The ornamental design for a combined microwave base and pan for pizza maker, as shown.

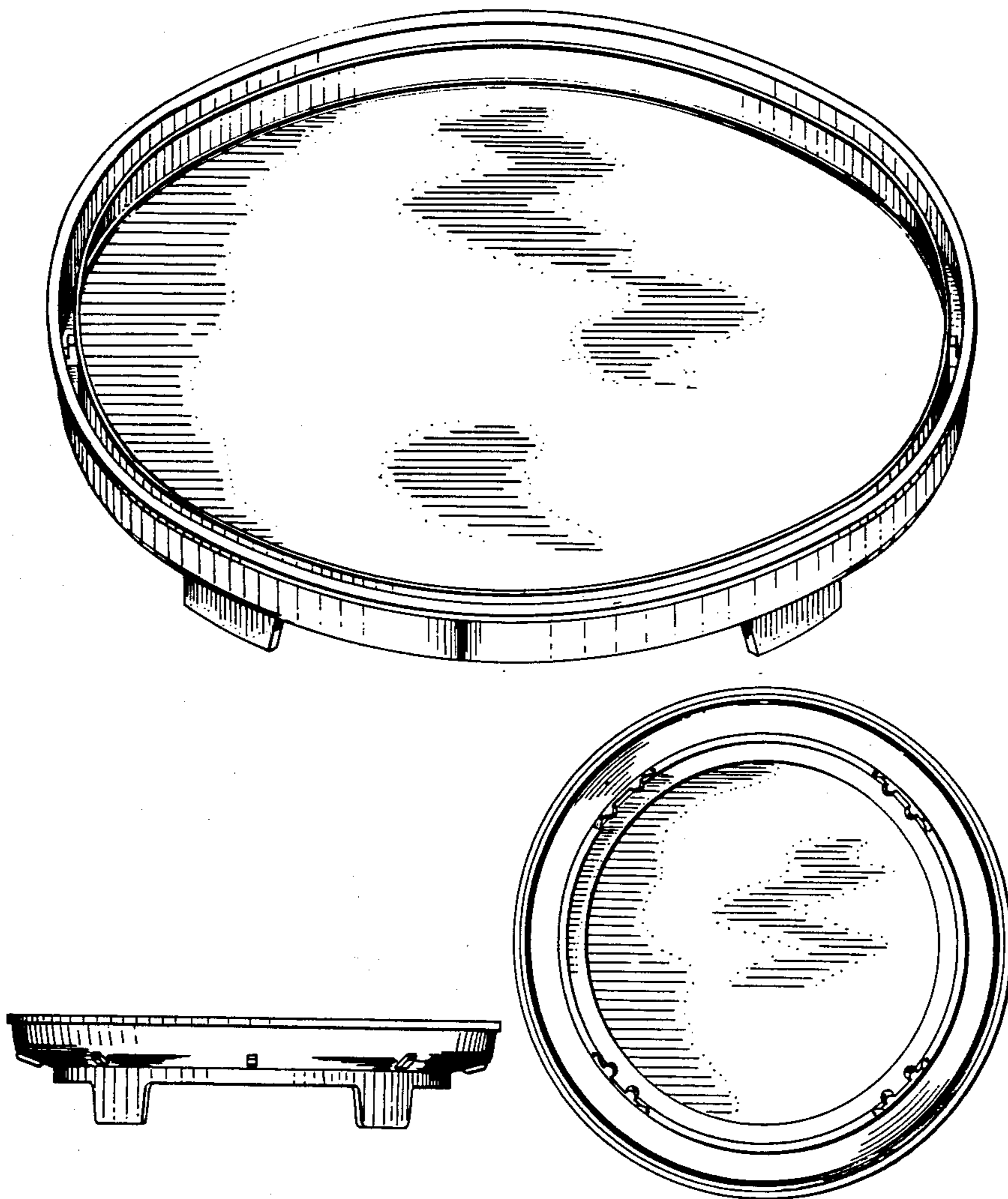
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



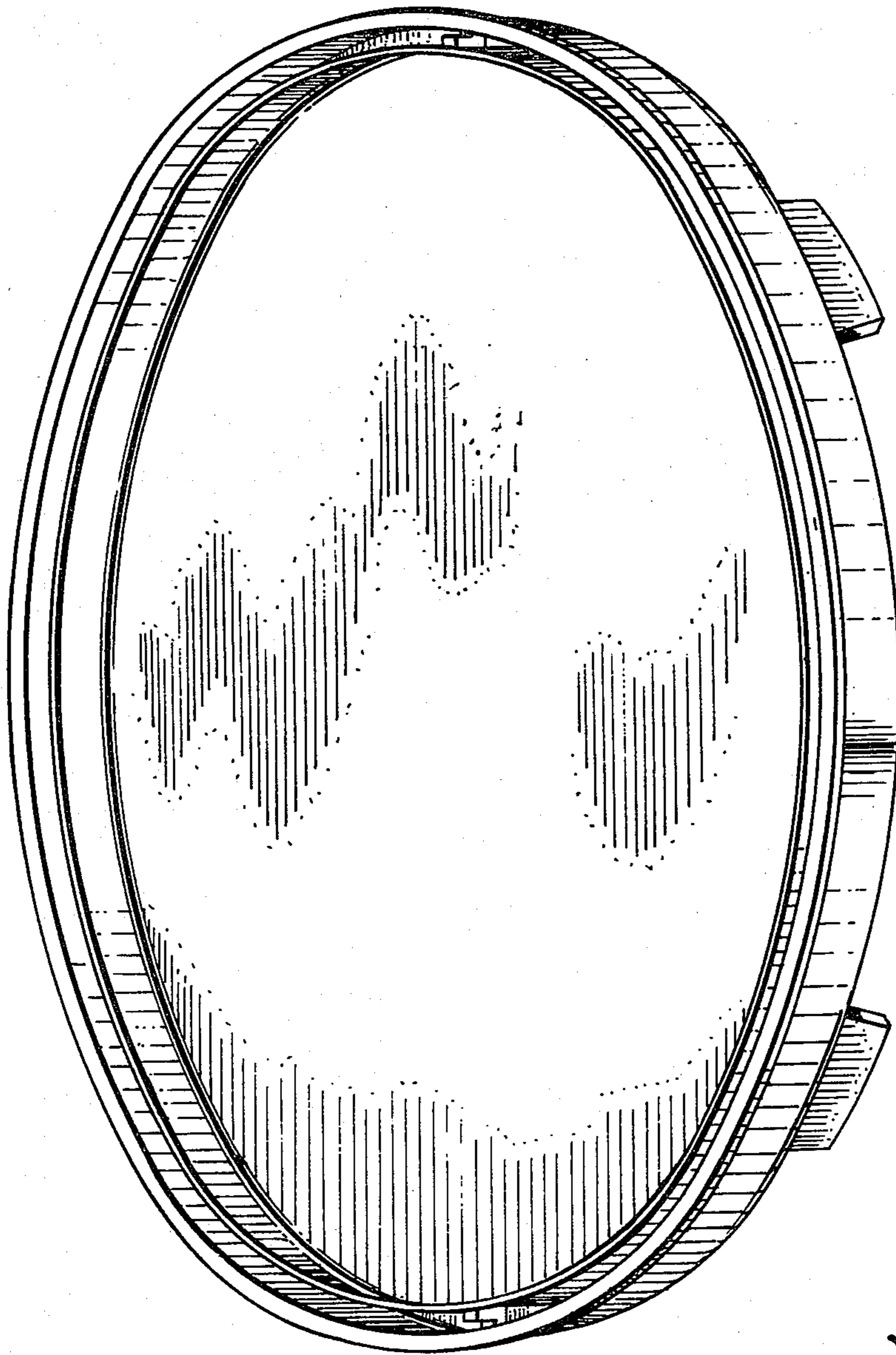

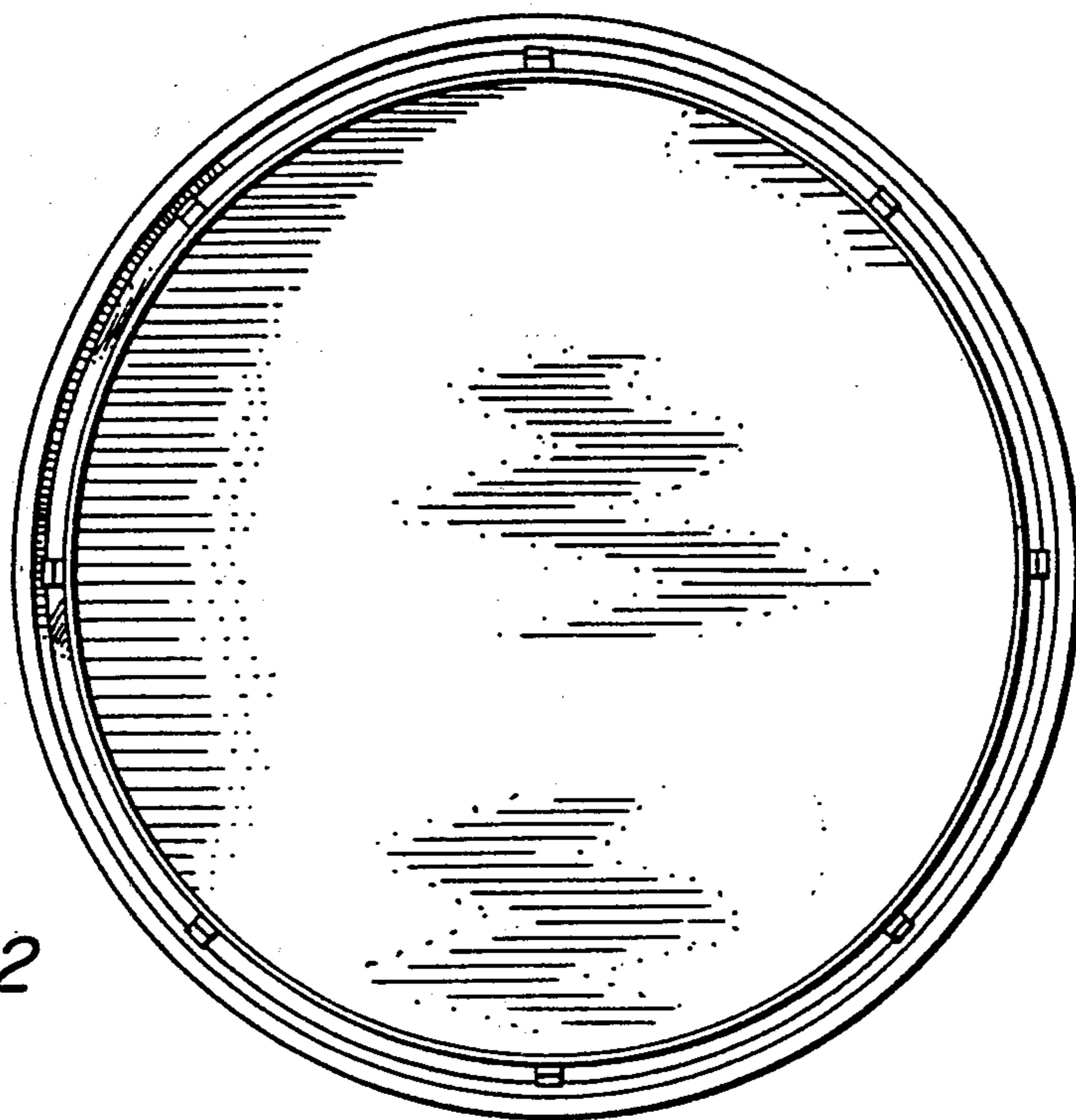

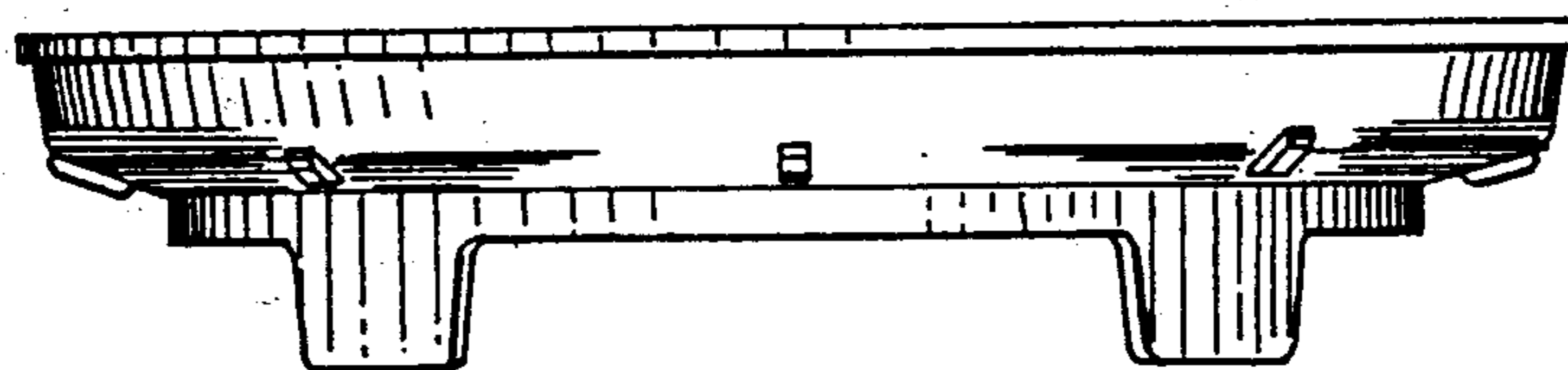

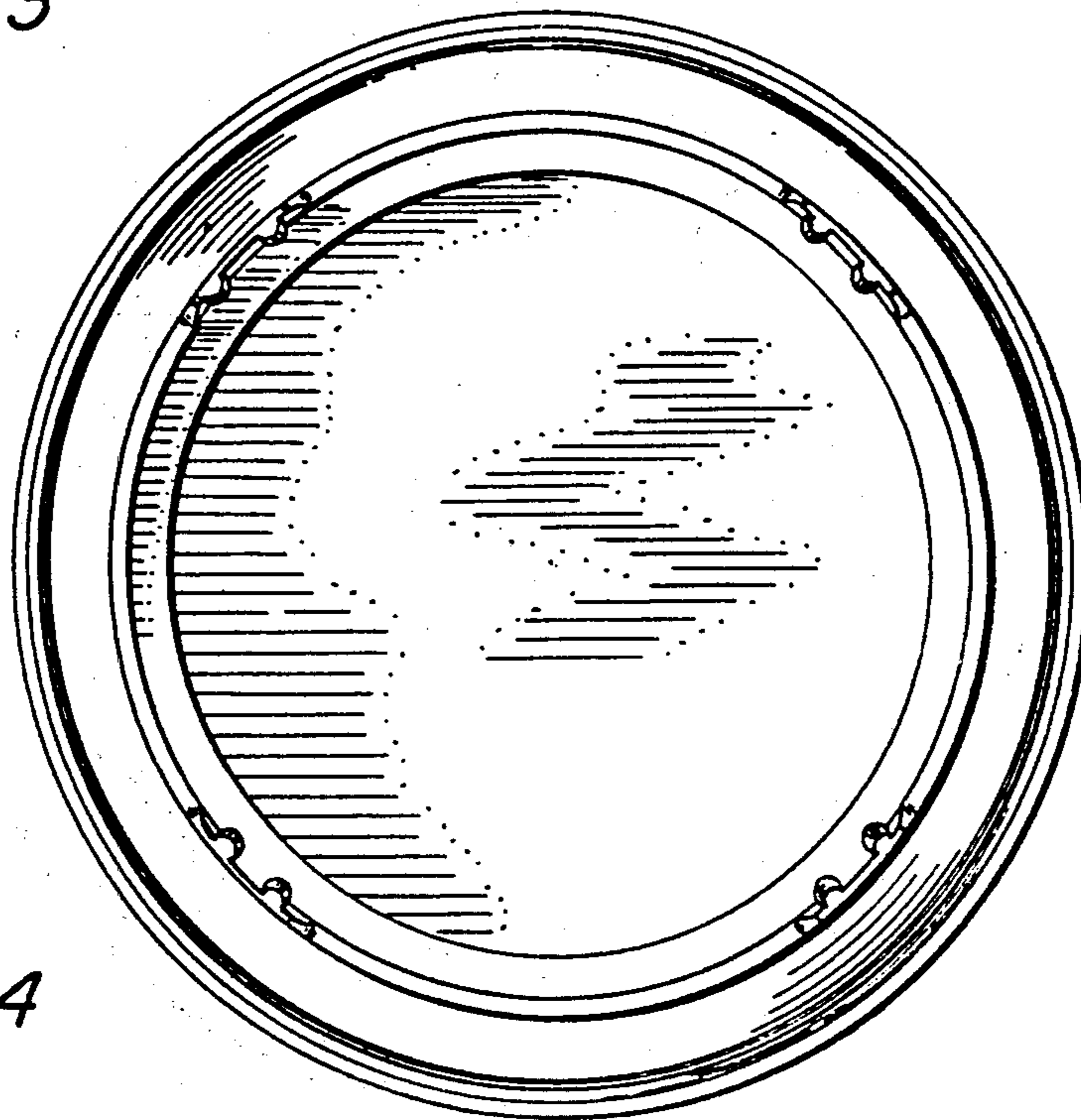

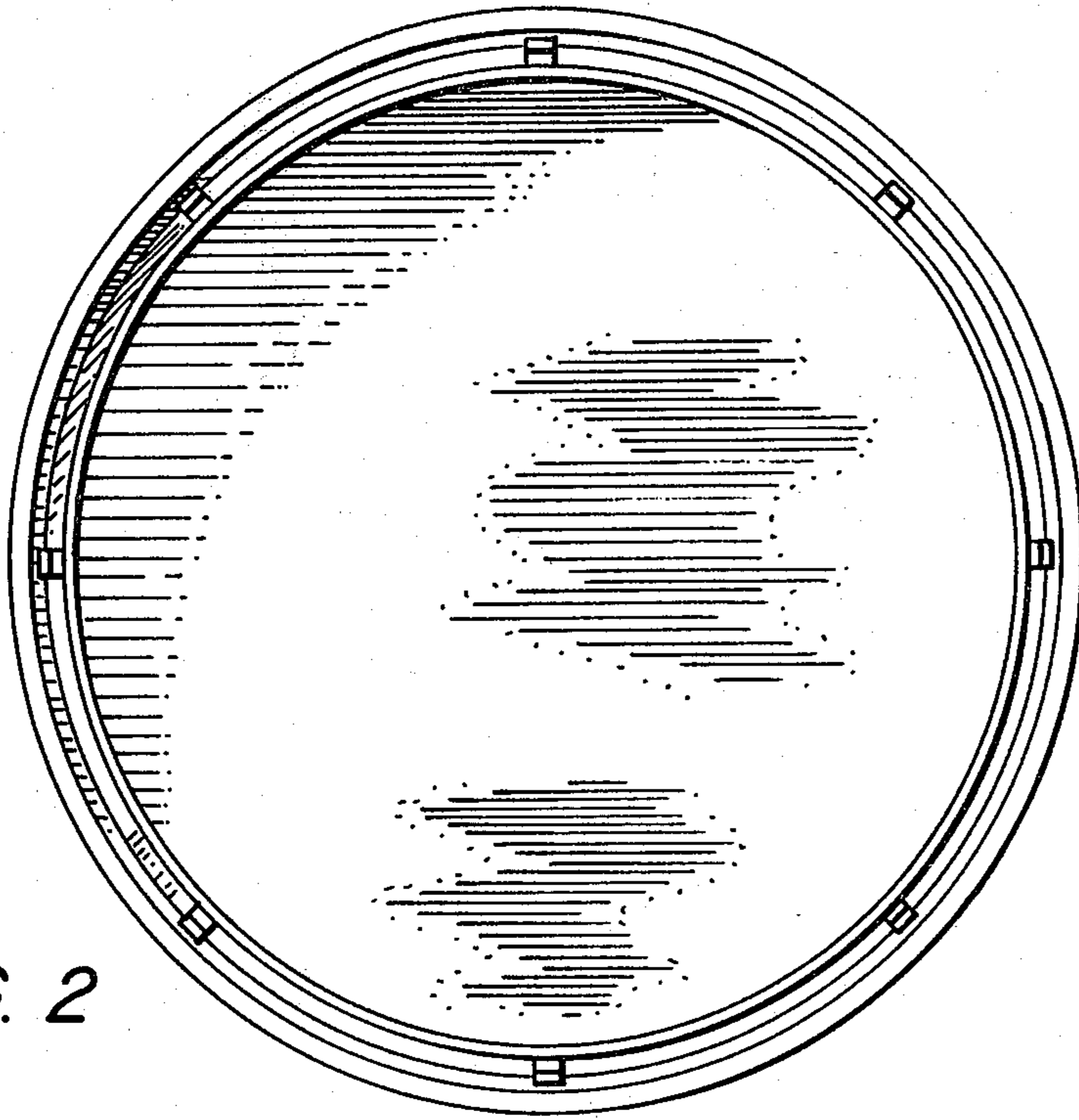

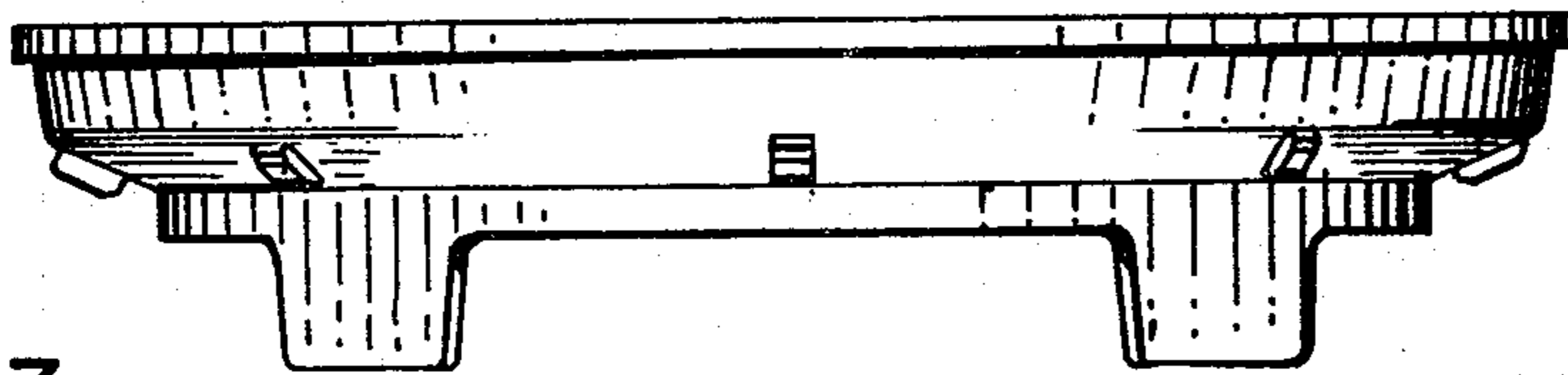

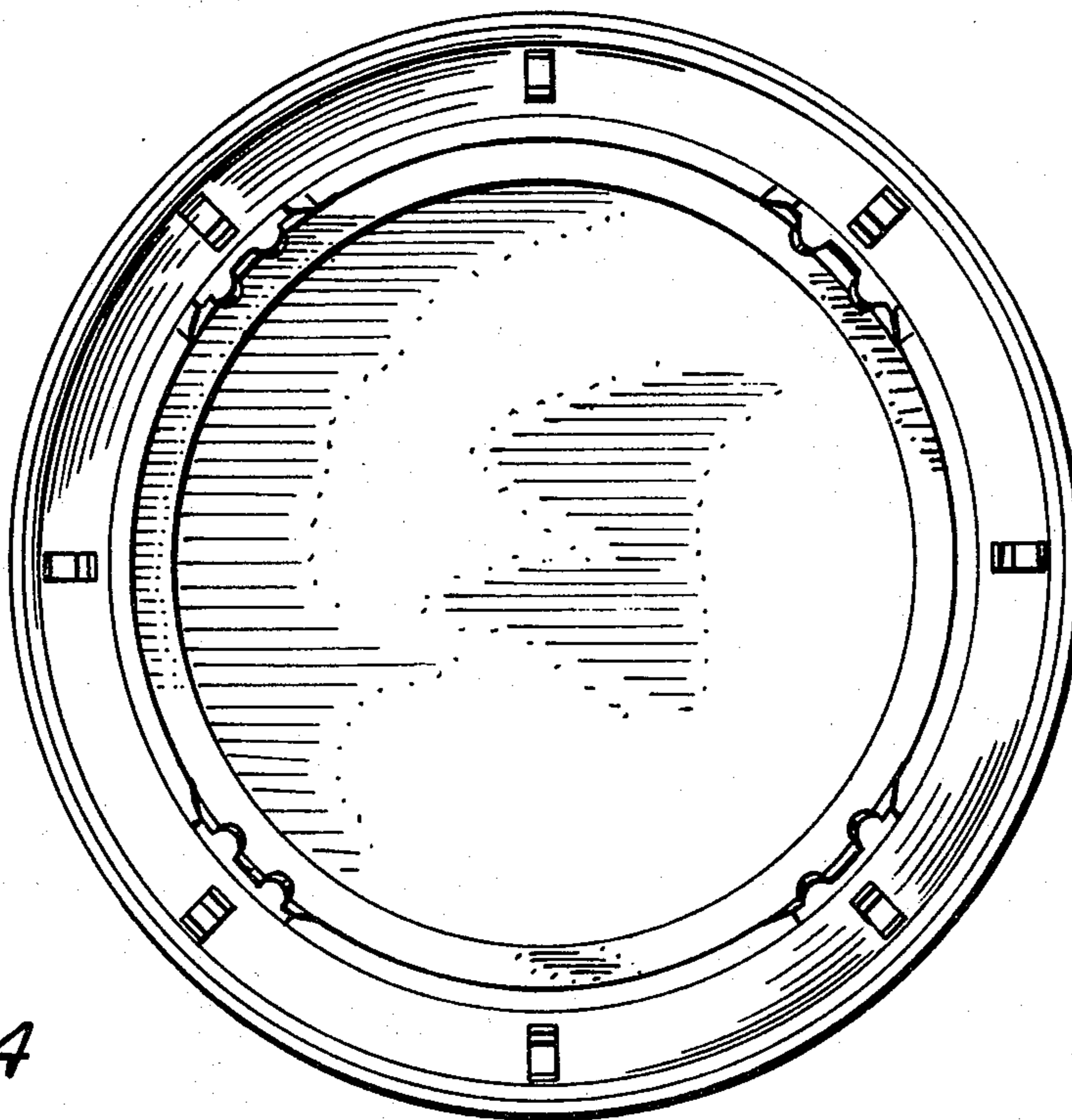
