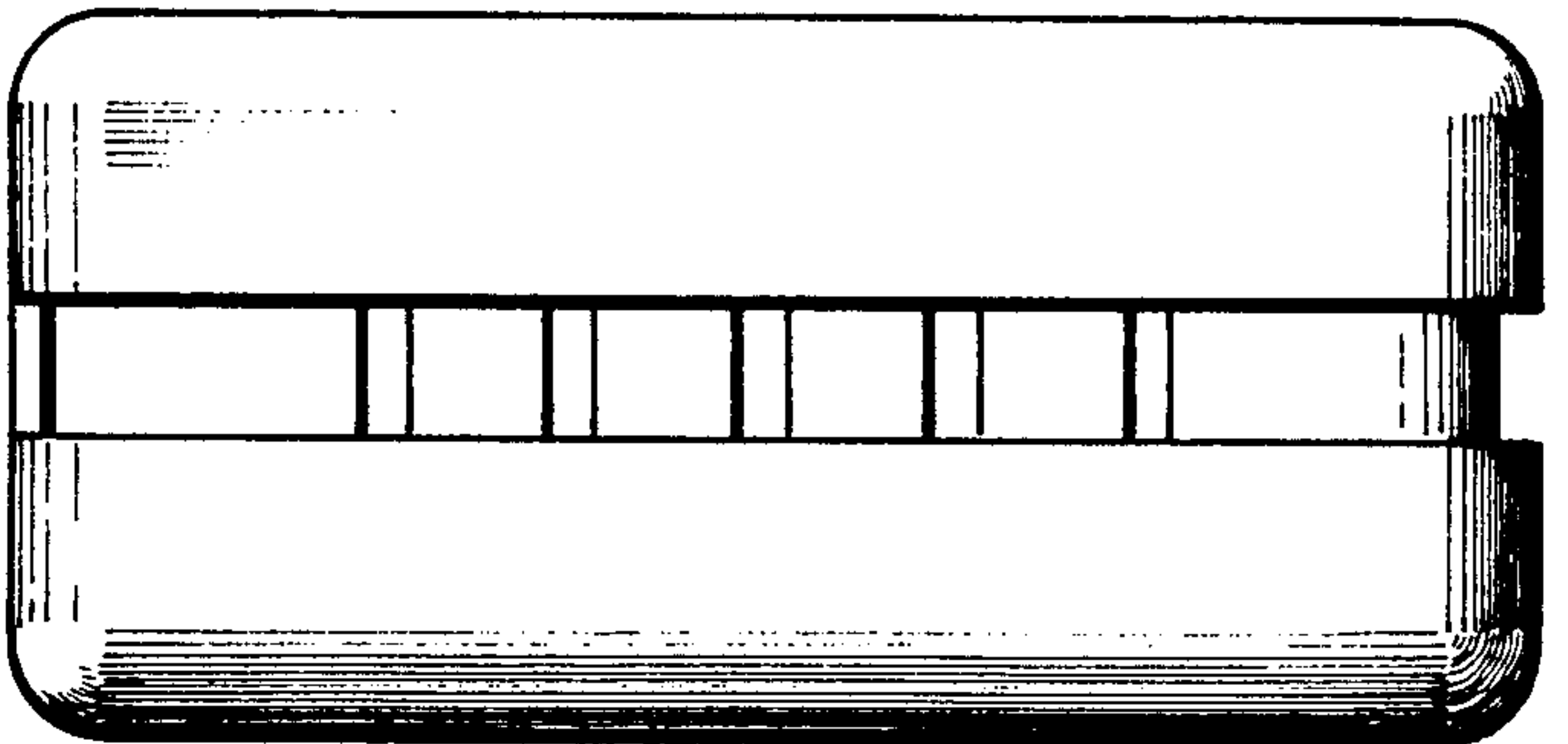
