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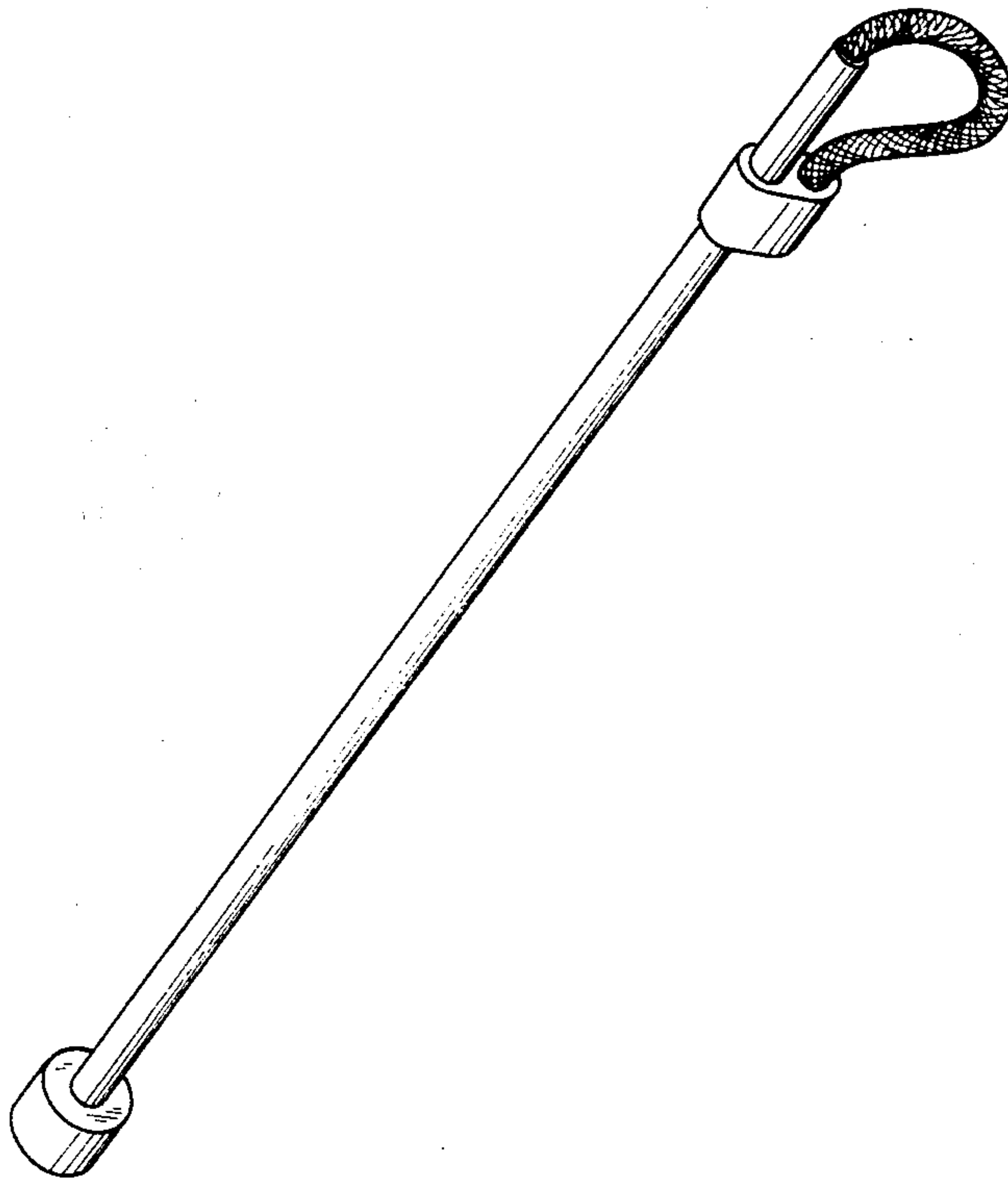

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a herbicide applicator, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a herbicide applicator showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a front perspective view of a second modified embodiment of the applicator illustrated in 1;
FIG. 8 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 10 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 11 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 12 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 13 is a front perspective view of a third embodiment of the applicator illustrated in FIG. 1;
FIG. 14 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 15 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 16 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 17 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 18 is a side elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 19 is a front perspective view of the applicator with the slide member rotated in an alternative position from that disclosed in FIG. 13.



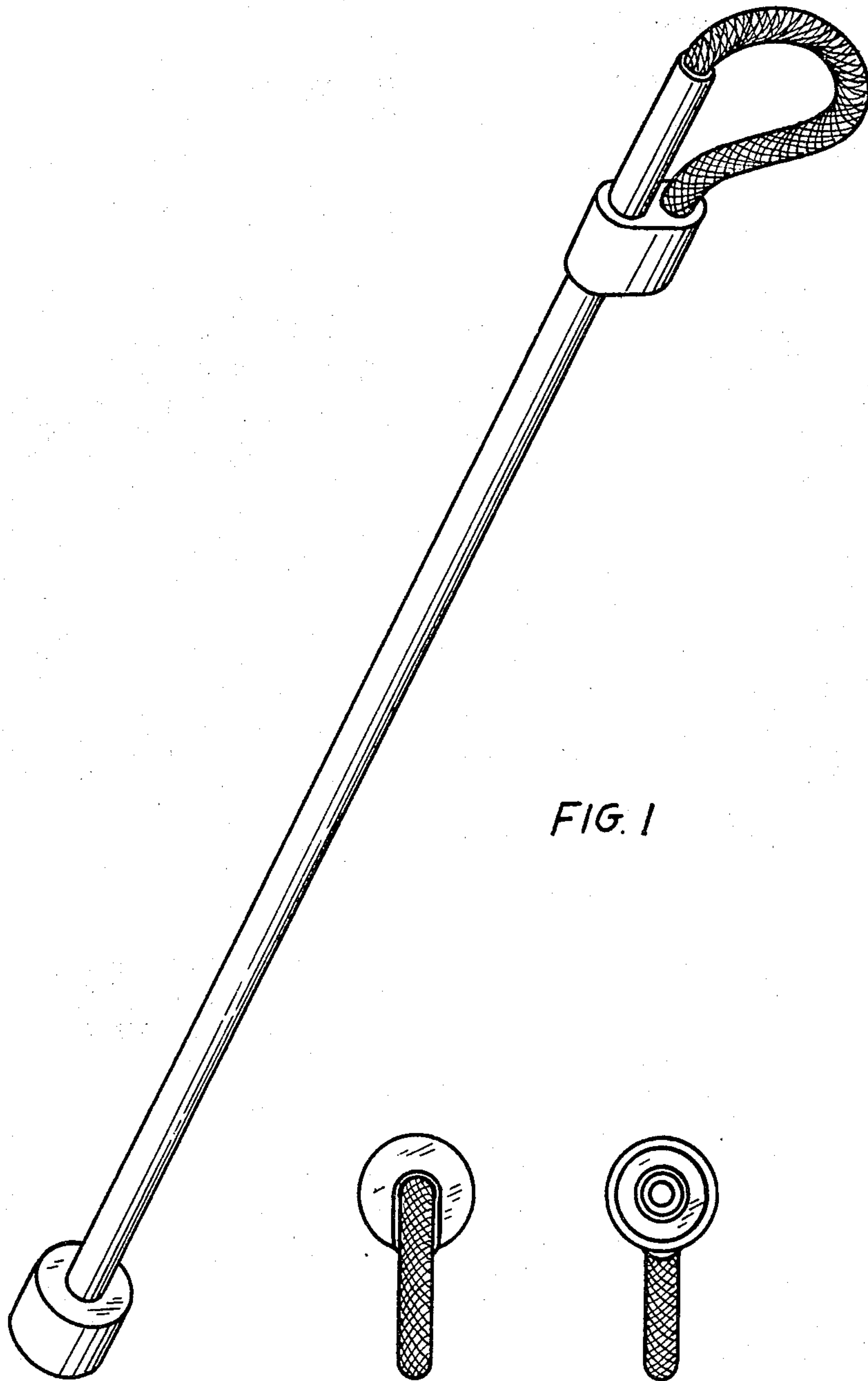

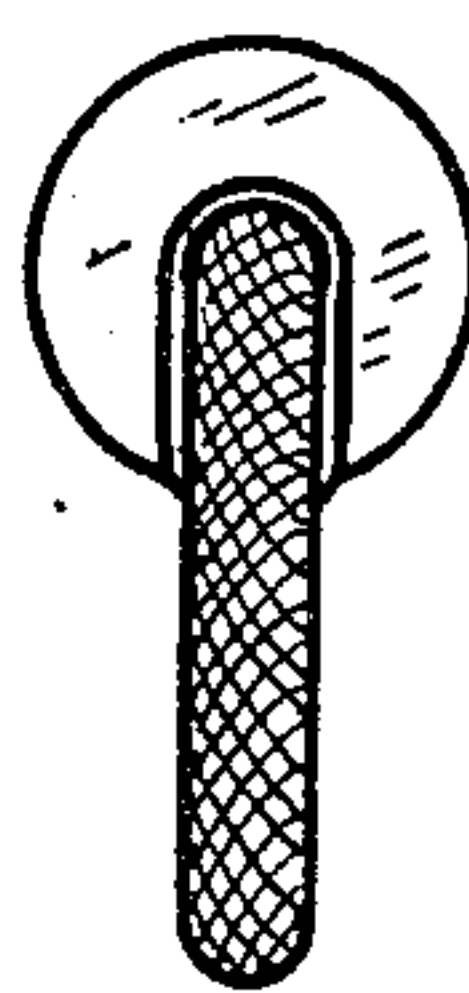

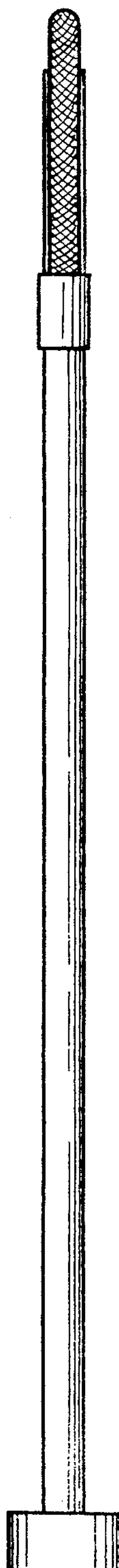

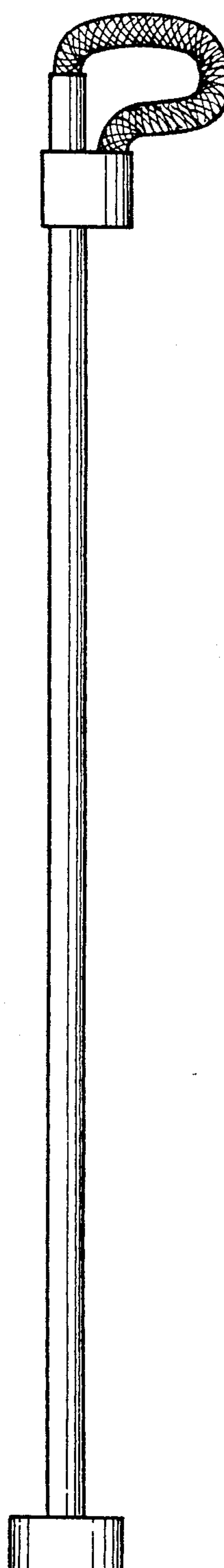

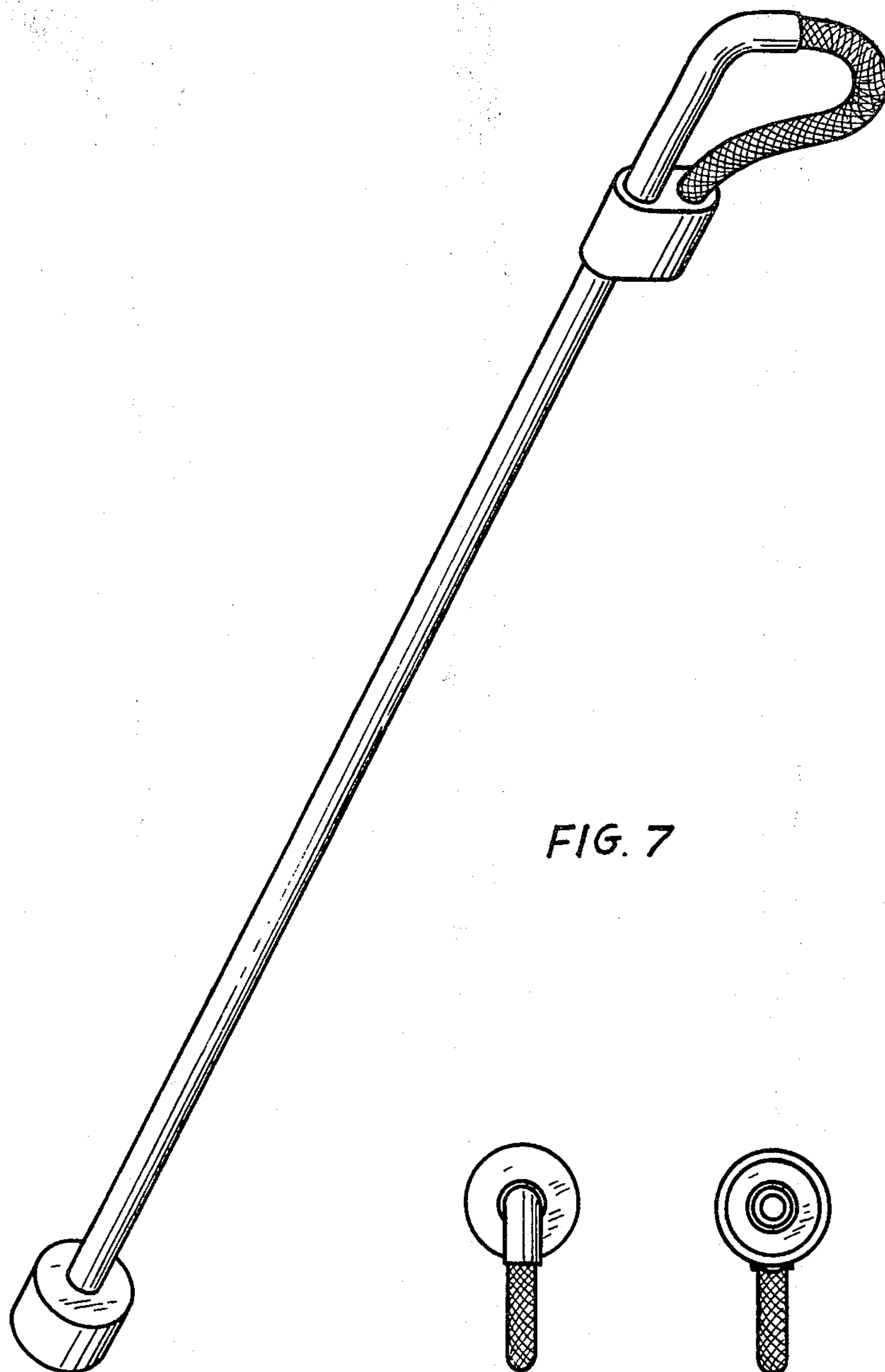

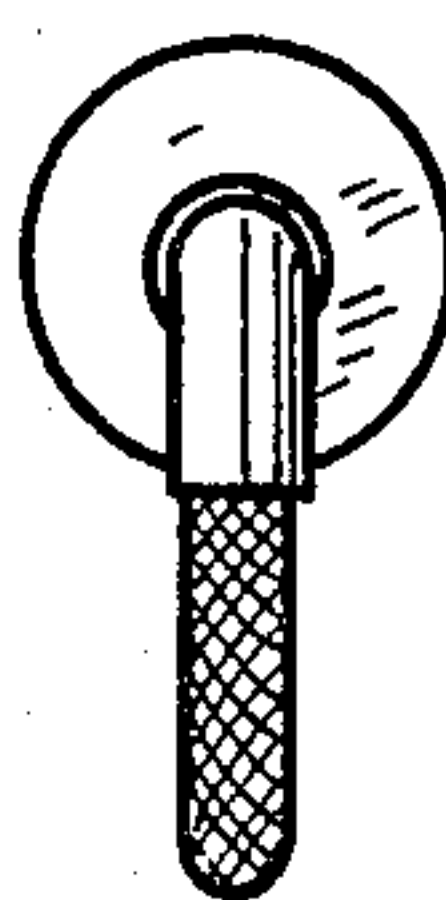

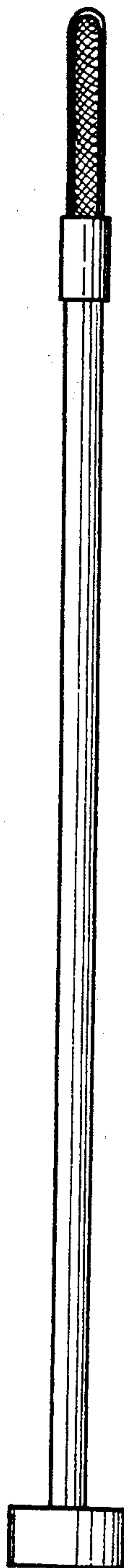

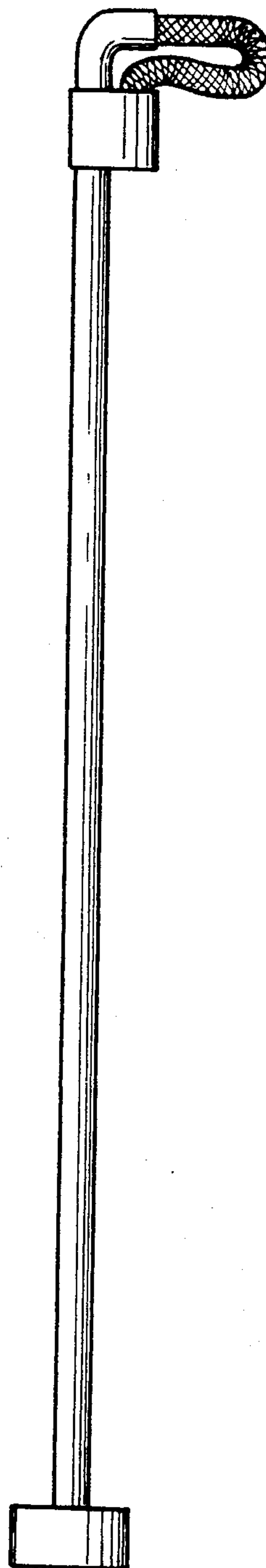

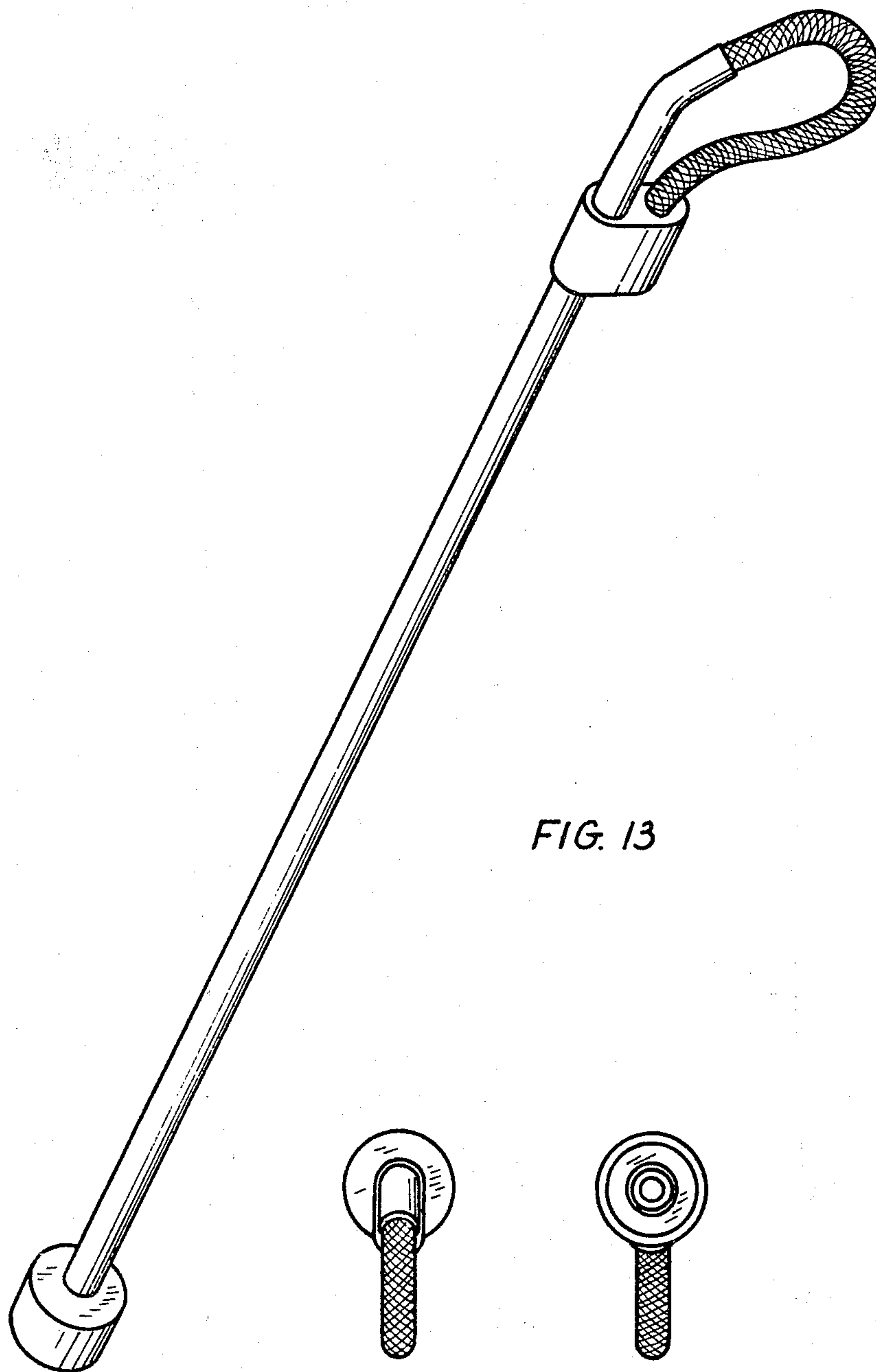

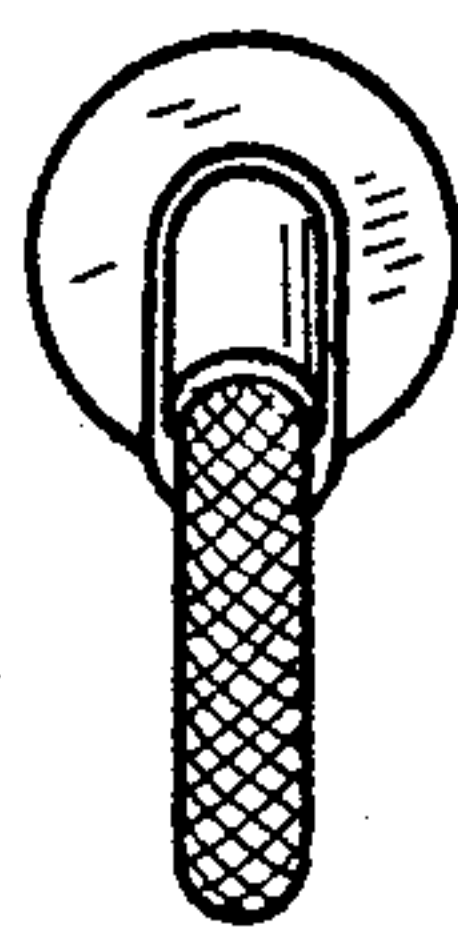

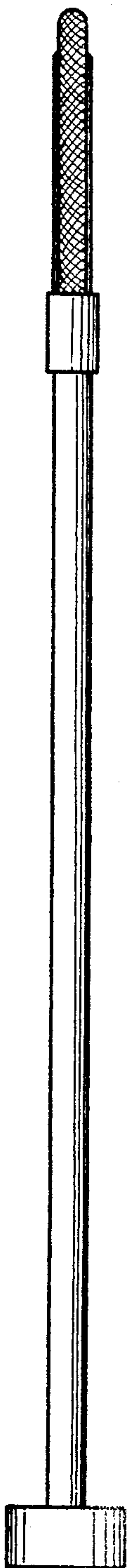

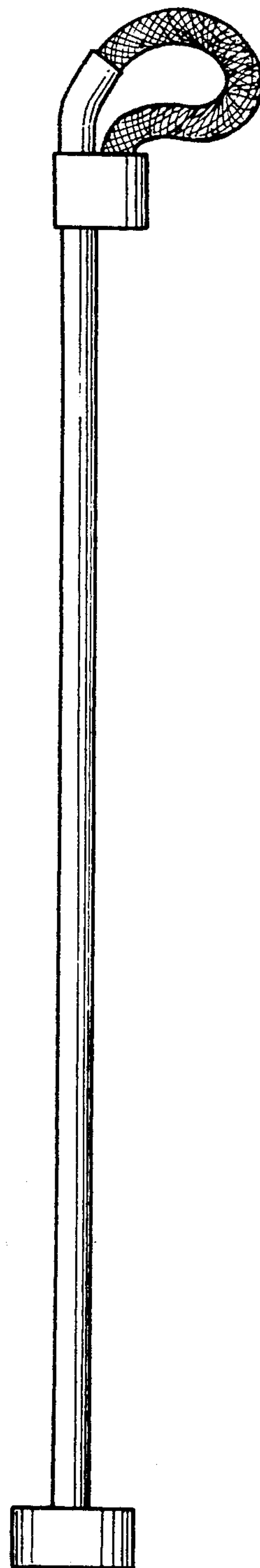

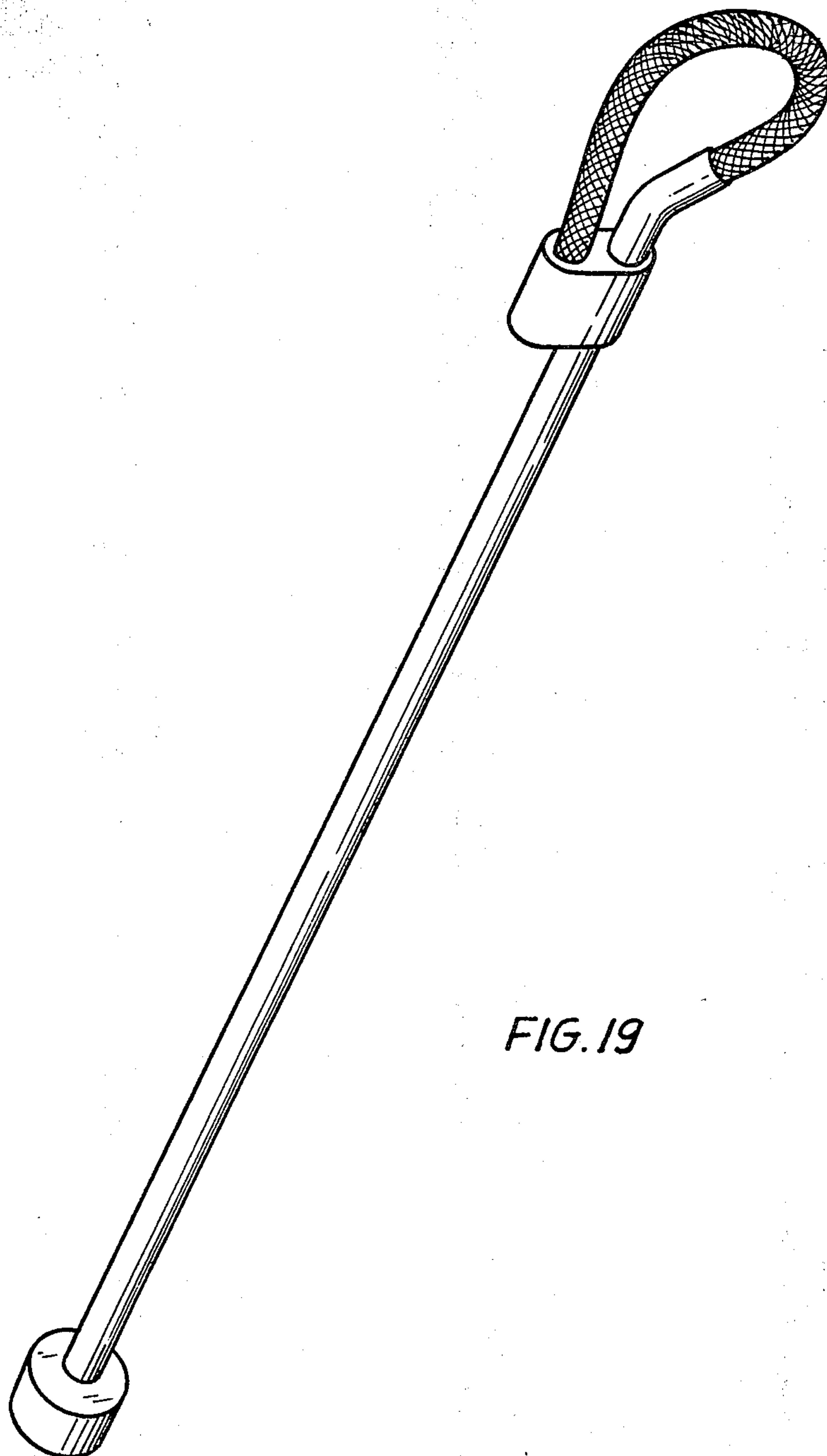
