FIG. 1 is a top plan view of an electronic printer in accordance with my new design;


FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;


FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

FIG. 6 is a left side view thereof.








