The ornamental design for a paint scraper blade holder, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a paint scraper blade holder showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

FIG. 6 is a longitudinal sectional elevational view thereof.

The right side elevational view not shown is a mirror image of the left side shown.

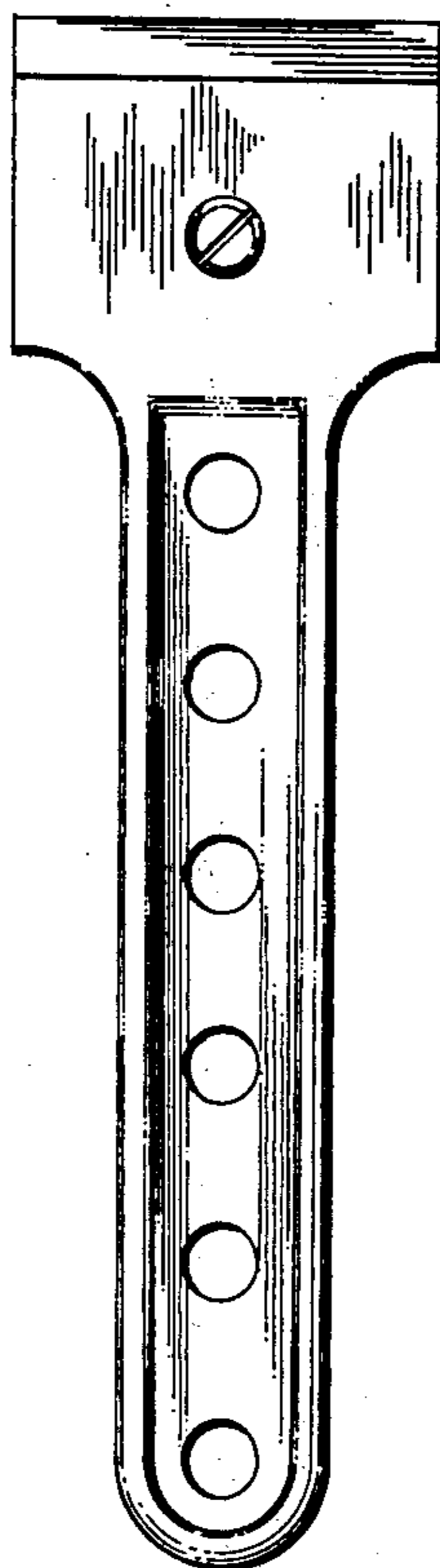

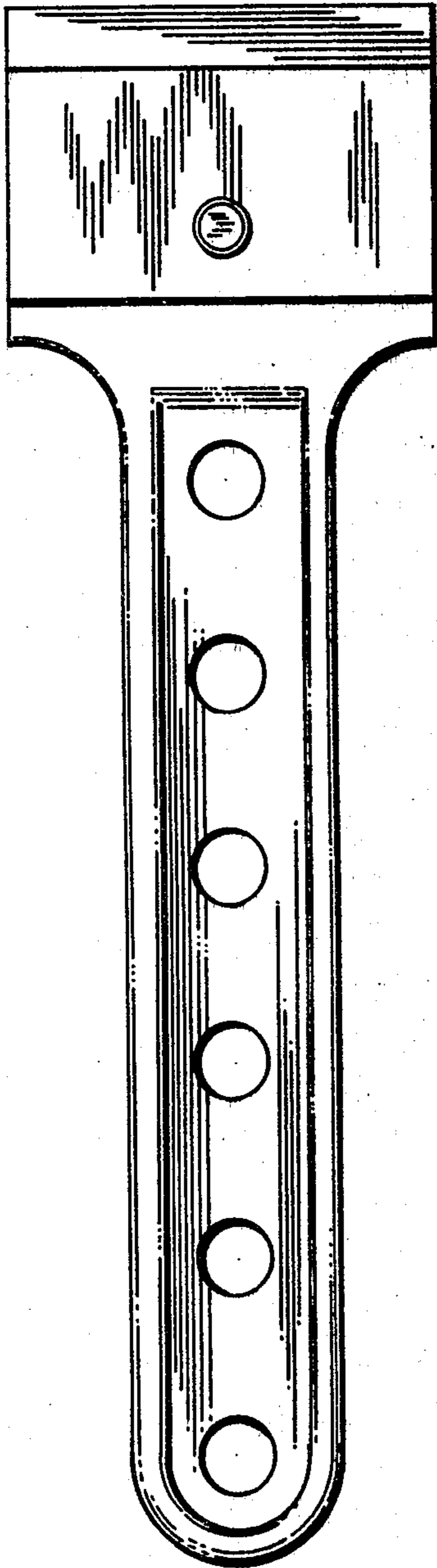

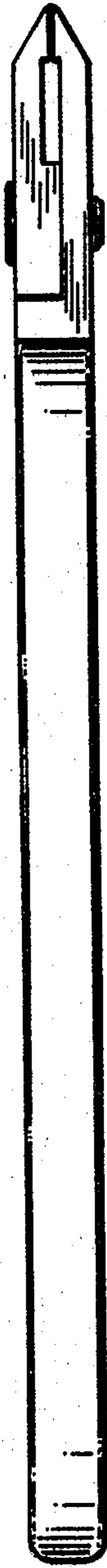

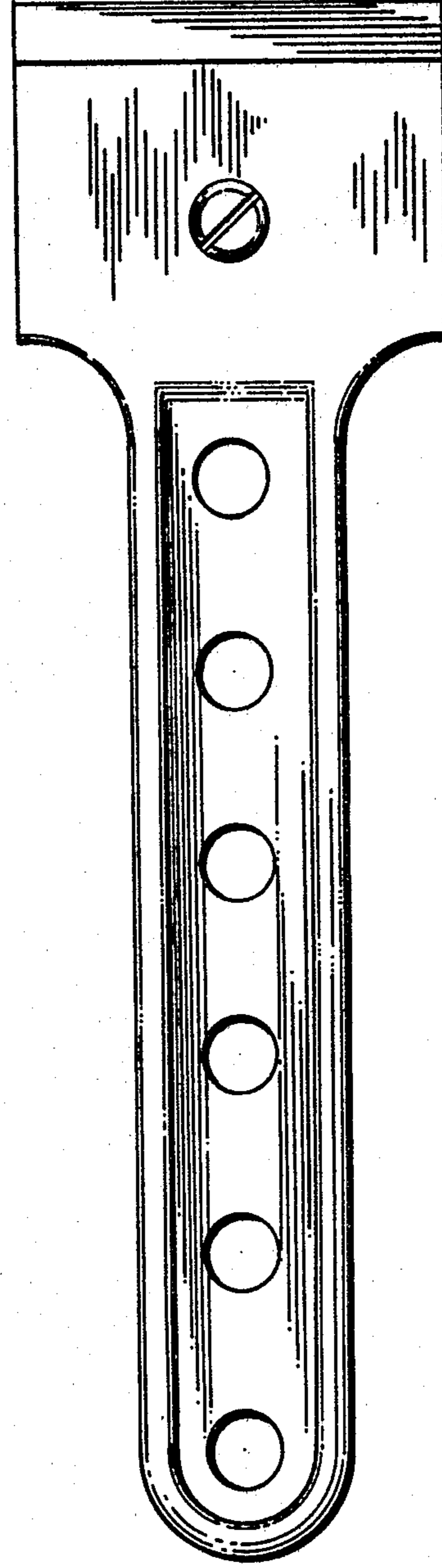

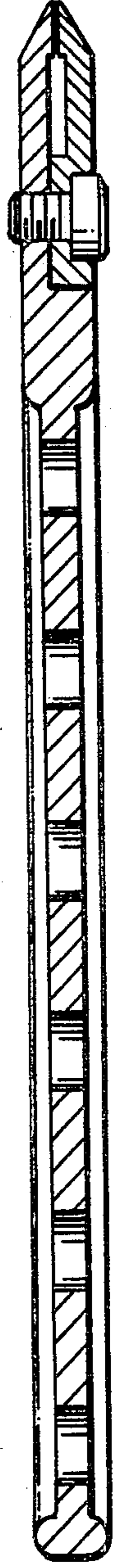
