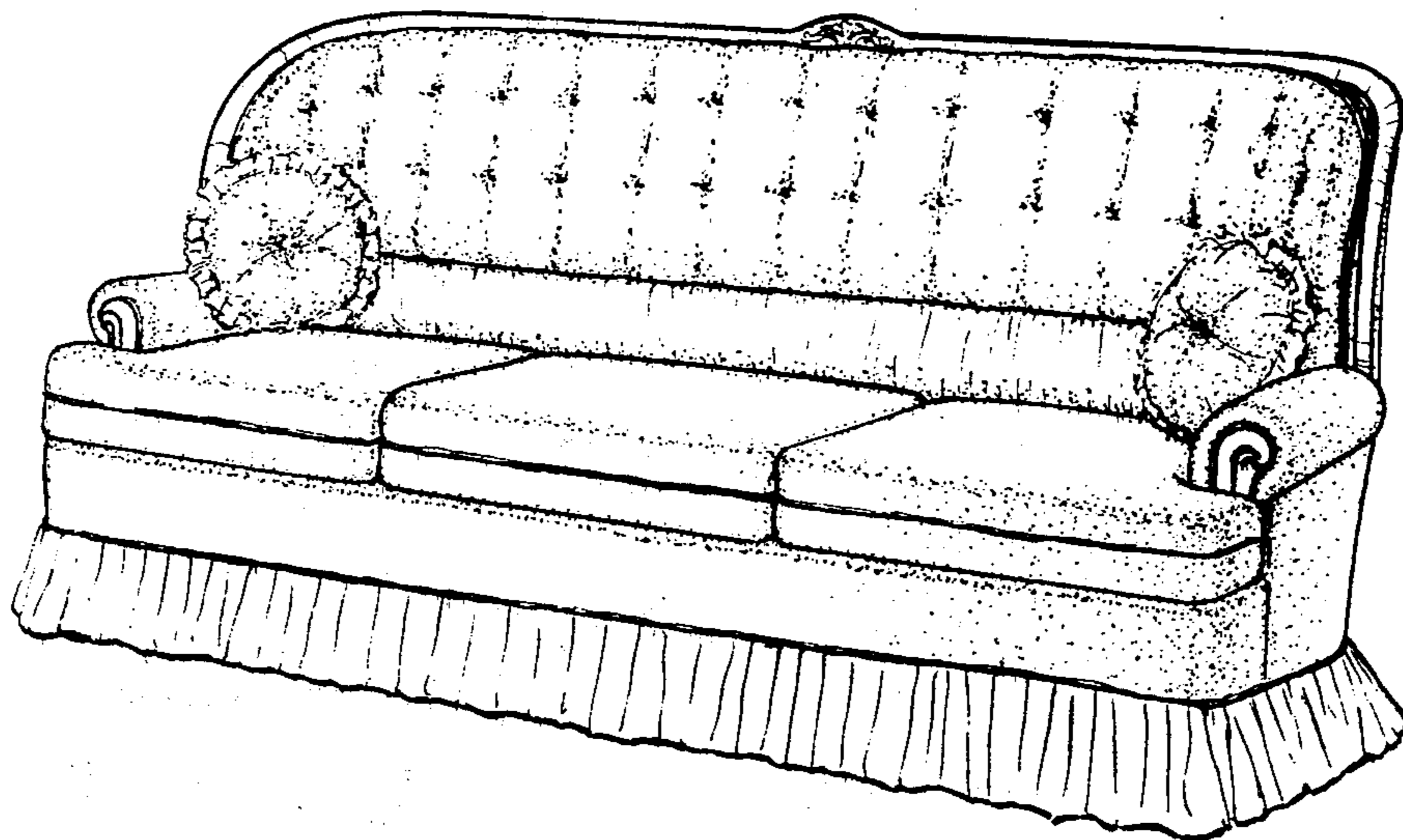

The ornamental design for a seat, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a seat showing my design in the form of a sofa; and
FIG. 2 is a front perspective view of a seat showing my design in the form of a settee.
The rear surface of the seat is conventionally plain and unornamented.



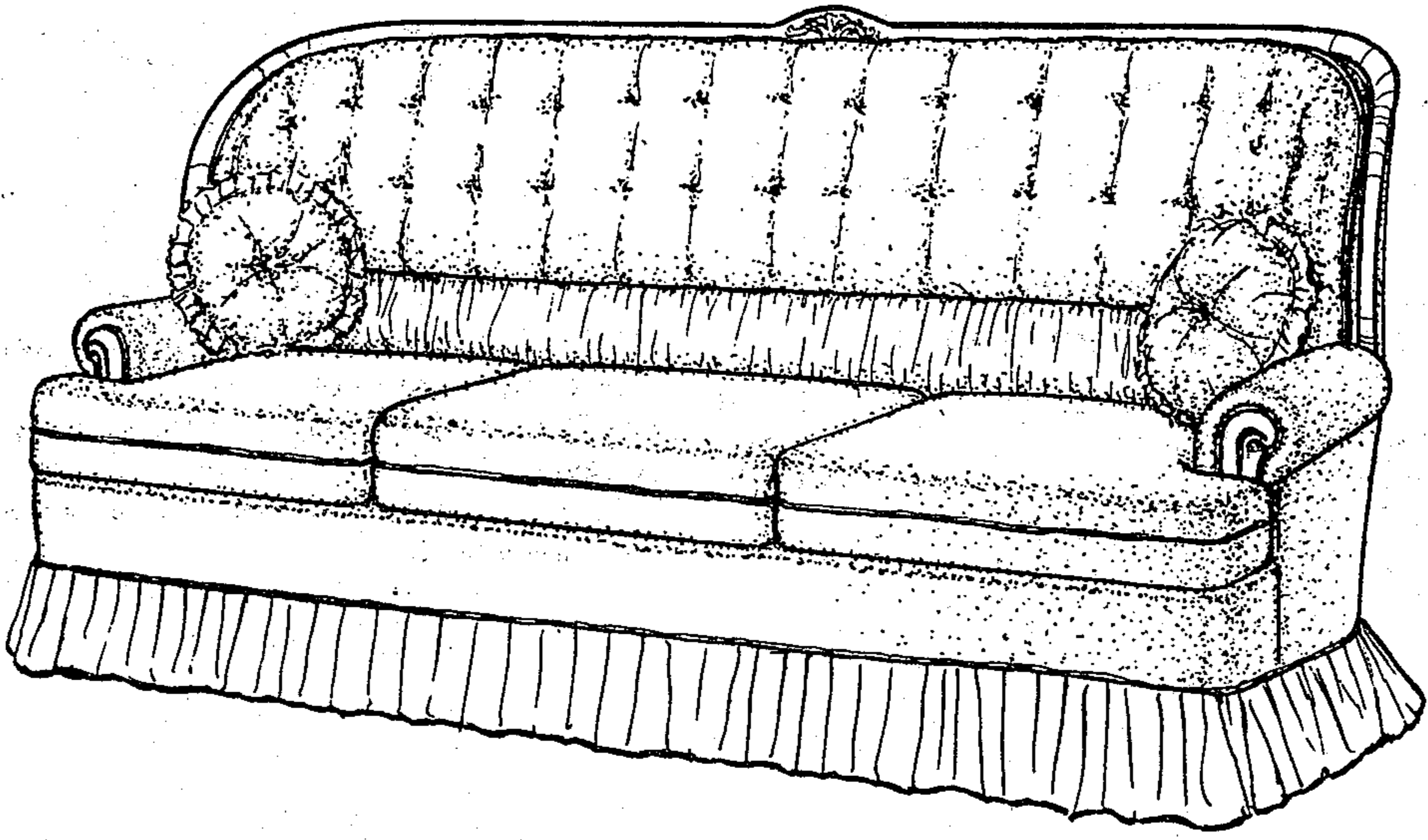

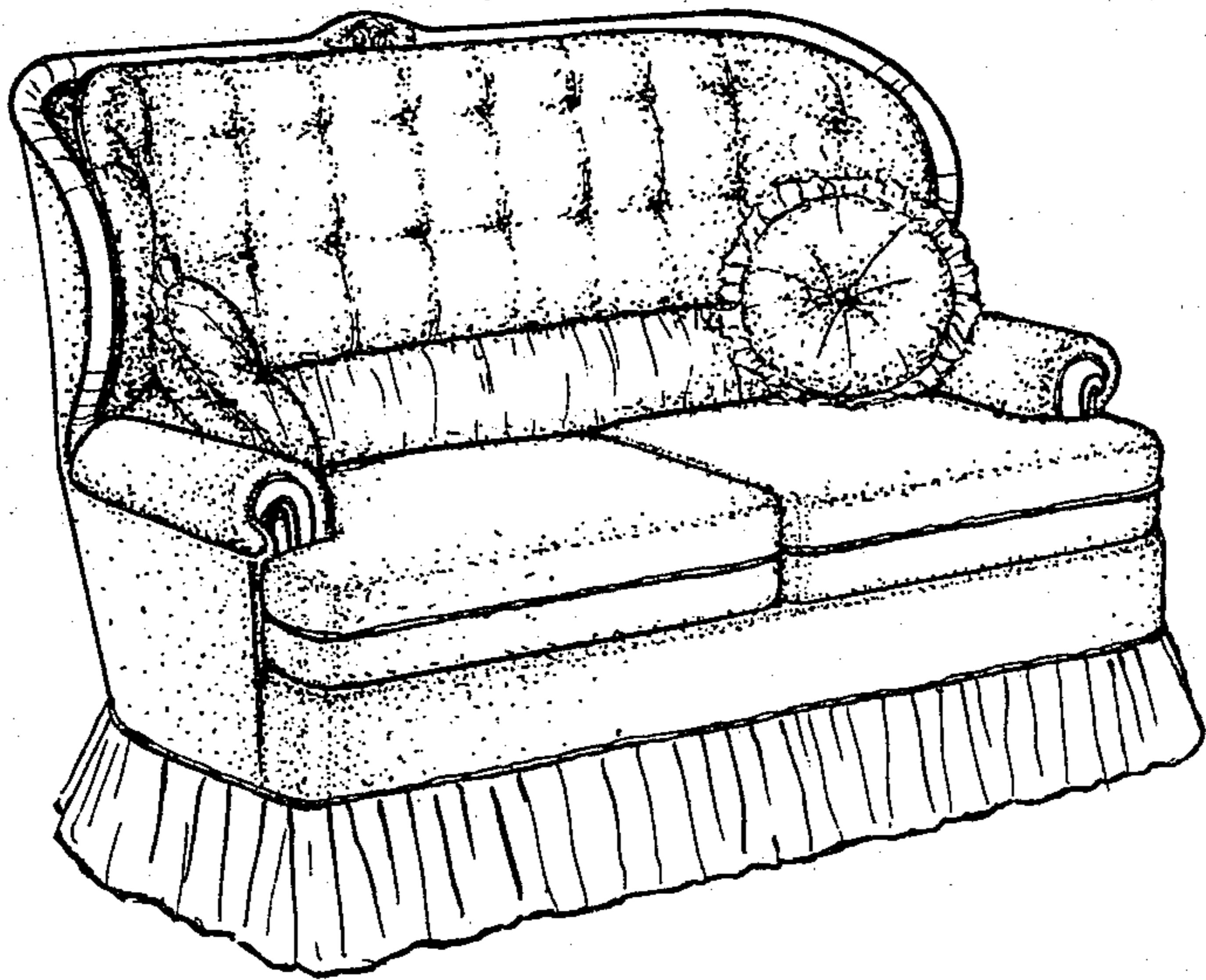
