DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a lollipop showing our new design;

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof.

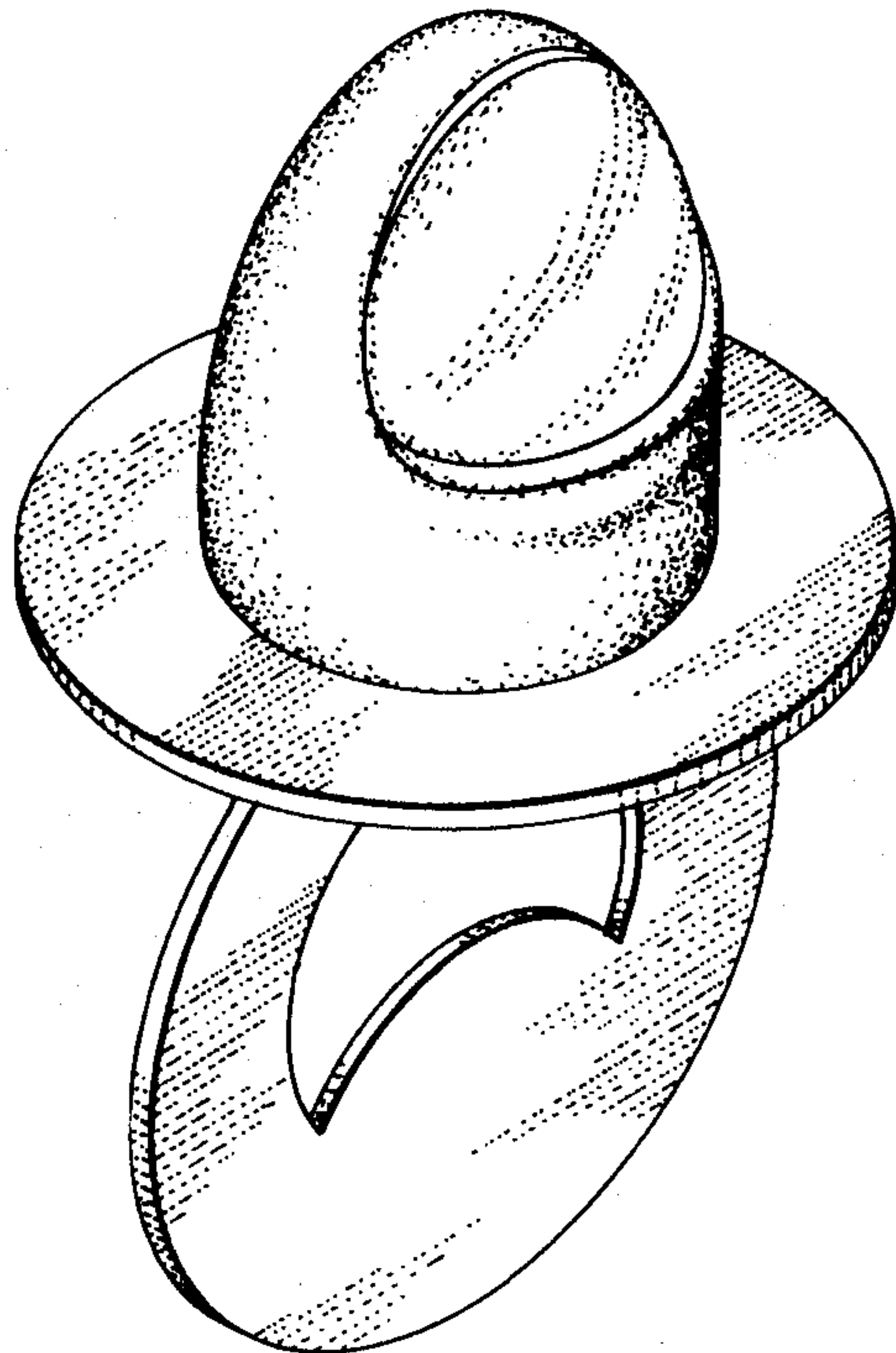

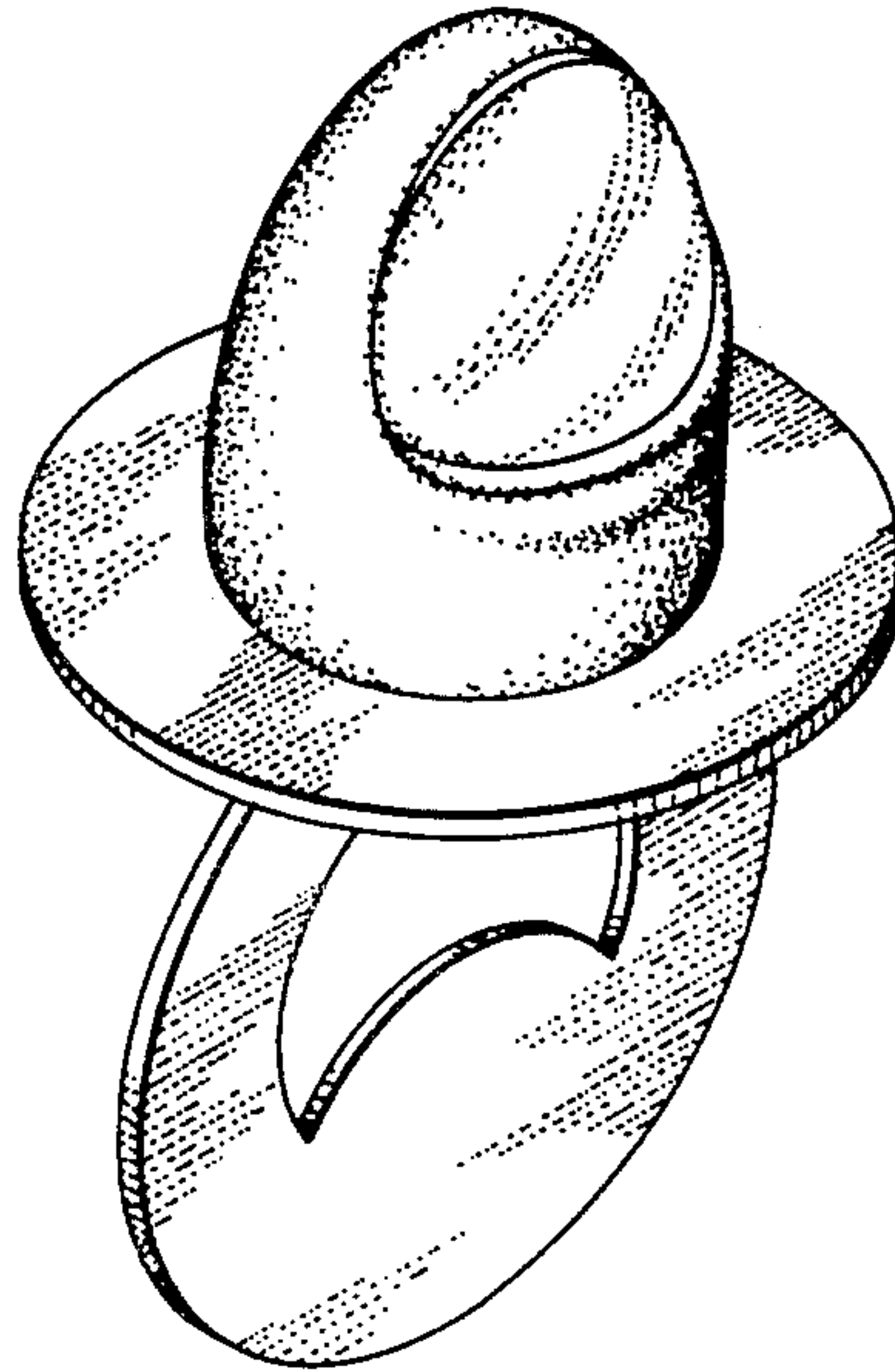

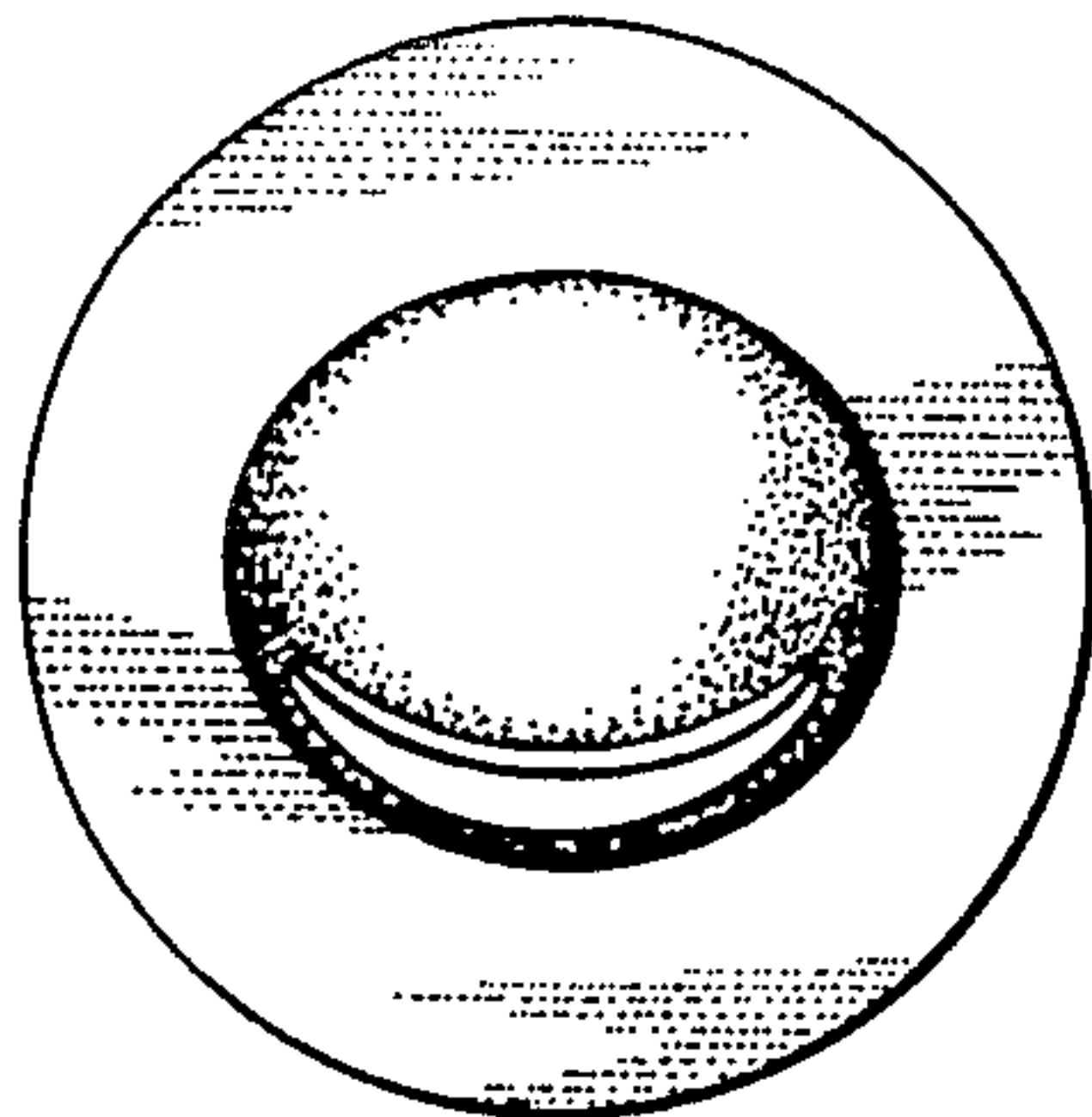

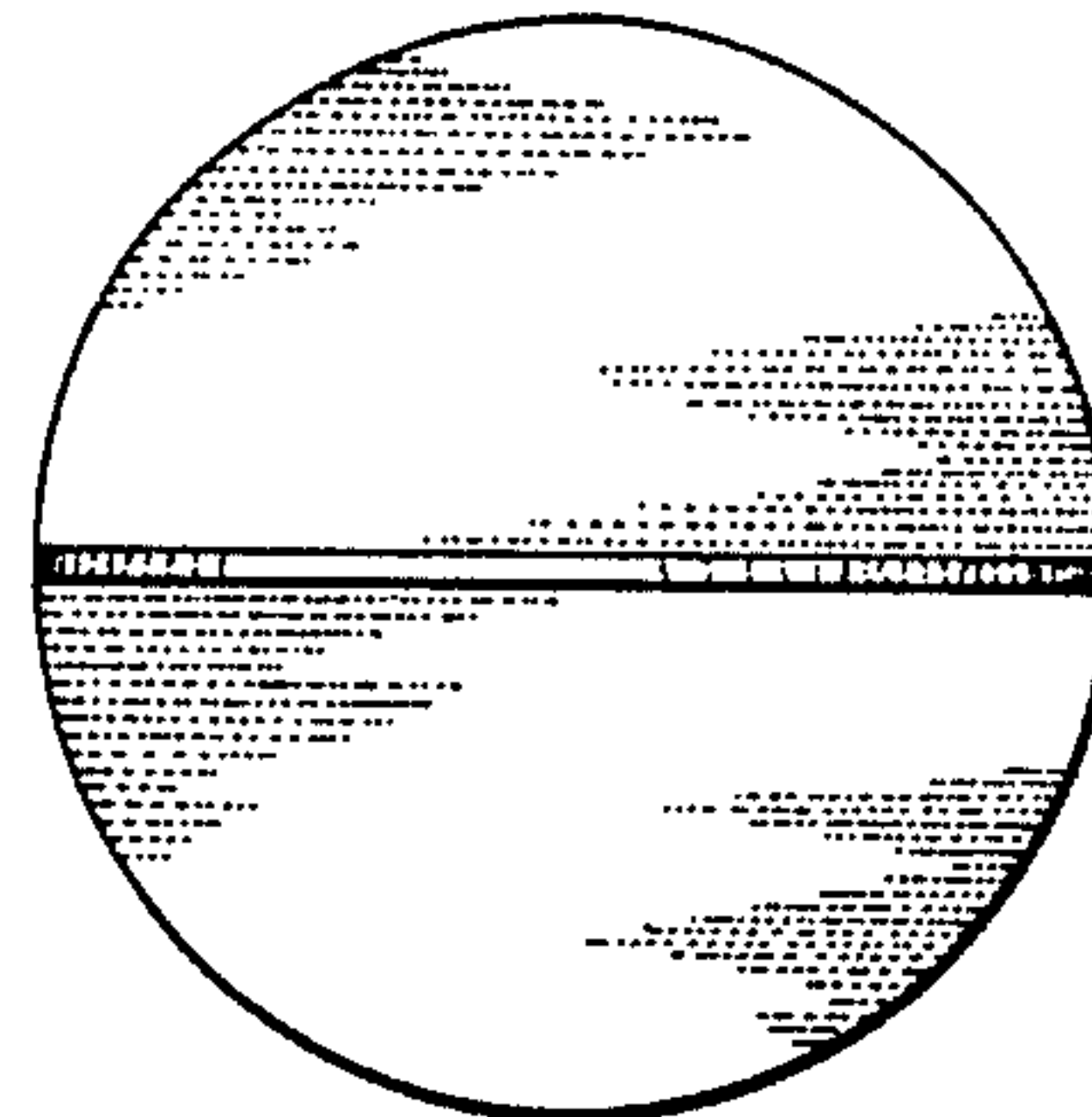

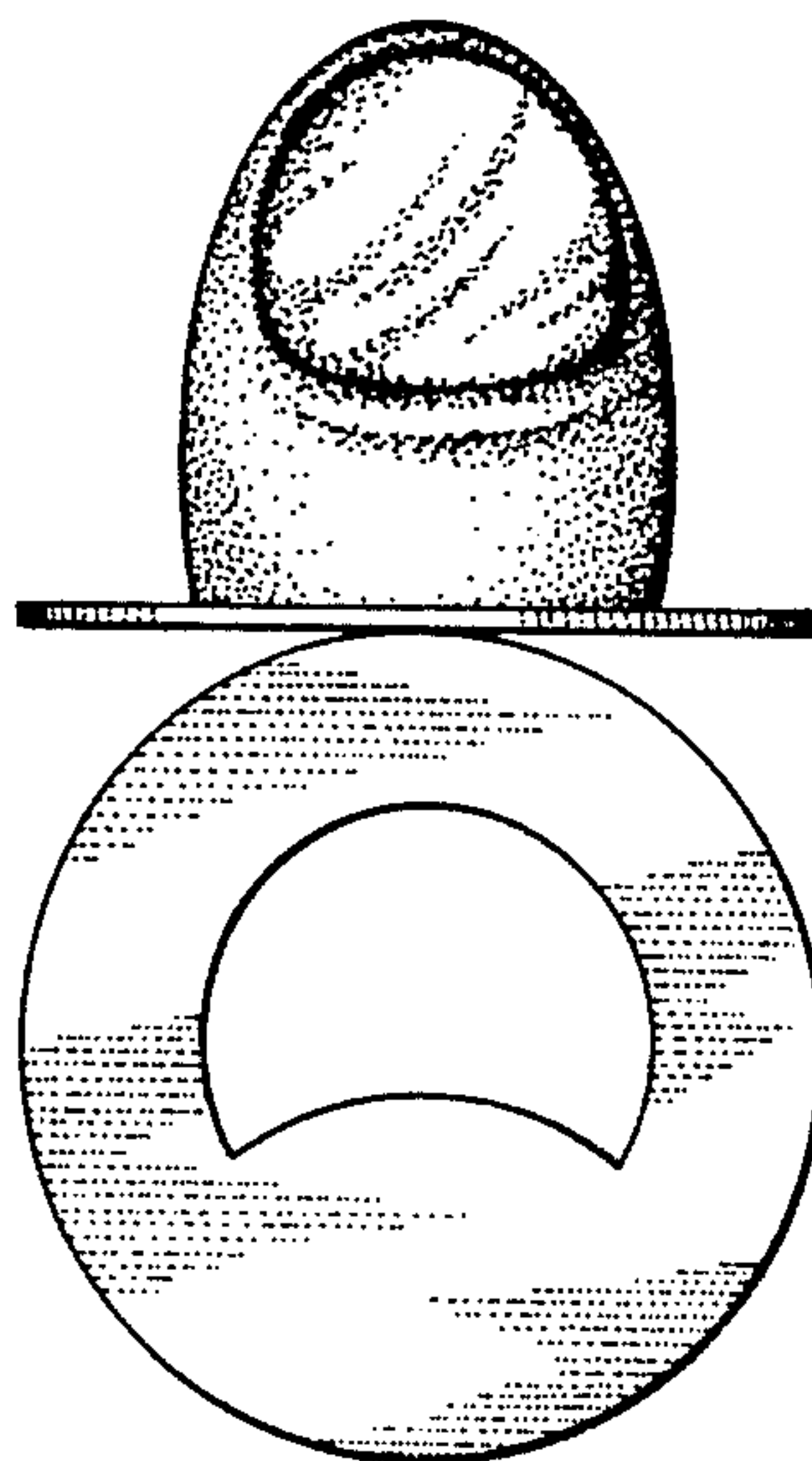

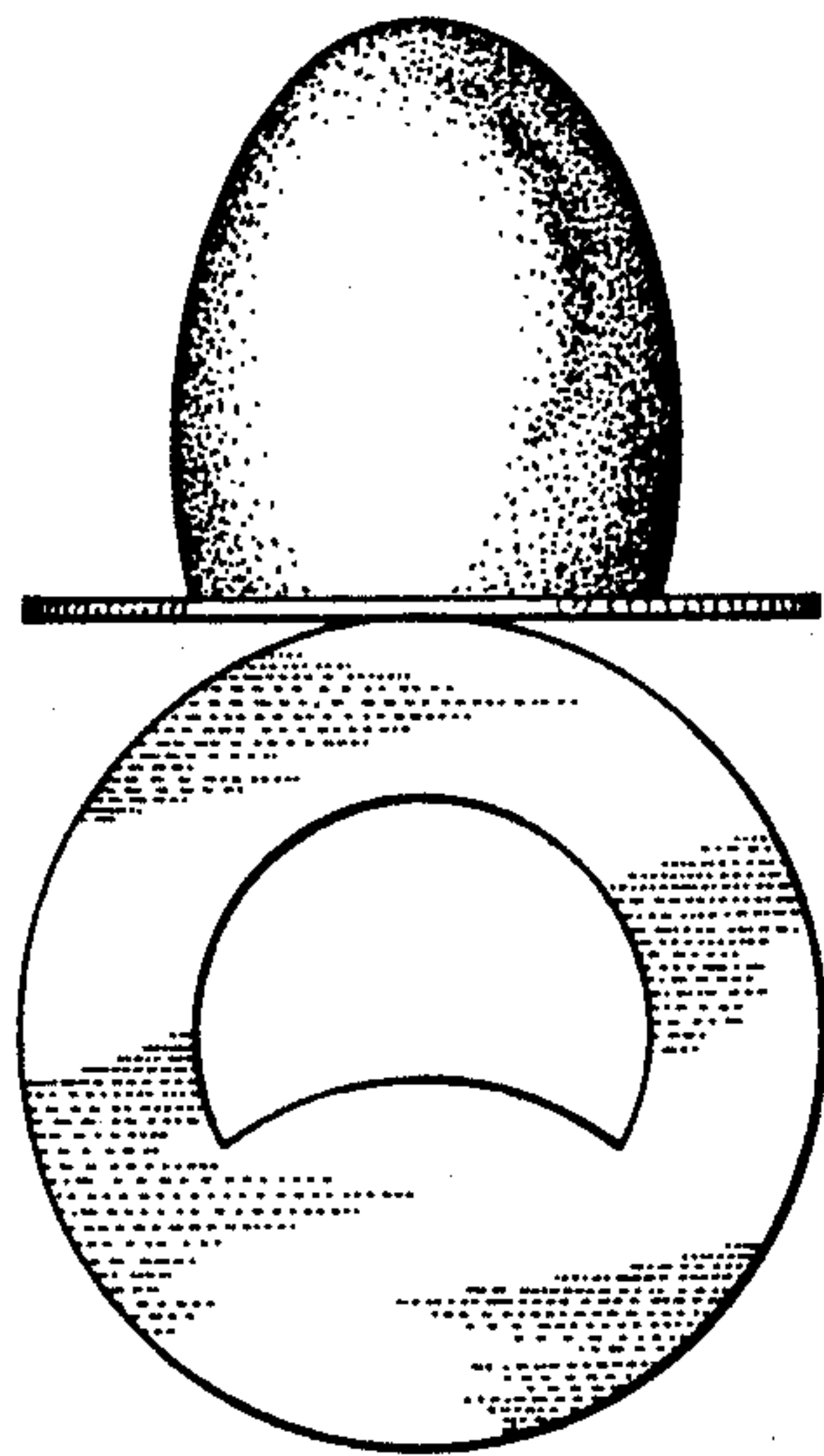
