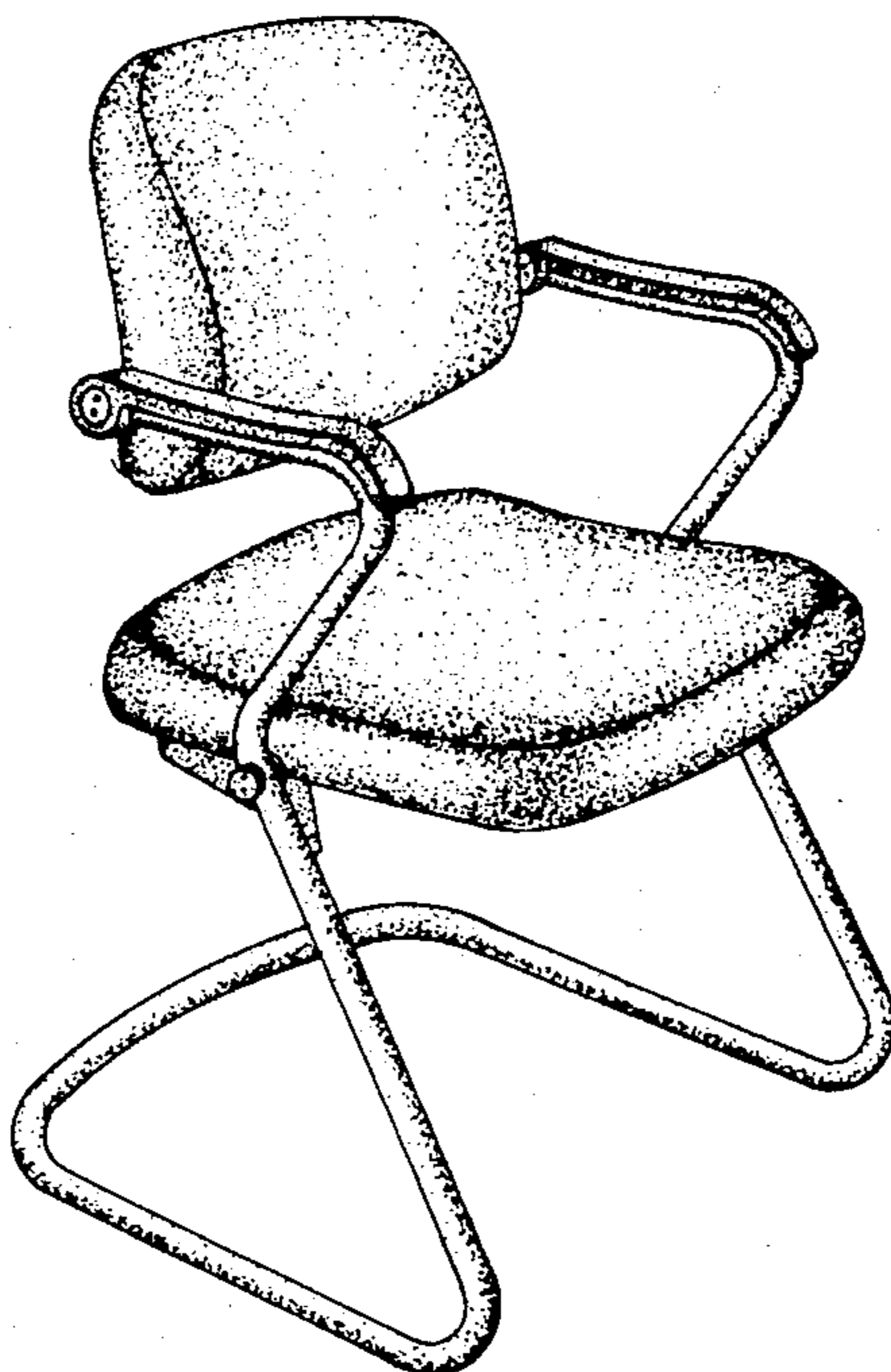

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side perspective view of my new chair; FIG. 2 is an opposite side elevation of the chair on a somewhat reduced scale, both sides being of the same appearance; and FIG. 3 is a quarter front perspective of the chair.



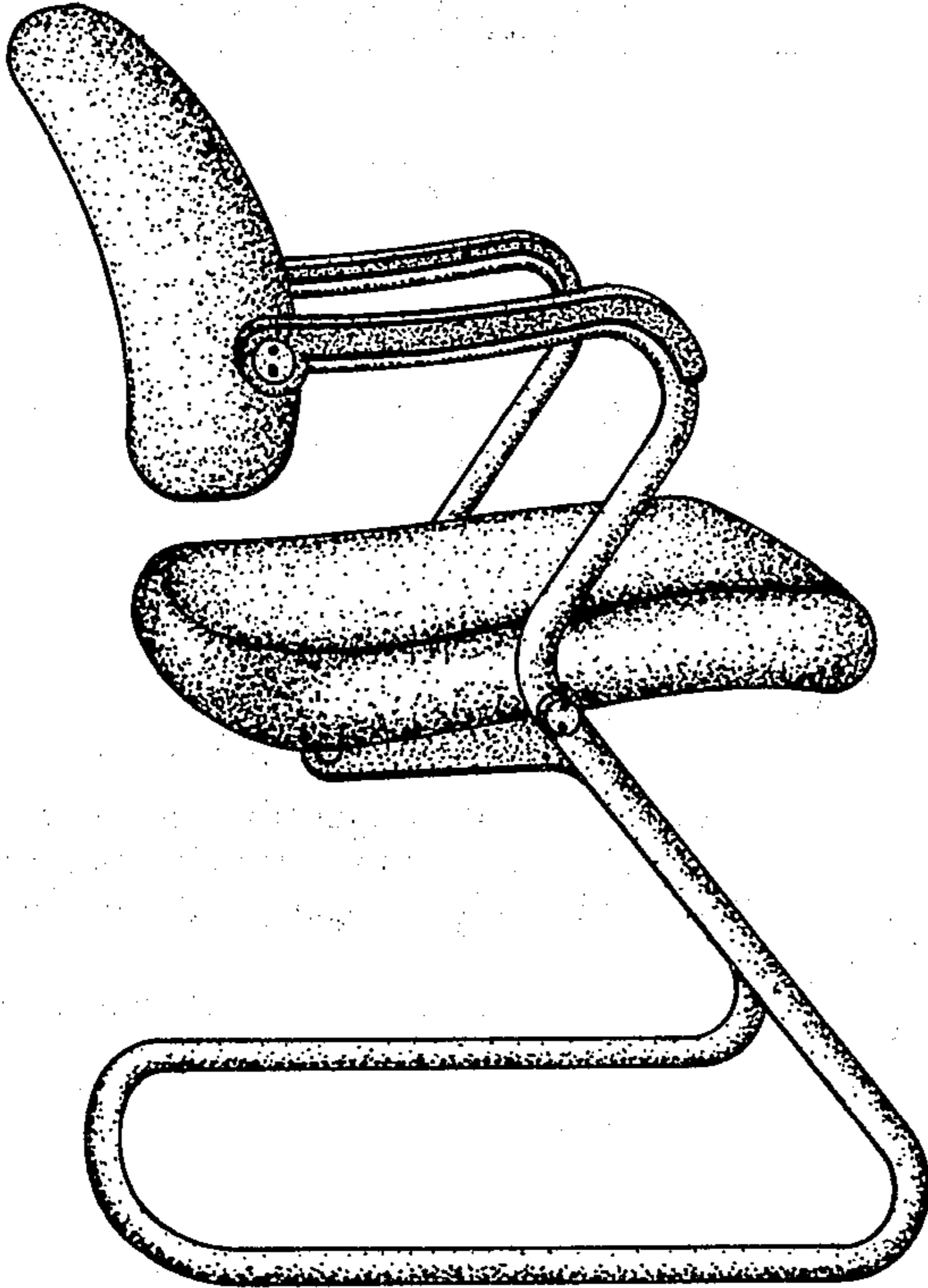

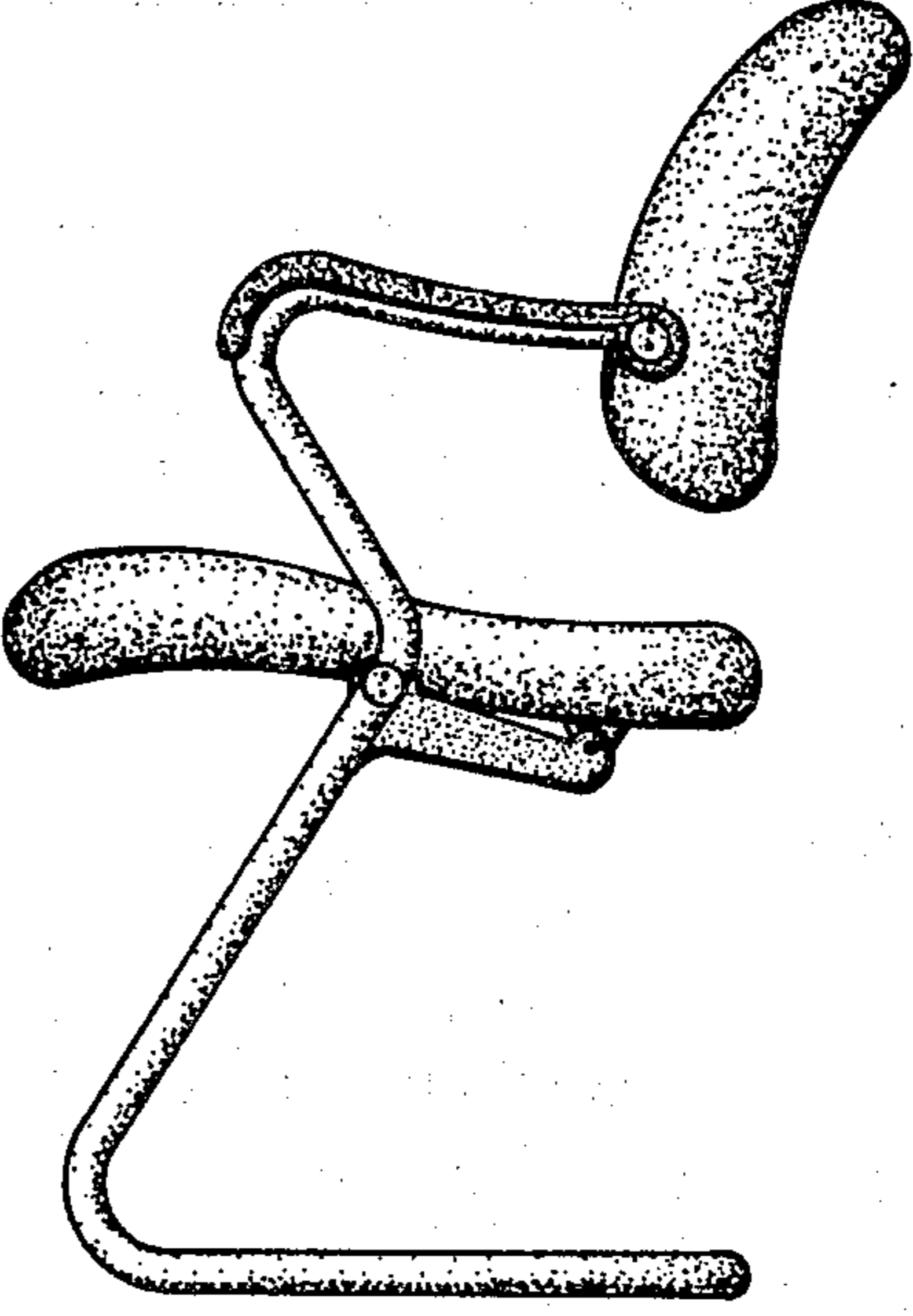

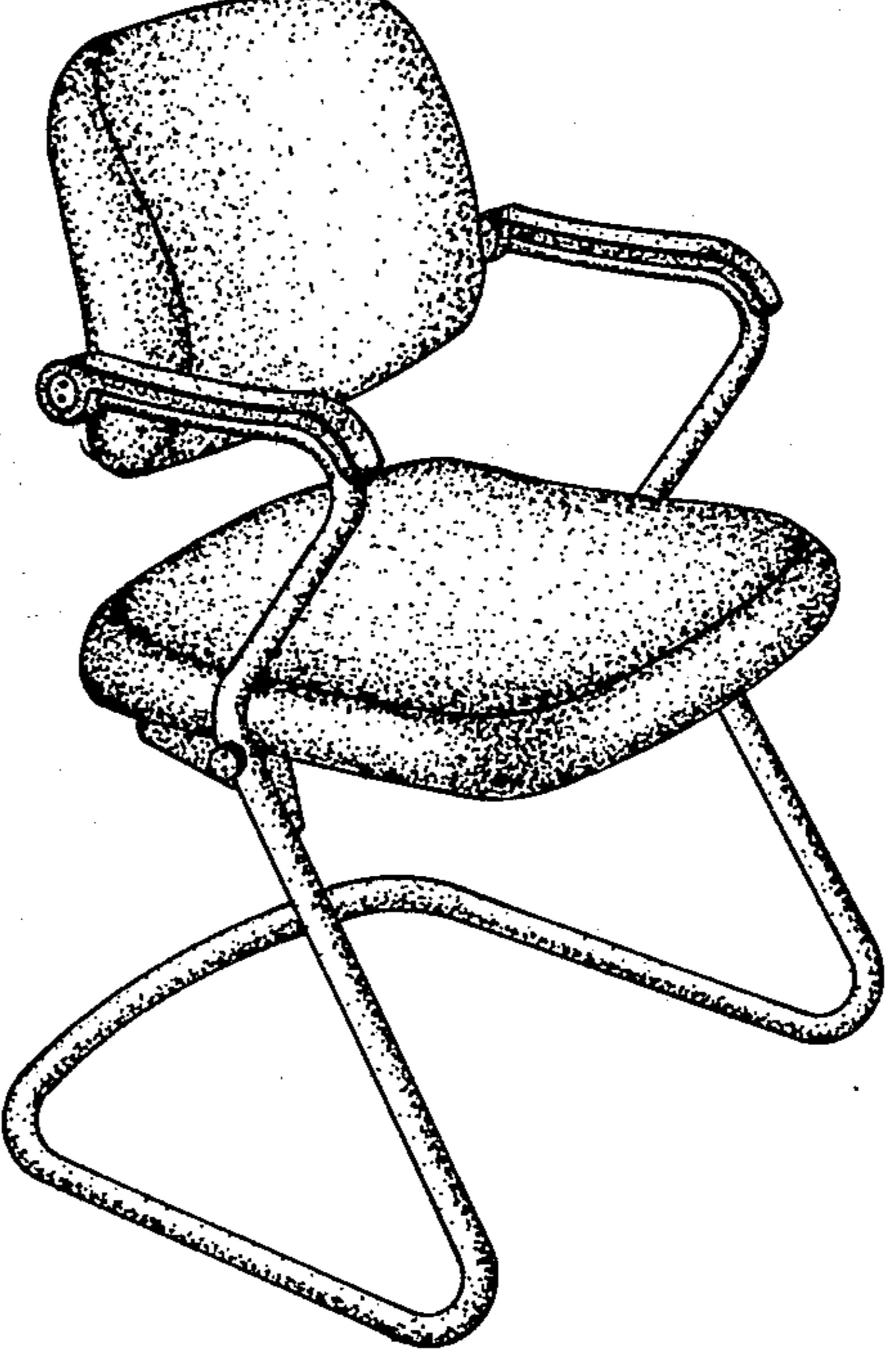
