DESCRIPTION

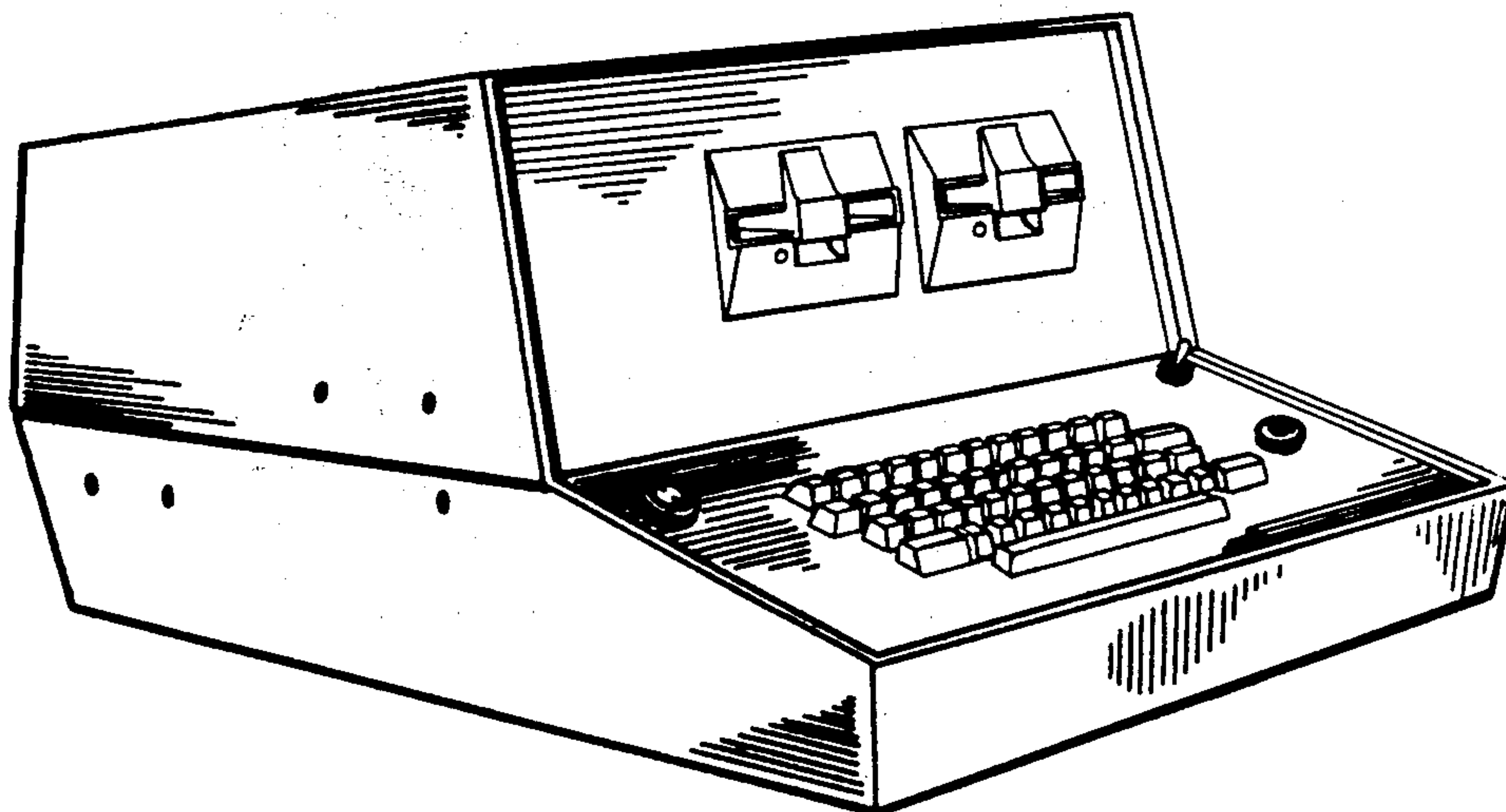
FIG. 1 is a front, right side perspective view of a key-

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



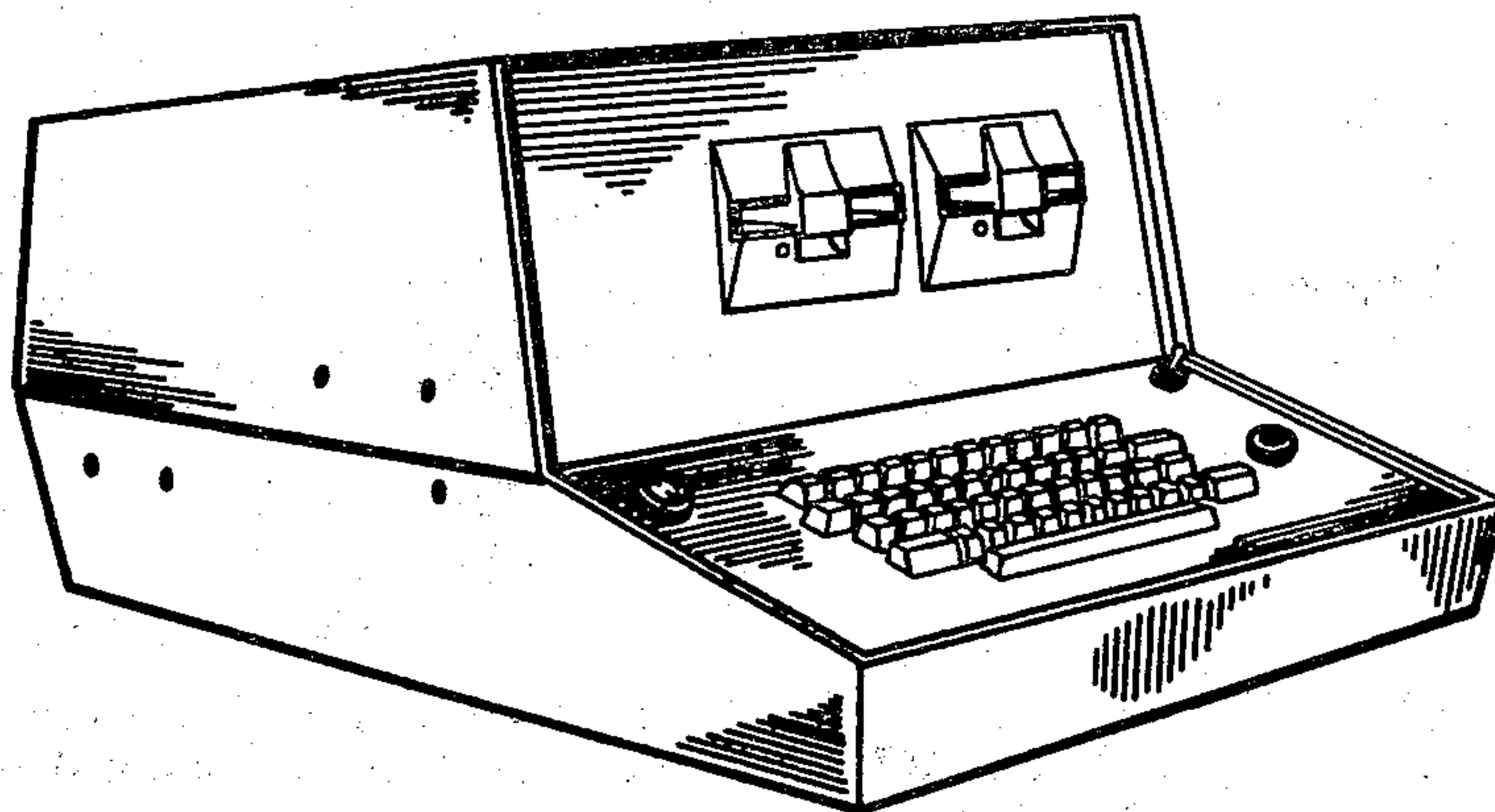

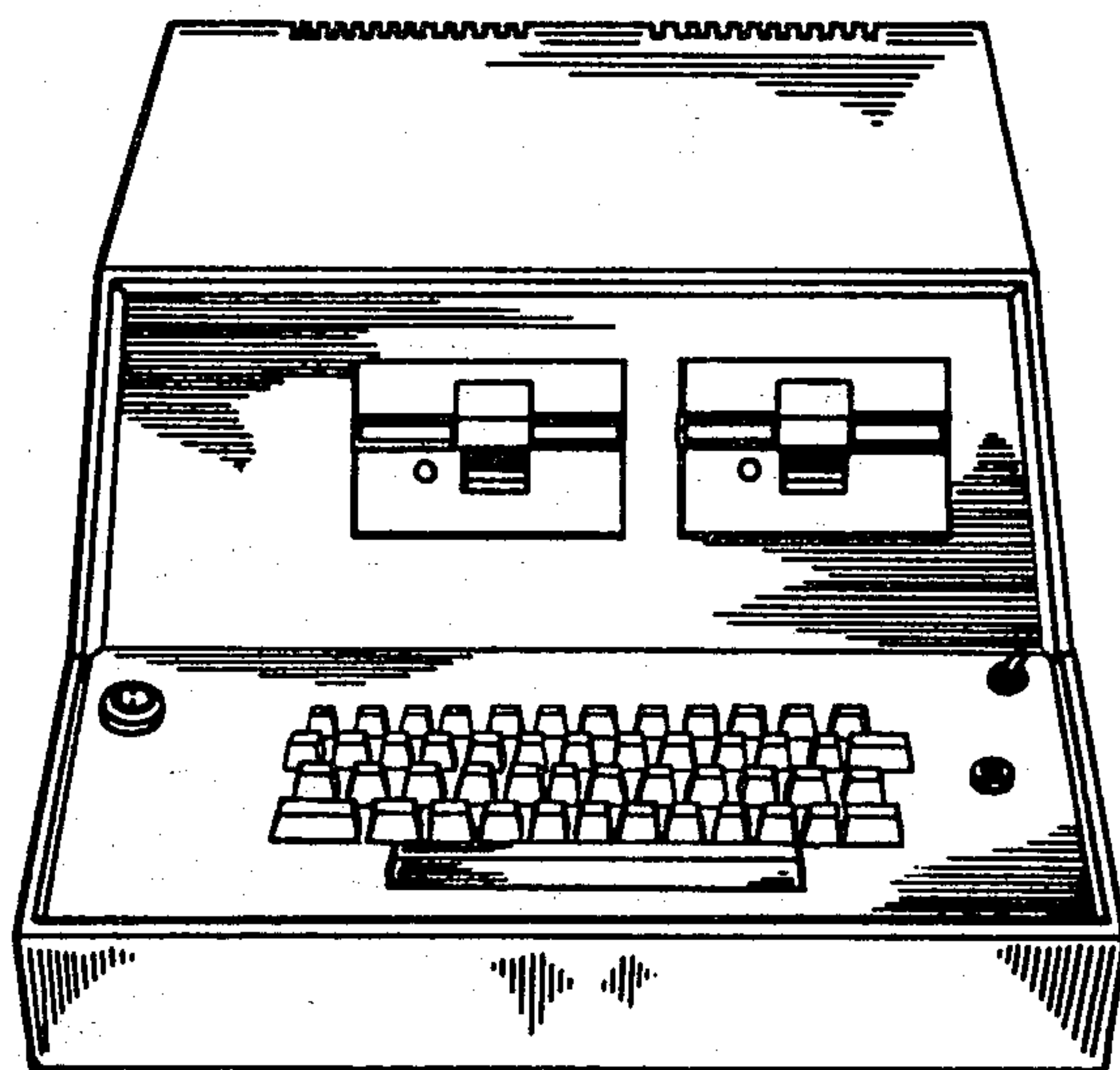

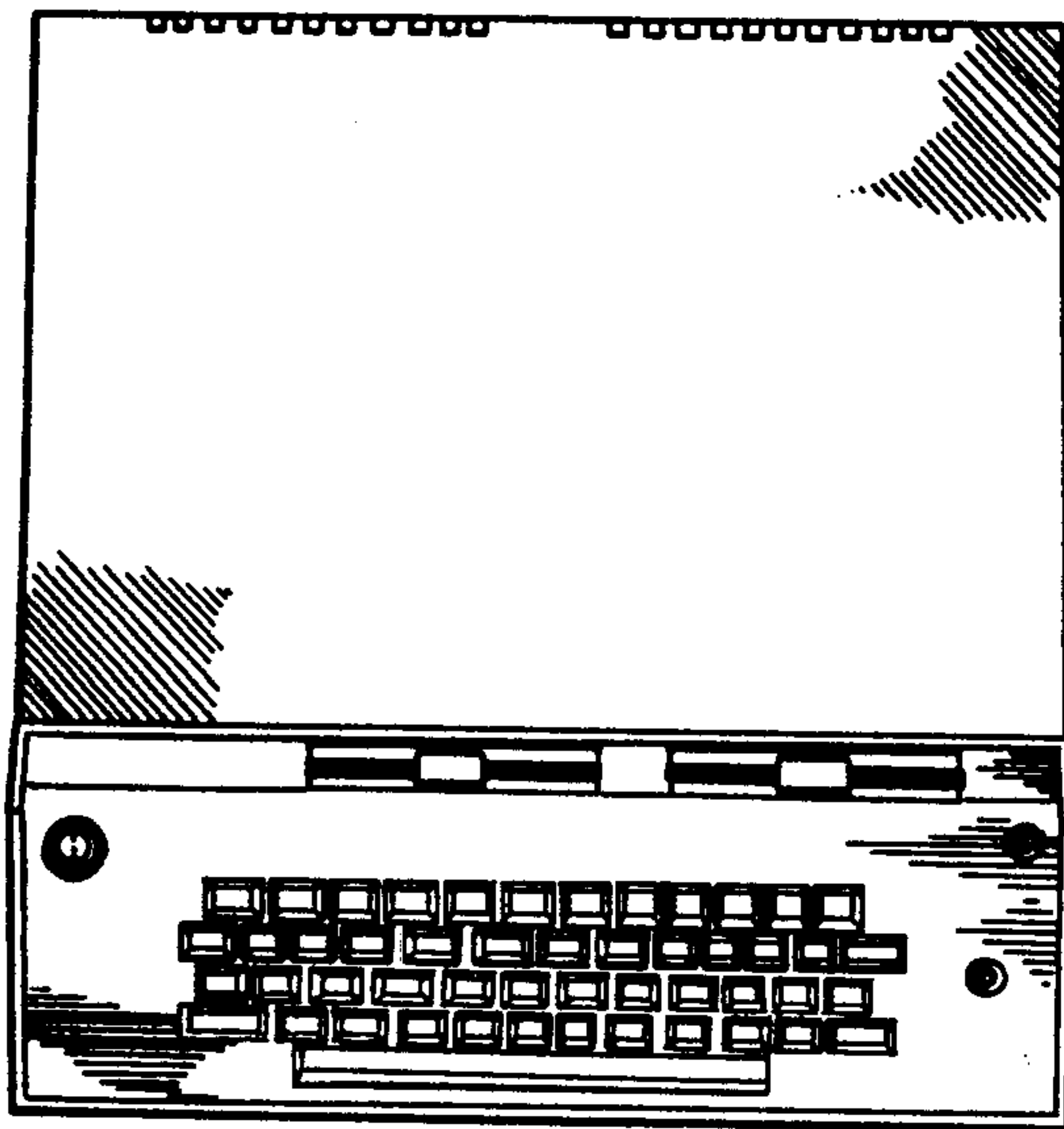

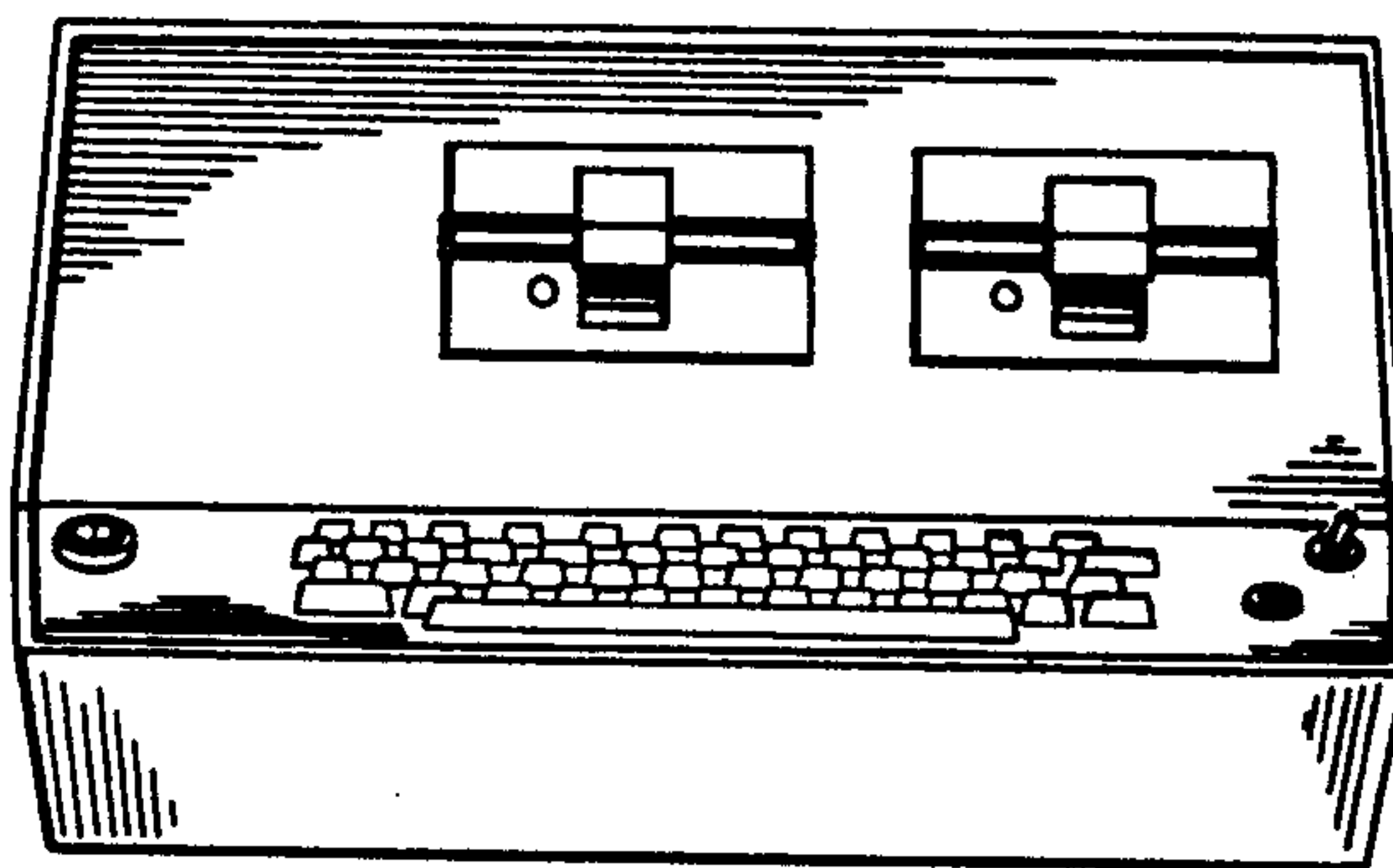

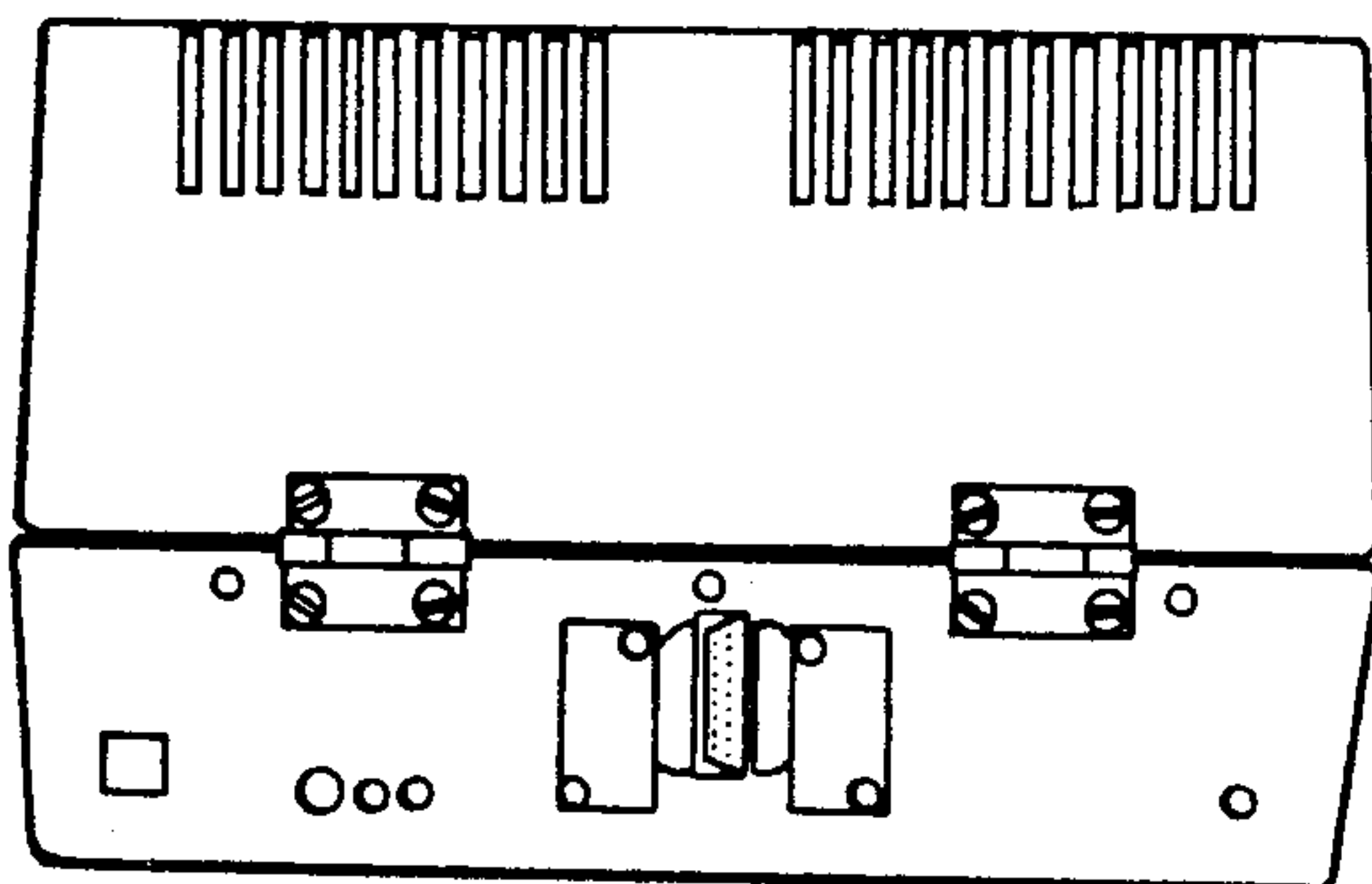
