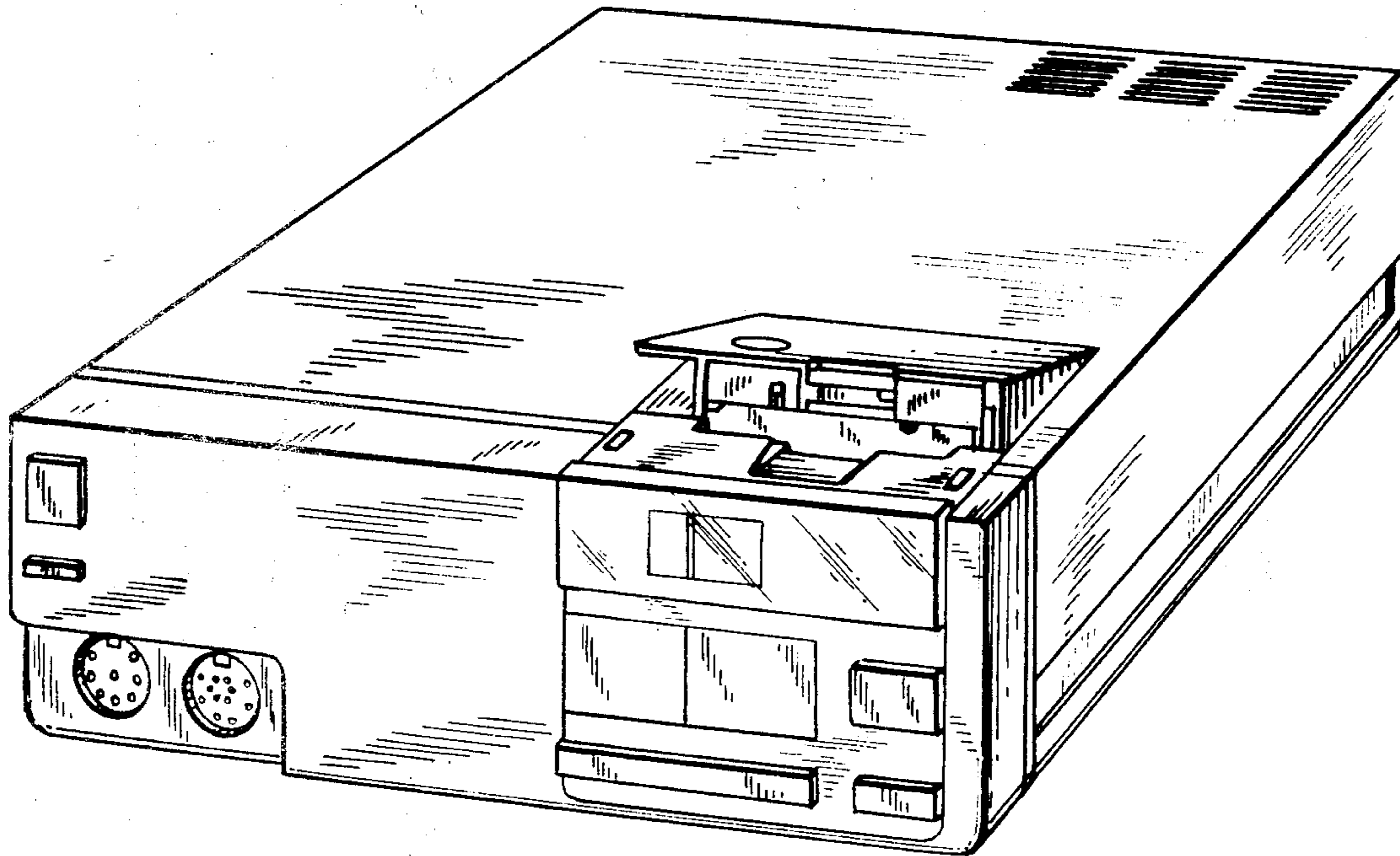

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a magnetic video disc player, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a magnetic video disc player showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 7 is a front, top and right side perspective view; and
FIG. 8 is a view like FIG. 7 with the disc holder in open position.



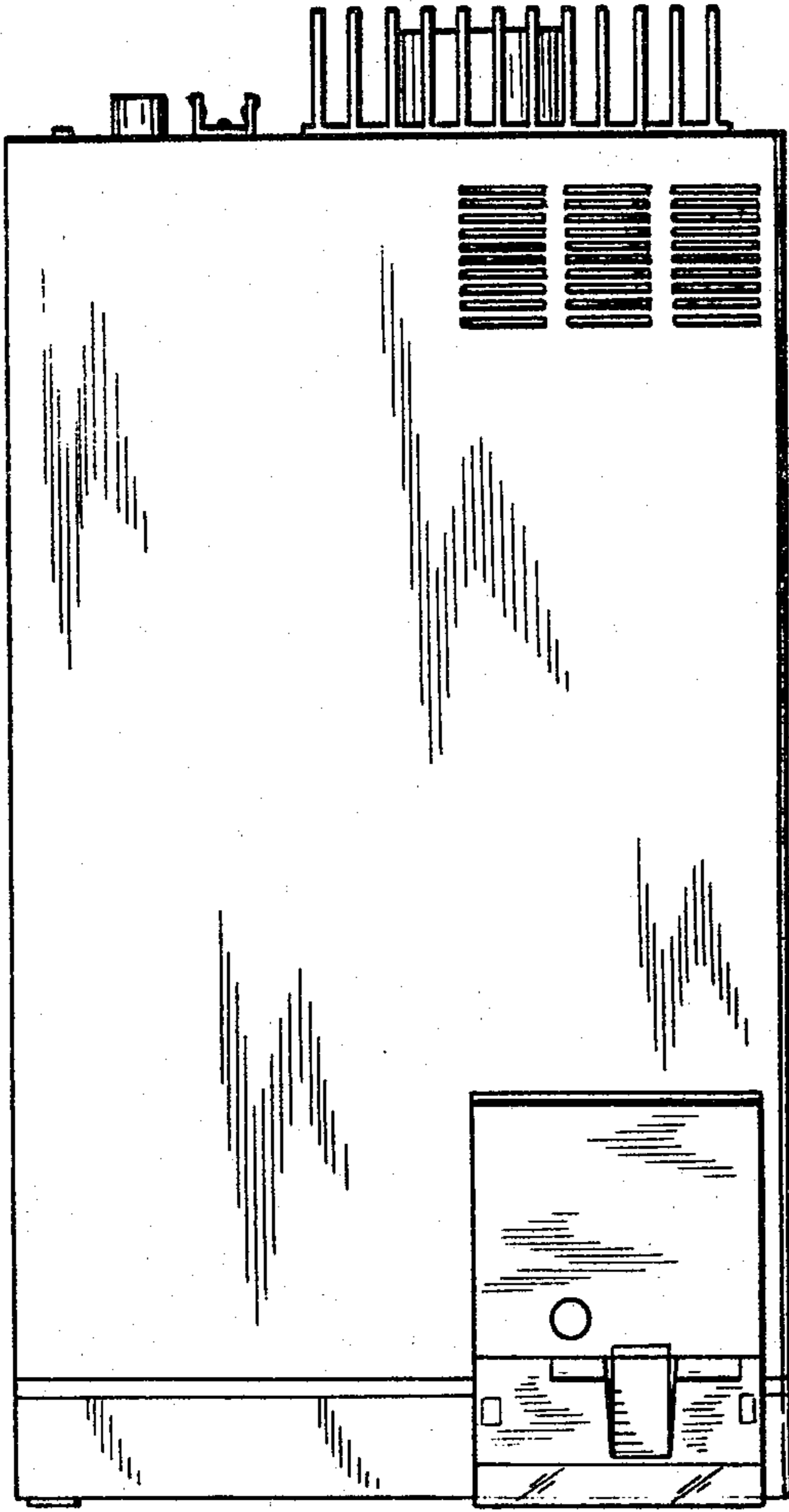

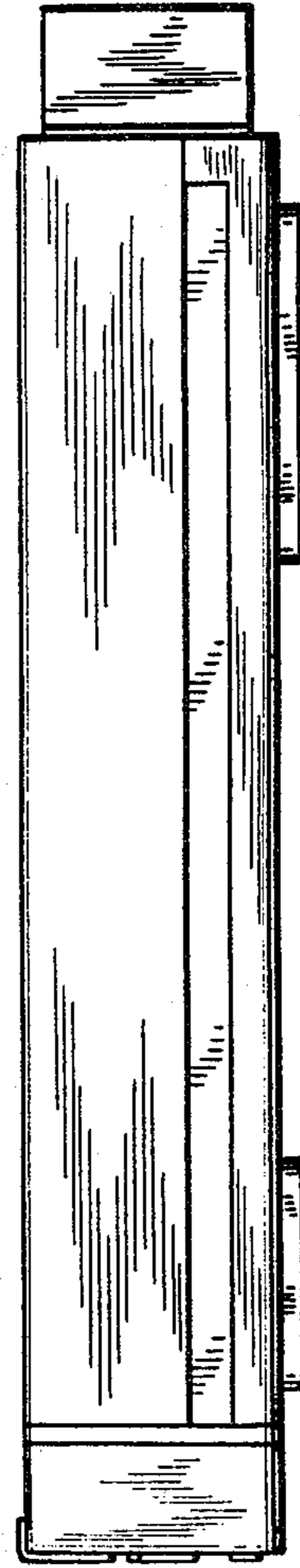

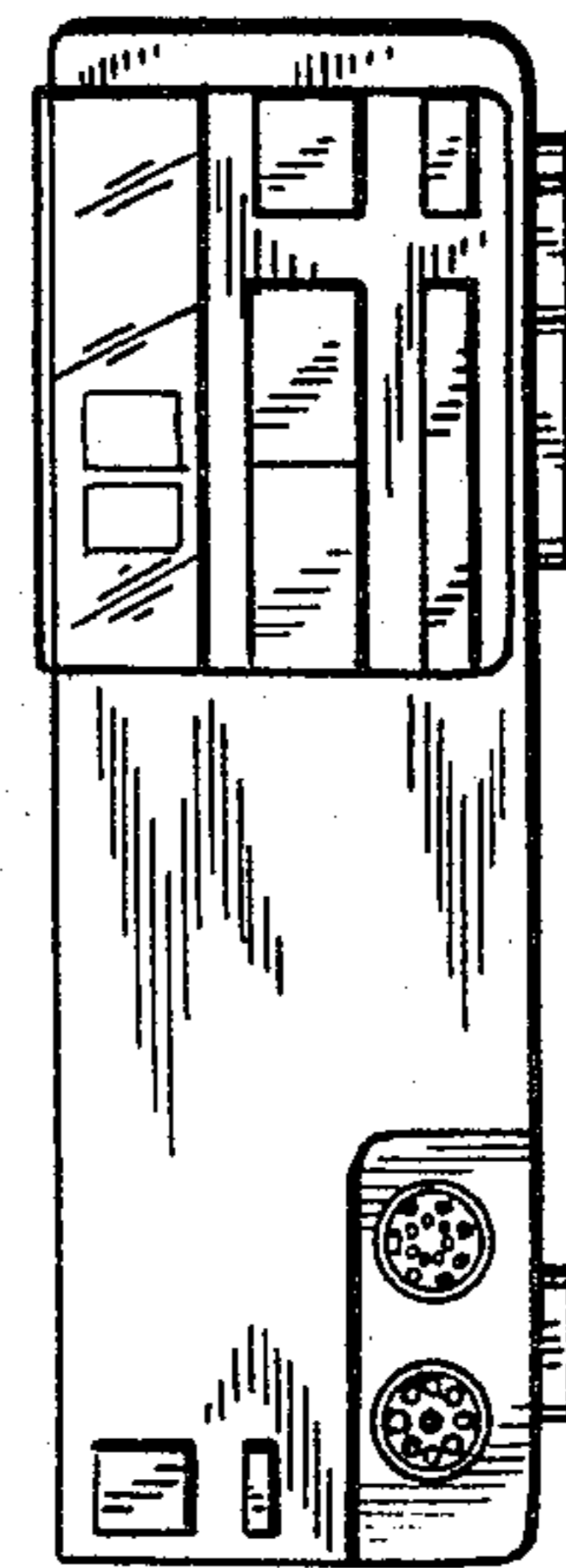

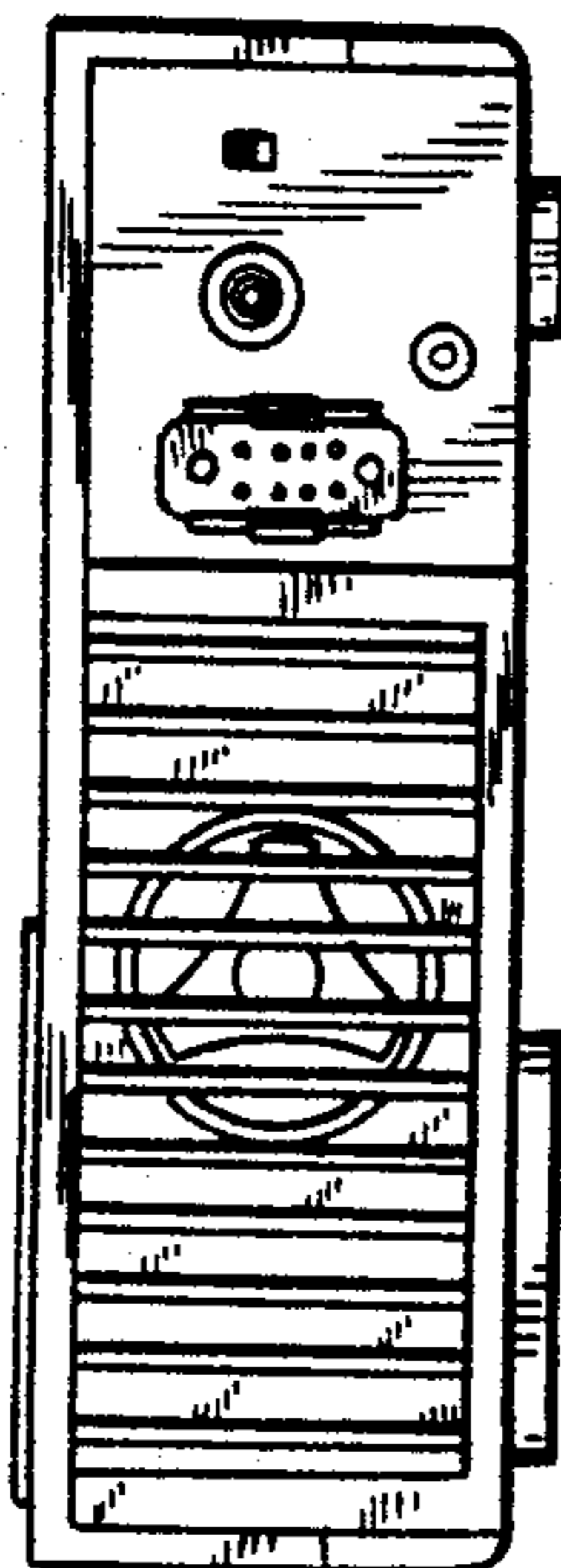
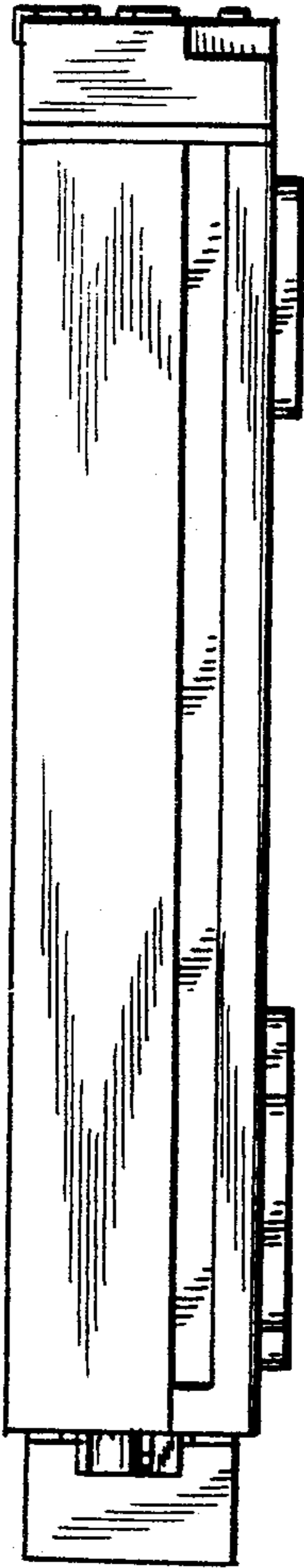

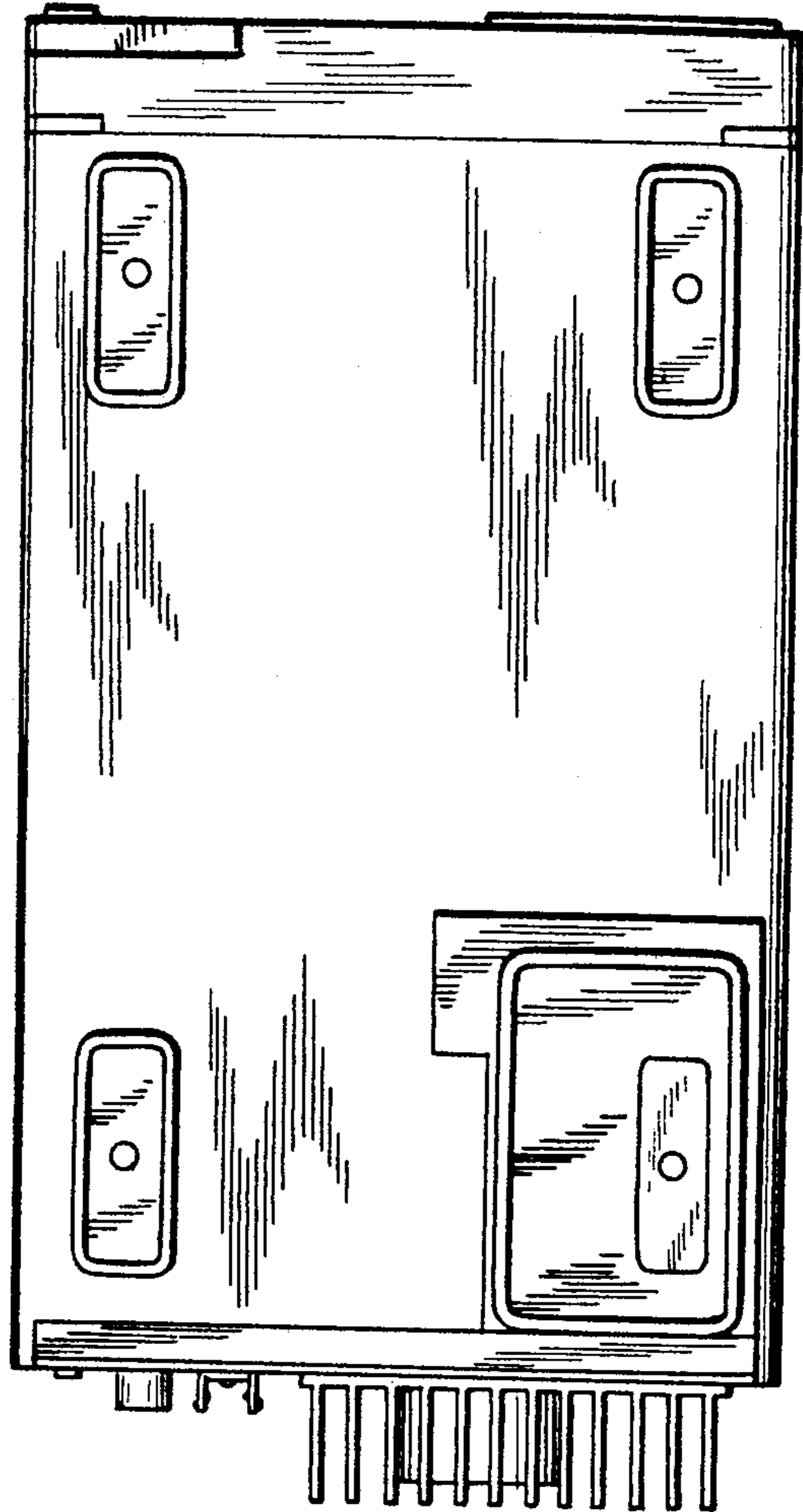

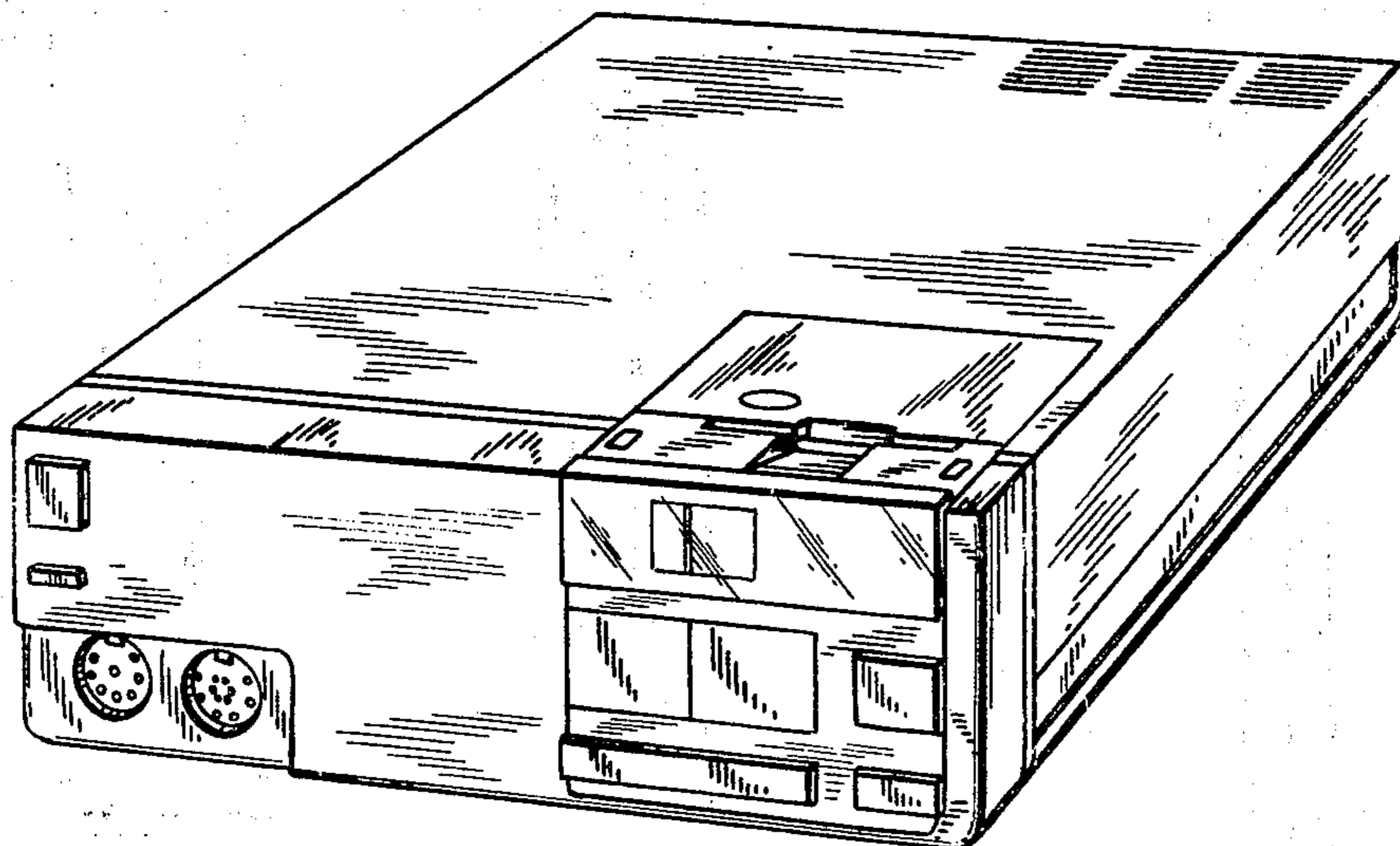
