The ornamental design for a paint can resealing press, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a paint can resealing press showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;


FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;


FIG. 6 is a side elevational view taken from the side opposite that shown in FIG. 1;


FIG. 7 is a top plan view of the press plate shown separately for clarity of illustration;
