[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a wall mounted exerciser housing, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a wall mounted exerciser housing showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being a mirror image;

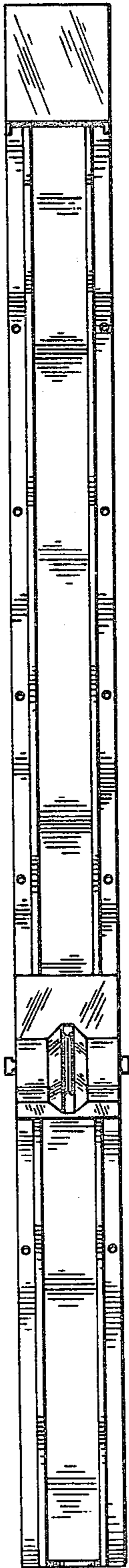

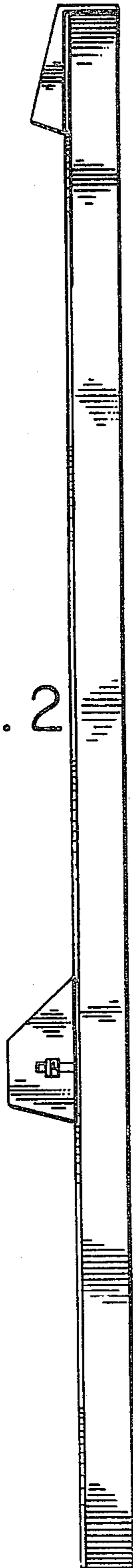

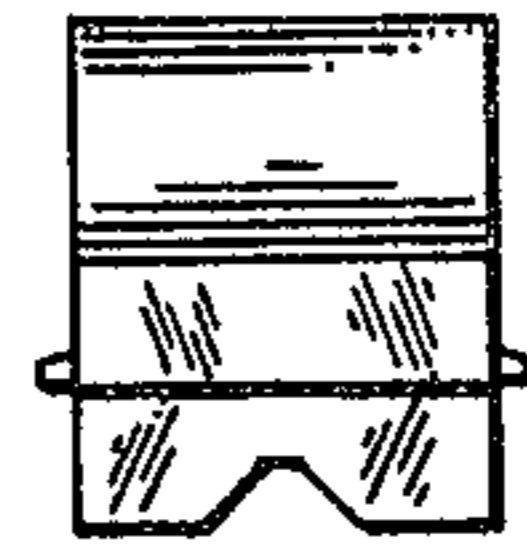
