DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a sports goggle embodying our new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale.

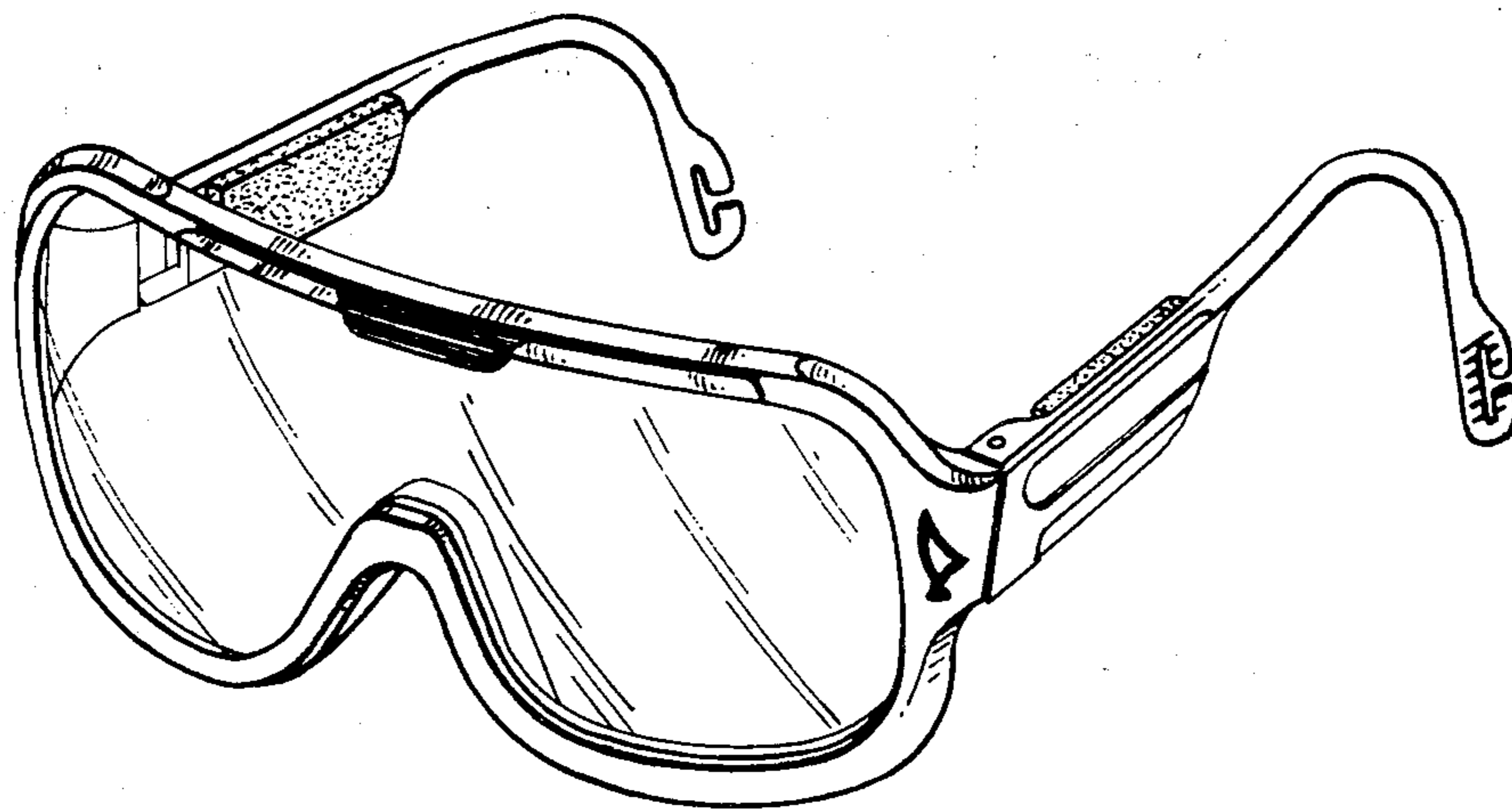

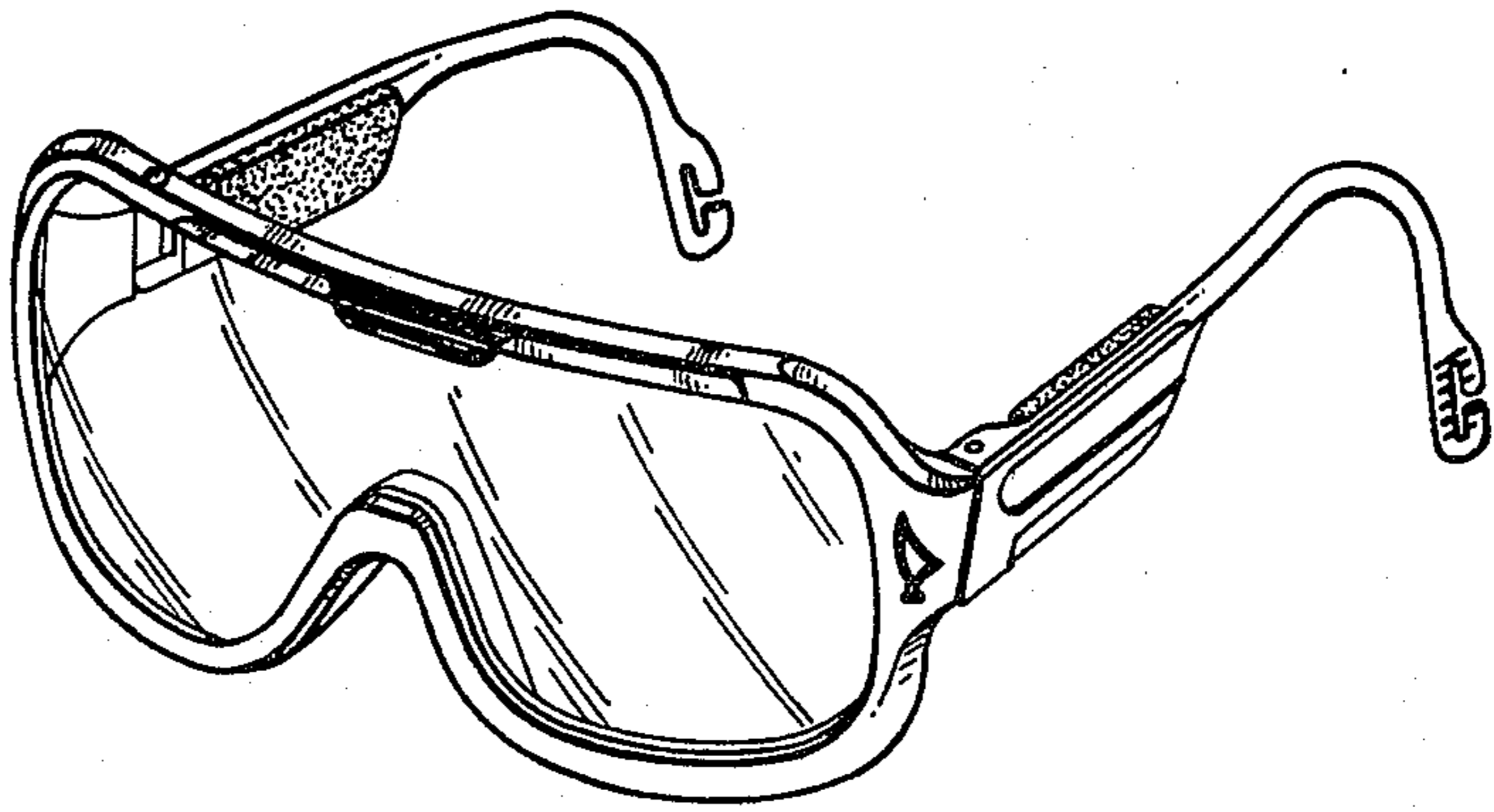

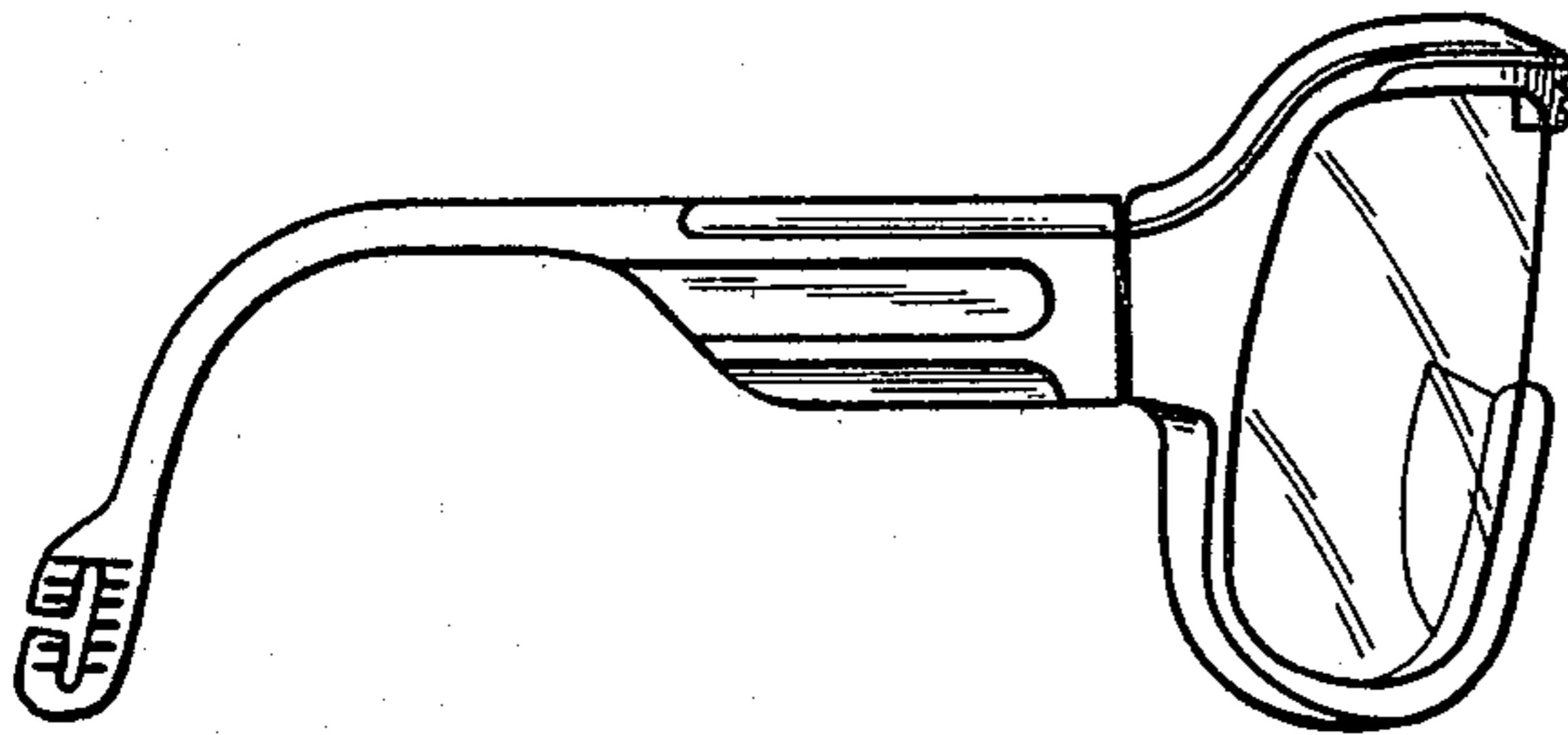

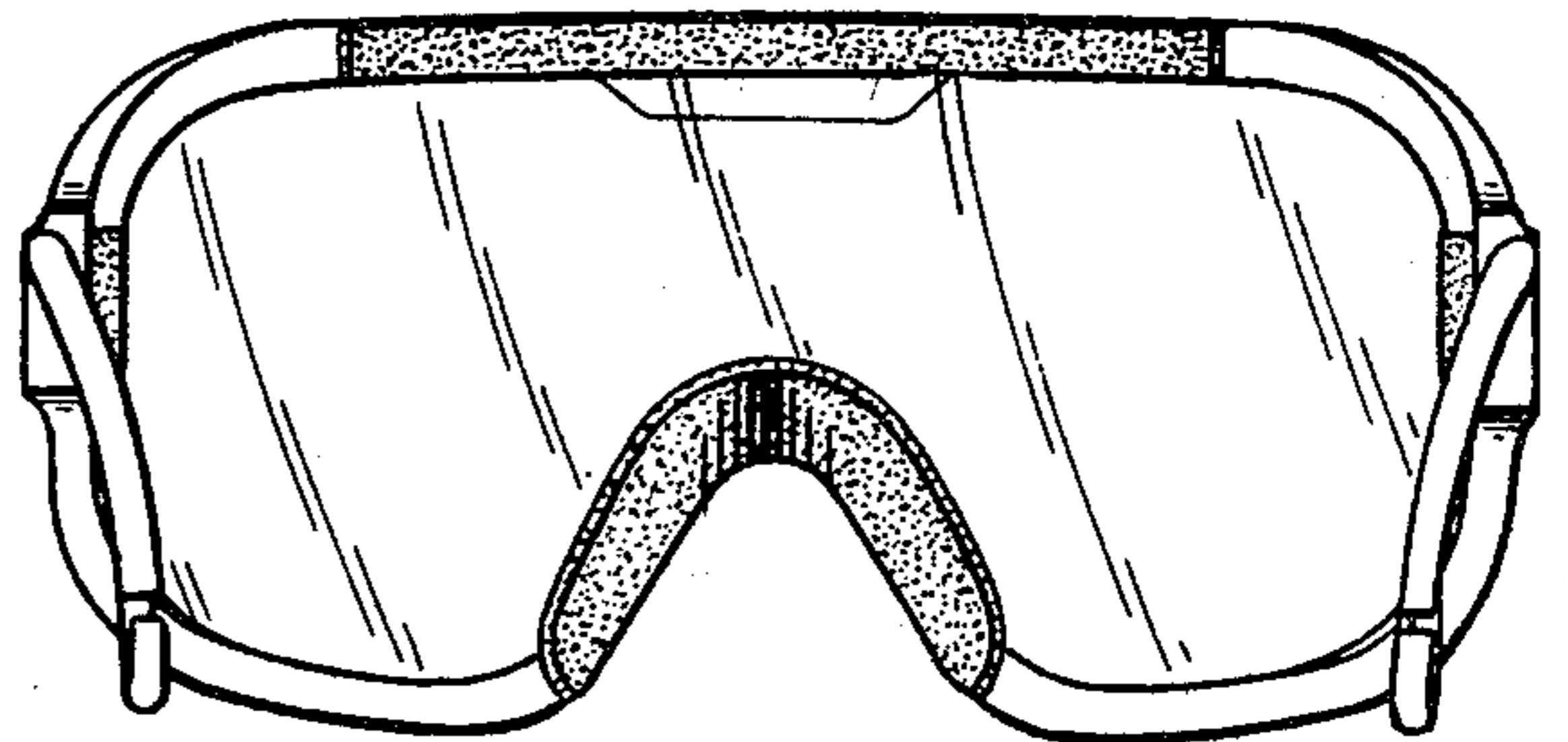

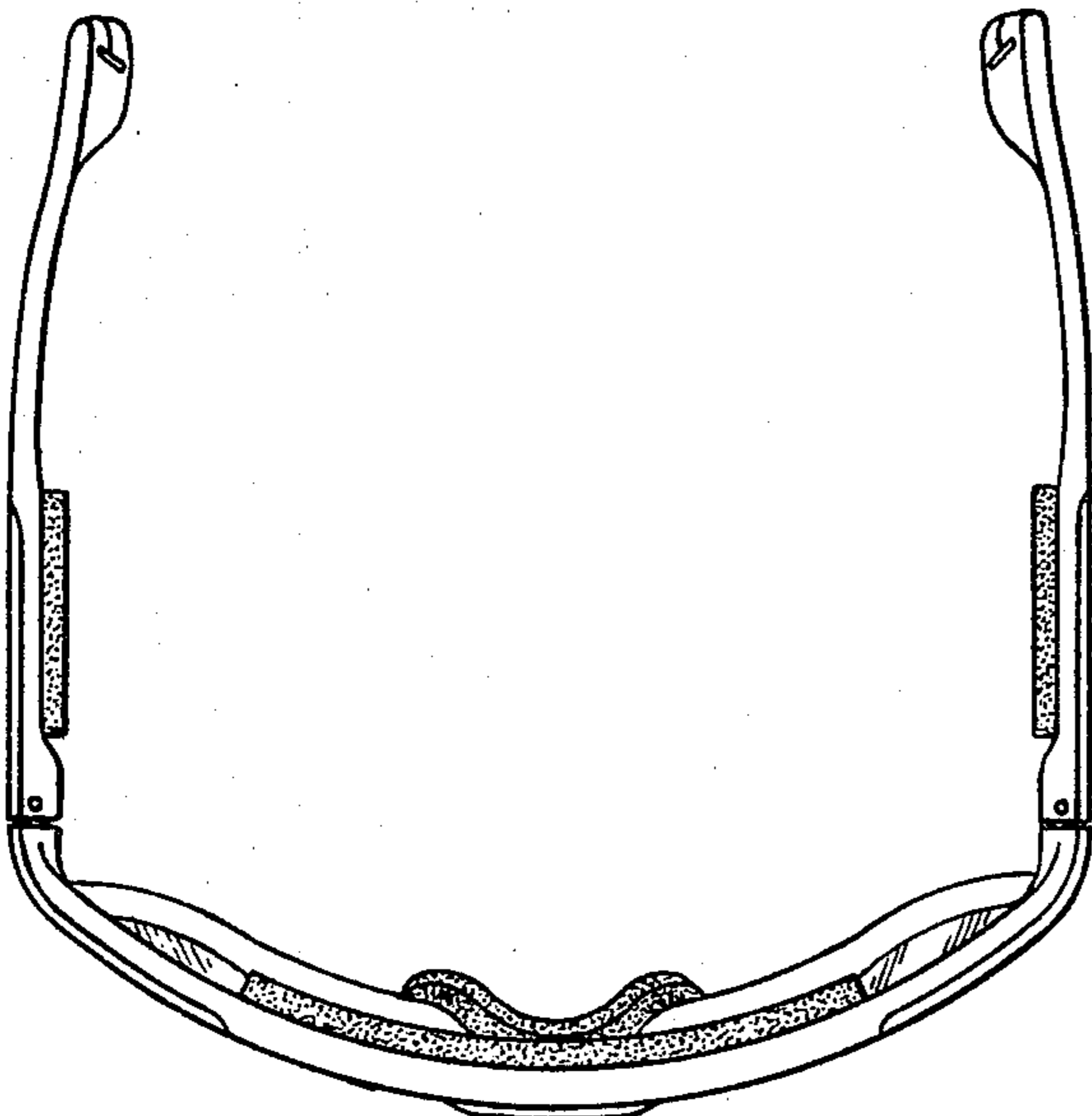
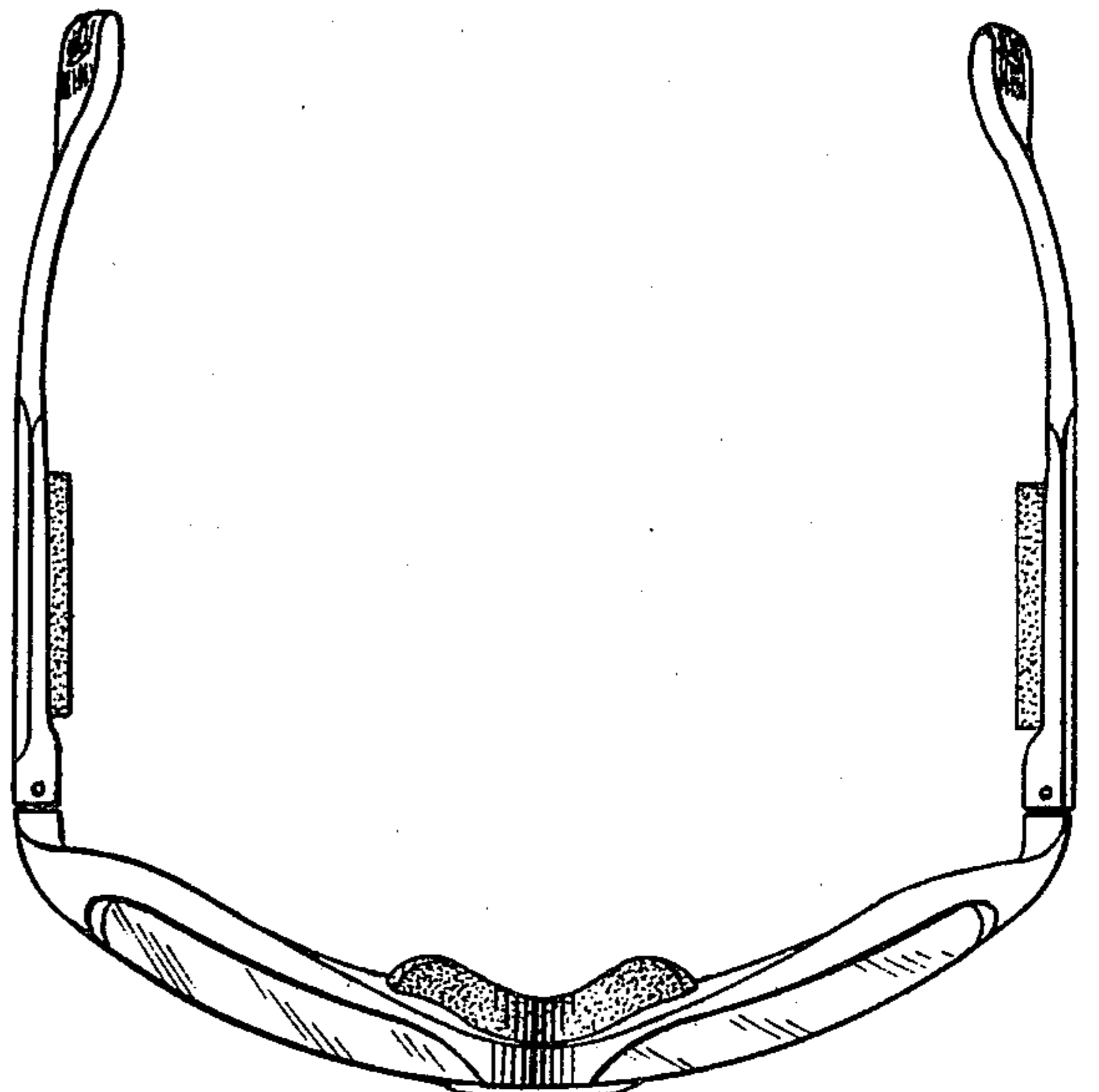

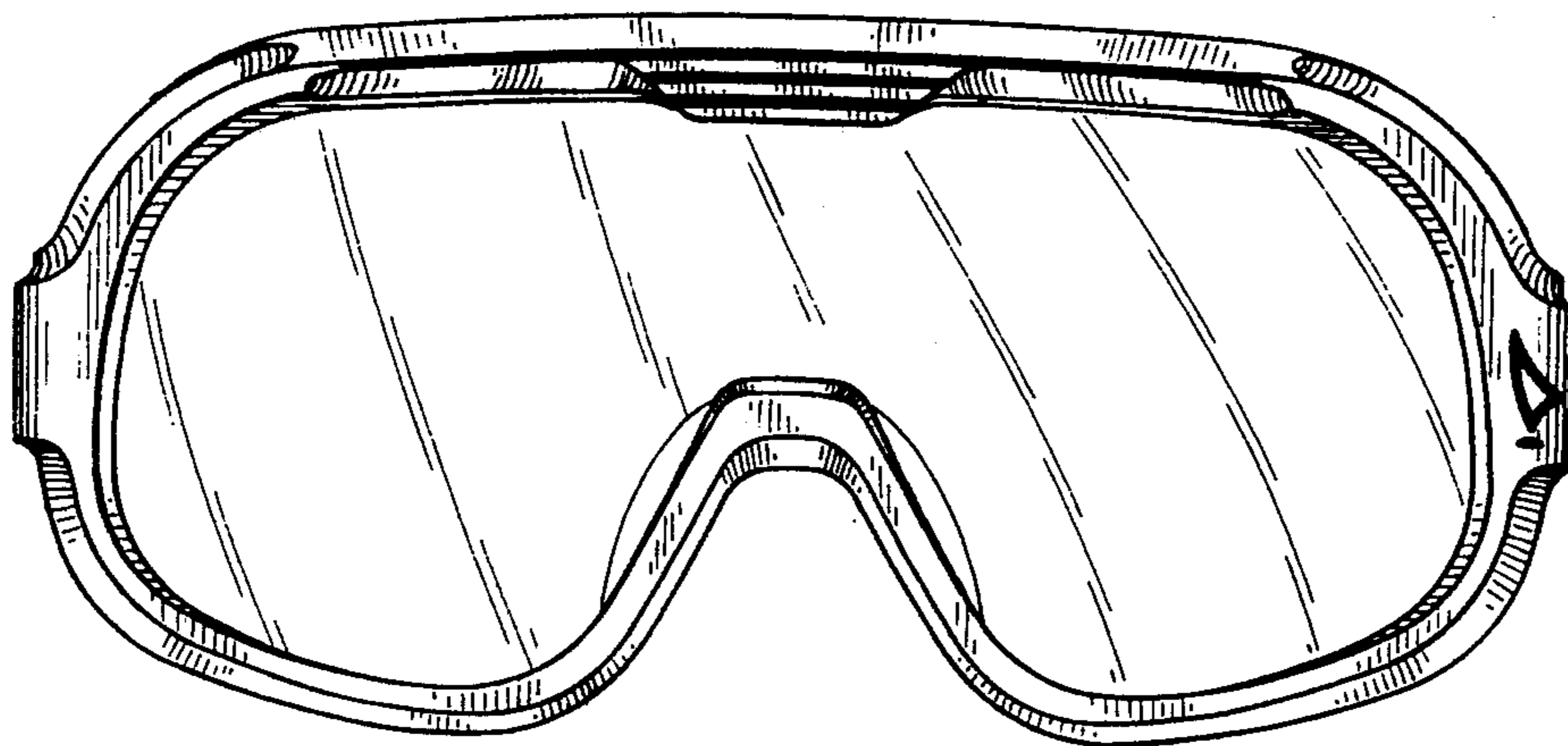
