[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a bathtub wall unit, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bathtub wall unit showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a cross sectional view taken on line 2—2 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is an enlarged front view of the rear panel thereof;

FIG. 4 is a cross section view taken on line 4—4 of FIG. 3;

FIG. 5 is a cross section view taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 3;

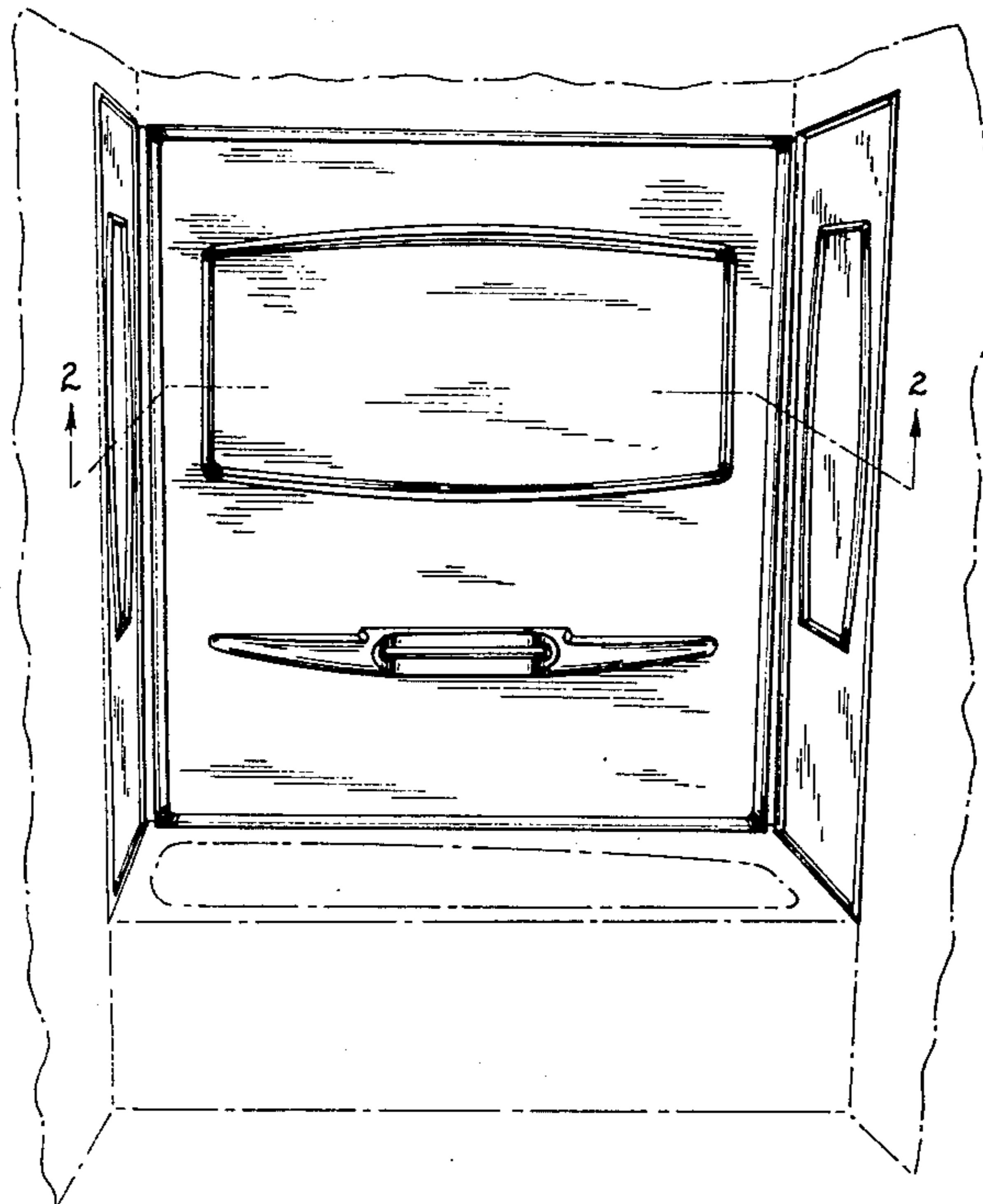
FIG. 6 is a cross section view taken on line 6—6 of FIG. 3;

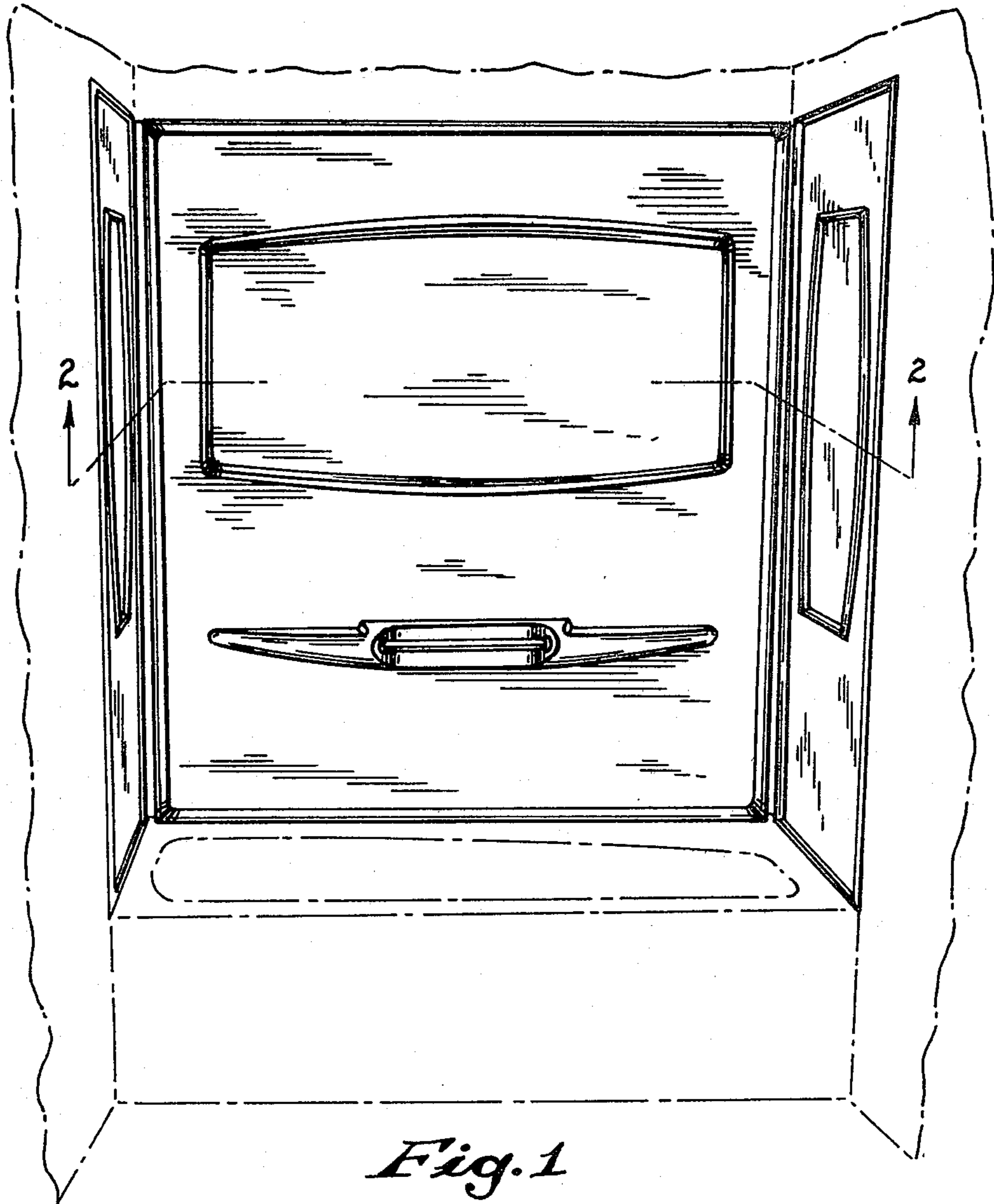
FIG. 7 is a fragmentary sectional view taken on line 7—7 of FIG. 3;

FIG. 8 is an enlarged front view of the right side panel thereof, the left side panel being the same as the right side panel shown; and

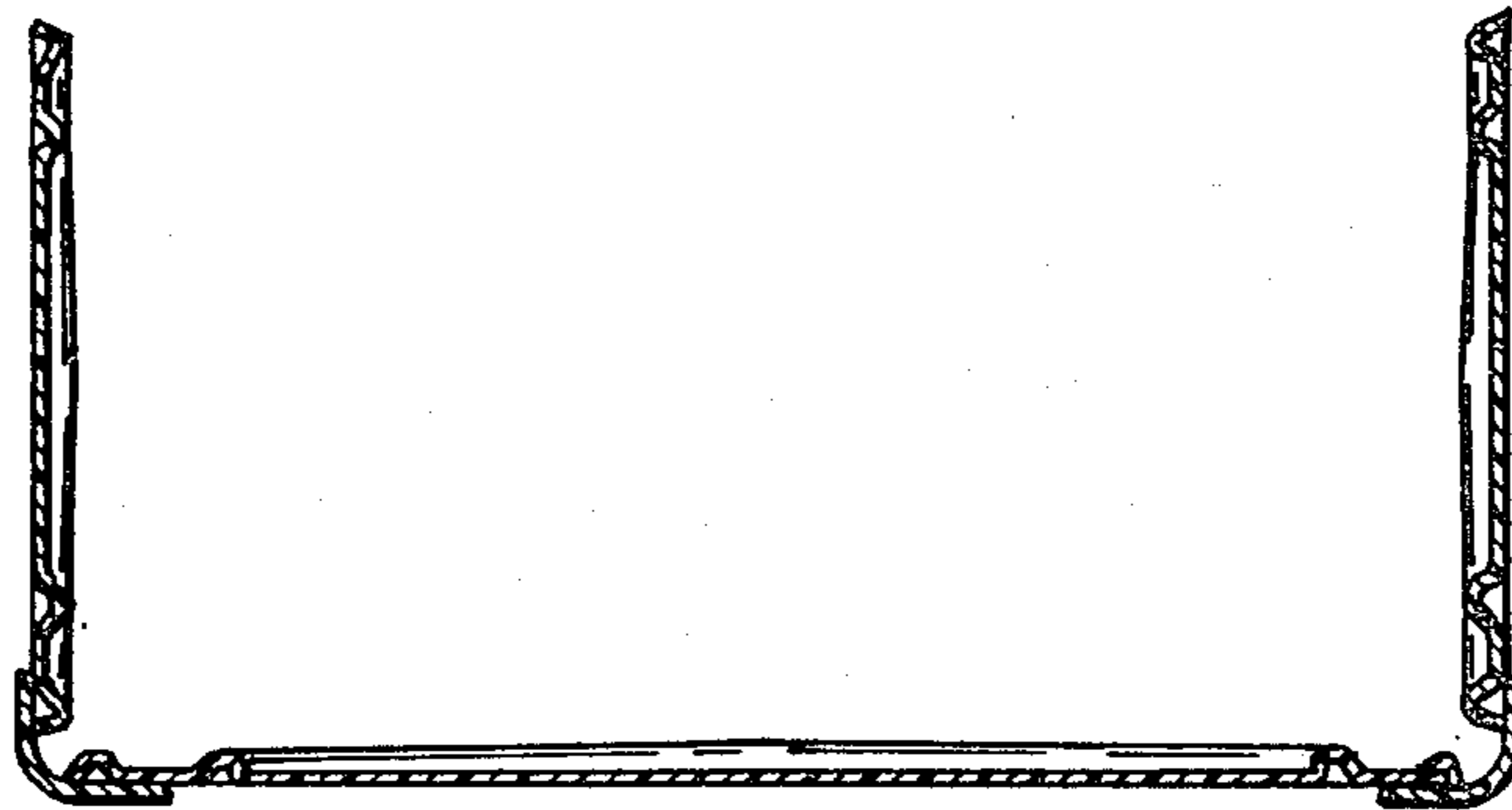
FIG. 9 is a cross sectional view taken on line 9—9 of FIG. 8.

The fragmentary broken line representation of a bathtub and bathroom walls in FIG. 1 is for purposes of illustration only.

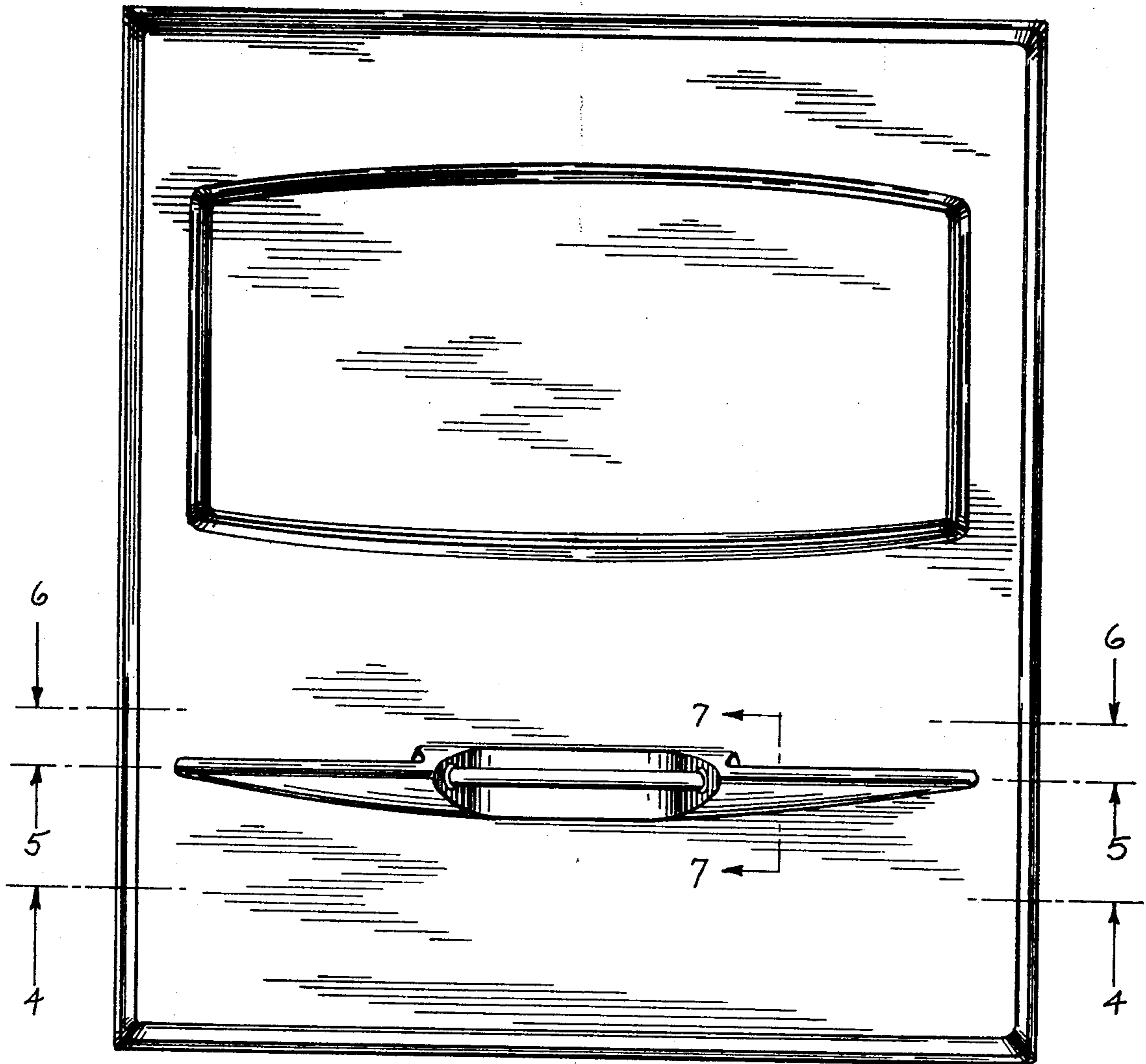

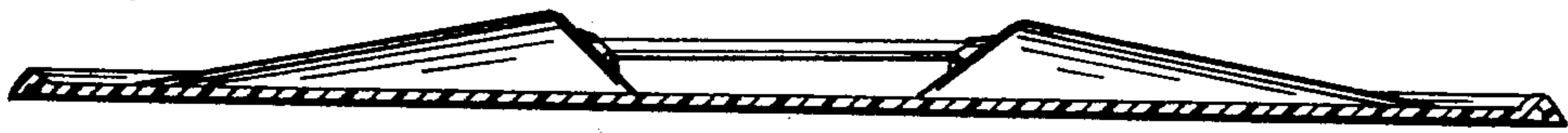

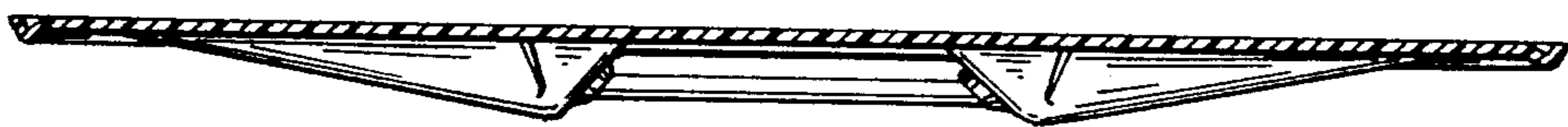
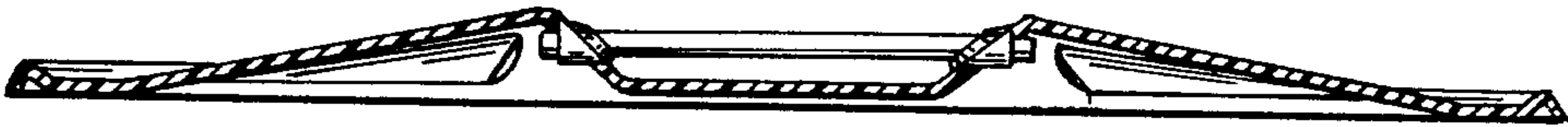

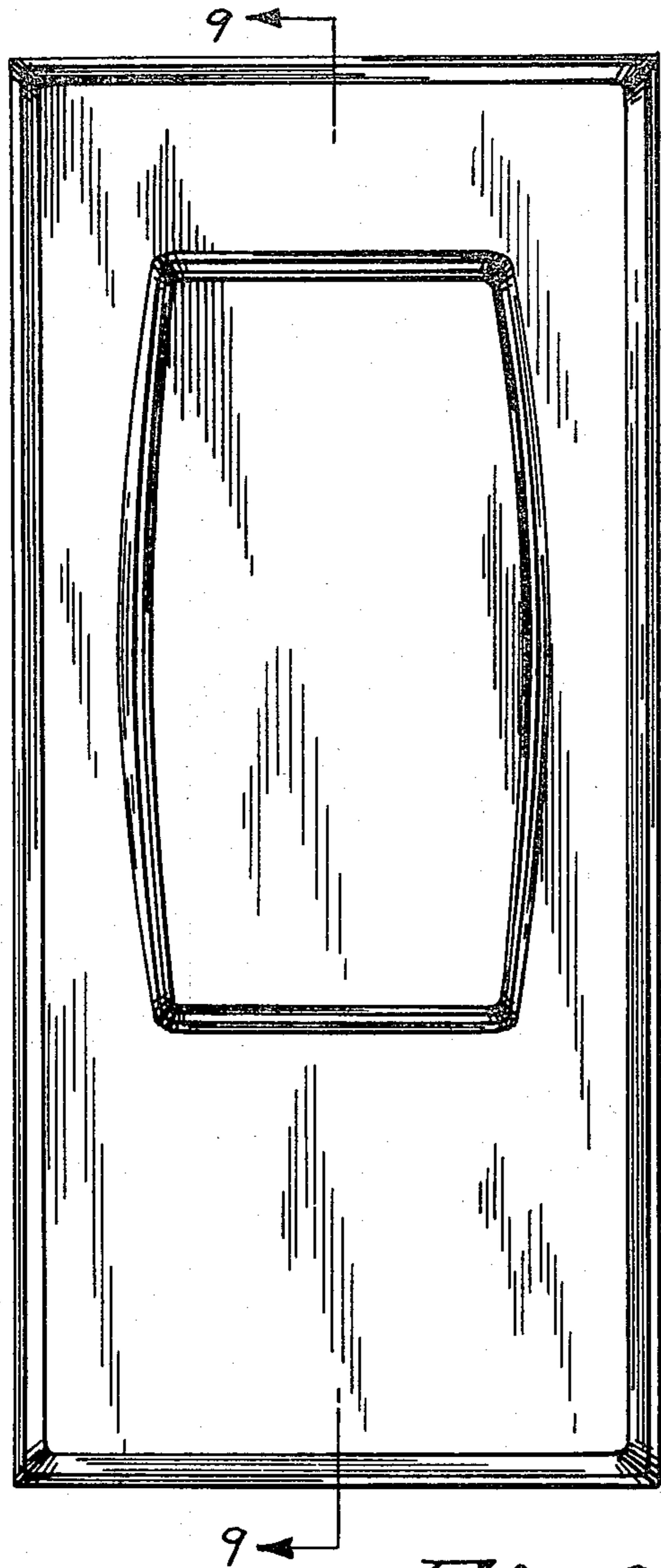

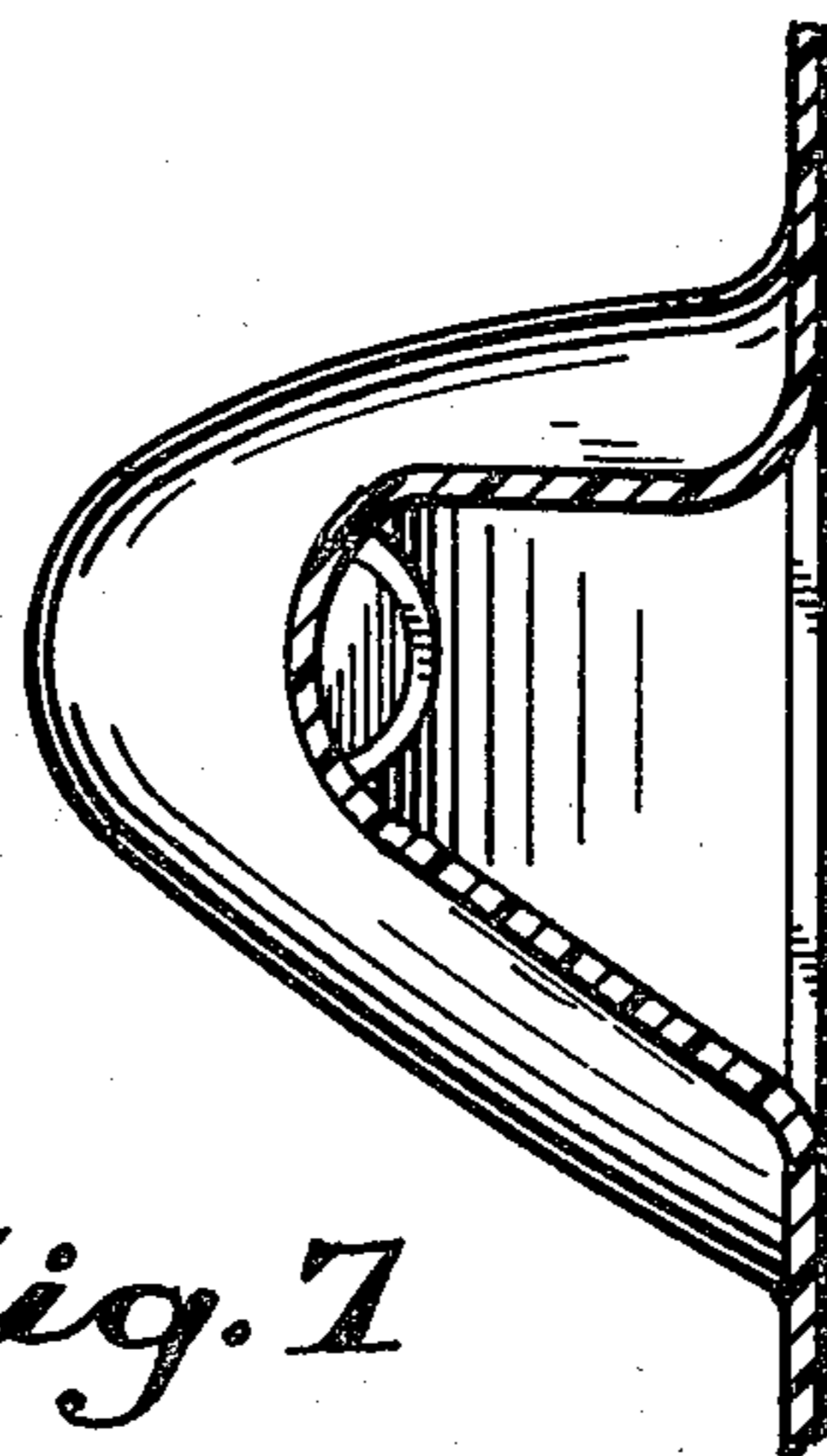
