[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a wristband for controlling nausea, suitable for use in applying pressure to a selected point on the wrist, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of a wristband for controlling nausea showing my new design.

 FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the wristband.

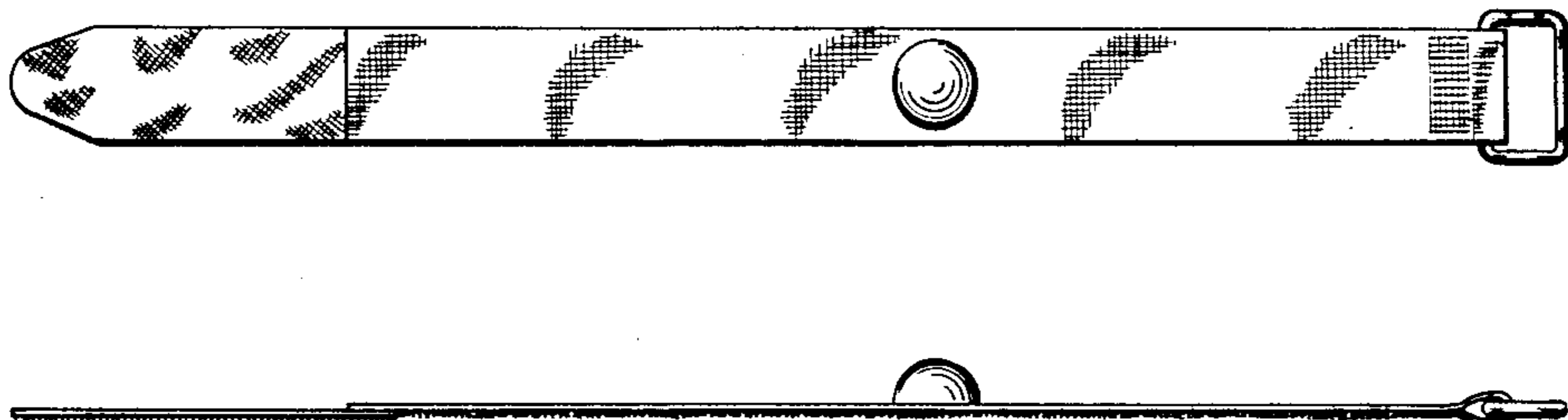

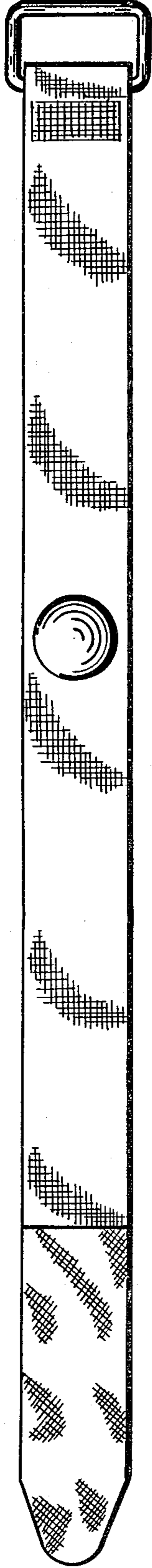

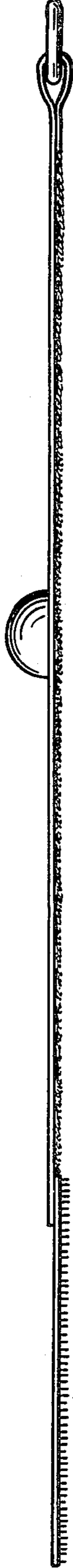

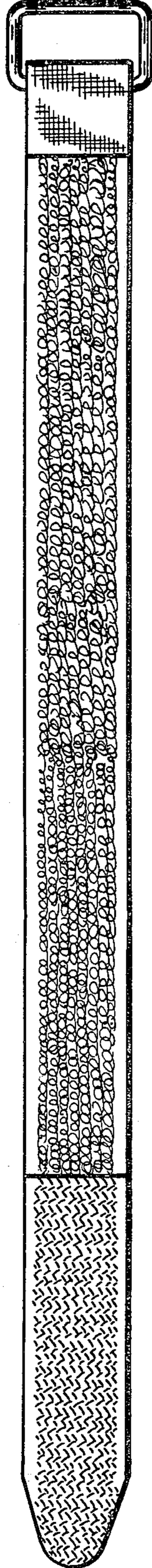
