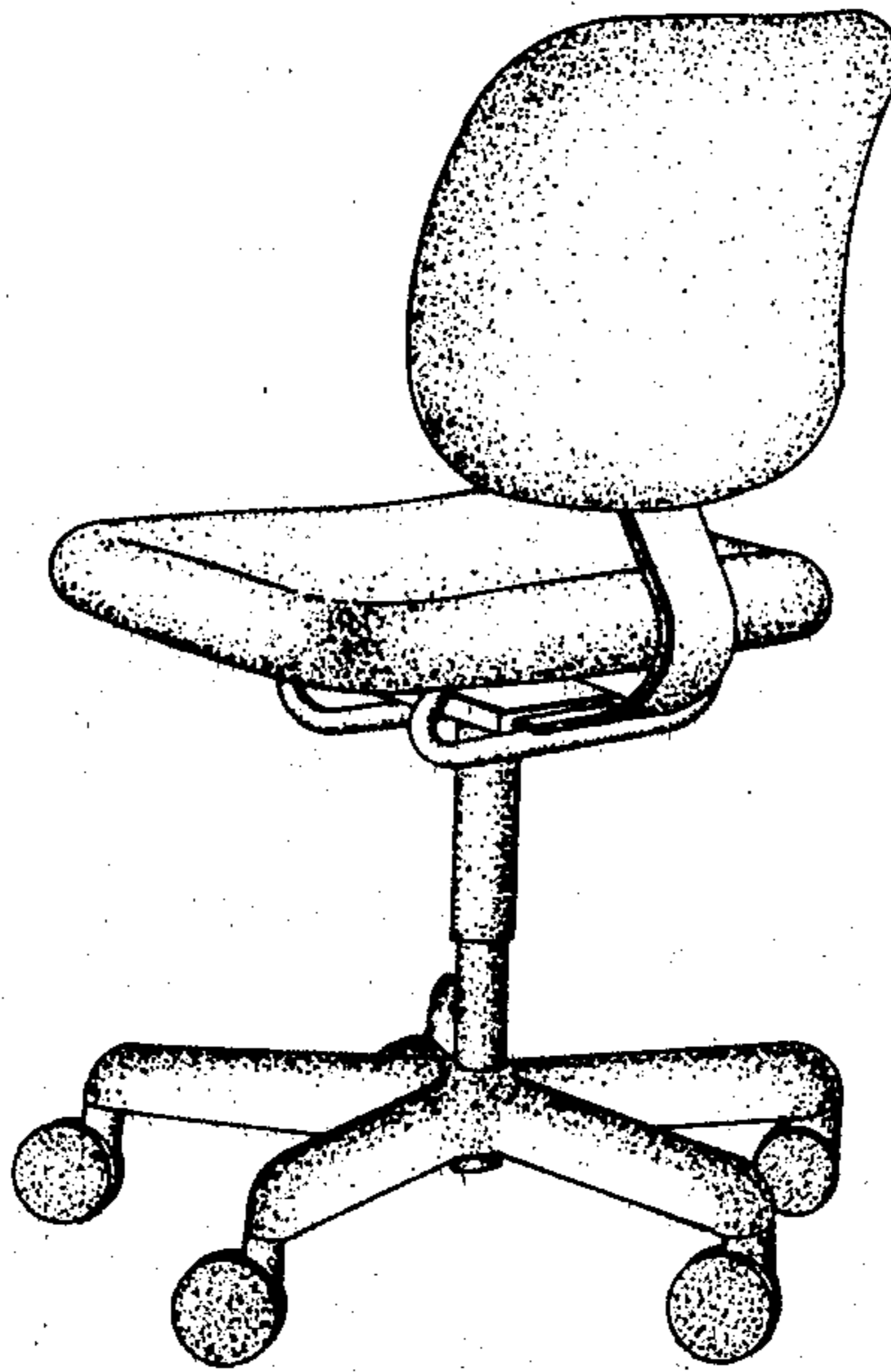

The ornamental design for a chair, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective of my new chair; FIG. 2 is a quarter rear perspective of the chair; FIG. 3 is a quarter front perspective of the chair; and FIG. 4 is a side elevation of the chair on a reduced scale, depicting the side opposite that shown in FIG. 3.



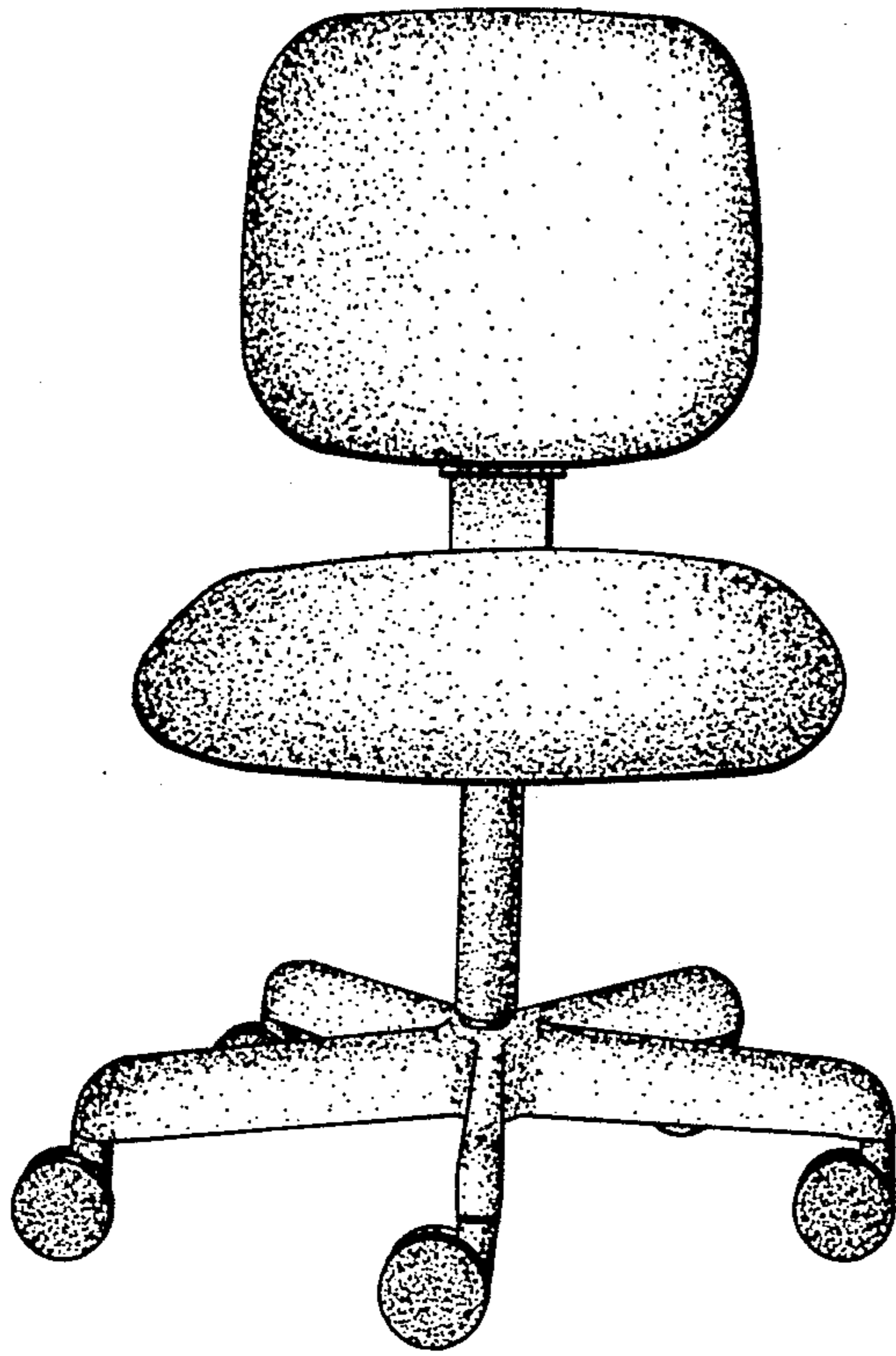

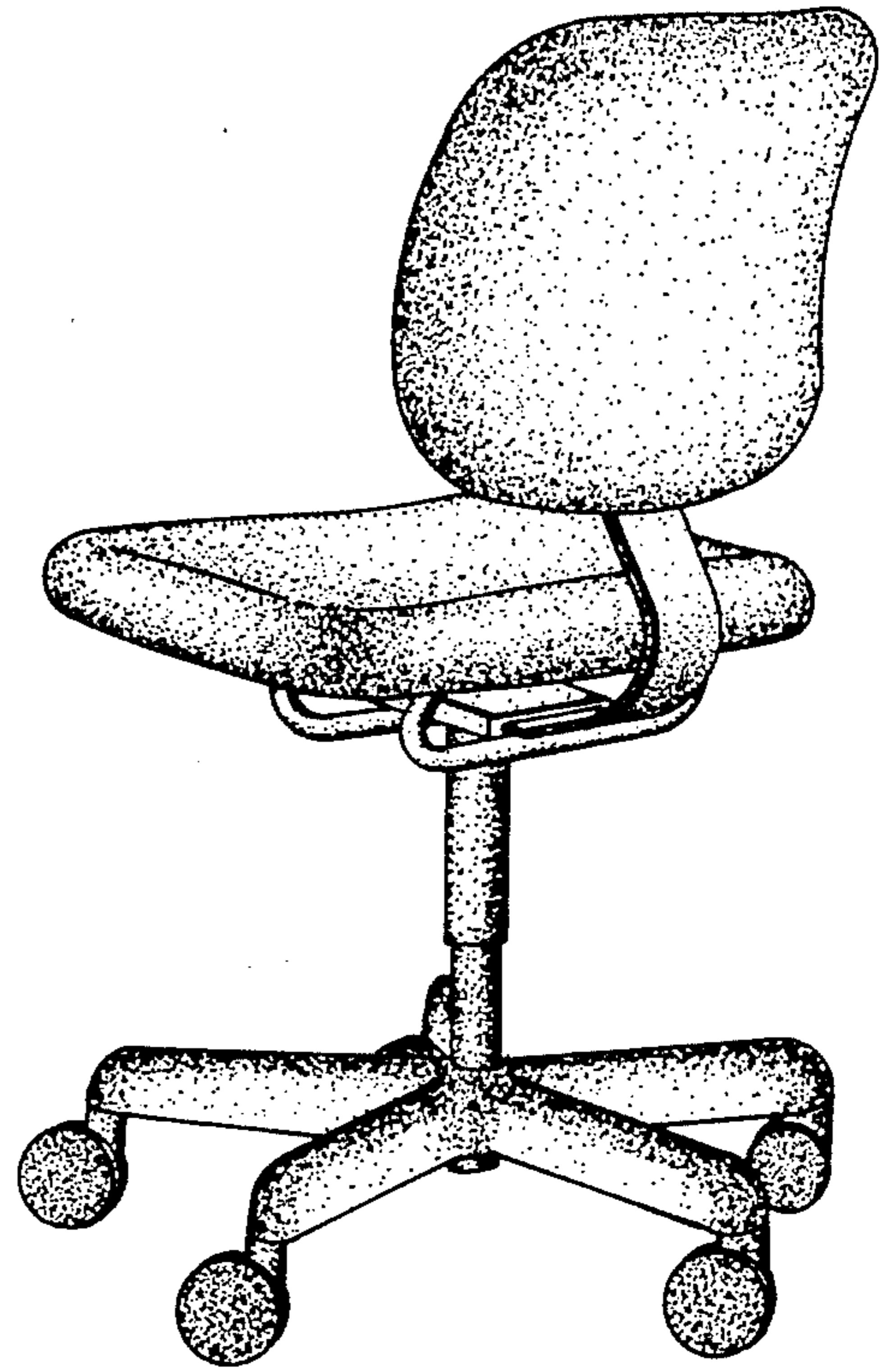

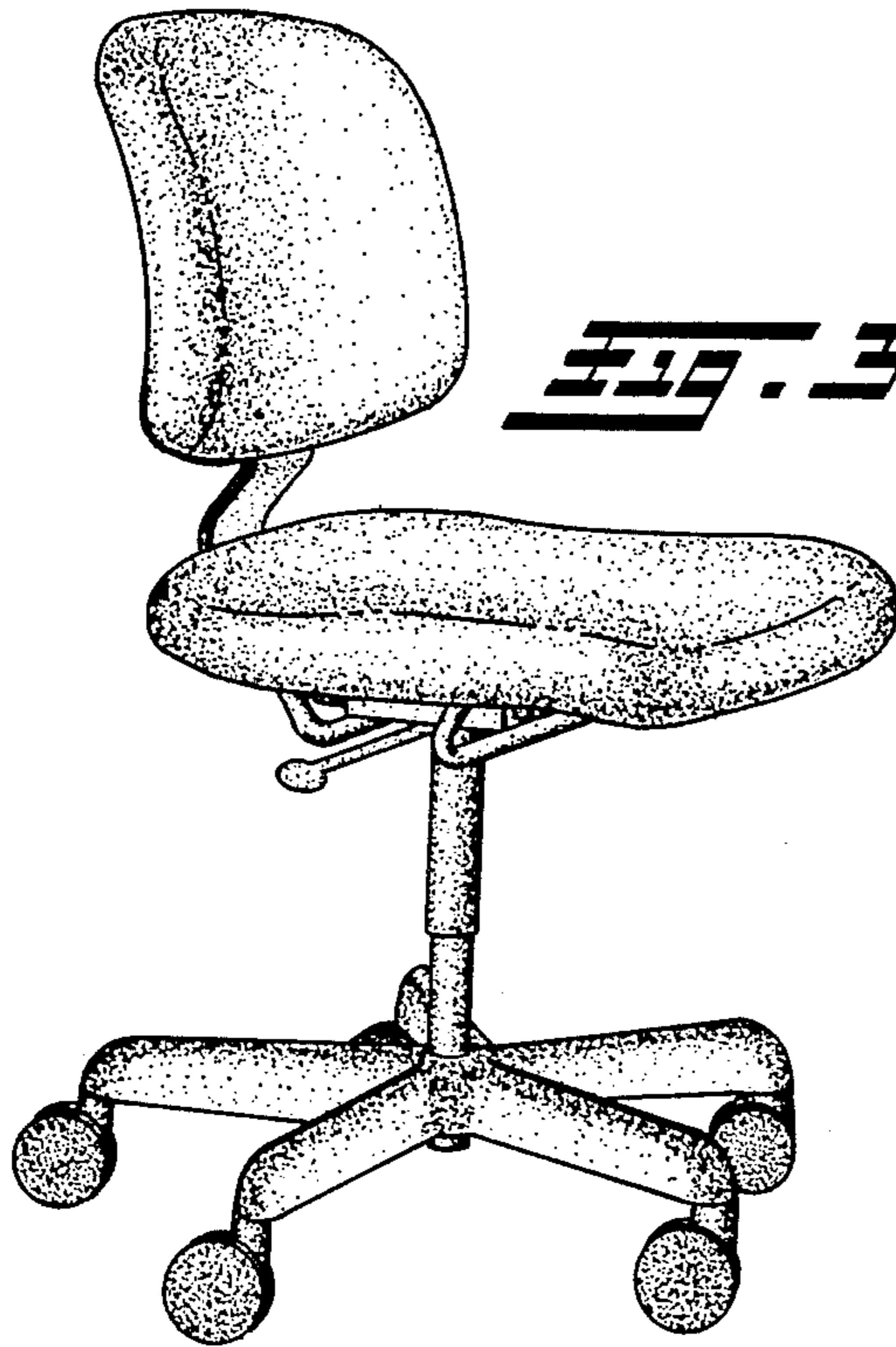

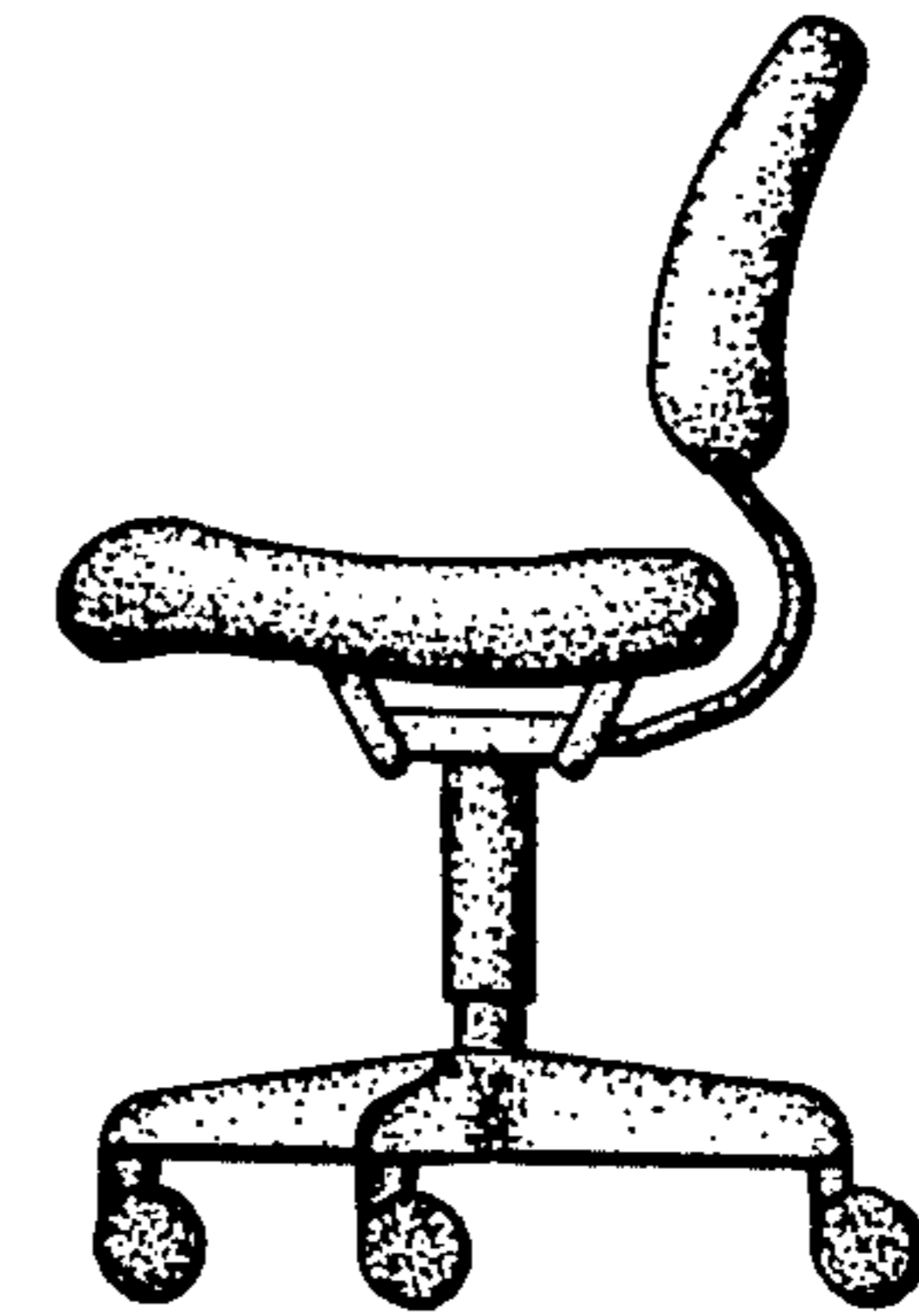
