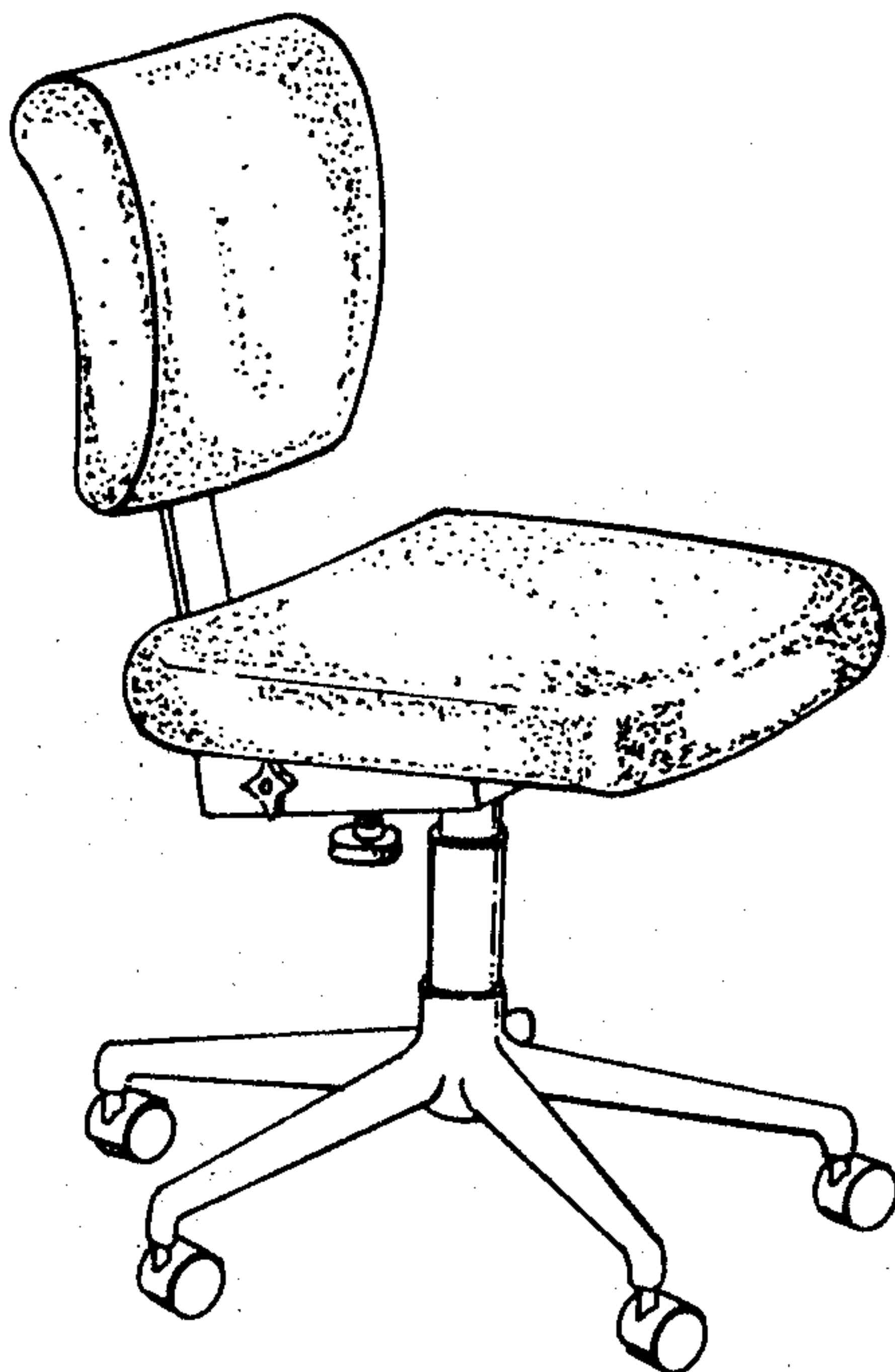

 FIG. 4 is a front perspective of an alternative embodiment thereof.



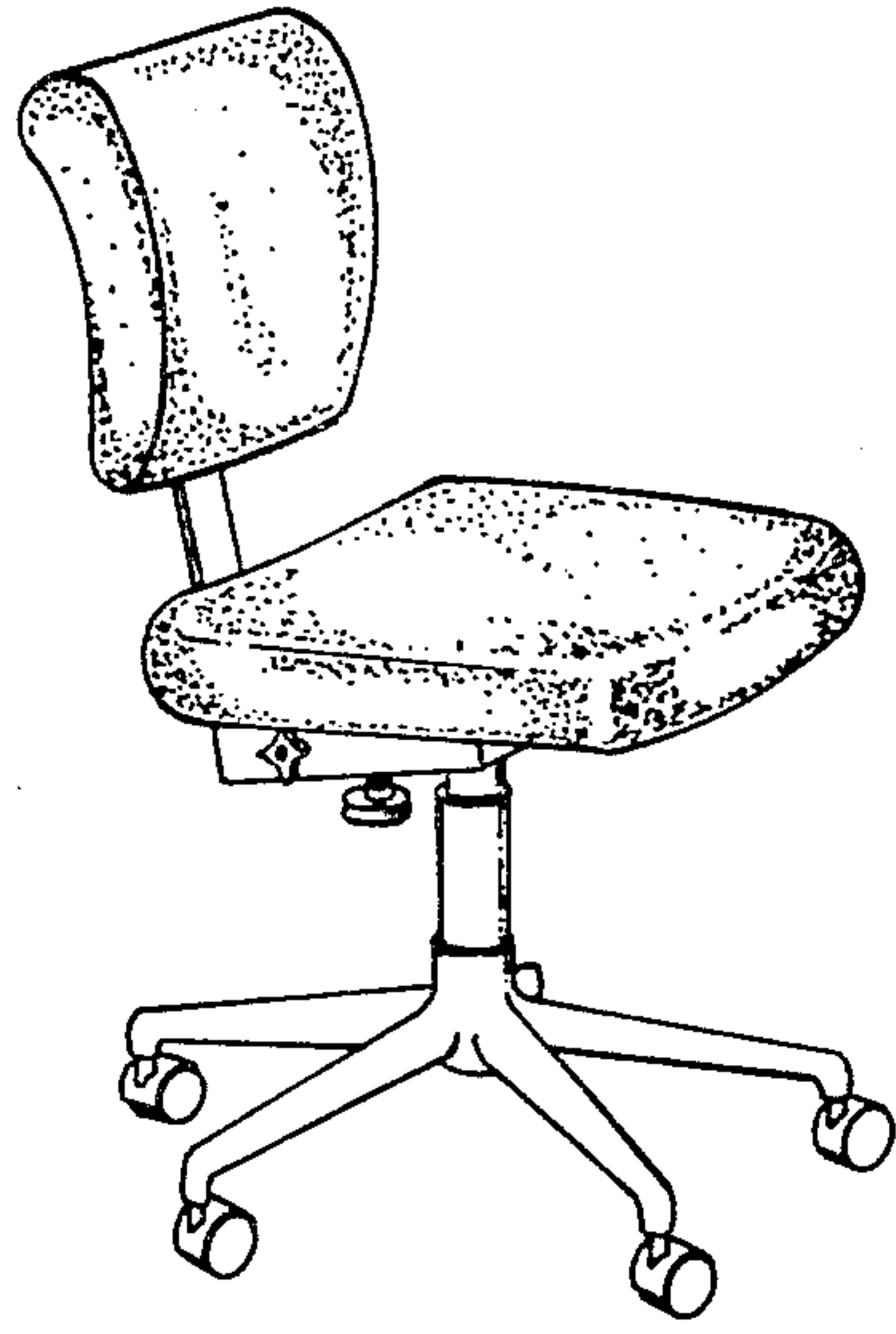

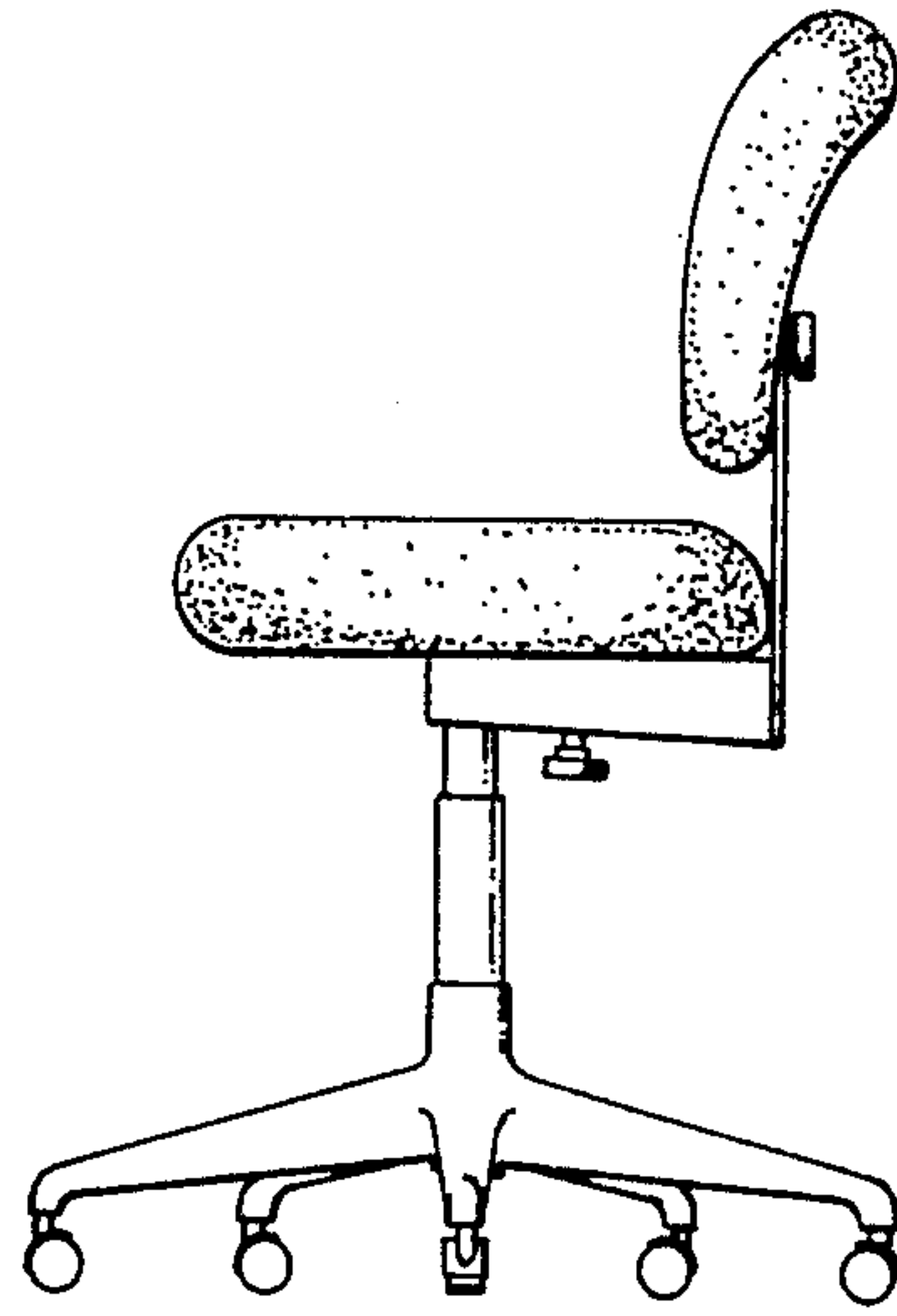

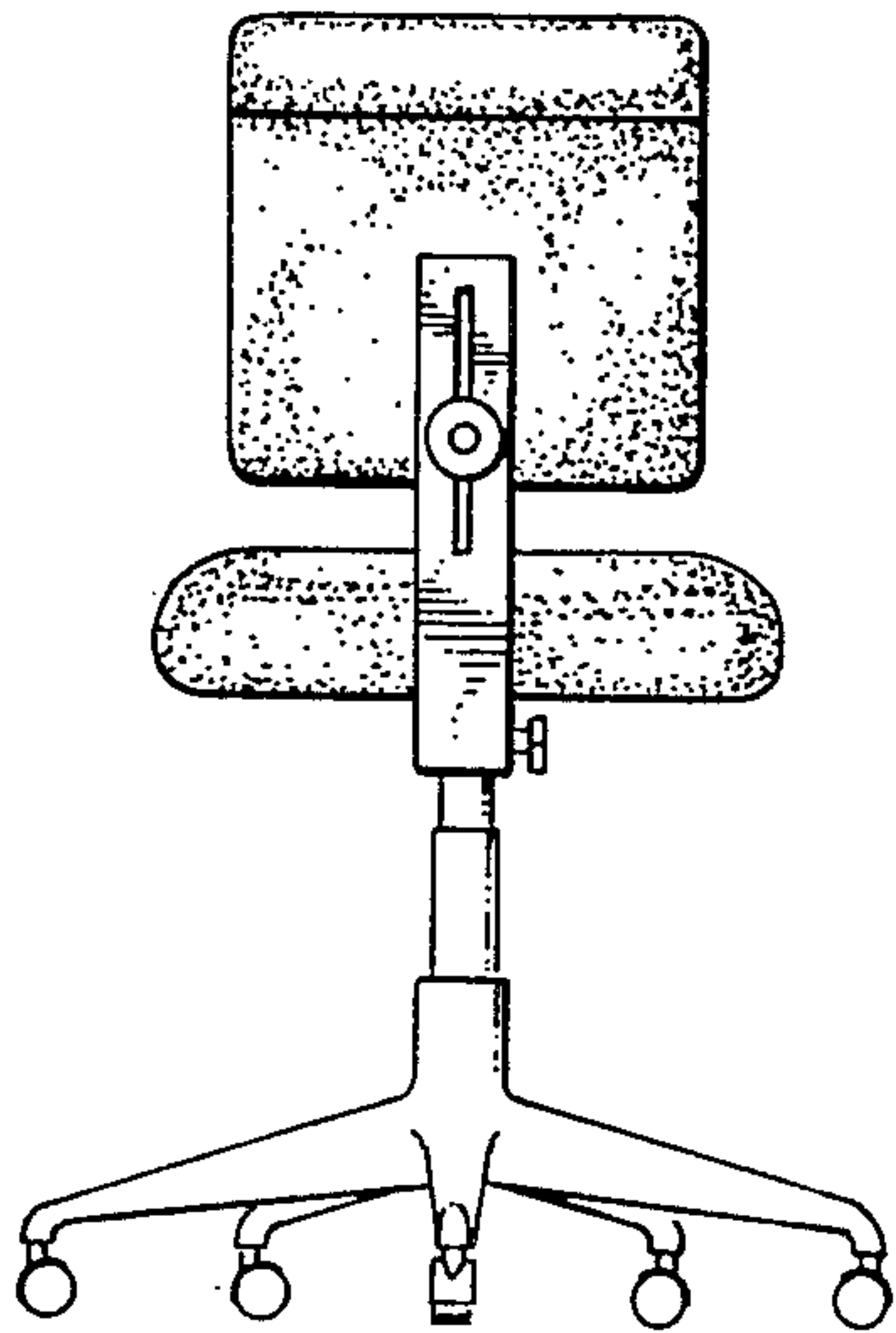

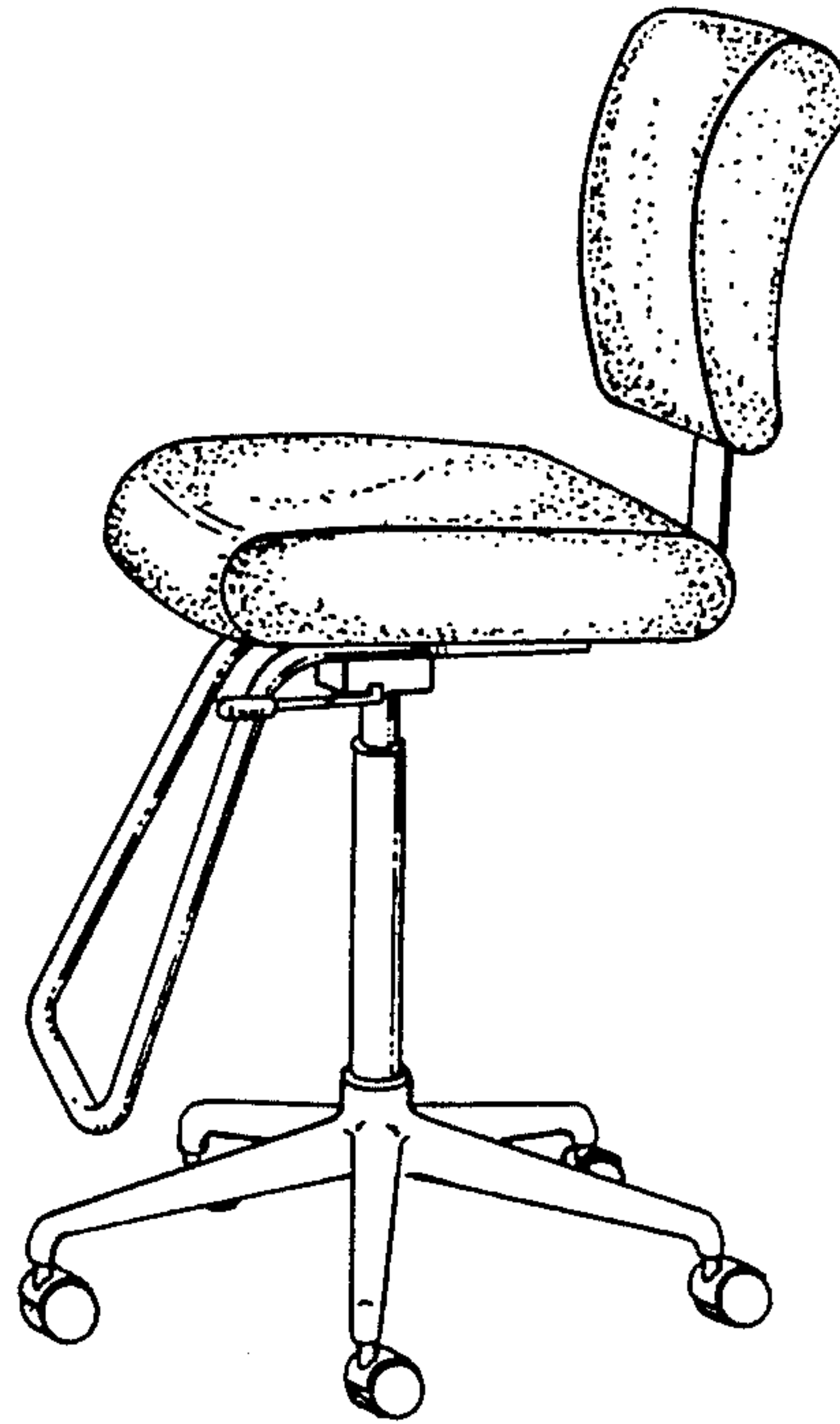
