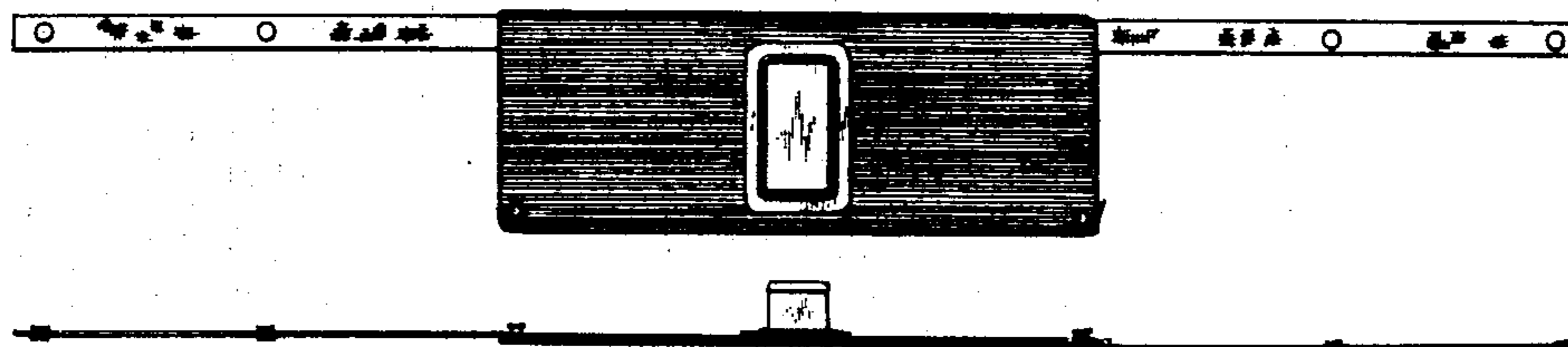
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a massaging and heating belt, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a massaging and heating belt showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view being a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left-side elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale;
FIG. 5 is a right-side elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale; and
FIG. 6 is a fragmentary top plan view of the right-hand corner of FIG. 1 on an enlarged scale.

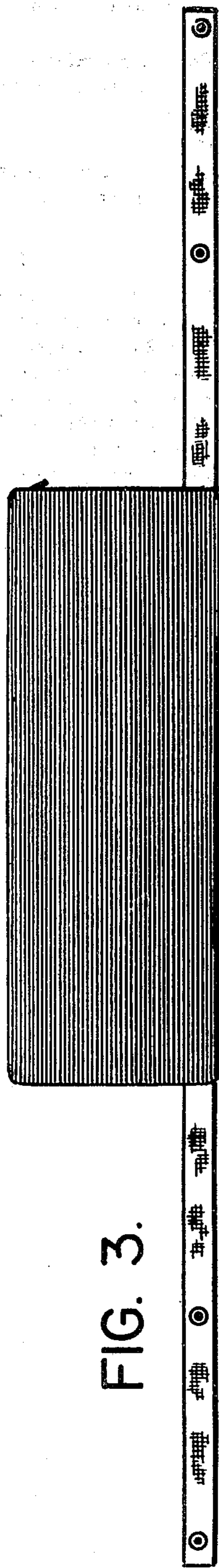
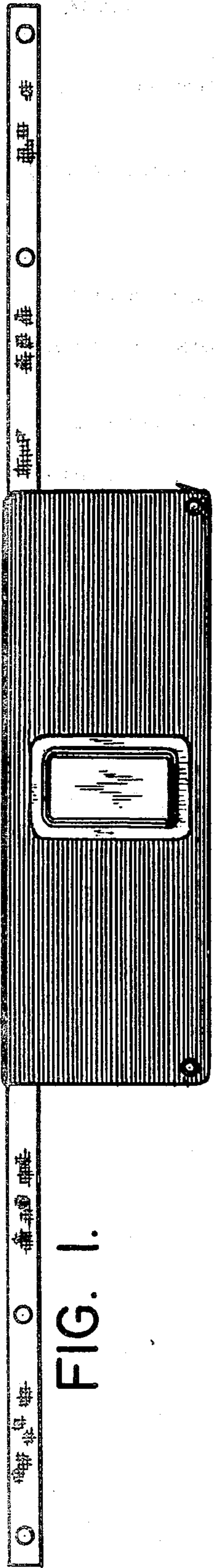
