FIG. 4 is a rear perspective view thereof.

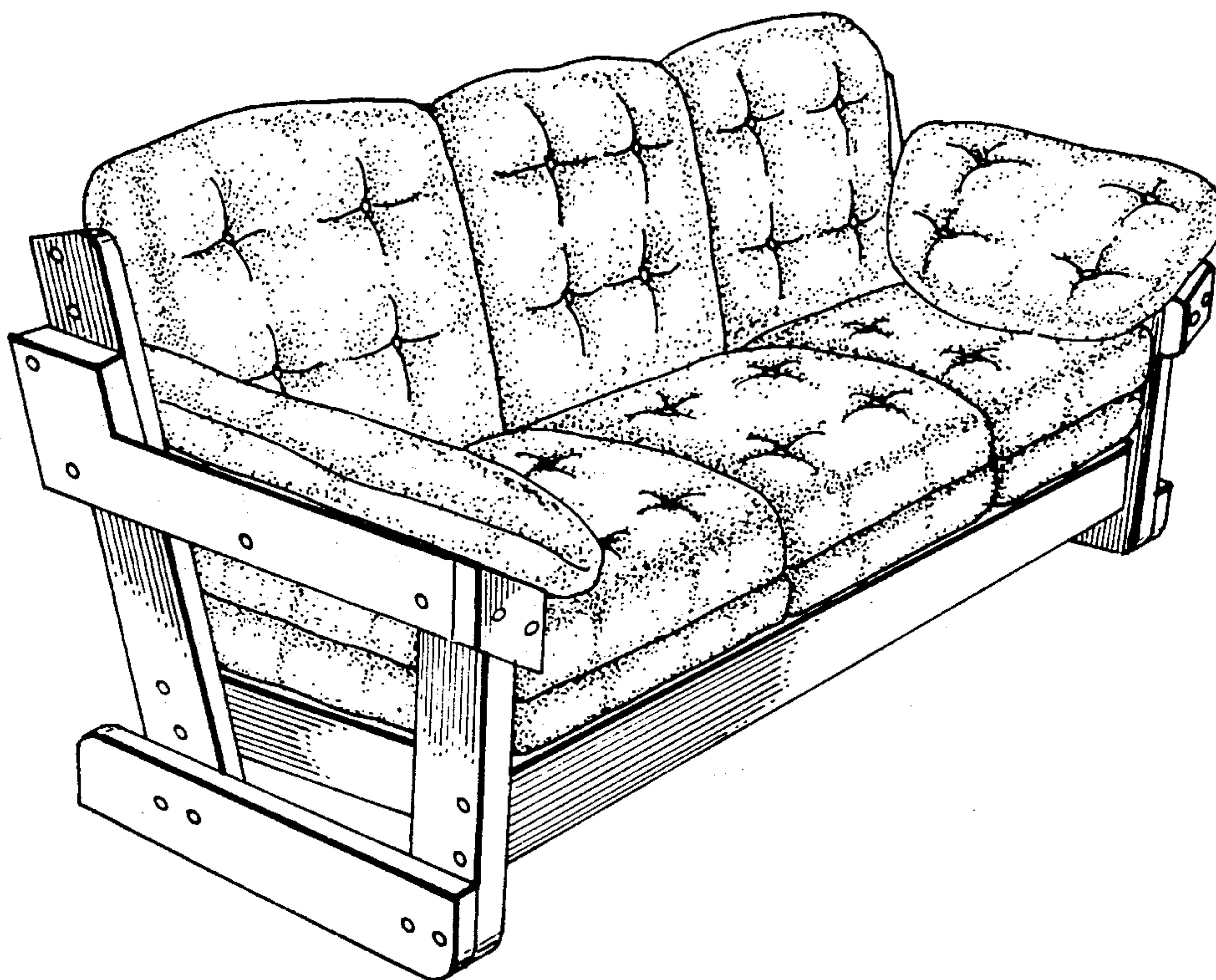

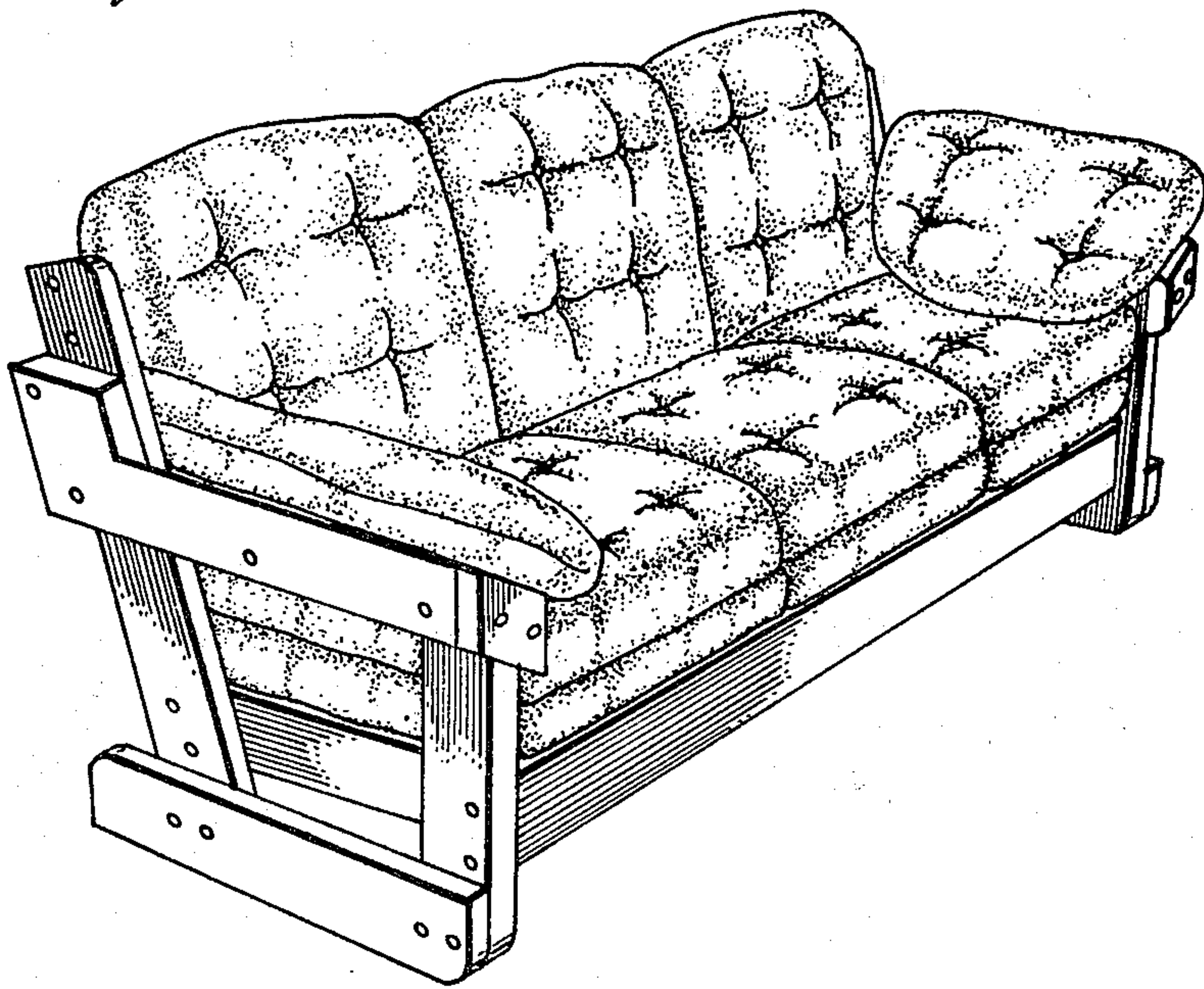

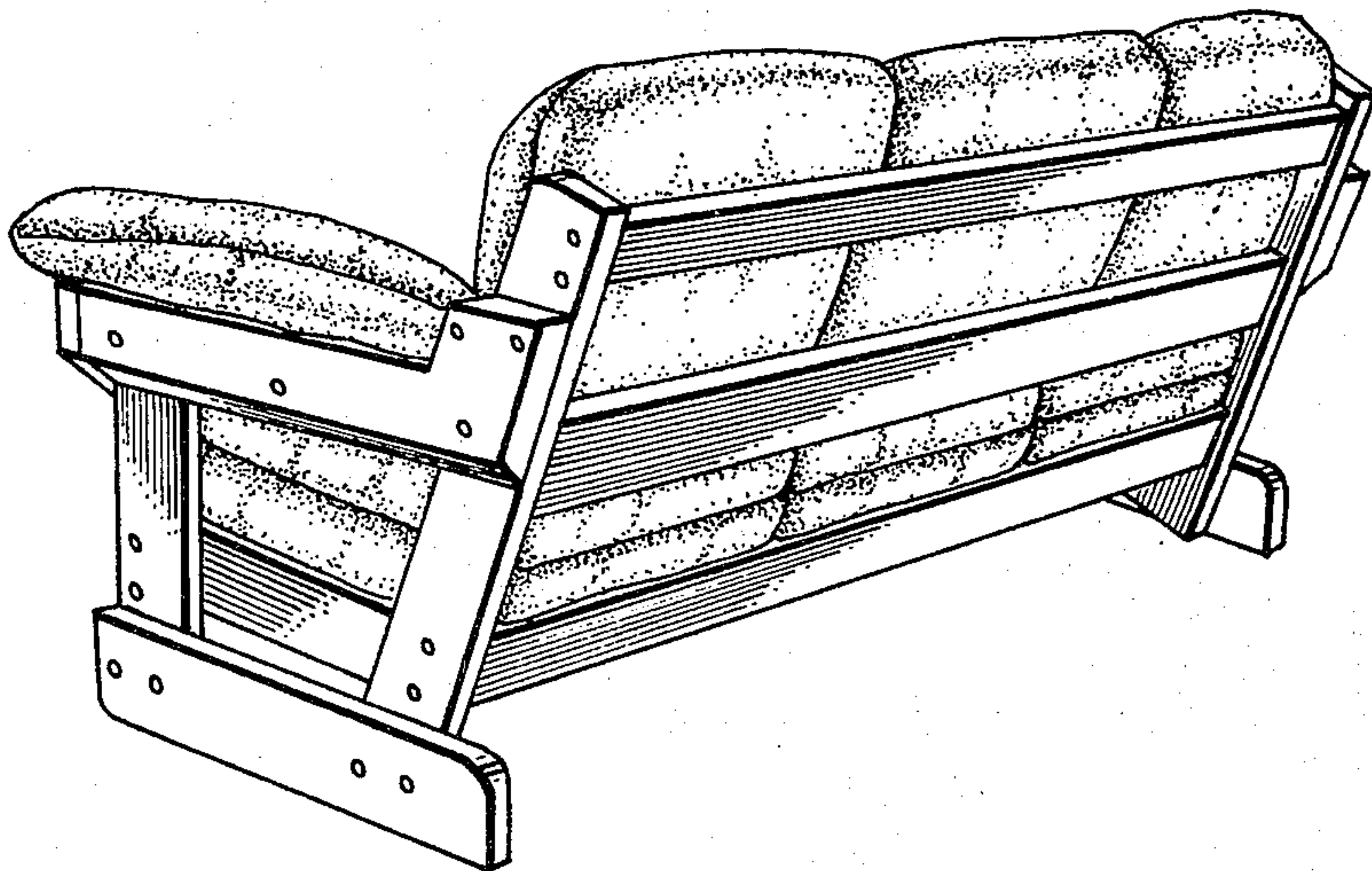

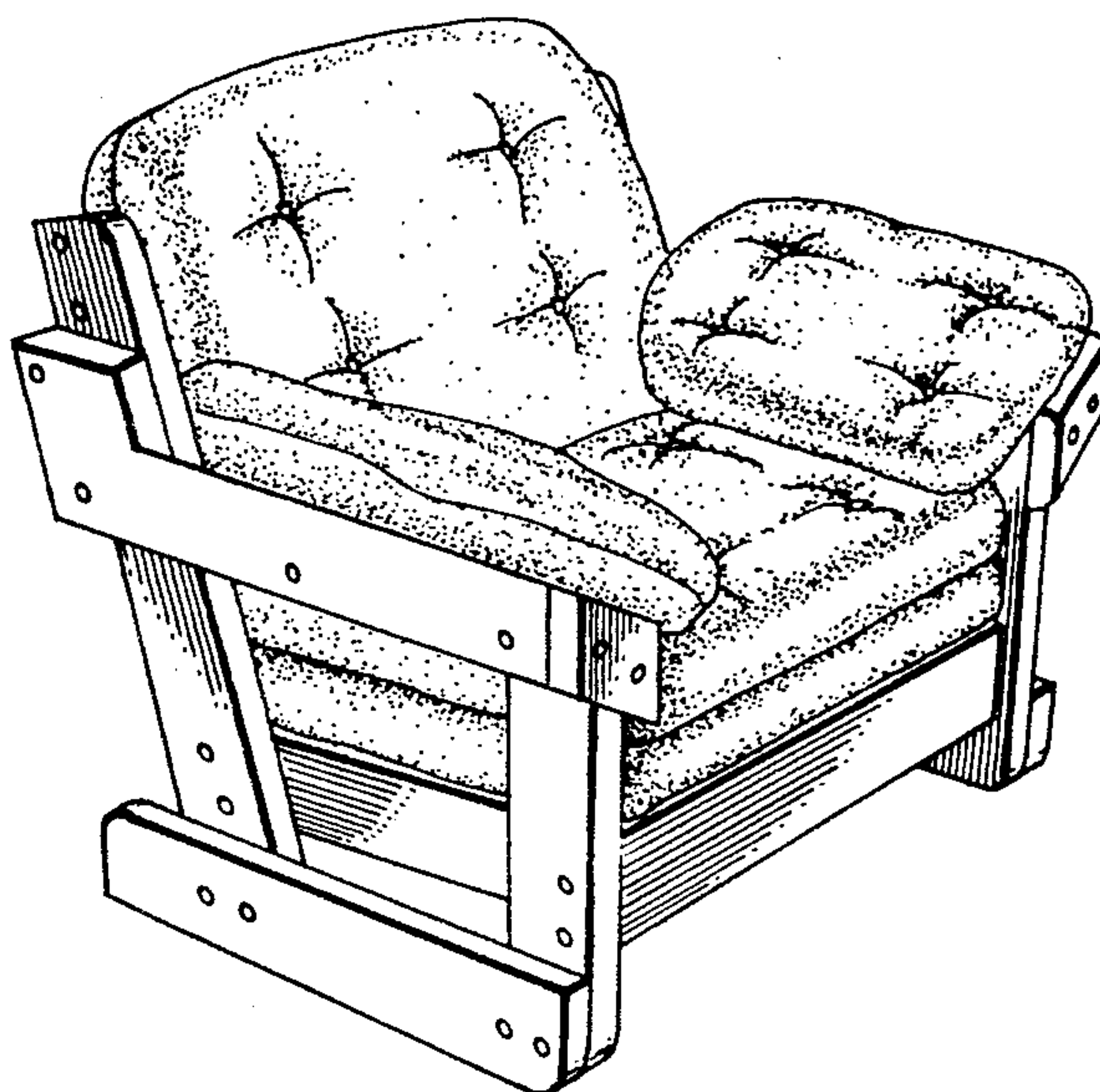
